PLEASE REMEMBER TO GAUGE SWATCH

10 cm of **UK: tr / US: dc** with a 4 mm crochet hook = 18 sts. and 11 rws
Granny Square A, 4 mm crochet hook = 13 cm sides, 18,5 cm diagonally
Granny Square B, 4 mm crochet hook = 14,5 cm sides, 20,5 cm diagonally
Granny Square C, 4 mm crochet hook = 16 cm sides, 22,5 cm diagonally

TOOLS & MATERIALS

4 mm crochet hook
 Stitch markers + 1 tapestry needle

«Don't skip the gauge swatch if you want to be sure that your finished piece is top-notch!»

STITCH PATTERNS USED

Please refer to the crochet chart symbols on the last page for the following stitches:

Chain stitch (ch) or starting chain

Slip stitch (sl. st.)

UK: Double crochet (dc) / US: Single crochet (sc)

UK: Treble crochet (tr) / US: Double crochet (dc)

UK: Treble crochet 2 tog. (tr2tog) / US: Double crochet 2 tog. (dc2tog)

UK: Treble crochet 3 tog. (tr3tog) / US: Double crochet 3 tog. (dc3tog)

Magic circle (see advice): wrap the yarn twice around your index finger, bring the yarn coming from the skein through the loop you just made, make 1 ch, then crochet your 1st round; at the end of the rnd, pull at the tail of your yarn to tighten the magic circle.

CONSTRUCTION

Since UK and US crochet terminology differs, these have been colour-coded. Choose what you're most familiar with; **UK / US**.

To assemble your granny squares, you can choose to assemble your granny squares once you've finished crocheting them all, or you can choose to assemble them as you go, by making the last row on your granny square following the assembly schematic – don't forget to check out our wooolschool for more tips & advice!

GRANNY SQUARES

With your 4 mm crochet hook, start by making a magic circle (see stitch patterns), work in the round in the following way (while also following the crochet chart):

1st rnd: ch 3 for the 1st **UK: (tr) / US: (dc)** st., *ch 1 (= corner), insert your hook into the circle and make 3 **(tr)/(dc)*** repeat from *to* 3 times tot., ch 1 (= corner), insert your hook into the circle and make 2 **(tr)/(dc)**, finish by making 1 sl. st. on the 3rd ch st. from the beginning of the round.

2nd rnd: make 1 sl. st. to start on the corner st., ch 3 for the 1st **(tr)/(dc)**, ch 1, make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** in the same corner ch st., *make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** + ch 1 + 3 **(tr)/(dc)** in the following corner ch st.* rep. from *to* 3 times tot., make 2 **(tr)/(dc)** on the 1st corner ch st., finish by making 1 sl. st. on the 3rd ch st. from the beginning of the round.

3rd rnd: make 1 sl. st. to start on the corner st., ch 3 for the 1st **(tr)/(dc)**, ch 1, make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** in the same corner ch st., *insert your hook between the 2 groups of 3 **(tr)/(dc)** sts. and make 3 **(tr)/(dc)**, make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** + ch 1 + 3 **(tr)/(dc)** in the corner ch st.* rep. from *to* 3 times tot., make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by inserting your hook between the 2 groups of 3 **(tr)/(dc)** sts., make 2 **(tr)/(dc)** on the 1st corner ch st., finish by making 1 sl. st. on the 3rd ch st. from the beginning of the round.

4th rnd: make 1 sl. st. to start on the corner st., ch 3 for the 1st **(tr)/(dc)**, ch 1, make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** in the same corner ch st., *(make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by ins. your hook betw. the 2 groups of 3 **(tr)/(dc)** sts.) rep. from (to) 2 times tot., make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** + ch 1 + 3 **(tr)/(dc)** in the corner ch st.* rep. from *to* 3 times tot., (make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by ins. your hook betw. the 2 groups of 3 **(tr)/(dc)** sts.) rep. (to) 2 times tot., make 2 **(tr)/(dc)** on the 1st corner ch st., finish by making 1 sl. st. on the 3rd ch st. from the beg. of the round.

