PLEASE REMEMBER TO GAUGE SWATCH

10 cm of stockinette or diamond lace stitch, on 5 mm needles = 15 sts. and 24 rws

YARN	COLOUR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52
P. LIGHT	CHANTILLY or BLEUET or JADE or YOUR CHOICE	3	3	3	4	4

Yarn composition: 53 % Acrylic - 29 % Polyamide - 18 % Wool

TOOLS & MATERIALS

4 mm knitting needles (1/1 ribbing)
5,5 mm knitting needles (stockinette - diamond lace stitch)
Stitch markers + 1 tapestry needle

STITCH PATTERNS USED

1/1 ribbing
Stockinette
Diamond lace stitch pattern (see chart)

«Don't skip the gauge swatch if you want to be sure that your finished piece is top-notch!»

KNITTING THE PATTERN

BACK PIECE

With your 4 mm needles, CO 74 - 78 - 84 - 90 - 98 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 4 cm.

Switch to your 5 mm needles, knit in stockinette, make 1 inc. on the 1st rw.

Your tot. stitch count should be: 75 - 79 - 85 - 91 - 99 sts.

Armholes

At a tot. height of 36 cm, BO on both sides: 1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 2 sts. and 1 x 1 sts.

We have 63 - 67 - 73 - 79 - 87 sts. left.

Shoulders and neckline

At a tot. height of 55 - 56 - 57 - 58 - 59 cm, BO for the shoulders on both sides:

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 5 sts.
1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 5 sts. and 1 x 6 sts.
1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 6 sts. and 1 x 7 sts.
1 x 7 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 7 sts.
1 x 8 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 8 sts. and 1 x 9 sts.

Simultaneously, as the 1st shoulder dec., BO the 17 - 17 - 17 - 19 - 19 centr. sts. for the neckline, then continue one side at a time, binding off on the neckline side, 2 rws above: 1 x 9 sts.

FRONT PIECE

With your 4 mm knitting needles, CO 74 - 78 - 84 - 90 - 98 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 4 cm.

Switch to your 5 mm needles, knit in stockinette, make 1 inc. on the 1st rw.

Your tot. stitch count should be: 75 - 79 - 85 - 91 - 99 sts.

Pay attention, at a tot. height of 30 cm, start knitting in the diamond lace stitch pattern (see chart).

Armholes

At a tot. height of 36 cm, BO on both sides: 1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 2 sts. and 1 x 1 sts.

We have 63 - 67 - 73 - 79 - 87 sts. left.

Neckline

At a tot. height of 48 - 49 - 50 - 51 - 52 cm, BO the 17 - 17 - 17 - 19 - 19 centr. sts., then finish one side at a time, BO on the neckline side: every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 sts. and 6 rws above: 1 x 1 sts.

Shoulder

At a tot. height of 55 - 56 - 57 - 58 - 59 cm, BO on the armhole side:

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 5 sts.
1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 5 sts. and 1 x 6 sts.
1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 6 sts. and 1 x 7 sts.
1 x 7 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 7 sts.
1 x 8 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 8 sts. and 1 x 9 sts.

SLEEVES

With your 4 mm knitting needles, CO 38 - 42 - 44 - 48 - 50 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 4 cm.

Switch to your 5 mm needles, knit in stockinette while distributing 8 - 6 - 8 - 6 - 8 inc. on the 1st rw.

We have: 46 - 48 - 52 - 54 - 58 sts.

Inc. 1 st. on each side:

16 rws above: 1 time and every 14 rws: 5 times
every 14 rws: 6 times
every 14 rws: 6 times
every 14 rws: 5 times and 12 rws above: 1 time
every 14 rws: 3 times and every 12 rws: 3 times

We have: 58 - 60 - 64 - 66 - 70 sts.

Rounding the shape

At a tot. height of 46 - 45,5 - 44,5 - 43,5 - 41,5 cm, BO on both sides:
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 4 x 2 sts., 1 x 3 sts. and 1 x 4 sts.
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 3 sts., 3 x 2 sts., 1 x 3 sts. and 1 x 4 sts.
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 2 x 3 sts. and 1 x 4 sts.
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 1 x 3 sts. and 2 x 4 sts.
1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 4 sts. and 1 x 5 sts.

BO the remaining 14 sts.

