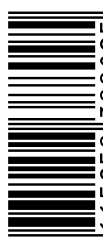

PLEASE REMEMBER TO GAUGE SWATCH

10 cm of stockinette (2 strands tog.), 4,5 mm needles = 18 sts. and 28 rws
14 sts. of cable stitch p. (2 strands tog.), 4,5 mm needles = 7 cm and 28 rws

YARN	COLOUR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52

Yarn composition: 70 % Mohair - 30 % Silk

TOOLS & MATERIALS

3 mm knitting needles (1/1 ribbing, button bands, neckband)
3,5 mm knitting needles (1/1 ribbing, bottom of body and sleeves)
4,5 mm knitting needles (stockinette - cable stitch pattern)
1 cable needle
Stitch markers + 1 tapestry needle
5 buttons Ø 18 mm ref.: 054604 1264 - 09

STITCH PATTERNS USED

1/1 ribbing

Stockinette

Cable stitch pattern (see chart)

Dec. (decrease) 14 sts. from the side edges:

to the right: K the 14 sts. of cable stitch pattern, then skpo (meaning: slip 1 st., knit 1 st., pass slipped stitch over)

to the left: on the last 16 sts., k2tog (meaning: knit 2 sts. together), then knit the following 14 sts. in cable stitch pattern.

«Don't skip the gauge swatch if you want to be sure that your finished piece is top-notch!»

KNITTING THE PATTERN

This project is knit with yarn held double (using 2 strands together).

BACK PIECE

With your 3,5 mm needles (yarn held double), CO 75 - 81 - 87 - 95 - 105 sts.
Knit in 1/1 ribbing, starting and ending with K1 - P1 - K1 - K1 - P1 for 5 cm.

Switch to your 4,5 mm needles and knit in stockinette, distributing 10 inc. on the 1st rw.

We have: 85 - 91 - 97 - 105 - 115 sts.

Armholes

At a tot. height of 33 cm, BO on both sides:

1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 2 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 sts.

We have 61 - 63 - 65 - 67 - 71 sts. left.

Shoulders and neckline

At a tot. height of 52 - 53 - 54 - 55 - 56 cm, BO for the shoulders on both sides:

1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 4 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 4 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 4 sts. and 1 x 5 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 4 sts. and 1 x 5 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 5 sts.

Simultaneously, as the 1st shoulder dec., BO the 13 - 13 - 13 - 15 - 15 centr. sts. for the neckline, then continue one side at a time, binding off on the neckline side: every 2 rws: 1 x 5 sts. and 1 x 4 sts.

KNITTING THE RIGHT HALF FRONT PIECE

With your 3,5 mm needles (yarn held double), CO 37 - 40 - 43 - 47 - 52 sts.
Knit in 1/1 ribbing, starting the 1st rw with K2, and ending with: P1 - K1 - P1 - P1 - K1, cont. knitting in 1/1 ribbing for 5 cm.

Switch to your 4,5 mm needles, knit in stockinette and cable stitch pattern (see the corresponding chart), distributing 6 inc. on the 1st rw.

We have: 43 - 46 - 49 - 53 - 58 sts.

Distribute your sts. in the following way (you can separate them using stitch markers): the 14 sts. of the cable stitch chart, then 29 - 32 - 35 - 39 - 44 sts. of stockinette.

Neckline

At a tot. height of 29 cm, dec. (decrease) 14 sts. from the side edges (see stitch patterns used), on the right side:

1 x 1 dec. then every 6 rws: 5 x 1 dec. and every 4 rws: 9 x 1 dec.

1 x 1 dec. then every 6 rws: 7 x 1 dec. and every 4 rws: 7 x 1 dec.

1 x 1 dec. then every 6 rws: 8 x 1 dec. and every 4 rws: 6 x 1 dec.

1 x 1 dec. then every 6 rws: 7 x 1 dec. and every 4 rws: 8 x 1 dec.

1 x 1 dec. then every 6 rws: 9 x 1 dec. and every 4 rws: 6 x 1 dec.

Armhole

Simultaneously, at a tot. height of 33 cm, BO to the left:

1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 2 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 sts.

We have: 31 - 32 - 33 - 34 - 36 sts. left.

Shoulder

At a tot. height of 52 - 53 - 54 - 55 - 56 cm, BO on the armhole side:

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 4 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 4 sts. and 1 x 5 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts. and 2 x 5 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts. and 2 x 5 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 5 sts.

Knit the left half of the front in an opposite way, mirroring the first piece, following the corresponding chart.

SLEEVES

With your 3,5 mm needles (yarn held double), CO 44 - 48 - 52 - 56 - 60 sts.
Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 7 cm.

Switch to your 4,5 mm needles, distributing 11 inc. on the 1st rw.

We have: 55 - 59 - 63 - 67 - 71 sts.

Inc. 1 st. on each side:

every 26 rws: 3 times

every 26 rws: 3 times

every 22 rws: 2 times and every 20 rws: 2 times

every 18 rws: 4 times and 16 rws above: 1 time

every 18 rws: 4 times and 16 rws above: 1 time

We have: 61 - 65 - 71 - 77 - 81 sts.

Rounding the shape

At a tot. height of 44 cm, BO on both sides:

1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 2 sts., 1 x 1 sts., every 4 rws: 7 x 1 sts., every 2 rws: 1 x 1 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 1 x 3 sts.