5th rnd: make 1 sl. st. to start on the corner st., ch 3 for the 1st **(tr)/(dc)**, ch 1, make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** in the same corner ch st., *(make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by ins. your hook betw. the 2 groups of 3 **(tr)/(dc)** sts.) rep. from (to) 3 times tot., make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** + ch 1 + 3 **(tr)/(dc)** in the corner ch st.* rep. from *to* 3 times tot., (make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by ins. your hook betw. the 2 groups of 3 **(tr)/(dc)** sts.) rep. from (to) 3 times tot., make 2 **(tr)/(dc)** on the 1st corner ch st., finish by making 1 sl. st. on the 3rd ch st. from the beg. of the round.

Cont. by following the corresponding crochet chart.

When you've finished 8 rnds - 9 rnds - 10 rnds of the chart, stop your work.

GRANNY TRIANGLES

With your 4 mm crochet hook, start by making a magic circle (see stitch patterns), work back and forth in the following way (while also following the crochet chart):

1st rw: ch 3 for the 1st **(tr)/(dc)**, ch 1, make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by inserting your hook into the magic circle, ch 1 (= corner), make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by ins. your hook into the magic circle, ch 1 and make 1 **(tr)/(dc)** by ins. your hook into the magic circle.

2nd rw: ch 3 for the 1st **(tr)/(dc)**, ch 1, make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by inserting your hook into the 1st ch st., make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** + 1 ch st. + 3 **(tr)/(dc)** into the corner ch st., make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** into the last ch st., ch 1 and make 1 **(tr)/(dc)** into the 3rd ch st. of the beg. of the last row.

3rd rw: ch 3 for the 1st **(tr)/(dc)**, ch 1, make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** into the 1st ch st., make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by ins. your hook betw. the 2 groups of 3 **(tr)/(dc)** sts., make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** + 1 ch st. + 3 **(tr)/(dc)** into the corner ch st., make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by ins. your hook betw. the 2 groups of 3 **(tr)/(dc)** sts., make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** into the last ch st., ch 1 and make 1 **(tr)/(dc)** into the 3rd ch st. of the beg. of the last row.

4th rw: ch 3 for the 1st **(tr)/(dc)**, ch 1, make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** into the 1st ch st., (make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by ins. your hook betw. the 2 groups of 3 **(tr)/(dc)** sts.) rep. from (to) 2 times tot., make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** + 1 ch st. + 3 **(tr)/(dc)** into the corner ch st., (make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by ins. your hook betw. the 2 groups of 3 **(tr)/(dc)** sts.) rep. from (to) 2 times tot., make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** into the last ch st., ch 1 and make 1 **(tr)/(dc)** into the 3rd ch st. of the beg. of the last row.

5th rw: ch 3 for the 1st **(tr)/(dc)**, ch 1, make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** into the 1st ch st., (make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by ins. your hook betw. the 2 groups of 3 **(tr)/(dc)** sts.) rep. from (to) 3 times tot., make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** + 1 ch st. + 3 **(tr)/(dc)** into the corner ch st., (make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** by ins. your hook betw. the 2 groups of 3 **(tr)/(dc)** sts.) rep. from (to) 3 times tot., make 3 **(tr)/(dc)** into the last ch st., ch 1 and make 1 **(tr)/(dc)** into the 3rd ch st. of the beg. of the last row.

Cont. by following the corresponding crochet chart.

When you've finished 8 rws - 9 rws - 10 rws of the chart, stop your work.

BACK AND FRONT PIECES

With your 4 mm crochet hook, make 7 triangles of 8 rws - 9 rws - 10 rws in col. NOIR (see pattern and chart A - B - C), place them in the following way: 3 on the bottom of the front piece, 3 on the bottom of the back piece, 1 at the back of the neckline (see symbol X in the pattern illustrations).

With your 4 mm crochet hook, make 4 squares of 8 rnds - 9 rnds - 10 rnds in col. NOIR (see pattern and chart A - B - C), place them between the back and front pieces, at the sides (see symbol Y in the pattern illustrations).