NECKBAND

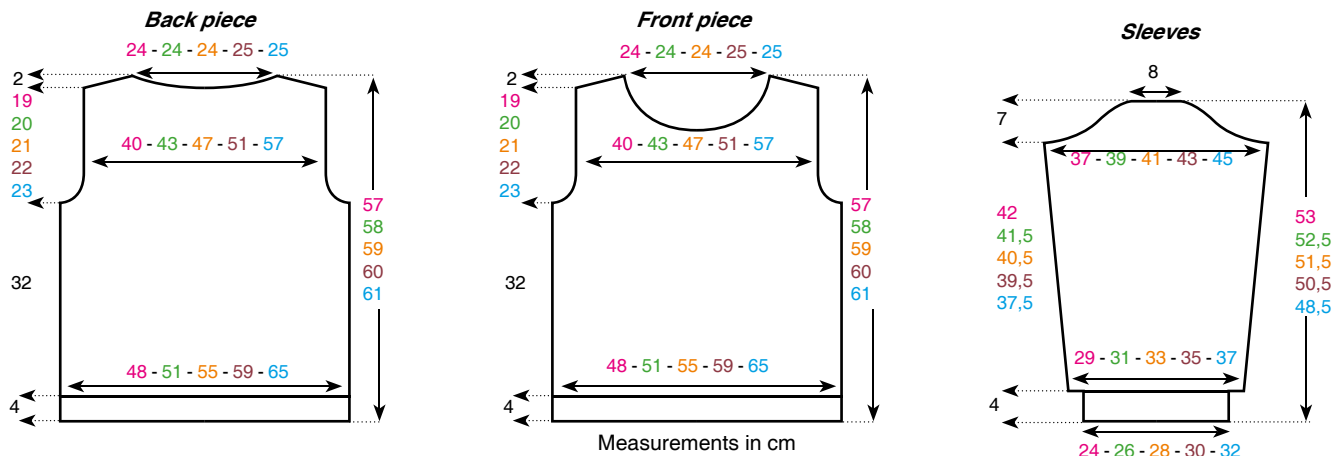
With your 4 mm knitting needles, CO 96 - 96 - 96 - 100 - 100 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 2,5 cm, then make 1 rw of knit stitches on the RS, and a few rows of stockinette in a diff. col.

SEAMING

Seam the shoulders, the sides and the underarms.

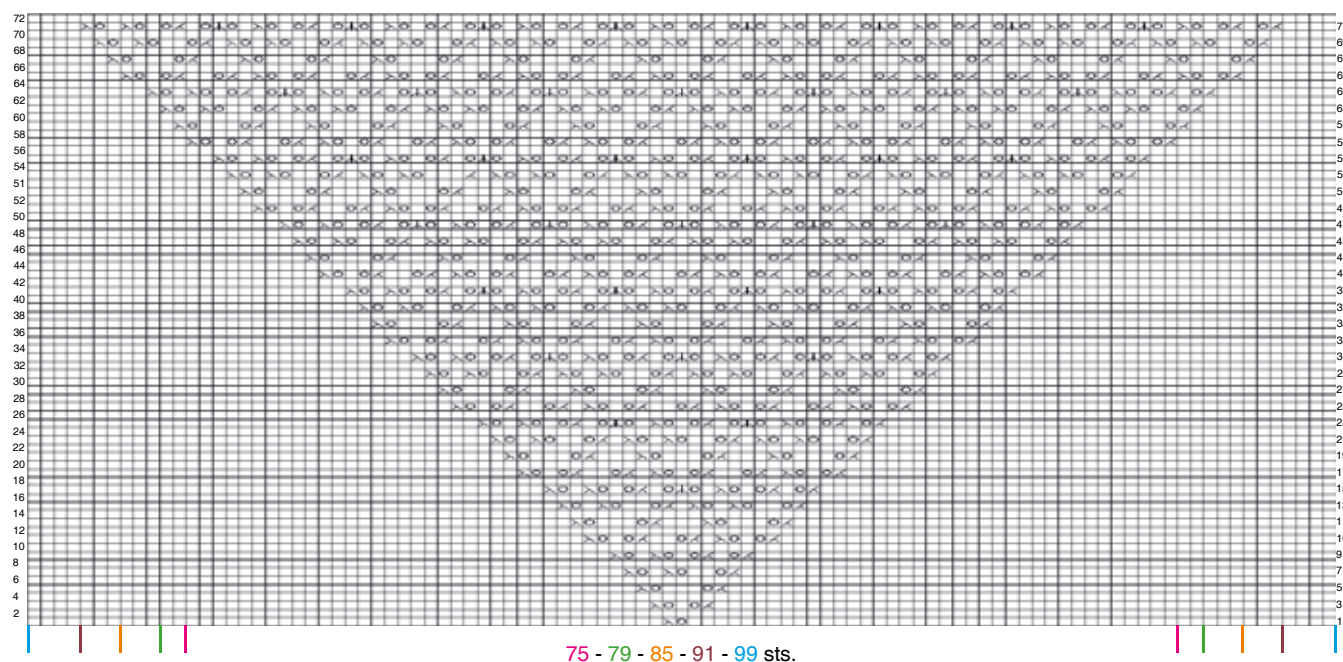
Attach the sleeves to the body.

Using backstitch, attach the neckband stitch by stitch on the right side of your work.



Diamond lace stitch pattern chart (front)

The chart represents the largest size, for any other size please refer to the instructions



At the edges, only make a YO if it's compensated by a decrease and vice versa.

	= RS: K1 / WS: P1
	= YO (yarn over)
	= K2tog (knit 2 sts. together)
	= skpo (on the RS: slip 1 st., knit 1 st., pass sl. st. over.)
	= double decrease done over 3 sts. (RS): sl2tog-K1-ssso. (slip 2 sts. tog., knit 1 st., pass slipped stitches over.)
