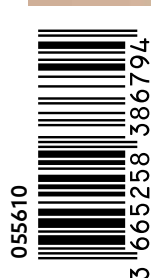

PLEASE REMEMBER TO GAUGE SWATCH

10 cm of stockinette or lace stitch on 5 mm needles = 16 sts. and 24 rws

YARN	COLOUR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52
P. EDEN	NATUREL	7	7	8	8	9

Yarn composition: 40 % Acrylic - 30 % Mohair - 30 % Polyamide

TOOLS & MATERIALS

4,5 mm needles (1/1 ribbing) - 5 mm needles (lace stitch - stockinette)
Stitch markers

1/1 ribbing

Stockinette

Lace stitch pattern (see chart)

«A gauge swatch verified and knit, assures a project with the perfect fit ! »

I-CORD: over 5 sts.

RS (right side): K the 1st st., Yf (yarn forwards), sl (slip) the 2nd st. pw (purlwise), Yb (yarn back), K the 3rd st., Yf, sl the 4th st. pw, Yb, K the 5th st.

WS (wrong side): sl the 1st st. pw wyif (with yarn in front), Yb, K the following st., Yf, slip the 3rd st. pw, Yb, K the following st., Yf, slip the 5th st. pw. Keep repeating these 2 rows.

KNITTING THE PROJECT

BACK PIECE

With your 4,5 mm needles, CO (cast on) 81 - 87 - 93 - 99 - 109 sts. Knit 1/1 ribbing for 6 cm.

Switch to your 5 mm needles, knit in stockinette and I-cord, in the following way:

5 sts. of the I-cord (see stitch patterns used), 71 - 77 - 83 - 89 - 99 sts. in stockinette and 5 sts. of the I-cord.

At a tot. height of 12 cm, PM (place stitch markers) on the selvedge sts. to indicate the beginning of the seam.

Cont. (continue) by knitting all sts. in stockinette.

Armholes

At a tot. height of 34 cm (measured from the centre of your work), PM on the selvedge sts. (indicating the seam).

Cont. by knitting the first and last 5 sts. as an I-cord and all sts. in between in stockinette.

Inc. (increase) 1 st. on each side 5 sts. away from the sides:

every 12 rws: 3 times and every 10 rws: 2 times.

every 12 rws: 5 times.

every 12 rws: 5 times.

14 rws above: 1 time and every 12 rws: 4 times.

every 14 rws: 2 times and every 12 rws: 3 times.

We have: 91 - 97 - 103 - 109 - 119 sts.

Neckline

At a tot. height of 59 - 60 - 61 - 62 - 63 cm (measured from the centre of your work), BO (bind off) for the neckline on the 23 - 23 - 23 - 25 - 25 centr. sts., then cont. one side at a time, binding off on the neckline side: 1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 2 sts. and 1 x 1 st.

Shoulder

At a tot. height of 62 - 63 - 64 - 65 - 66 cm (measured on the neckline side), BO the 25 - 28 - 31 - 33 - 38 sts. remaining.

FRONT PIECE

With your 4,5 mm needles, CO 81 - 87 - 93 - 99 - 109 sts. Knit 1/1 ribbing for 6 cm.

Switch to your 5 mm needles, knit in stockinette, the lace stitch pattern and I-cord, in the following way:

5 sts. of the I-cord (see stitch patterns used), 12 - 15 - 18 - 21 - 26 sts. in stockinette, the 47 sts. of the lace stitch pattern (see chart), 12 - 15 - 18 - 21 - 26 sts. in stockinette and 5 sts. of the I-cord.

At a tot. height of 12 cm, PM on the selvedge sts. to indicate the beginning of the seam.

Cont. by knitting in stockinette and the lace stitch pattern.

Armhole

At a tot. height of 34 cm (measured from the centre of your work), PM on the selvedge sts. Replace the 5 sts. of stockinette on each side (the first and last 5 sts. of your rw) with the 5 sts. of i-cord. Inc. 1 st. at 5 sts. from each side (start and end of your rw):

every 12 rws: 3 times and every 10 rws: 2 times.

every 12 rws: 5 times.

every 12 rws: 5 times.

14 rws above: 1 time and every 12 rws: 4 times.

every 14 rws: 2 times and every 12 rws: 3 times.

