10 cm of stockinette on 5 mm needles = 17 sts. and 23 rws

Yarn composition: 55 % Polyamide - 25 % Acrylic - 20 % Wool

TOOLS & MATERIALS

From the PPY range:
4 mm knitting needles (1/1 ribbing)
5 mm knitting needles (stockinette)
Stitch holder + 1 tapestry needle
1 button Ø 9 mm ref: 055150 9999

STITCH PATTERNS USED

1/1 ribbing

Stockinette

Wavy 1/1 rib edge: Knit 6 rws of 1/1 ribbing then make 1 rw in the following way: knit 4 sts. in 1/1 ribbing then *make 1 wrapped st., 5 sts. in 1/1 ribbing*, rep. from *to*, finish with 1 wrapped st and 4 sts. in 1/1 ribbing. Finish in 1/1 ribbing.

Wrapped stitch: pass your right needle under the cast on rw (in front of your work) then pass the st. on your left needle onto your right needle and make your right needle come back in front of your work. Put the st. back onto your left needle and knit it. Finish in 1/1 ribbing.

KNITTING THE PATTERN

BACK PIECE

With your 4 mm needles, CO (cast on) 76 - 80 - 88 - 94 - 104 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 6 cm.

Switch to your 5 mm needles and knit in stockinette, distributing 3 - 5 - 5 - 5 - 5 inc. (increases) on the 1st rw.

We have: 79 - 85 - 93 - 99 - 109 sts.

Armholes

At a tot. height of 29 cm, BO (bind off) on both sides:

1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 st.
1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 st.
1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 3 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 st.
1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 4 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 st.
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 3 sts., 3 x 2 sts. and 4 x 1 st.
We have: 59 - 61 - 63 - 65 - 69 sts. left.

Keyhole opening

At a tot. height of 36 - 37 - 38 - 39 - 40 cm, BO the centr. st. then cont. one side at a time, binding off on the opening side every 2 rws: 2 x 1 st., then cont. knitting straight for 11 rws.

In the following rw, at 1 st. from the edge (opening side) make 1 inc. 1 time and 2 rws above: 1 time.

We have: 29 - 30 - 31 - 32 - 34 sts.

Neckline

At a tot. height of 44 - 45 - 46 - 47 - 48 cm, cont. by BO on the neckline side: 1 x 8 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.

1 x 8 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.
1 x 8 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.
1 x 9 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.
1 x 9 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.

Shoulder

At a tot. height of 48 - 49 - 50 - 51 - 52 cm, BO on the armhole side:

1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts. and 2 x 4 sts.
1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 4 sts.
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 4 sts.
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 4 sts.
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 5 sts.

Finish the other side of the opening in the same way.

FRONT PIECE

Knit the front piece in the same way as the back piece, until the armholes.

We have: 59 - 61 - 63 - 65 - 69 sts.

Neckline

At a tot. height of 44 - 45 - 46 - 47 - 48 cm, BO the 17 - 17 - 17 - 19 - 19 centr. sts. Then finish one side at a time, binding off on the neckline side every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.

Shoulder

At a tot. height of 48 - 49 - 50 - 51 - 52 cm, BO on the armhole side:

1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts. and 2 x 4 sts.
1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 4 sts.
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 4 sts.
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 3 x 4 sts.
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts. and 2 x 5 sts.

SLEEVES

With your 4 mm needles, CO 50 - 54 - 56 - 60 - 64 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 6 cm.

Switch to your 5 mm needles and knit in stockinette, distributing 5 inc. on the 1st rw.

We have: 55 - 59 - 61 - 65 - 69 sts.

Inc. 1 st. on both sides:

every 6 rws: 4 times
every 6 rws: 4 times
every 6 rws: 3 times and every 4 rws: 2 times
every 4 rws: 6 times
every 4 rws: 7 times

We have: 63 - 67 - 71 - 77 - 83 sts.

