To knit this project, you'll need:

Size 34/36: 7 skeins of PHIL GIVRE in the colourway NATUREL
Size 38/40: 7 skeins of PHIL GIVRE in the colourway NATUREL
Size 42/44: 8 skeins of PHIL GIVRE in the colourway NATUREL
Size 46/48: 9 skeins of PHIL GIVRE in the colourway NATUREL
Size 50/52: 10 skeins of PHIL GIVRE in the colourway NATUREL

Yarn composition: 54 % Alpaca - 46 % Polyamide

Tools and materials needed:

PPY circular knitting needles n° 4,5 and n° 5,5 (4,5 mm, 5,5 mm) or other sizes following your gauge swatch
1 cable needle
Stitch markers + 1 tapestry needle
Stitch holders

Gauge swatch & obtaining the right dimensions for your project:

When knitting your gauge swatch, it's always best to do so "in pattern". For this model we'll be using stockinette and your 5,5 mm needles. 16 sts. (stitches) and 23 rws (rows) = a square of 10 cm x 10 cm.
You should also make gauge swatches for the 2 charts used:
The leaves stitch pattern (see chart 2) using your 5,5 mm needles = 5,5 cm wide for the 10 sts. at the beginning and 20,5 cm wide for the 36 sts. at the end. The 54 rnds (rounds) = 22 cm height.
The cable stitch pattern (see chart 1) using your 5,5 mm needles = 3 cm wide for the 7 sts. repeat.

Stitch patterns used:

1/1 ribbing in the round

Stockinette in the round

Leaves stitch pattern (see chart 2)

Cable stitch pattern (see chart 1)

Dec. (decrease) on each side of the stitch marker: when you have 3 sts. left before the stitch marker: K2tog (knit 2 sts. together), K1, sl. (slip) stitch marker, K1, then skpo (meaning: slip 1 st., K1, pass the slipped st. over the knitted st.)

CONSTRUCTION

When reading the pattern, follow the colour corresponding to the size you wish to knit, we've colour-coded our instructions to help you.
The sweater is knit top down in the round, in one piece, starting at the neckline.

KNITTING THE YOKE

Step 1: With your 5,5 mm circ. needles, CO (cast on) 80 sts., join in the round. PM (place stitch marker) at the 1st st. to indicate the BOR (beginning of round).

Step 2: Knit the leaves stitch pattern (see chart 2) in the round. The motif should repeat 8 times in the round (you can place stitch markers between each repeat to better navigate your project).

Step 3: Knit the 54 rounds of the leaves stitch pattern, we now have: 288 sts., 36 sts. for each motif repeat.

Step 4: Knit in stockinette and the cable stitch pattern (see chart 1) by organising your sts. in the following way: 2 sts. in stockinette, **the 7 sts. of the cable stitch pattern, 11 sts. in stockinette**, rep. (repeat) the bold sequence 14 more times, then knit the 7 sts. of the cable stitch pattern and 9 sts. in stockinette.

Knit for 2 rounds.

Knit for 4 rounds while making 16 inc. (increases) in the 3rd round (1 inc. in each section of stockinette, except the first 2 sts. at BOR).

Knit for 6 rounds while making 16 inc. (increases) in the 3rd and 5th round (1 inc. in each section of stockinette, except the first 2 sts. at BOR).

Knit for 8 rounds while making 16 inc. (increases) in the 3rd, 5th and 7th round (1 inc. in each section of stockinette, except the first 2 sts. at BOR).

Knit for 12 rounds while making 16 inc. (increases) in the 3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th and 11th round (1 inc. in each section of stockinette, except the first 2 sts. at BOR).

We now have: 288 - 304 - 320 - 336 - 368 sts., we've increased with 11 - 12 - 13 - 14 - 16 sts. in stockinette between each cable.

Step 5: Place 4 more stitch markers:

PM n° 1 after the 66th - 69th - 72nd - 75th - 81st st., indicating the 1st part of the back piece.

PM n° 2 at 59 - 63 - 67 - 71 - 79 sts. from M n° 1, indicating the 1st sleeve.

PM n° 3 at 85 - 89 - 93 - 97 - 105 sts. from M n° 2, indicating the front piece.

PM n° 4 at 59 - 63 - 67 - 71 - 79 sts. from M n° 3, indicating the 2nd sleeve.

We have: 19 - 20 - 21 - 22 - 24 sts. left until the BOR, these sts. are for the 2nd part of the back piece.

Step 6: Leave your sts. on hold.

KNITTING THE BACK AND FRONT PIECE

Step 1: With your 5,5 mm circ. needles, pick up the 66 - 69 - 72 - 75 - 81 sts. for the 1st part of the back piece, CO 4 - 6 - 8 - 10 - 12 sts. for the underarms (always knit these sts. in stockinette), PM at the centre of these 4 - 6 - 8 - 10 - 12 sts. (= sides of the sweater), pick up the 85 - 89 - 93 - 97 - 105 sts. for the front piece, CO 4 - 6 - 8 - 10 - 12 sts. for the underarms (always knit these sts. in stockinette), PM at the centre of these 4 - 6 - 8 - 10 - 12 sts. (= sides of the sweater), pick up the 19 - 20 - 21 - 22 - 24 sts. of the 2nd part of the back piece (leave the other sts. on hold, we knit the sleeves later).

