Estimated time 30 hours or more to finish

To knit this sweater, you'll need:

Size 34/36: 9 skeins of PHIL CHIC in the colourway ABRICOT or NUDE
Size 38/40: 10 skeins of PHIL CHIC in the colourway ABRICOT or NUDE
Size 42/44: 11 skeins of PHIL CHIC in the colourway ABRICOT or NUDE
Size 46/48: 12 skeins of PHIL CHIC in the colourway ABRICOT or NUDE
Size 50/52: 13 skeins of PHIL CHIC in the colourway ABRICOT or NUDE

Yarn composition: 50 % Mohair - 32 % Wool - 16 % Polyamide - 2 % Elastane

Tools & materials needed:

PPY knitting needles n° 4 and n° 5 (4 mm, 5 mm) or other sizes following your gauge swatch
1 tapestry needle

Gauge swatch & obtaining the right dimensions for your sweater:

When knitting your gauge swatch, it's always best to do so "in pattern". For this model we'll be using half fisherman's rib and your 5 mm needles. 16 sts. (stitches) and 35 rws (rows) = a square of 10 cm x 10 cm.

Stitch patterns used:

1/1 ribbing

Half fisherman's rib: is knit over an uneven number of sts

1st rw: 1 selvedge st., P1., **K1b** (knit 1 below), P1. Rep. (repeat) the **bold** sequence for the entire row, ending with 1 selvedge st.

2nd rw: K (knit) all sts.

Keep repeating these 2 rows.

CONSTRUCTION

When reading the pattern, follow the colour corresponding to the size you wish to knit, we've colour-coded our instructions to help you.

KNITTING THE BACK PIECE

Step 1: With your 4 mm needles, CO (cast on) 89 - 93 - 99 - 105 - 115 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing, starting and ending the 1st rw with: K1. Knit in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 7 cm.

Step 2: Switch to your 5 mm needles and begin knitting in half fisherman's rib (see stitch patterns used).

Knit in half fisherman's rib until you've reached a tot. height of 35 cm.

Step 3: Shape the raglan armholes by BO (binding off) on both sides:

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 5 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., rep. the bold sequence 4 more times and 2 rws above: 1 x 1 st.**

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 7 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., rep. the bold sequence 3 more times and 2 rws above: 1 x 1 st.**

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 11 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., rep. the bold sequence 1 more time and 2 rws above: 10 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st. and 2 rws above: 1 x 1 st.**

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 12 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., rep. the bold sequence 1 more time and 2 rws above: 10 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st. and 2 rws above: 1 x 1 st.**

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 1 x 2 sts., 39 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st. and 2 rws above: 1 x 1 st.**

Step 4: BO the 23 - 23 - 23 - 25 - 25 sts. remaining.

KNITTING THE FRONT PIECE

Step 1: With your 4 mm needles, CO 89 - 93 - 99 - 105 - 115 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing, starting and ending the 1st rw with: K1. Knit in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 7 cm.

Step 2: Switch to your 5 mm needles and begin knitting in half fisherman's rib (see stitch patterns used).

Knit in half fisherman's rib until you've reached a tot. height of 35 cm.

Step 3: Shape the raglan armholes by BO on both sides:

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 5 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., rep. the bold sequence 3 more times and every 2 rws: 3 x 1 st.**

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 7 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., rep. the bold sequence 2 more times and every 2 rws: 5 x 1 st.**

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 11 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., rep. the bold sequence 1 more time and every 2 rws: 8 x 1 st.**

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 12 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., rep. the bold sequence 1 more time and every 2 rws: 8 x 1 st.**

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 1 x 2 sts., 37 x 1 st.**

Continue knitting in half fisherman's rib until you've reached a tot. height of 50 - 51 - 52 - 53 - 54 cm.

Step 4: Shape the neckline by BO the 9 - 9 - 9 - 11 - 11 centr. (central) sts. then finish one side at a time by BO on the neckline side, every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 1 x 1 st.

Step 5: BO the 3 sts. remaining.

Step 6: Finish the other side of the neckline.

KNITTING THE RIGHT SLEEVE

Step 1: With your 4 mm needles, CO 48 - 50 - 54 - 56 - 60 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 5 cm.

Step 2: Switch to your 5 mm needles and begin knitting in half fisherman's rib (see stitch patterns used), while distributing 3 inc. (increases) on the 1st rw. We have: 51 - 53 - 57 - 59 - 63 sts.

Step 3: Inc. 1 st. on each side:

every 12 rws: 7 times and every 10 rws: 5 times.

every 12 rws: 2 times and every 10 rws: 11 times.

every 10 rws: 12 times and every 8 rws: 2 times.

every 10 rws: 4 times and every 8 rws: 12 times.

every 8 rws: 12 times and every 6 rws: 7 times.

We have: 75 - 79 - 85 - 91 - 101 sts.

Continue knitting in half fisherman's rib until you've reached a tot. height of 46 cm.

Step 4: Shape the raglan armholes by BO on both sides:

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 5 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., rep. the bold sequence 3 more times and every 2 rws: 3 x 1 st.**

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 7 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., rep. the bold sequence 2 more times and every 2 rws: 5 x 1 st.**

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 11 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., rep. the bold sequence 1 more time and every 2 rws: 8 x 1 st.**

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 12 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st., rep. the bold sequence 1 more time and every 2 rws: 8 x 1 st.**

1 x 2 sts. then **every 2 rws: 1 x 2 sts., 37 x 1 st.**

We have: 17 - 17 - 17 - 19 - 19 sts. left.

