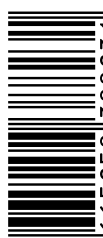

PLEASE REMEMBER TO GAUGE SWATCH

10 cm of stockinette or cables & lace stitch pattern, on 6 mm needles = 15 sts. and 23 rws

YARN	COLOUR	32/34	34/38	40/42	44/46	48/50
P. GIVRE	ROSE	6	6	7	7	8

Yarn composition: 54 % Alpaca - 46 % Polyamide

TOOLS & MATERIALS

6 mm knitting needles (stockinette, cables & lace stitch pattern)

5 mm knitting needles (1/1 ribbing)

Cable needle, tapestry needle, stitch markers

STITCH PATTERNS USED

1/1 ribbing - Stockinette - Cables and lace stitch pattern: see chart

KNITTING THE PATTERN

«A gauge swatch verified and knit, assures a project with the perfect fit ! »

BACK PIECE

With your 5 mm needles, CO 70 - 74 - 80 - 86 - 94 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 4 cm.

Switch to your 6 mm needles, knit in stockinette and cables & lace stitch pattern (see chart), while distributing 5 inc. on the 1st rw.

Your tot. stitch count should be: 75 - 79 - 85 - 91 - 99 sts.

Distribute your sts. in the following way (you can separate them using stitch markers): 23 - 25 - 28 - 31 - 35 sts. in stockinette, the 29 sts. of the chart, then the last 23 - 25 - 28 - 31 - 35 sts. in stockinette.

Armholes

At a tot. height of 36 cm, BO on both sides: 1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 2 sts. and 1 x 1 sts.

We have 63 - 67 - 73 - 79 - 87 sts. left.

Shoulders

At a tot. height of 55 - 56 - 57 - 58 - 59 cm, BO for the shoulders on both sides:

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 4 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts. and 2 x 5 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 5 sts. and 1 x 6 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 6 sts.

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 7 sts.

Neckline

At a tot. height of 56 - 57 - 58 - 59 - 60 cm, BO the 15 - 15 - 15 - 17 - 17 centr. sts., then finish one side at a time, BO on the neckline side, 2 rws above: 1 x 8 sts.

FRONT PIECE

Knit the front piece in the same way as the back piece, until the armholes.

Your tot. stitch count should be: 63 - 67 - 73 - 79 - 87 sts.

Neckline

At a tot. height of 49 - 50 - 51 - 52 - 53 cm, BO the 11 - 11 - 11 - 13 - 13 centr. sts., then finish one side at a time, BO on the neckline side: every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 2 x 1 sts. and 4 rws above: 1 x 1 sts.

Shoulder

At a tot. height of 55 - 56 - 57 - 58 - 59 cm, BO on the armhole side:

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 4 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts. and 2 x 5 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 5 sts. and 1 x 6 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 6 sts.

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 7 sts.

SLEEVES

With your 5 mm needles, CO 38 - 42 - 44 - 48 - 52 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 6 cm.

Switch to your 6 mm needles, knit in stockinette and cables & lace stitch pattern, while distributing 9 - 9 - 9 - 9 - 7 inc. on the 1st rw.

Your tot. stitch count should be: 47 - 51 - 53 - 57 - 59 sts.

Distribute your sts. in the following way: 9 - 11 - 12 - 14 - 15 sts. in stockinette, the 29 sts. of the chart, then the last 9 - 11 - 12 - 14 - 15 sts. in stockinette.

Inc. 1 sts. on each side:

every 14 rws: 5 times

every 14 rws: 5 times

every 14 rws: 5 times

every 14 rws: 4 times and 12 rws above: 1 time

14 rws above: 1 time and every 12 rws: 4 times

Your tot. stitch count should be: 57 - 61 - 63 - 67 - 69 sts.

Rounding the shape

At a tot. height of 43 - 42,5 - 41,5 - 40,5 - 38,5 cm, BO on both sides:

1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts., 6 x 1 sts., 1 x 2 sts. and 2 x 3 sts.

1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 4 x 1 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 3 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 4 x 1 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 3 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts., 4 x 1 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 1 x 3 sts. and 1 x 4 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts., 4 x 1 sts., 1 x 2 sts., 2 x 3 sts. and 1 x 4 sts.

BO the remaining 13 sts.