Neckline

At a tot. height of 35 - 36 - 37 - 38 - 39 cm, BO the centr. st., then cont. one side at a time, binding off on the neckline side:

4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., *4 rws above: 1 x 1 st. and 2 rws above: 1 x 1 st.* rep. from *to* 9 times tot. and 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st.

every 2 rws: 2 x 1 st., *4 rws above: 1 x 1 st. and 2 rws above: 1 x 1 st.* rep. from *to* 9 times tot. and 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st.

Shoulder

At a tot. height of 62 - 63 - 64 - 65 - 66 cm (measured on the neckline side), BO the 25 - 28 - 31 - 33 - 38 sts. remaining.

NECKBAND

With your 4,5 mm needles, CO 147 - 147 - 147 - 151 - 151 sts. Knit 1/1 ribbing while binding off on each side, every rw: 1 x 1 st. for 4,5 cm (10 rws).

We have: 127 - 127 - 127 - 131 - 131 sts. left, BO all sts.

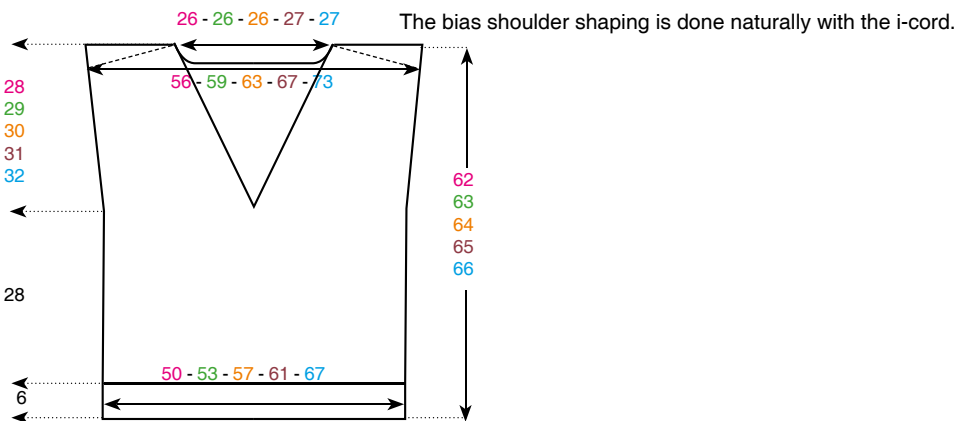
SEAMING

Seam the shoulders.

Seam the sides (refer to your stitch markers).

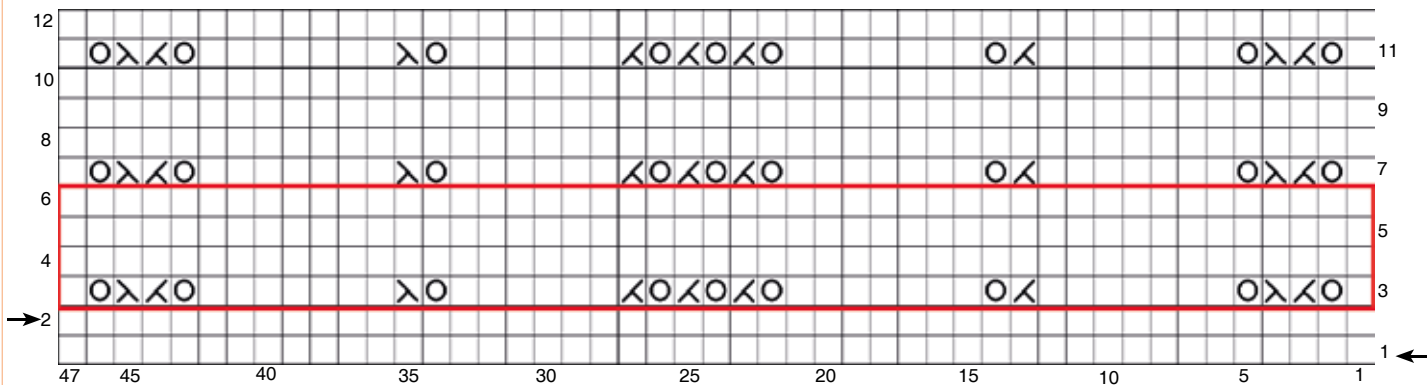
Sew the 2 points of the neckband together then place the cast on rw around the neckline and attach the neckband.
