Estimated time 30 hours or more to finish

To knit this model, you'll need:

One size: 7 skeins of PHIL ROMANCE in the colourway ECRU

Yarn composition: 100 % Polyamide

Tools & Materials needed:

PPY 5 mm knitting needles (or other size following your gauge swatch)

PPY 5 mm crochet hook

1 tapestry needle

Dimensions: 130 cm circumference, 37 cm height.

Gauge swatch & obtaining the right dimensions for your project:

When knitting your gauge swatch, it's always best to do so "in pattern". For this model we'll be using stocking stitch (stockinette) and your main gauge needles (5 mm). 21 sts. and 29 rws = a square of 10 cm x 10 cm, after blocking.

Stitch patterns used (knitting & crochet):

Stockinette (stocking stitch) = RS: K all sts, WS= P all sts.

Slip stitch (sl st): insert your crochet hook into 1 st., pull 1 loop through and pass it through the loop on your hook.

(UK:) **Double crochet (dc)** / (US:) **Single crochet (sc)**: insert your crochet hook into 1 st., pull through a loop, YO (yarn over), pull the yarn through the 2 loops on your hook.

(UK:) **Treble crochet (tr)** / (US:) **Double crochet (dc)**: Wrap the yarn over (YO) your crochet hook, insert your hook into 1 st., YO and pull the hook through 1 st., we now have 3 loops. YO again, pull through the first 2 loops, make one last YO and pull through the 2 remaining loops. We've now done one tr / dc.

CONSTRUCTION

This shawl is knit flat and seamed, the borders are done in crochet. Since UK and US crochet terminology differs, these have been colour-coded. Choose what you're most familiar with; **UK** / **US**.

KNITTING THE SHAWL

Step 1: With your 5 mm needles, CO (cast on) 78 sts. Knit in stockinette.

Step 2: At a tot. height of 130 cm, BO (bind off) all sts.

CROCHETING THE BORDER

Step 1: With your 5 mm crochet hook, crochet the border on one side at a time, by making one row of **double crochet (dc)** / **single crochet (sc)**, working in multiples of 4 + 1.

Step 2: Crochet the shells (see 2nd rw of the diagram). Stop the work, secure your threads.

Step 3: Repeat the same steps on the other side, for the second border.

SEAMING & FINISHING TOUCHES

Step 1: Make 2 twists on the shawl (so that the right sides meet up at the seam and face the same direction).

Step 2: Seam the shawl together (BO edge to CO edge).