NECKBAND

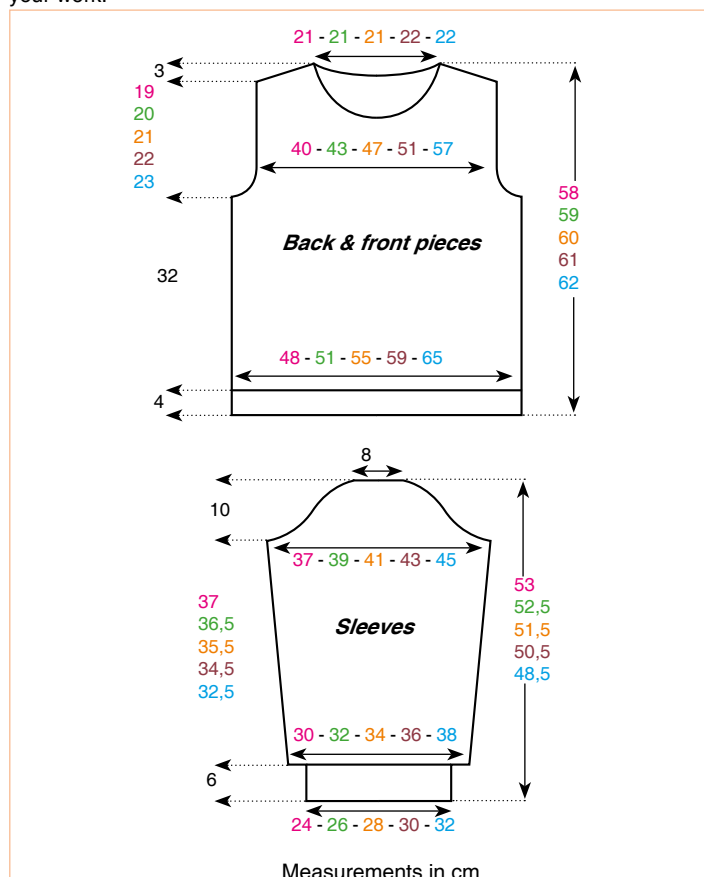
With your 5 mm needles, CO 86 - 86 - 86 - 90 - 90 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 3,5 cm, then knit 1 rw on the RS and knit a few rows of stock. in a diff. col.

SEAMING

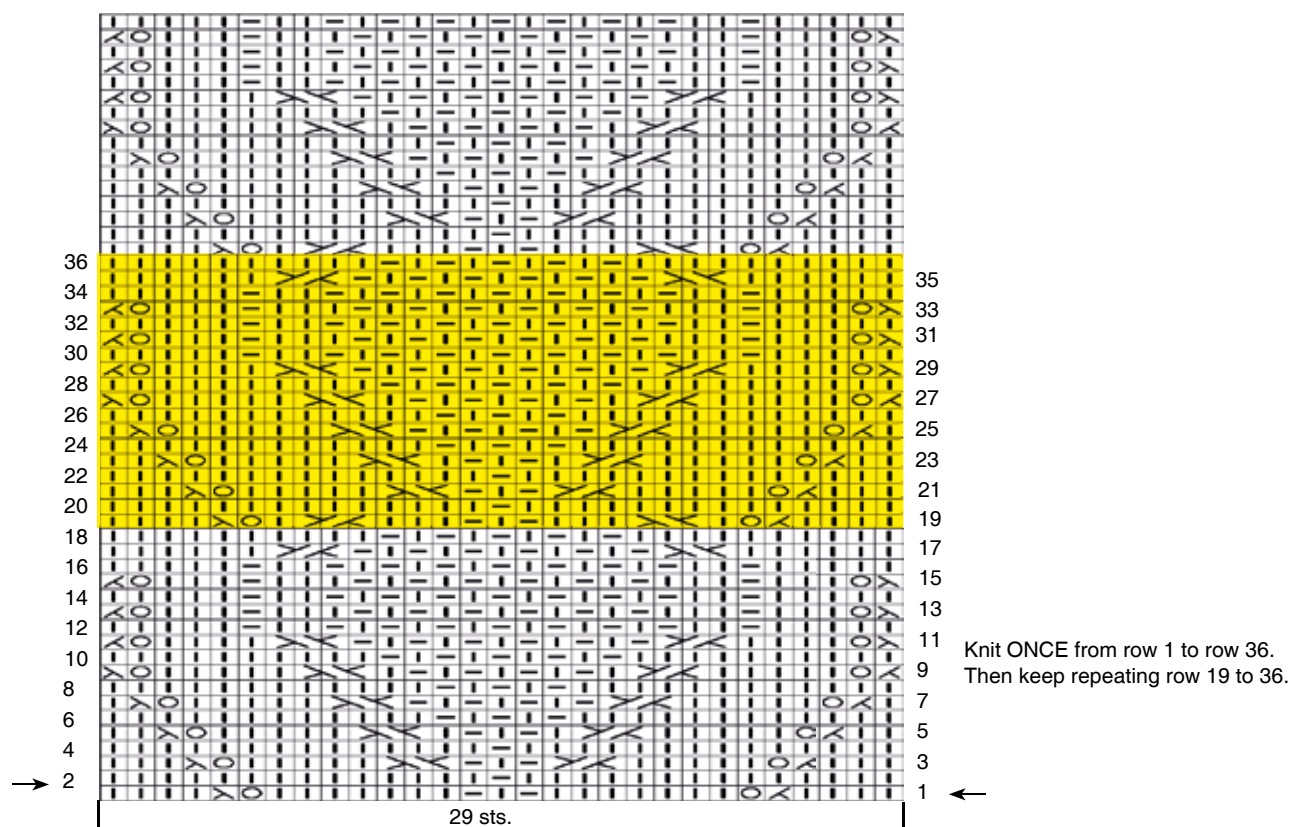
Seam the shoulders, the sides and the underarms.

Attach the sleeves to the body.

Using backstitch, attach the neckband stitch by stitch on the right side of your work.
