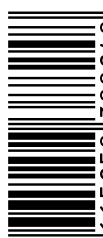

PLEASE REMEMBER TO GAUGE SWATCH

10 cm of stockinette, on 3,5 mm needles = 24 sts. and 32 rws
62 rws of stockinette with garter stitch stripes on 3,5 mm needles = 17 cm

YARN	COLOUR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52
P. MÉRINOS 3,5	ÉCRU ACAJOU	9 1	9 1	10 1	10 1	11 1

Yarn composition: 100% Merino wool

TOOLS & MATERIALS

2,5 mm knitting needles (1/1 ribbing)
3,5 mm knitting needles (stockinette - stockinette striped with garter stitch)
4 buttons Ø 14 mm ref.: 054602 2333 05

STITCH PATTERNS USED

1/1 Ribbing
Garter stitch

Stockinette

Stockinette striped with garter stitch: *2 rws of garter stitch in ACAJOU, 8 rws of stockinette in ÉCRU* repeat from *to* 6 times tot. and 2 rws of garter stitch in ACAJOU (62 rws in tot.).

«Don't skip the gauge swatch if you want to be sure that your finished piece is top-notch!»

KNITTING THE PATTERN

BACK piece

With your 2,5 mm needles, CO 108 - 114 - 122 - 132 - 144 sts. in col. ÉCRU. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 4 cm.

Switch to your 3,5 mm needles and knit in stockinette while distributing 10 - 10 - 12 - 12 - 14 inc. on the 1st rw.

Your tot. stitch count should now be: 118 - 124 - 134 - 144 - 158 sts.

At a tot. height of 18,5 cm, start knitting stockinette striped with garter stitch (see stitch patterns used).

When the 62 rws of stockinette striped with garter stitch are done, cont. by knitting in stockinette with col. ÉCRU.

Armholes

Meanwhile, at a tot. height of 32 cm, BO on both sides: 1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 sts.

You should have 98 - 104 - 114 - 124 - 138 sts. left.

Shoulders and neckline

At a tot. height of 53 - 54 - 55 - 56 - 57 cm, BO for the shoulders on both sides:

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 6 sts.

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 7 sts.

1 x 8 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 8 sts.

1 x 9 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 9 sts.

1 x 10 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 11 sts.

At the same time as the 1st shoulder dec., BO for the neckline on the 22 - 22 - 22 - 24 - 24 centr. sts. then finish one side at a time, binding off on the neckline side, every 2 rws: 2 x 7 sts.

FRONT piece

With your 2,5 mm needles, CO 108 - 114 - 122 - 132 - 144 sts. in col. ÉCRU. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 4 cm.

Switch to your 3,5 mm needles and knit in stockinette while distributing 10 - 10 - 12 - 12 - 14 inc. on the 1st rw.

Your tot. stitch count should be: 118 - 124 - 134 - 144 - 158 sts.

At a tot. height of 18,5 cm, start knitting stockinette striped with garter stitch (see stitch patterns used).

When the 62 rws of stockinette striped with garter stitch are done, cont. by knitting in stockinette with col. ÉCRU.

Opening

Meanwhile, at a tot. height of 31 cm, BO the 4 centr. sts. then finish one side at a time.

Your tot. stitch count should be: 57 - 60 - 65 - 70 - 77 sts.

Armhole

At a tot. height of 32 cm, BO on the exterior side: 1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 sts.

You should have 47 - 50 - 55 - 60 - 67 sts. left.

Neckline

At a tot. height of 46 - 47 - 48 - 49 - 50 cm, BO on the opening side:

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 4 x 1 sts. and every 4 rws: 2 x 1 sts.

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 4 x 1 sts. and every 4 rws: 2 x 1 sts.

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 4 x 1 sts. and every 4 rws: 2 x 1 sts.

1 x 7 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 4 x 1 sts. and every 4 rws: 2 x 1 sts.

1 x 7 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 4 x 1 sts. and every 4 rws: 2 x 1 sts.

Shoulder

At a tot. height of 53 - 54 - 55 - 56 - 57 cm, BO on the exterior side:

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 6 sts.

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 7 sts.

1 x 8 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 8 sts.

1 x 9 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 9 sts.

1 x 10 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 11 sts.

SLEEVES

With your 2,5 mm needles, CO 52 - 56 - 62 - 66 - 72 sts. in col. ÉCRU. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 7 cm.

Switch to your 3,5 mm needles and knit in stockinette while distributing 14 inc. on the 1st rw.

