To knit this sweater, you'll need:

Size 34/36: 6 skeins of PHIL CHIC in the colourway ABRICOT, VIOLET, BLUEBERRY or YOUR CHOICE

Size 38/40: 7 skeins of PHIL CHIC in the colourway ABRICOT, VIOLET, BLUEBERRY or YOUR CHOICE

Size 42/44: 7 skeins of PHIL CHIC in the colourway ABRICOT, VIOLET, BLUEBERRY or YOUR CHOICE

Size 46/48: 8 skeins of PHIL CHIC in the colourway ABRICOT, VIOLET, BLUEBERRY or YOUR CHOICE

Size 50/52: 8 skeins of PHIL CHIC in the colourway ABRICOT, VIOLET, BLUEBERRY or YOUR CHOICE

Yarn composition: 50 % Mohair - 32 % Wool - 16 % Polyamide - 2 % Elastane

Tools & Materials needed:

From the PPY line:

Circular knitting needles n° 5,5 and 6 (5,5 mm, 6 mm) or other sizes following your gauge swatch)

Stitch markers

1 tapestry needle

5 buttons Ø 20 mm. ref.: 054579 2844 10

Gauge swatch & obtaining the right dimensions for your sweater:

When knitting your gauge swatch, it's always best to do so "in pattern". For this model we'll be using stockinette and your 6 mm circular needles. 18 stitches and 28 rows = a square of 10 cm x 10 cm, after blocking.

CONSTRUCTION

The different size options have been colour-coded in order to help you follow the instructions for the size you wish to knit with more ease.

KNITTING THE BODY

WE BEGIN AT THE BOTTOM OF THE BODY

The body is knit in one piece on circ. needles, without side seams (but not in the round!).

Step 1: With your 5,5 mm circ. needles, CO 167 - 179 - 195 - 207 - 231 sts.

Step 2: Knit in 1/1 ribbing (meaning: K1, P1, until the end of the row. For the following rows: Knit all sts. as they appear, meaning: K knit sts, P purl sts.) Knit in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 3 cm.

Step 3: Switch to your 6 mm circ. needles and knit in stockinette (meaning: 1st rw (RS): K all sts. 2nd rw (WS): P all sts. Keep repeating these 2 rows.

Knit in stockinette until you've reached a tot. height of 30 cm.

Step 4: Separate your work into 3 parts.

Knit the first 41 - 44 - 48 - 51 - 57 sts. and leave on hold for the right half of the front piece. Knit the following 85 - 91 - 99 - 105 - 117 centr. sts. and leave on hold for the back piece. Knit the last 41 - 44 - 48 - 51 - 57 sts. and leave on hold for the left half of the front piece.

Finishing the left half of the front piece:

Step 5: Continue by knitting in stockinette on the last 41 - 44 - 48 - 51 - 57 sts., increasing with 1 st. in the beginning of the row.
We now have: 42 - 45 - 49 - 52 - 58 sts.

Continue knitting straight, in stockinette, until you've reached a total height of 41 - 42 - 43 - 44 - 45 cm.

Step 6: Shape the neckline, on the left in the following way:

Knit 1 row, then on the following row BO (bind off) 6 - 6 - 6 - 7 - 7 sts., finish the row.

Knit 1 row, then on the following row BO 4 sts., finish the row.

Knit 1 row, then on the following row BO 3 sts., finish the row

Knit 1 row, then on the following row BO 2 sts., finish the row.

Knit 3 rows, then on the following row BO 1 sts., finish the row.

Knit 5 rows, then on the following row BO 1 sts., finish the row.

We have: 26 - 29 - 33 - 35 - 41 sts. left.

Step 7: Knit in stockinette, until you've reached a total height of 49 - 50 - 51 - 52 - 53 cm, then BO all sts.

Finishing the right half of the front piece:

Step 8: Continue by knitting in stockinette on the first 41 - 44 - 48 - 51 - 57 sts., increasing with 1 st. in the beginning of the row.

We now have: 42 - 45 - 49 - 52 - 58 sts.

Continue knitting straight, in stockinette, until you've reached a total height of 41 - 42 - 43 - 44 - 45 cm.

Step 9: Shape the neckline, on the right in the following way:

BO 6 - 6 - 6 - 7 - 7 sts., finish the row, then knit 1 row.

BO 4 sts., finish the row, then knit 1 row.

BO 3 sts., finish the row, then knit 1 row.

BO 2 sts., finish the row, then knit 3 rows.

BO 1 st., finish the row, then knit 5 rows.

BO 1 st., finish the row,.

We have: 26 - 29 - 33 - 35 - 41 sts. left.

Step 10: Continue knitting in stockinette, until you've reached a total height of 49 - 50 - 51 - 52 - 53 cm, then BO all sts.

Finishing the back piece:

Step 11: Continue by knitting in stockinette on the 85 - 91 - 99 - 105 - 117 centr. sts. that you put on hold for the back. Knit 1 row on the RS, increasing with 1 st. at the beginning and end of the row. We now have: 87 - 93 - 101 - 107 - 119 sts.

