



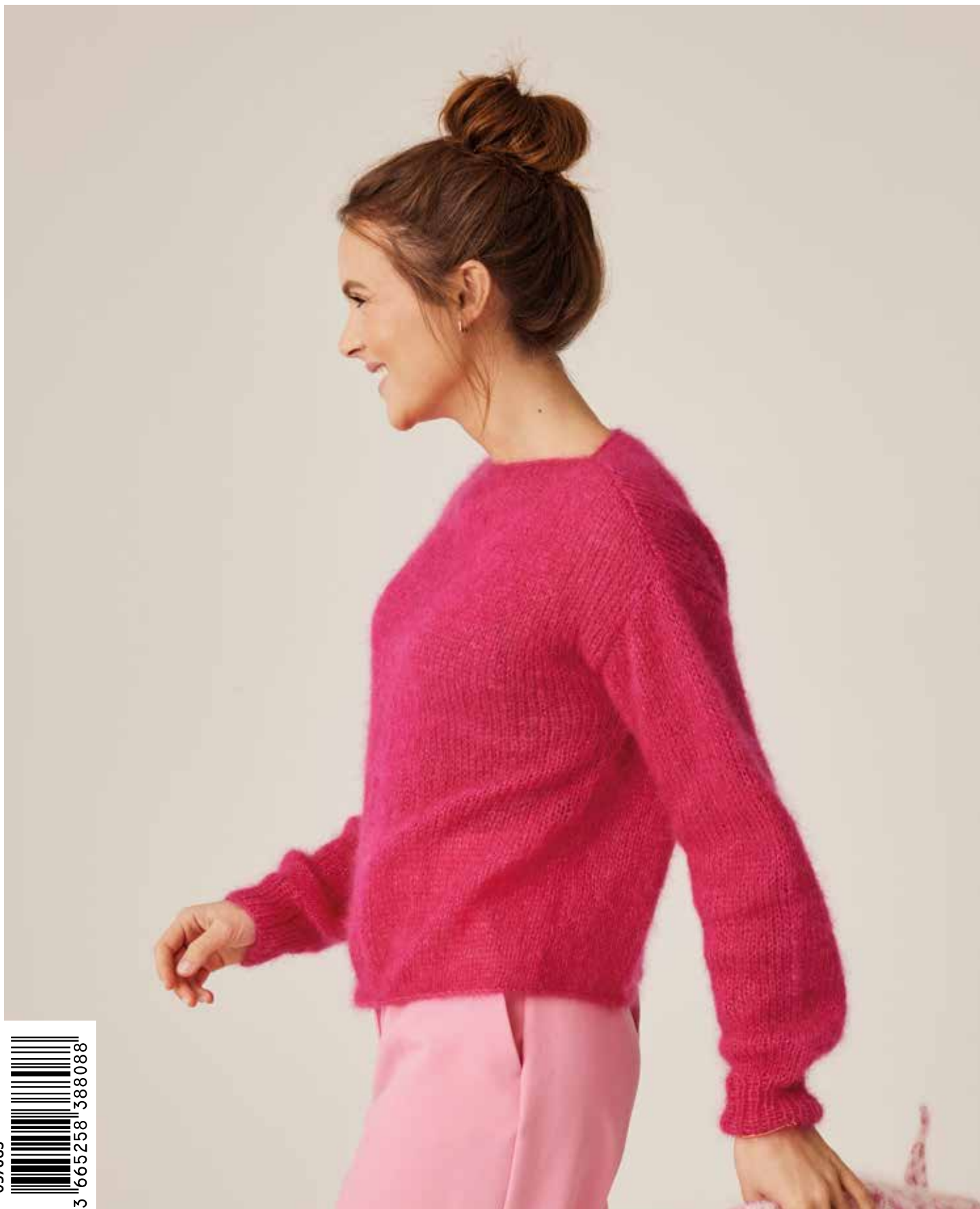

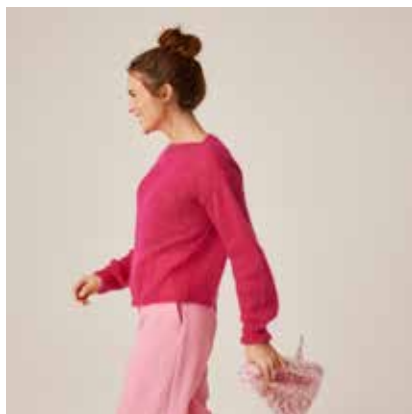

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = cast on
BO = bind off
K = knit
P = purl
st(s). = stitch(es)
rw(s) = row(s)
rnd(s) = round(s)
RS = right side
WS = wrong side
inc. = increase
PM = place (stitch) marker
BOR = beginning or round/row
EOR = end of round/row
cont. = continue
tot. = total
centr. = central
circ. = circular

PLEASE REMEMBER TO GAUGE SWATCH

10 cm of stockinette (held double), on 6 mm needles = 16 sts. and 24 rws

YARN	COLOUR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52
P. MOHAIR SOIE	FUCHSIA	7	7	7	8	8

Yarn composition: 70 % Mohair - 30 % Silk

If you wish to knit this pattern with less seaming, you can use circular needles and knit the body in the round (until the armholes) and knit the sleeves following the instructions in the coloured squares. (1 round = 1 row)

TOOLS & MATERIALS

5 mm knitting needles (1/1 ribbing)
6 mm knitting needles (stockinette/stocking stitch)
Stitch markers

5 mm circular knitting needles (1/1 ribbing)
6 mm circular knitting needles (stockinette)

STITCH PATTERNS USED

1/1 ribbing:

1st rw (RS): *K1, P1*, keep repeating from * to *

2nd rw (WS): Knit all sts. as they appear, meaning: K knit sts, P purl sts.

