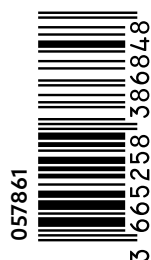

To knit this sweater, you'll need:

Size 34/36: 6 skeins of PHIL VENUS in the colourway MENTHOL or PETUNIA or YOUR CHOICE

Size 38/40: 6 skeins of PHIL VENUS in the colourway MENTHOL or PETUNIA or YOUR CHOICE

Size 42/44: 6 skeins of PHIL VENUS in the colourway MENTHOL or PETUNIA or YOUR CHOICE

Size 46/48: 7 skeins of PHIL VENUS in the colourway MENTHOL or PETUNIA or YOUR CHOICE

Size 50/52: 7 skeins of PHIL VENUS in the colourway MENTHOL or PETUNIA or YOUR CHOICE

Yarn composition: 52 % Polyamide - 33 % Merino Wool - 15 % Alpaca

Tools & Materials needed:

From the PPY line:

Knitting needles 3,5 mm and 4 mm (or other sizes following your gauge swatch)

Stitch markers

1 tapestry needle

4 buttons Ø 20 mm ref: 054580 2225 10

Gauge swatch & obtaining the right dimensions for your sweater:

When knitting your gauge swatch, it's always best to do so "in pattern". For this model we'll be using stockinette and your 4 mm needles. 20 stitches and 30 rows = a square of 10 cm x 10 cm, after blocking

CONSTRUCTION

The different size options have been colour-coded in order to help you follow the instructions for the size you wish to knit with more ease.

KNITTING THE BACK

Step 1: With your 3,5 mm needles, CO 97 - 103 - 111 - 119 - 131 sts.

Step 2: Knit in 1/1 ribbing (meaning: K1, P1, until the end of the row. For the following rows: Knit all sts. as they appear, meaning: K knit sts, P purl sts.) Knit in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 2 cm.

Step 3: Switch to your 4 mm needles, knit 1 row of knit stitches, increasing with 1 st. in the beginning of the row.

We now have 98 - 104 - 112 - 120 - 132 sts. Continue by knitting in stockinette (meaning: 1st rw (RS): K all sts. 2nd rw (WS): P all sts. Keep repeating these 2 rws), continue until you've reached a tot. height of 28 cm.

Step 4: PM (place stitch markers) on the first and last st. of the row, to indicate the armholes.

Step 5: Continue knitting in stockinette until you've reached a tot. height of 48 - 49 - 50 - 51 - 52 cm.

Step 6: BO all sts. PM after the 29th - 32rd - 36th - 39th - 45th st. and before the 70th - 73rd - 77th - 82nd - 88th st., to indicate the end of the shoulder seams.

KNITTING THE RIGHT HALF FRONT PIECE

Step 1: With your 3,5 mm needles, CO 47 - 49 - 53 - 57 - 63 sts.

Step 2: Knit in 1/1 ribbing, starting the 1st row with K2. Finish the row with P1. Knit in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 2 cm.

Step 3: Switch to your 4 mm needles, knit in stockinette inc. (increase) 1 sts. on the 1st row - inc. 1 sts. on the 1st row - inc. 1 sts. on the 1st row - inc. 1 sts. on the 1st row.

We now have 47 - 50 - 54 - 58 - 64 sts. Continue knitting in stockinette until you've reached a tot. height of 28 - 29 - 30 - 31 - 32 cm.

Step 4: Shape the neckline in the following way:

On the first 2 sts.: K2tog (knit 2 sts. together) and finish the row. Knit 3 rows. Repeat this sequence 11 more times. K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 1 row. Repeat this sequence 5 more times.

K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 3 rows. Repeat this sequence 11 more times. K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 1 row. Repeat this sequence 5 more times.

K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 3 rows. Repeat this sequence 11 more times. K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 1 row. Repeat this sequence 5 more times.

K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 3 rows. Repeat this sequence 10 more times. K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 1 row. Repeat this sequence 7 more times.

K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 3 rows. Repeat this sequence 10 more times. K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 1 row. Repeat this sequence 7 more times.

Step 5: Continue knitting in stockinette until you've reached a tot. height of 48 - 49 - 50 - 51 - 52 cm.

Step 6: BO all sts. PM on the left selvedge stitch, at a tot. height of 28 cm, to indicate the armhole.

KNITTING THE LEFT HALF FRONT PIECE

Step 1: With your 3,5 mm needles, CO 47 - 49 - 53 - 57 - 63 sts.

Step 2: Knit in 1/1 ribbing, starting the 1st row with P1. Finish the row with K2. Knit in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 2 cm.

Step 3: Switch to your 4 mm needles, knit in stockinette inc. 1 sts. on the 1st row - inc. 1 sts. on the 1st row - inc. 1 sts. on the 1st row - inc. 1 sts. on the 1st row.

We now have 47 - 50 - 54 - 58 - 64 sts. Continue knitting in stockinette until you've reached a tot. height of 28 - 29 - 30 - 31 - 32 cm.

Step 4: Shape the neckline in the following way: knit 1 row, to get to the purlside (wrong side of your work):

K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 3 rows. Repeat this sequence 11 more times. K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 1 row. Repeat this sequence 5 more times.

K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 3 rows. Repeat this sequence 11 more times. K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 1 row. Repeat this sequence 5 more times.

K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 3 rows. Repeat this sequence 11 more times. K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 1 row. Repeat this sequence 5 more times.

K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 3 rows. Repeat this sequence 10 more times. K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 1 row. Repeat this sequence 7 more times.

