### PLEASE REMEMBER TO GAUGE SWATCH

32 sts. (2 motif repeats) of the chevron stitch pattern (see chart) with a 3,5 mm crochet hook = 11 cm, 20 cm = 19 rws

### TOOLS & MATERIALS

3,5 mm crochet hook

Stitch markers, 1 tapestry needle

3 buttons Ø 22 mm ref.: 054600 2225 11

«To avoid a bad surprise:  
check your gauge swatch twice

### STITCH PATTERNS USED

Please refer to the crochet chart symbols on the last page for the following stitches:

Chain stitch (ch) or starting chain

Slip stitch (sl. st.)

UK: Double crochet (dc) / US: Single crochet (sc)

UK: Treble crochet (tr) / US: Double crochet (dc)

UK: Triple treble crochet / US: Double treble crochet (dtr)

UK: Treble crochet 2 tog. (tr2tog) / US: Double crochet 2 tog. (dc2tog)

UK: Treble crochet 3 tog. (tr3tog) / US: Double crochet 3 tog. (dc3tog)

UK: Treble crochet 5 tog. (tr5tog) / US: Double crochet 5tog. (dc5tog)

= \*1 YO, insert your crochet hook into 1 st., pull out 1 loop, 1 YO, pull the yarn through the first 2 loops\* repeat from \*to\* 5 times tot., 1 YO, pull the yarn through the last 6 loops on your crochet hook.

**Striped chevrons stitch pattern** (see chart): \*2 rws of col. GITANE, 2 rws of col. CANARD, 2 rws of col. TILLEUL, 2 rws of col. NOISETTE, 2 rws of col. ÉCRU, 2 rws of col. NATUREL\*, keep repeating from \*to\*.

### CONSTRUCTION

The different size options have been colour-coded in order to help you follow the instructions for the size you wish to crochet with more ease. Since UK and US crochet terminology differs, these have also been colour-coded. Choose what you're most familiar with; **UK** / **US**.

### BACK and FRONT pieces

With your 3,5 mm crochet hook, make a starting chain (loosely) of 145 - 161 - 177 - 193 - 209 chain stitches (ch), in col. GITANE. Continue by working in the striped chevron stitch pattern (see chart and stitch patterns used).

### Armholes

At a tot. height of 38,5 cm, PM (place stitch markers) on both side edges.

### Shoulders and neckline

At a tot. height of 55,5 - 55,5 - 58 - 58 - 60,5 cm, make the finishing rw (see chart) in the col. of the last row of chevrons you made. Then stop your work and PM for the 75 - 75 - 75 - 79 - 79 centr. sts. to indicate the neckline.

### SLEEVES

With your 3,5 mm crochet hook, make a starting chain (loosely) of 97 - 97 - 113 - 113 - 129 chain stitches (ch), in col. GITANE. Continue by working in the striped chevron stitch pattern (see chart and stitch patterns used).

At a tot. height of 49 - 47 - 45 - 43 - 41 cm, make the finishing rw (see chart) in the col. of the last row of chevrons you made, then stop your work.

### SEAMING

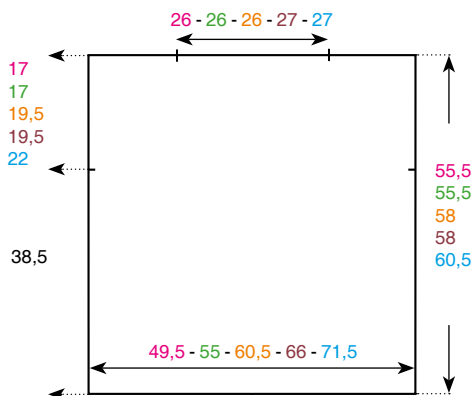
Seam the shoulders until the stitch markers you left for the neckline.

Attach the top of the sleeves to the body, using the stitch markers you left for the armholes as reference.

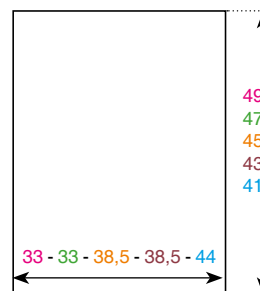
Seam the sides and the underarms.

Sew the buttons onto the left shoulder, spacing them out evenly.