Your tot. stitch count should be: 66 - 70 - 76 - 80 - 86 sts.

Inc. 1 sts. on each side:

every 8 rws: 12 times and every 6 rws: 5 times.

every 8 rws: 11 times and every 6 rws: 6 times.

every 8 rws: 9 times and every 6 rws: 8 times.

every 8 rws: 8 times and every 6 rws: 9 times.

every 8 rws: 6 times and every 6 rws: 11 times.

Your tot. stitch count should be: 100 - 104 - 110 - 114 - 120 sts.

Pay attention, at a tot. height of 31,5 - 31 - 30 - 29 - 27 cm, start knitting stockinette striped with garter stitch (see stitch patterns used).

When the 62 rws of stockinette striped with garter stitch are done, cont. by knitting in stockinette with col. ÉCRU.

Rounding the shape

Meanwhile, at a tot. height of 46 - 45,5 - 44,5 - 43,5 - 41,5 cm, BO on both sides:

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 2 x 3 sts., 3 x 2 sts., 3 x 3 sts. and 2 x 4 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 2 x 3 sts., 3 x 2 sts., 3 x 3 sts., 1 x 4 sts. and 1 x 5 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 5 sts., 3 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 3 x 3 sts. and 2 x 5 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 5 sts., 1 x 4 sts., 2 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 2 x 3 sts., 1 x 4 sts. and 2 x 5 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 5 sts., 1 x 4 sts., 5 x 3 sts., 2 x 4 sts. and 2 x 5 sts.

BO the remaining 26 sts.

COLLAR

With your 3,5 mm needles, CO 131 - 131 - 131 - 137 - 137 sts. in col. ÉCRU. Knit 6 rws of stockinette, make 1 purl row on the knit side (RS) of your work (= edge/fold row). Then knit 5 rws of stockinette and knit a few rows of stockinette in a diff. colour.

BUTTON BAND

With your 3,5 mm needles, CO 41 - 43 - 45 - 48 - 50 sts. in col. ÉCRU. Knit 6 rws of stockinette, make 1 purl row on the knit side of your work (fold rw), then knit 5 rws of stockinette and a few rows of stockinette in a diff. col.

SEAMING

Seam the shoulders, the sides and the underarms.
Attach the sleeves to the body.

Using backstitch, attach the collar stitch by stitch on the right side of your work. Using backstitch, attach the button band stitch by stitch around the neck opening and on half of the collar (or until the edge/fold rw).

Using the col. ÉCRU, embroider onto the last row of the button band, in the following way: make 3 small sts. on the 2nd st. (collar side) then ***skip 2 sts., 3 small sts. on the following st.*** repeat from ***to***.

Embroider the other button band in the same way.

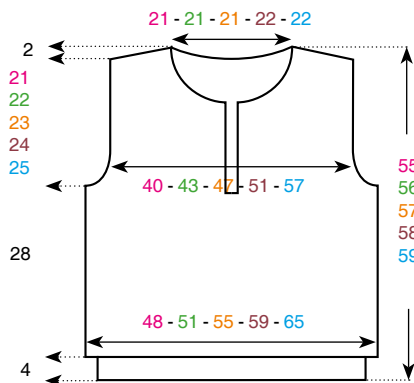
Using the col. ÉCRU, embroider onto the collar (neck band), in the following way: make 3 small sts. on the 2nd st. (opening side) then ***skip 2 sts., 3 small sts. on the following st.*** repeat from ***to***.

Fold the collar (neckband) then the button bands in two, towards the interior (at the edge/fold row) and keep them in place with an invisible stitch on the wrong side of your work.

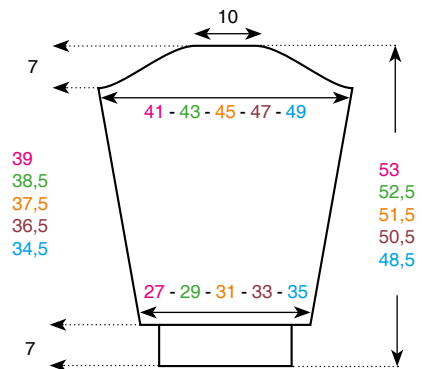
Make 4 buttonholes using your needle and the buttonhole stitch (it looks like a loop, see advice section) on the edge/fold row of the button band (left side of the neckline), make the 1st buttonhole at the top of the button band, the 4th at 2 cm from the opening and the others spaced evenly between them.

Sew your buttons onto the edge/fold row of the other button band.