We have: 178 - 190 - 202 - 214 - 234 sts.

Step 2: Join in the round and PM in a diff. col. for the BOR.

Step 3: Knit in stockinette and the cable stitch pattern (see chart 1).

We have: 11 - 12 - 13 - 14 - 16 sts. of stockinette between 2 cables except at the sides of the sweater where we have 10 - 12 - 14 - 16 - 18 sts. of stockinette.

Keep knitting in stockinette and the cable stitch pattern until you've reached a tot. height of 54 - 55 - 56 - 57 - 58 cm.

Step 4: Switch to your 4,5 mm circ. needles and knit in 1/1 ribbing (in the round).

Cont. knitting in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 58 - 59 - 60 - 61 - 62 cm.

Step 4: BO (bind off) all sts.

KNITTING THE SLEEVES

Step 1: With your 5,5 mm circ. needles, pick up 1 st. for each of the 2 - 3 - 4 - 5 - 6 last sts. added for the underarm, pick up the 59 - 63 - 67 - 71 - 79 sts. of one sleeve, then pick up 1 st. for each of the 2 - 3 - 4 - 5 - 6 first sts. added for the underarm.

We have: 63 - 69 - 75 - 81 - 91 sts.

Step 2: Join in the round and PM at the BOR.

Knit in stockinette and the cable stitch pattern (in the round).

We have: 11 - 12 - 13 - 14 - 16 sts. of stockinette between 2 cables except at the underarm where we have 20 - 24 - 28 - 32 - 38 sts. of stockinette.

Step 3: Make 1 dec. on each side of the stitch marker (see stitch patterns):

every 14 rws: 5 times.

every 12 rws: 6 times.

every 8 rws: 2 times and every 10 rws: 6 times.

every 8 rws: 7 times and every 10 rws: 2 times.

every 6 rws: 13 times.

We have: 53 - 57 - 59 - 63 - 65 sts.

Keep knitting in stockinette and the cable stitch pattern until you've reached a tot. height of 60 - 61 - 62 - 63 - 64 cm.

Step 4: Switch to your 4,5 mm circ. needles and knit in 1/1 ribbing (in the round), while distributing 15 dec. in the 1st rnd.

We have: 38 - 42 - 44 - 48 - 50 sts.

Cont. knitting in 1/1 ribbing until you've reached a tot. height of 63 - 64 - 65 - 66 - 67 cm.

Step 5: BO all sts.

Knit the second sleeve in the same way.

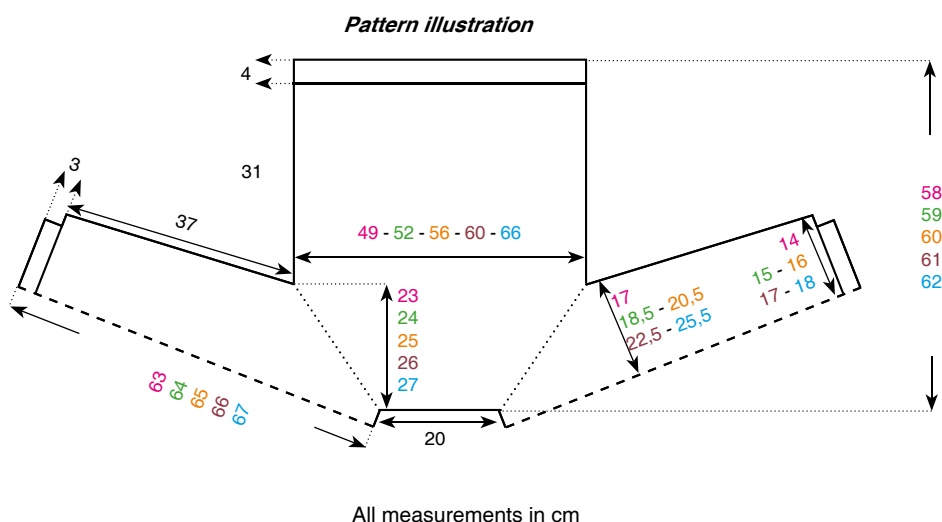
KNITTING THE NECKBAND

Step 1: With your 4,5 mm circ. needles, pick up 88 sts. around the neckline on the RS of your work.

Step 2: Join in the round and PM at the BOR.

Step 3: Knit in 1/1 ribbing (in the round) until you've reached a tot. height of 4 cm.

Step 4: BO all sts. for a scalloped neckline, in the following way: insert your needle into the st. 6 rnds below (on the RS) to BO the 5th st. Then BO every 8th st. in the same way (inserting your needle into the st. 6 rnds below).

⌘ = K2tog (knit 2 sts. together)

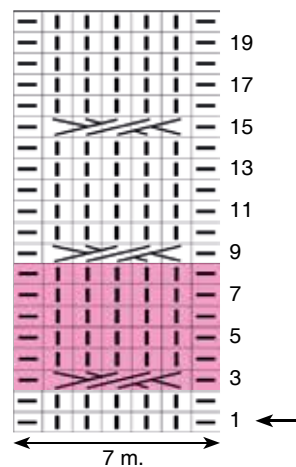
⌘ = skpo (meaning: slip 1 st., K1, pass the slipped st. over the knitted st.)
