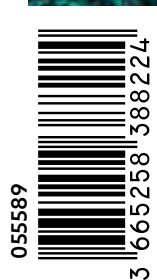
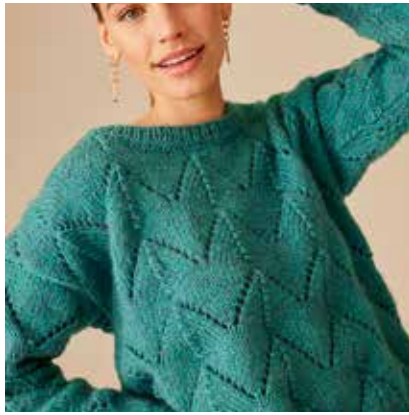

PLEASE REMEMBER TO GAUGE SWATCH

1 chevron lace repeat (16 sts.) on 5,5 mm needles, yarn held double: 1 thread of P. PARTNER 3,5 and 1 thread of P. LIGHT = 10 cm and 2 repeats in height of 18 rws = 16 cm

YARN	COLOUR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52
P. PARTNER 3,5	VERONESE or VITAMINE	7	7	8	8	9
P. LIGHT	PAON or ECUREUIL	4	4	4	4	4

Yarn composition: 43 % Polyamide - 34 % Acrylic - 17 % Worsted Wool - 6 % Wool

TOOLS & MATERIALS

5 mm knitting needles (1/1 ribbing), 5,5 mm knitting needles (chevron lace)
Stitch markers + 1 tapestry needle

STITCH PATTERNS USED

1/1 ribbing - Stockinette

Chevron lace stitch pattern: see chart

«Don't skip the gauge swatch if you want to be sure that your finished piece is top-notch!»

KNITTING THE PATTERN

BACK PIECE

With your 5 mm needles, **yarn held double**, CO 82 - 88 - 98 - 104 - 114 sts.
Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 5 cm.

Switch to your 5,5 mm needles and knit in chevron lace (see chart), making 1 inc. on the 1st row and starting on the 1st - 17th - 17th - 17th - 17th row of the chart, by making:

K2, then the 2nd st. of the chart

K5, then the 2nd st. of the chart

K2, then the 2nd st. of the chart

K5, then the 2nd st. of the chart

K2, then the 2nd st. of the chart

Your tot. stitch count should now be: 83 - 89 - 99 - 105 - 115 sts.

Armholes

At a tot. height of 32 cm, PM on both sides, at the selvedge sts.

Shoulders

At a tot. height of 52 - 53 - 54 - 55 - 56 cm, you've knit the repeat 6 times, finish in stockinette and BO on both sides:

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 6 sts. and 2 x 7 sts.

1 x 7 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 7 sts. and 1 x 8 sts.

1 x 8 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 8 sts. and 2 x 9 sts.

1 x 9 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 9 sts. and 1 x 10 sts.

1 x 10 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 10 sts. and 2 x 11 sts.

Neckline

Meanwhile, at a tot. height of 53 - 54 - 55 - 56 - 57 cm, BO the 21 centr. sts. for the neckline. Then finish one side at a time, binding off on the neckline side, 2 rws above: 1 x 5 sts.

FRONT PIECE

Knit the front piece in the same way as the back piece, until the armholes. Your tot. stitch count should be: 83 - 89 - 99 - 105 - 115 sts.

Neckline

At a tot. height of 45 - 46 - 47 - 48 - 49 cm, BO the 15 centr. sts., then finish one side at a time, BO on the neckline side, every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2

sts., 1 x 1 sts. then every 4 rws: 2 x 1 sts., pay attention: to compensate for the YO, replace the double dec. with 1 skpo (slip 1, K1, pass over.)

Shoulder

At a tot. height of 52 - 53 - 54 - 55 - 56 cm, BO on the exterior side:

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 6 sts. and 2 x 7 sts.

1 x 7 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 7 sts. and 1 x 8 sts.

1 x 8 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 8 sts. and 2 x 9 sts.

1 x 9 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 9 sts. and 1 x 10 sts.

1 x 10 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 10 sts. and 2 x 11 sts.

SLEEVES

With your 5 mm needles, **yarn held double**, CO 38 - 42 - 46 - 46 - 50 sts.
Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 6 - 6 - 5 - 5 - 4 cm.

Switch to your 5,5 mm needles and knit in chevron lace (see chart), making on the 1st row 1 - 1 - 3 - 3 - 3 inc. and starting on the 1st - 17th - 17th - 17th - 17th row of the chart, by making:

K4, then the 2nd st. of the chart

K6, then the 2nd st. of the chart

K1, then the 2nd st. of the chart

K1, then the 2nd st. of the chart

K3, then the 2nd st. of the chart

Your tot. stitch count should now be: 39 - 43 - 49 - 49 - 53 sts.

Inc. 1 st. on each side:

every 8 rws: 5 - 7 - 9 - 2 - 5 times and every 6 rws: 8 - 5 - 2 - 11 - 7 times.

We now have: 65 - 67 - 71 - 75 - 77 sts.

At a tot. height of 48 - 47 - 45 - 44 - 43 cm, loosely BO all sts.

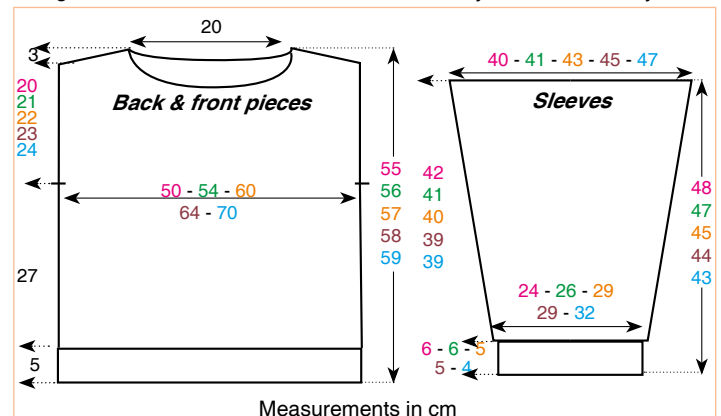
NECKBAND

With your 5 mm needles, **yarn held double**, CO 90 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 2 cm then knit a few rows of stockinette in a diff. col.

SEAMING

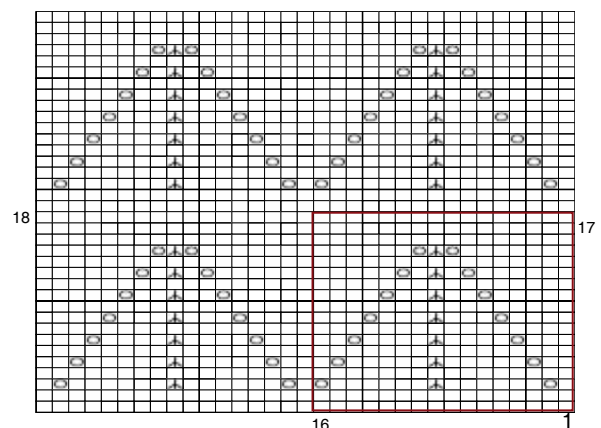
Seam the shoulders, attach the sleeves between the marked sts. indicating the back and the front. Seam the sides and the underarms.

Using backstitch, sew the neckband on the RS of your work, stitch by stitch.

Always repeat the square of 16 sts. and 18 rws

□ = K1 on the RS. P1 on the WS.

■ = YO (yarn over)

▣ = double decrease done over 3 sts. (RS): sl2tog-K1-ssso. (slip 2 sts. tog., knit 1 st., pass slipped stitches over.)