With your 4 mm crochet hook, make 24 striped squares of 8 rnds - 9 rnds - 10 rnds (see pattern and chart A - B - C), by making 2 squares in each colourway listed in the table down below (make the magic circle with the col. of the 1st round).

SLEEVES

The sleeves are made in several parts.

Granny Squares

With your 4 mm crochet hook, make 4 striped squares of 8 rnds (see chart A), make 1 square in each of the 4 colourways of the table down below (make the magic circle with the col. of the 1st round):

	rnds: 1, 2	rnds: 3, 4	rnds: 5, 6	rnds: 7, 8

Cuff

With your 4 mm crochet hook, make a starting chain of 51 - 55 - 59 sts. in col. NOIR. Work in striped (tr)/(dc), making 1 rw in each of the following col.: NOIR, CÈDRE, VÉRONÈSE, NOIR, LIE DE VIN, VITAMINE, PAVOT.

Continuing the sleeve

Cont. making (tr)/(dc) sts. (with your 4 mm crochet hook) but now in the col. NOIR, do this on the first 14 - 16 - 18 (tr)/(dc) sts. of the cuff.

You may now join the (tr)/(dc) sts. in col. NOIR to the Granny squares, as you go along by making 1 sl. st. on the last rnd of granny squares, after the last (tr)/(dc) st. of the odd numbered rows, or before the 1st (tr)/(dc) st. of the even numbered rws.

Make 1 inc. to the right (= 2 (tr)/(dc) on the selvedge (tr)/(dc) st.):

every 5 rws: 6 times and 4 rws above: 1 time.
every 4 rws: 5 times and every 3 rws: 5 times.
every 3 rws: 10 times and every 2 rws: 3 times.
We have 21 - 26 - 31 (tr)/(dc) sts.

Raglan

At a tot. height of 42 cm, we've made 38 rws of (tr)/(dc) sts. in col. NOIR, PM (place st. marker) at the right side selvedge sts., make on the right side:
1 x (tr2tog)/(dc2tog) then on every rw: 18 x (tr2tog)/(dc2tog)
1 x (tr2tog)/(dc2tog) then on every rw: *5 x (tr2tog)/(dc2tog), 1 x (tr3tog)/(dc3tog)* rep. from *to* 3 times tot.
1 x (tr2tog)/(dc2tog) then on every rw: *2 x (tr2tog)/(dc2tog), 1 x (tr3tog)/(dc3tog)* rep. from *to* 6 times tot.

At a tot. height of 59 cm, we've made 57 rws of (tr)/(dc) sts. in col. NOIR, we have 2 - 4 - 6 (tr)/(dc) sts. left, stop your work.

Repeat the same steps but in the opposite way (mirroring), on the 14 - 16 - 18 last (tr)/(dc) sts. of the cuff.

Cont. by making (tr)/(dc) sts. in col. NOIR on the 2 - 4 - 6 remaining (tr)/(dc) sts. to the left, then on top of the granny square n° 16, by making 23 (tr)/(dc) sts. on it and on the 2 - 4 - 6 remaining (tr)/(dc) sts. to the right.

Simultaneously, make on both sides:

1 x (tr2tog)/(dc2tog) then on every rw: 4 x 2 (tr2tog)/(dc2tog)
1 x (tr2tog)/(dc2tog) then on every rw: 6 x 2 (tr2tog)/(dc2tog)
1 x (tr2tog)/(dc2tog) then on every rw: 8 x 2 (tr2tog)/(dc2tog)

At a tot. height of 64 - 65,5 - 67 cm, we've made 5 - 7 - 9 rws of (tr)/(dc) sts. on top of the last granny square, we have 17 sts. left, stop your work.

SEAMING

For those who've chosen to assemble your granny squares at the end of your work:

- Back and front pieces:

Seam the granny squares together, following the assembly schematic.
Place the 7 triangles in col. NOIR in the following way: 3 at the bottom of the front piece, 3 at the bottom of the back piece, 1 at the back of the neckline (see symbol X in the pattern illustrations).
Place the 4 squares in col. NOIR between the back and front pieces, at the sides (see symbol Y in the pattern illustrations).