Step 12: Continue knitting in stockinette, until you've reached a total height of 49 - 50 - 51 - 52 - 53 sts.

Step 13: BO all sts. PM (place stitch markers) on the 26th - 29th - 33rd - 35th - 41st st. and the 61st - 64th - 68th - 72nd - 78th st., to indicate the neckline.

Step 14: Place the back and front pieces right sides together. Sew the shoulders together using an invisible seam (backstitching), following the red lines on the pattern illustration.

KNITTING THE SLEEVES

Step 1: With your 6 mm needles, pick up 66 - 70 - 74 - 78 - 82 sts. for the armhole (yellow dotted lines in the pattern illustration).

Step 2: PM at the 1st st. to indicate BOR (beginning of round). Join in the round and knit stockinette in the round (meaning: K all sts. on every round).

Step 3: Continue in stockinette, while decreasing in the following way:

K2tog (knit 2 sts. together) on each side of the stitch marker, at the: 11th, 21st, 33rd, 45th, 57th, 69th, 81st, 93rd, 105th and 117th round.

K2tog on each side of the stitch marker, at the: 11th, 21st, 31st, 43rd, 55th, 67th, 79th, 91st, 103rd and 115th round.

K2tog on each side of the stitch marker, at the: 11th, 21st, 31st, 41st, 53rd, 65th, 77th, 89th, 101st and 113rd round.

K2tog on each side of the stitch marker, at the: 11th, 21st, 31st, 41st, 51st, 63rd, 75th, 87th, 99th and 111th round.

K2tog on each side of the stitch marker, at the: 11th, 21st, 31st, 41st, 51st, 61st, 71st, 81st, 93rd and 105th round.

We have: 46 - 50 - 54 - 58 - 62 sts. left. Continue knitting in stockinette, until you've reached a total height of 46 - 45,5 - 44,5 - 43,5 - 41,5 cm.

Step 4: Switch to your 5,5 mm needles and start knitting in circ. 1/1 ribbing (meaning: K1, P1. every round), making on the 1st round: K2tog, 4 times. We now have: **42 - 46 - 50 - 54 - 58** sts. Continue knitting until you've reached a total height of **49 - 48,5 - 47,5 - 46,5 - 44,5** cm. BO all sts.

Knit the second sleeve in the same way.

KNITTING THE NECKBAND

Step 1: With your 5,5 mm circ. needles, pick up **93 - 93 - 93 - 99 - 99** sts. around the neckline.

Step 2: Knit in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 3 cm, then BO all sts.

KNITTING THE BUTTON BAND

Step 1: With your 5,5 mm circ. needles, pick up along the left front piece and on the 3 cm of the neckband **91 - 93 - 95 - 97 - 99** sts.

Step 2: Knit in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 3 cm, then BO all sts.

Knit the second button band in the following way:

Step 1: With your 5,5 mm circ. needles, pick up along the right front piece and on the 3 cm of the neckband **91 - 93 - 95 - 97 - 99** sts.

Step 2: Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 4 rows.

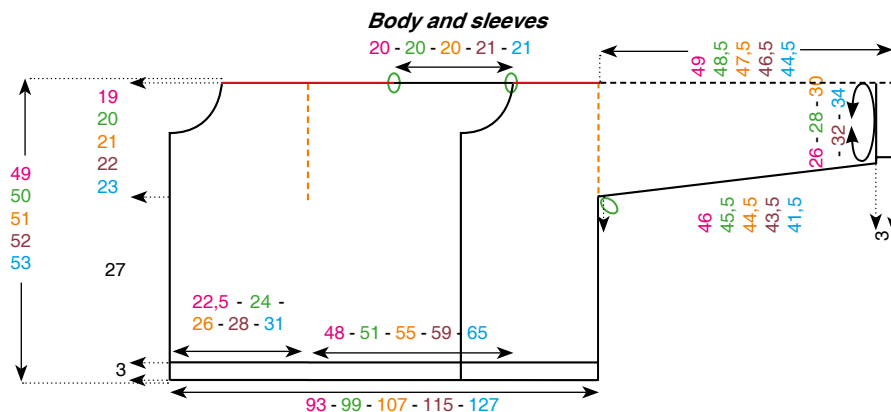
Step 3: Knit 1 row to shape the buttonholes, in the following way: Knit **5 - 6 - 5 - 6 - 5** sts. **K2tog, knit 18 - 18 - 19 - 19 - 20** sts. Repeat the sequence in **bold** 3 more times. K2tog and finish the row.

Step 4: In the following row, increase 1 sts. on top of each buttonhole that you shaped by knitting 2 together on the last row.

Step 5: Knit in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 3 cm, then BO all sts.

SEAMING & FINISHING TOUCHES

Step 1: Sew the buttons onto the button band, matching up with the buttonholes.