Rounding the shape

At a tot. height of 19 cm, BO on both sides:

1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 2 sts., 3 x 1 st., every 8 rws: 3 x 1 st., then every 2 rws: 1 x 2 sts. and 1 x 3 sts.
1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 2 sts., 3 x 1 st., 6 rws above: 1 x 1 st., every 8 rws: 2 x 1 st., then every 2 rws: 1 x 2 sts. and 1 x 3 sts.
1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 2 sts., 3 x 1 st., 6 rws above: 1 x 1 st., 8 rws above: 1 x 1 st., 6 rws above: 1 x 1 st., every 2 rws: 2 x 2 sts. and 1 x 3 sts.
1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 3 x 1 st., every 6 rws: 3 x 1 st. then every 2 rws: 2 x 2 sts. and 1 x 3 sts.
1 x 3 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 3 x 1 st., 6 rws above: 1 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., 6 rws above: 1 x 1 st., then every 2 rws: 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 3 sts.
We have: 31 sts. remaining.

Shape the shoulder gathers in the following way: K2, *K3tog, K1* rep. from * to * 6 times tot., finish with K3tog, K2. Knit 1 rw over the 17 sts. remaining, then BO all sts.

Collar

With your 4 mm needles, CO 75 - 75 - 75 - 81 - 81 sts. and knit in wavy 1/1 rib edge (see stitch patterns used) for 6 cm, then make 1 rw of knit sts. on the RS (right side) and a few rws of stockinette in a diff. colour.

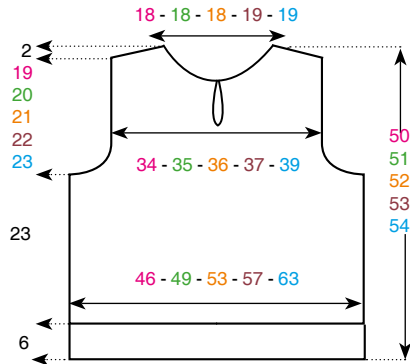
SEAMING

Seam the shoulders, sides and underarms.

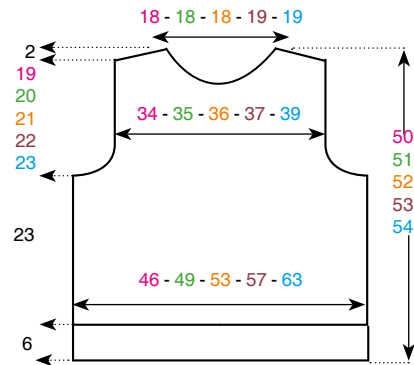
Gather the top of the sleeves over 8 cm, attach the sleeves to the armholes. Using backstitch, sew the collar onto the RS of your work, stitch by stitch.

Make 1 buttonhole using your needle (it looks like a loop, see advice section) at the top of the keyhole opening on the back, attach the button so that it faces the buttonhole.

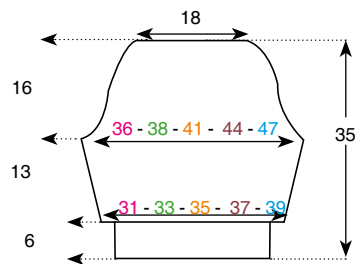
Back piece



Front piece

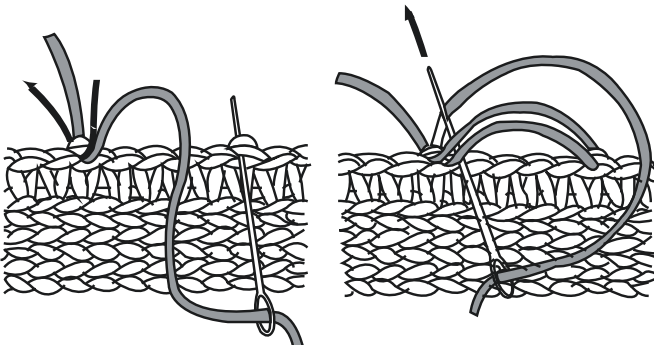


Sleeves

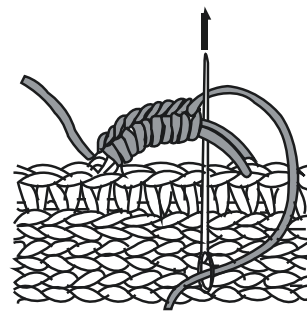


Measurements in cm

Buttonhole stitch using a needle



Thread a tapestry needle and insert it into the border, make 2 (or 3) loops by going from the left to the right, at the placement where you want your buttonhole to be, make sure the length (distance between where you insert your needle to the right and left) is slightly larger than the diameter of your button.



Tightly embroider around the 2 (or 3) loops you made using the buttonhole stitch.

Weave in your ends on the wrong side of your work.