K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 3 rows. Repeat this sequence 10 more times. K2tog (on the first 2 sts.) and finish the row. Knit 1 row. Repeat this sequence 7 more times.

Step 5: Continue knitting in stockinette until you've reached a tot. height of 48 - 49 - 50 - 51 - 52 cm.

Step 6: BO all sts. PM on the right selvedge stitch, at a tot. height of 28 cm, to indicate the armhole.

KNITTING THE SLEEVES

Step 1: With your 3,5 mm needles, CO 50 - 54 - 58 - 62 - 66 sts.

Step 2: Knit in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 2 cm.

Step 3: Switch to your 4 mm needles and begin knitting in stockinette, inc. (increase) by 1 st. at the beginning and end of the following rows:

11th, 21st, 31st, 41st, 51st, 61st, 71st, 79th, 87th, 95th, 103rd, 111th, 119th, 127th and 135th row.

11th, 21st, 31st, 41st, 51st, 61st, 69th, 77th, 85th, 93rd, 101st, 109th, 117th, 125th and 133rd row.

11th, 21st, 31st, 41st, 49th, 57th, 65th, 73rd, 81st, 89th, 97th, 105th, 113th, 121st and 129th row.
 11th, 21st, 31st, 39th, 47th, 55th, 63rd, 71st, 79th, 87th, 95th, 103rd, 111th, 119th and 127th row.
 9th, 17th, 25th, 33rd, 41st, 49th, 57th, 65th, 73rd, 81st, 89th, 97th, 105th, 113th and 121st row.
 We now have 80 - 84 - 88 - 92 - 96 sts.

Step 4: Continue knitting in stockinette until you've reached a tot. height of 49 - 48,5 - 47,5 - 46,5 - 44,5 cm.
 BO all sts. PM in the middle of the sleeve (point M in the pattern illustration).

Knit the second sleeve in the same way.

KNITTING THE NECKBAND AND THE BUTTON BANDS

Step 1: With your 3,5 mm needles, CO 9 sts.

Step 2: Knit in 1/1 ribbing, starting and ending with K2. Continue knitting until you've reached a tot. height of 61 - 62 - 63 - 65 - 66 cm.

Step 3: BO all sts.

Step 4: With your 3,5 mm needles, CO 9 sts.

Step 5: Knit in 1/1 ribbing, starting and ending with K2, do this for 4 rows.

Step 6: Shape 4 buttonholes in the following way: on the 5th row, **K4, K2tog, then K3**. In the following row, increase 1 sts. on top of each buttonhole that you shaped by knitting 2 together on the last row.
 Repeat the sequence in **bold** on the 23rd, 41st and 57th row -
 23rd, 41st, 57th row - 25th, 43rd and 63rd row - 25th, 45th and 65th row -
 25th, 45th and 65th row.

Step 7: Knit in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 61 - 62 - 63 - 65 - 66 cm.

Step 8: BO all sts.

SEAMING & FINISHING TOUCHES

Step 1: Place the back and two front pieces right sides together. Seam the shoulders using backstitch, until the stitch markers you put in place, following the green lines on the pattern illustration.

Step 2: Place one sleeve between the 2 stitch markers of the back and front pieces. Place the right side of the sleeve towards the right side of the body. Match up the M point of the sleeve, with the M point of the shoulder seam, as indicated in the pattern illustration.

Backstitch the sleeve into place following the red lines in the pattern illustration. Assemble and seam the second sleeve in the same way.

Step 3: Seam the sides (of the back and half front pieces) together using the mattress stitch, following the blue lines in the pattern illustration.

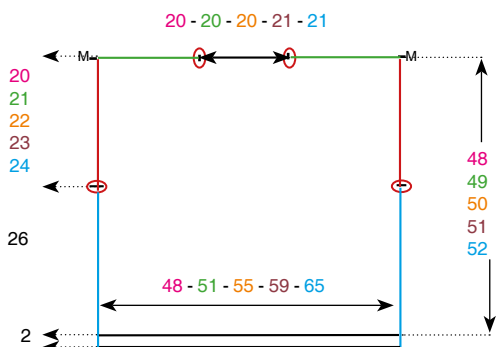
Step 4: Seam the underarms closed in the same way, following the yellow lines in the pattern illustration.

Step 5: Attach the button band with the buttonholes along the right half front piece, until the middle of the back neckline, using backstitch.

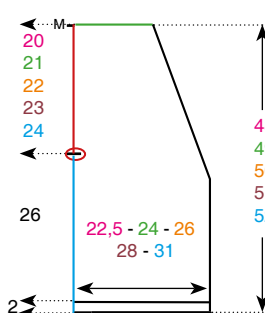
Step 6: Attach the other button band in the same way, along the left half front piece. Bring the two button bands together at the middle of the back neckline.

Step 7: Sew the buttons onto the button band, matching up with the buttonholes.

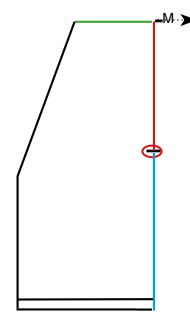
Back piece



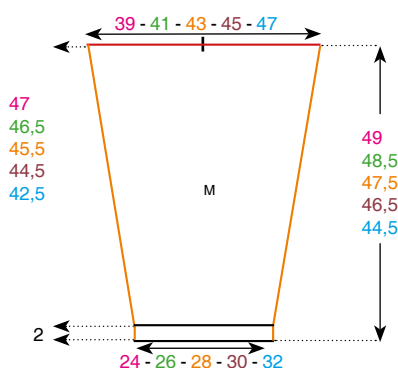
Right half front piece