Step 5: Continue by BO to the right:

1 x 4 sts. then **every 2 rws: 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.**

1 x 4 sts. then **every 2 rws: 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.**

1 x 4 sts. then **every 2 rws: 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.**

1 x 5 sts. then **every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.**

1 x 5 sts. then **every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.**

Simultaneously, BO to the left: 1 x 1 st. then 2 rws above: 1 x 1 st., 4 rws above: 1 x 1 st. and 2 rws above: 1 x 1 st.

Step 6: BO the 3 sts. remaining.

Knit the left sleeve in an opposite way, mirroring the right sleeve.

KNITTING THE NECKBAND

Step 1: With your 4 mm needles, CO 100 - 100 - 100 - 106 - 106 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 4 cm.

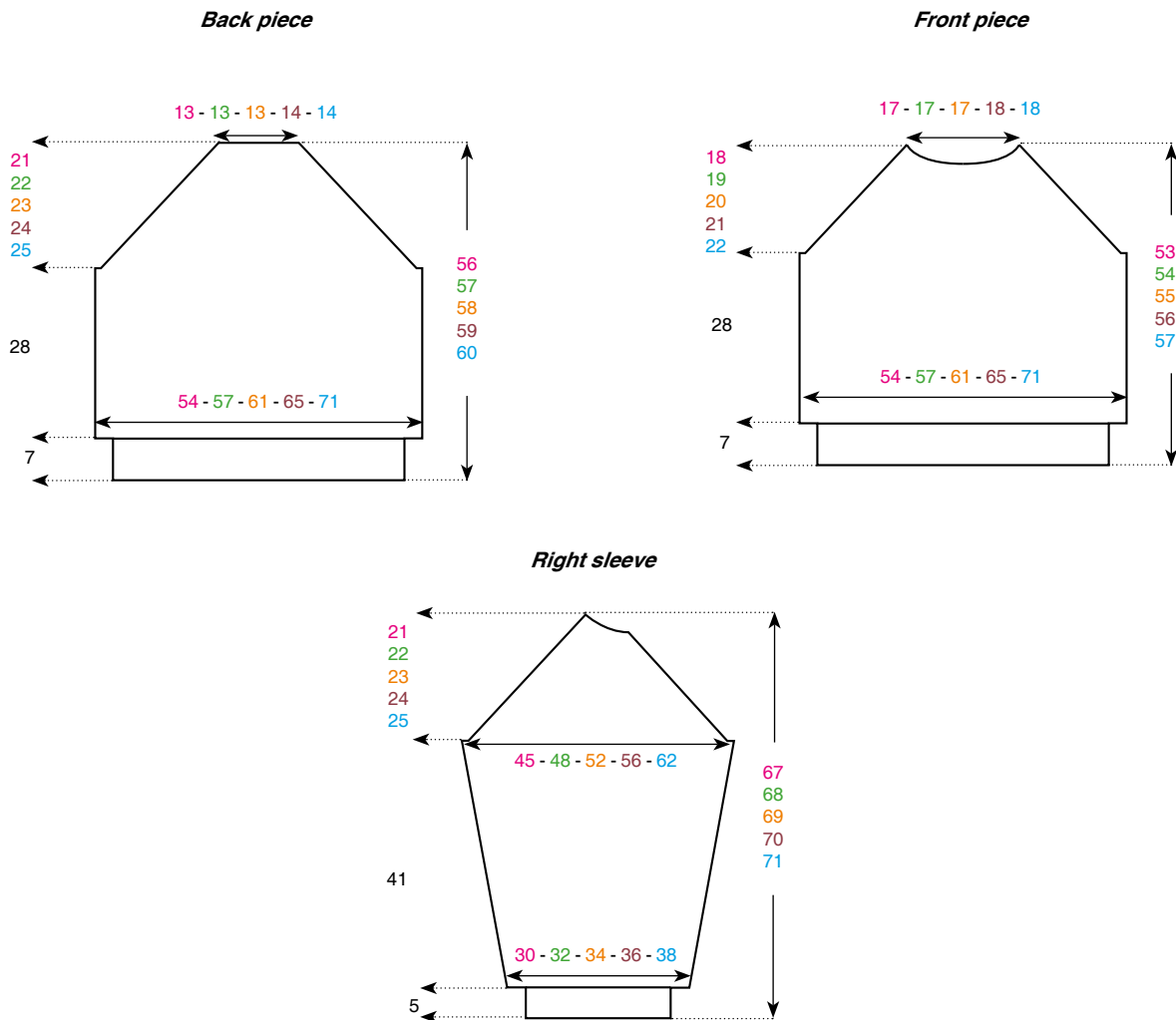
Step 2: Make 1 rw of knit sts. on the RS (right side) then knit a few rws of stockinette in a diff. col.

SEAMING & FINISHING TOUCHES

Step 1: Attach the sleeves to the body by the raglan (the shorter side corresponds to the front piece).

Step 2: Seam the sides and the underarms.

Step 3: Using backstitch, attach the neckband, stitch by stitch on the right side of your work.
