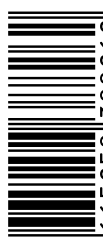

PLEASE REMEMBER TO GAUGE SWATCH

10 cm of stockinette, on 6 mm needles = 18 sts. and 26 rws

YARN	COLOUR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52
P. LÉO	FAUVE	7	8	8	9	9

Yarn composition: 71 % Mohair - 17 % Polyamide - 10 % Wool - 2 % Elastane

If you wish to knit this pattern with less seaming, you can use circular needles to knit the body in the round (until the armholes) and knit the sleeves, following the instructions in the coloured squares. (1 round = 1 row)

TOOLS & MATERIALS

5 mm knitting needles (1/2 ribbing)
6 mm knitting needles (stockinette)
Stitch markers + 1 tapestry needle
5 mm circular knitting needles (1/2 ribbing)
6 mm circular knitting needles (stockinette)

STITCH PATTERNS USED

1/2 ribbing:

1st rw (RS): *K1, P1*, keep repeating from * to *

2nd rw (WS): Knit all sts. as they appear, meaning: K knit sts, P purl sts. Keep repeating these 2 rws.

Stockinette: RS: K all sts. WS: P all sts.

1/2 rib (in the round): K1, P2.

Stockinette (in the round): K all sts.

KNITTING THE PATTERN

BACK and FRONT (pieces)

With your 5 mm needles, CO 92 - 98 - 107 - 113 - 125 sts., Knit in 1/2 ribbing, starting and ending the 1st rw with P2, do this for 3 cm.

With your 5 mm circ. needles, CO 180 - 192 - 210 - 222 - 246 sts., PM at the 1st st. (to indicate BOR), PM at the middle of your work (to indicate back/front). Join in the round.

Knit in 1/2 ribbing for 3 cm.

Switch to your 6 mm needles and knit in stockinette, while distributing 5 - 5 - 4 - 4 - 4 inc.

Your tot. stitch count should now be: 97 - 103 - 111 - 117 - 129 sts.

Switch to your 6 mm circ. needles and knit in stockinette, while distributing 10 - 10 - 8 - 8 - 8 inc.

Your tot. stitch count should now be: 190 - 202 - 218 - 230 - 254 sts.

Armholes

At a tot. height of 36 cm, PM on both sides, at the selvage sts. (edges), to indicate the seams for the sleeves.

At a tot. height of 36 cm, we separate the front and back and knit them one at a time..

K the first 95 - 101 - 109 - 115 - 127 sts. for the back, cont. by following the rest of the instructions, leaving the remaining sts. on hold.

Shoulders

At a tot. height of 54 - 55 - 56 - 57 - 58 cm, BO on both sides:

1 x 4 sts. then every 2nd rw: 3 x 4 sts. and 1 x 5 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2nd rw: 4 x 5 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2nd rw: 2 x 5 sts. and 2 x 6 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2nd rw: 4 x 6 sts.

1 x 6 sts. then every 2nd rw: 4 x 7 sts.

At a tot. height of 58 - 59 - 60 - 61 - 62 cm, BO the remaining 55 - 55 - 57 - 59 - 61 sts., PM on each side of the 45 - 45 - 45 - 47 - 47 centr. sts. to indicate the neckline.

Knit the front piece in the same way as the back piece.

To finish the front piece, pick up the sts. left on hold and repeat the work done for the back piece.

SLEEVES

With your 5 mm needles, CO 47 - 50 - 53 - 56 - 62 sts. Knit in 1/2 ribbing, starting and ending the 1st rw with P2, do this for 4,5 cm.

Switch to your 6 mm needles and knit in stockinette, while distributing 28 - 27 - 28 - 29 - 27 inc.

Your tot. stitch count should now be: 75 - 77 - 81 - 85 - 89 sts.

With your 5 mm circ. needles, CO 45 - 48 - 51 - 54 - 60 sts., PM at the 1st st. (to indicate BOR), join in the round.

Knit in 1/2 ribbing for 4,5 cm.

Switch to your 6 mm circ. needles and knit in stockinette, while distributing 28 - 27 - 28 - 29 - 27 inc. on the 1st round.

Your tot. stitch count should now be: 73 - 75 - 79 - 83 - 87 sts.

BO on both sides: (or on each side of your stitch marker)

every 18 rws: 5 x 1 sts.

every 18 rws: 5 x 1 sts.

every 18 rws: 4 x 1 sts. and 16 rws above: 1 x 1 sts.

every 18 rws: 3 x 1 sts. every 16 rws: 2 x 1 sts.

every 16 rws: 5 x 1 sts.

You should have 65 - 67 - 71 - 75 - 79 sts. (or 63 - 65 - 69 - 73 - 77 sts.) left.

At a tot. height of 46 - 45,5 - 44,5 - 43,5 - 41,5 cm, BO all sts.

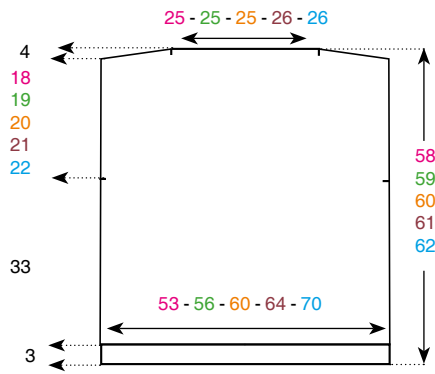
Knit the second sleeve in the same way.

SEAMING

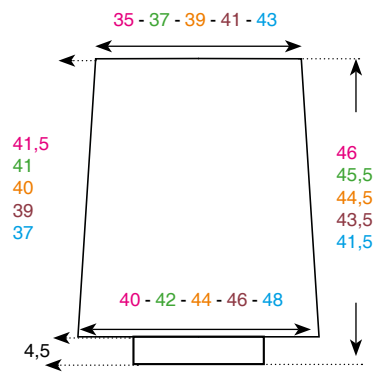
Seam the shoulders, attach the sleeves between the marked sts. indicating the back and the front. Seam the sides and the underarms.
