PLEASE REMEMBER TO GAUGE SWATCH

10 cm of stockinette on 5 mm needles = 17 sts. and 23 rws

YARN	COLOUR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52
P. BEAUCENCY	FAÏENCE	10	11	12	12	13

Yarn composition: 55 % Polyamide - 25 % Acrylic - 20% Wool

TOOLS & MATERIALS

4 mm needles (1/1 ribbing) - 5 mm needles (stockinette)

5 buttons Ø 15 mm, ref.: 054581 2257 06

Stitch markers

STITCH PATTERNS USED

1/1 ribbing - Stockinette

KNITTING THE PATTERN

BACK PIECE

With your 4 mm needles, CO (cast on) 85 - 89 - 97 - 103 - 113 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing starting and ending the 1st rw with K1, knit in 1/1 rib for 6 cm.

Switch to your 5 mm needles and knit in stockinette, distributing 11 inc. (increases) on the 1st rw. We have: 96 - 100 - 108 - 114 - 124 sts.

Armholes

At a tot. height of 29,5 cm, PM (place stitch markers) on the selvedge sts. and cont. knitting straight.

Shoulders

At a tot. height of 50,5 - 51,5 - 52,5 - 53,5 - 54,5 cm, BO (bind off) on both sides: 1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 5 x 5 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 4 x 5 sts. and 1 x 6 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 5 x 6 sts.

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 4 x 6 sts. and 1 x 7 sts.

1 x 7 sts. then every 2 rws: 5 x 7 sts.

Neckline

Caution, simultaneously: at a tot. height of 53 - 54 - 55 - 56 - 57 cm, BO the 20 - 20 - 20 - 22 - 22 centr. sts. then cont. one side at a time, BO on the neckline side 2 rws above: 1 x 9 sts.

RIGHT HALF FRONT PIECE

With your 4 mm needles, CO 41 - 43 - 47 - 51 - 55 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing starting and ending the 1st rw with K2, knit in 1/1 rib for 6 cm.

Switch to your 5 mm needles and knit in stockinette, distributing 6 - 6 - 6 - 5 - 6 inc. on the 1st rw. We have: 47 - 49 - 53 - 56 - 61 sts.

Neckline

At a tot. height of 29 - 30 - 31 - 32 - 33 cm, BO on the neckline side 1 x 1 st., then:

every 4 rws: 12 x 1 st. and every 2 rws: 5 x 1 st.

every 4 rws: 12 x 1 st. and every 2 rws: 5 x 1 st.

Armholes

At a tot. height of 29,5 cm, PM on the left side selvedge st.

Shoulder

At a tot. height of 50,5 - 51,5 - 52,5 - 53,5 - 54,5 cm, BO on the left side:

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 5 x 5 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 4 x 5 sts. and 1 x 6 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 5 x 6 sts.

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 4 x 6 sts. and 1 x 7 sts.

1 x 7 sts. then every 2 rws: 5 x 7 sts.

Knit the left half front piece in an opposite way, mirroring the right piece.

SLEEVES

With your 4 mm needles, CO 40 - 44 - 46 - 50 - 54 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 3,5 cm.

Switch to your 5 mm needles and knit in stockinette, distributing 14 inc. on the 1st rw.

We have: 54 - 58 - 60 - 64 - 68 sts.

Inc. 1 st. on each side:

every 10 rws: 8 times and 8 rws above: 1 time

every 10 rws: 7 times and every 8 rws: 2 times.

every 10 rws: 6 times and every 8 rws: 3 times.

every 10 rws: 5 times and every 8 rws: 4 times.

every 10 rws: 3 times and every 8 rws: 6 times.

We have: 72 - 76 - 78 - 82 - 86 sts.

At a tot. height of 45,5 - 45 - 44 - 43 - 41 cm, BO all sts.

BUTTON BAND AND NECKBAND

With your 4 mm needles, CO 118 - 120 - 122 - 126 - 128 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing starting 1st rw with K2 and ending with K1. Knit in 1/1 rib for 3,5 cm then make 1 rw of knit sts. on the RS (right side) and a few rws of stockinette in a diff. colour.

Knit a second band in a similar way by CO 119 - 121 - 123 - 127 - 129 sts., starting with P1 (ending with K2). On the 4th rw, distribute 5 buttonholes of 1 st., make the 1st buttonhole at 3 sts. away from the edge and the following spaced out by 12 - 13 - 13 - 14 - 14 sts. between them.

SEAMING

Seam the shoulders. Attach the sleeves to the body, between the stitches marked on the back and front pieces. Seam the sides and the underarms. Using backstitch, attach the button bands stitch by stitch along the half front pieces and the neckline of the back piece.

Sew the buttons onto the button band, matching up with the buttonholes.