Keep repeating these 2 rws

Stockinette / stocking stitch:

1st rw (RS): K all sts.

2nd rw (WS): P all sts.

Keep repeating these 2 rws

1/1 rib (in the round): K1, P1.

Stockinette (in the round): K all sts.

CONSTRUCTION

This sweater is knit entirely with the yarn held double.

BACK and FRONT pieces

Step 1: we begin at the bottom of the back or front piece

With your 6 mm needles, CO 82 - 86 - 94 - 100 - 110 sts. Knit in stockinette (please refer to stitch patterns used).

With your 6 mm circ. needles, CO 160 - 168 - 184 - 196 - 216 sts., PM at the 1st st. (to indicate BOR), PM at the middle of your work (to indicate back/front). Join in the round.

Knit in stockinette (please refer to stitch patterns used).

Step 2: the armholes

At a tot. height of 32 cm, PM on both sides, at the selvage sts (edges), to indicate the seams for the sleeves.

At a tot. height of 32 cm, we separate the front and back and knit them one at a time.

K the first 80 - 84 - 92 - 98 - 108 sts. for the back, inc 1 st. on each side (selvage sts for seaming the sleeves later).

We now have 82 - 86 - 94 - 100 - 110 sts., cont. by following the rest of the instructions, leaving the remaining sts. on hold.

Step 3: the shoulders

At a tot. height of 51 - 52 - 53 - 54 - 55 cm, BO on both sides:

1 x 3 sts. then every 2nd rw: 3 x 4 sts.

1 x 4 sts. then every 2nd rw: 3 x 4 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2nd rw: 3 x 5 sts.

1 x 5 sts. then every 2nd rw: 2 x 5 sts. and 1 x 6 sts.

1 x 6 sts. then every 2nd rw: 2 x 6 sts. and 1 x 7 sts.

Step 4: the neckline

At a tot. height of 55 - 56 - 57 - 58 - 59 cm, BO the remaining 52 - 54 - 54 - 58 - 60 sts., PM on each side of the 44 - 44 - 44 - 46 - 46 centr. sts. to indicate the neckline.

Step 5: the front

Knit the front piece in the same way as the back piece.

SLEEVES

Step 1: we start at the cuff

With your 5 mm needles, CO 38 - 42 - 44 - 48 - 52 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 5 cm.

With your 5 mm circ. needles, CO 36 - 40 - 42 - 46 - 50 sts., PM at the 1st st. (to indicate BOR). Join in the round.

Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 5 cm.

Step 2: we knit the sleeve

Switch to your 6 mm needles and knit in stockinette (please refer to stitch patterns used), distributing 7 inc. on the 1st rw.

We now have: 45 - 49 - 51 - 55 - 59 sts.

Inc. 1 sts. on each side:

Switch to your 6 mm circ. needles and knit in stockinette (please refer to stitch patterns used), distributing 7 inc. in the 1st rnd.

We now have: 43 - 47 - 49 - 53 - 57 sts.

Inc. 1 sts. on each side of the stitch marker (BOR/EOR):

every 12th rw/rnd: 7 times and 10 rws/rnds above: 1 time.

every 12th rw/rnd: 6 times and every 10th rw/rnd: 2 times.

every 12th rw/rnd: 5 times and every 10th rw/rnd: 3 times.

every 12th rw/rnd: 3 times and every 10th rw/rnd: 5 times.

12 rws/rnds above: 1 time and every 10th rw/rnd: 7 times.

We now have: 61 - 65 - 67 - 71 - 75 sts.

(or 59 - 63 - 65 - 69 - 73 sts.)

At a tot. height of 48 - 47,5 - 46,5 - 45,5 - 43,5 cm, BO all sts.

Step 3: we knit the second sleeve (in the same way)

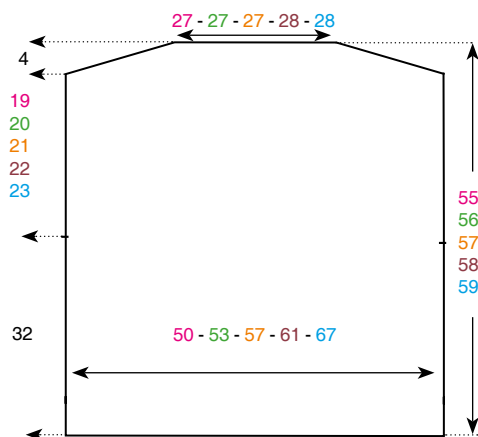
SEAMING

Seam the shoulders until the stitch markers left for the neckline.

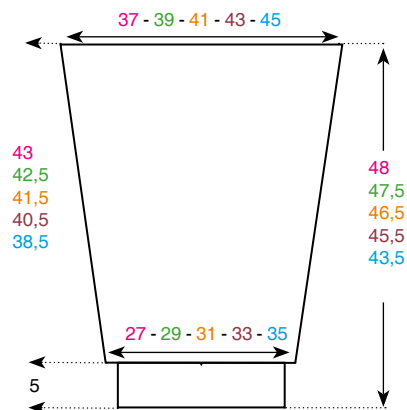
Attach the sleeves between the marked sts. indicating the back and the front. Seam the sides and the underarms.