- Sleeves

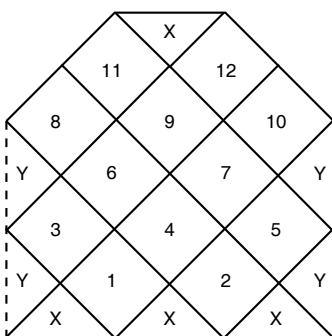
Seam the 3 remaining granny squares to the granny square n° 16 by following the assembly schematic.
Seam this «band» of granny squares onto the 23 centr. sts. of the cuff that we left open, then seam onto the (tr)/(dc) sts. in col. NOIR on both sides.

For everyone:

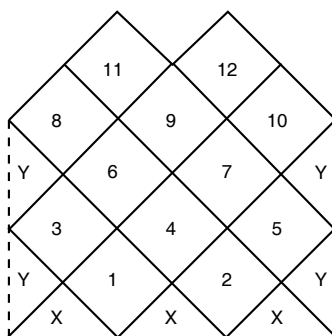
Seam the underarms. Attach the sleeves to the body.
With your 4 mm crochet hook, make 1 rnd of (dc)/(sc) in col. NOIR around the neckline.

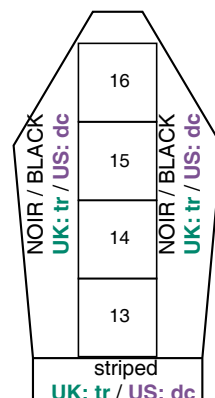

Chart Granny Triangle A

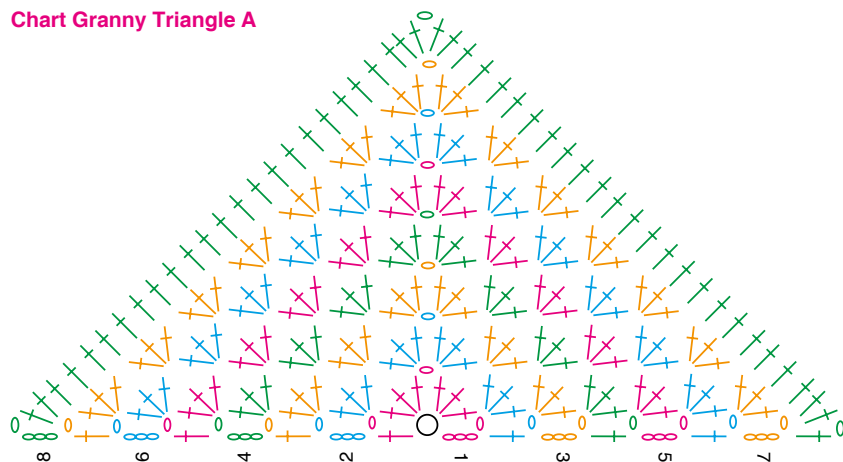

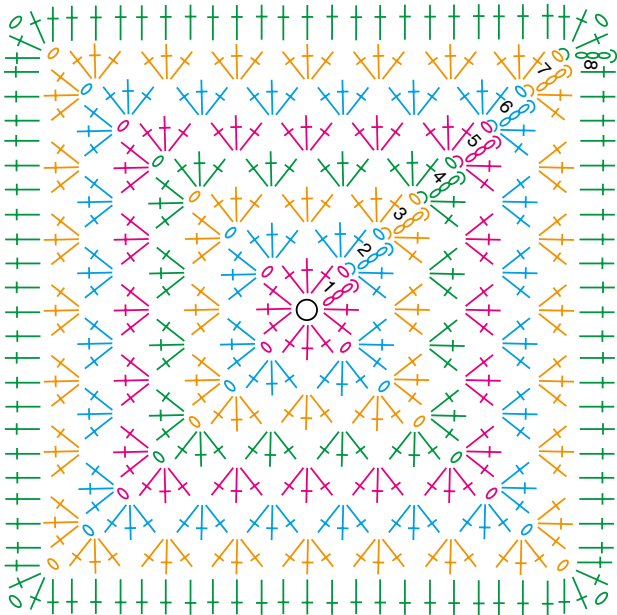