1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 2 sts., 3 x 1 sts., every 4 rws: 5 x 1 sts., every 2 rws: 3 x 1 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 1 x 3 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts., 3 x 1 sts., every 4 rws: 5 x 1 sts., every 2 rws: 3 x 1 sts., 1 x 2 sts. and 2 x 3 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts., 2 x 1 sts., every 4 rws: 5 x 1 sts., every 2 rws: 2 x 1 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 3 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts., 2 x 1 sts., every 4 rws: 5 x 1 sts., every 2 rws: 2 x 1 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 1 x 3 sts. and 1 x 4 sts.

BO the 15 sts. remaining.

BUTTON BANDS AND NECKBAND

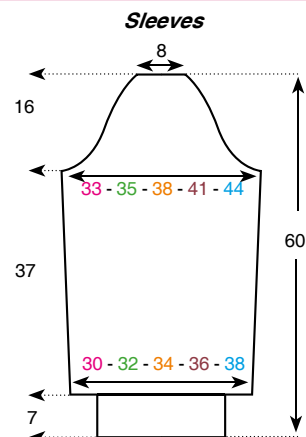
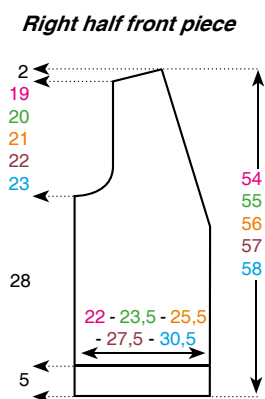
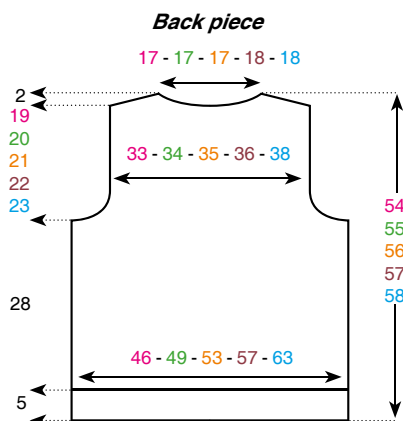
With your 3 mm needles (yarn held double), CO 7 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing, starting and ending the 1st rw with K2. Cont. in 1/1 ribbing for 63 - 64 - 65 - 66,5 - 67,5 cm, then BO all sts. Knit a 2nd band in the same way, distributing 5 buttonholes (of 3 rws): the 1st one at 1 cm from the edge, the following with a 5,5 cm distance between them.

SEAMING

Seam the shoulders, the sides and the underarms.
Attach the sleeves to the body.

Attach the buttons so that they match up with the buttonholes.

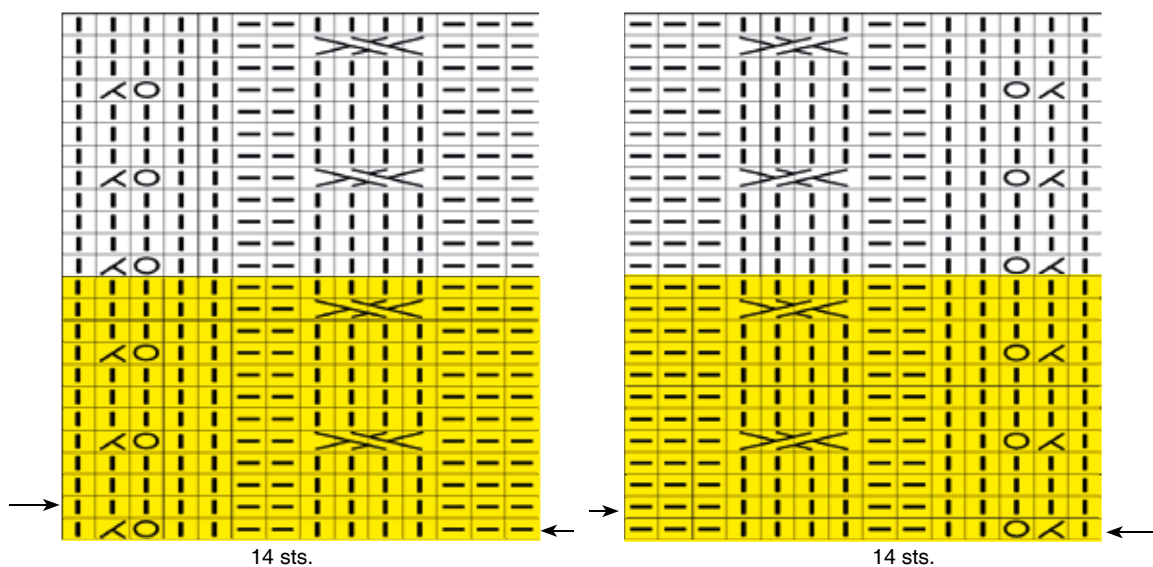
Using backstitch, attach the neckband and button bands stitch by stitch, along the front pieces and back of the neckline.



Measurements in cm

Right front half

Repeat the coloured squares

→ = reading direction

■ = RS: K1 / WS: P1

■ = RS: P1 / WS: K1

⊗ = YO (yarn over)

⊠ = K2tog (knit 2 sts. together)

⊠ = C4B / cable 4 back (right leaning cable done over 4 sts., 2 and 2) = RS: slip 2 to cn. (cable needle) and hold back (behind your work), K2, K2 from cn.

⊠ = C4F / cable 4 front (left leaning cable done over 4 sts., 2 and 2) = RS: slip 2 to cn. (cable needle) and hold in front (of your work), K2, K2 from cn.
