Estimated time between 10 to 20 hours to finish

To knit this project, you'll need

Shoe size 37/39: 2 skeins of PHIL BABY SOCKS in the colourway BEIGE or GRIS CHINE CLAIR

Shoe size 40/42: 2 skeins of PHIL BABY SOCKS in the colourway BEIGE or GRIS CHINE CLAIR

Shoe size 43/45: 2 skeins of PHIL BABY SOCKS in the colourway BEIGE or GRIS CHINE CLAIR

Yarn composition: 75% Merino Wool - 25% Polyamide

Tools & Materials needed:

From the PPY range:

2 mm mini-circular knitting needles (1/1 ribbing)

2,5 mm mini-circular knitting needles (reverse stockinette of the heel and toe, lace and cables stitch pattern)

Cable needle

Stitch markers - stitch holder

1 tapestry needle

Gauge swatch & obtaining the right dimensions for your project:

When knitting your gauge swatch, it's always best to do so "in pattern". For this model we'll be using reverse stockinette and your 2,5 mm needles. 29 sts. (stitches) and 38 rws (rows) = a square of 10 cm x 10 cm.

You should also make another gauge swatch;

in lace and cables stitch pattern chart A with your 2,5 mm needles. 33 sts. and 37 rws = a square of 10 cm x 10 cm.

or lace and cables stitch pattern chart B with your 2,5 mm needles. 35 sts. and 37 rws = a square of 11 cm (wide) x 10 cm (tall).

Stitch patterns used:

1/1 ribbing

Reverse stockinette in the round: Purl every rw.

Lace and cables stitch pattern A: see chart

Lace and cables stitch pattern B: see chart

Skpo: slip 1 st., knit 1 st., pass the slipped stitch over the knitted stitch.

Sk2po: slip 1 st., knit 2 sts. together, pass the slipped stitch over the stitch you just made.

CONSTRUCTION

The different size options have been colour-coded in order to help you follow the instructions for the size you wish to knit with more ease.

Step 1: With your 2,5 mm circular needles, CO (cast on) 66 - 66 - 70 sts., (cast on loosely), PM (place stitch marker) at the 1st st. to indicate BOR (beginning of round) then join in the round.

Switch to your 2 mm circular needles and knit in 1/1 ribbing for 8 cm.

Step 2: Switch to your 2,5 mm circ. needles and knit in the lace and cables stitch pattern following: chart A - chart A - chart B (see charts).

KNITTING THE HEEL

Step 3: At a tot. height of 19 cm, put the first 33 - 33 - 35 sts. on hold for the top of the foot. Continue by knitting back and forth (not in the round) in reverse stockinette on the remaining 33 - 33 - 35 sts., using your 2,5 mm needles. Leave sts. on hold on each side, every 2 rws: 1 st., 8 times.

When you have: 17 - 17 - 19 sts. remaining, pick up sts. on each side every 2 rws: 1 st, 8 times. We have: 33 - 33 - 35 sts.

Step 4: Pick up the 33 - 33 - 35 sts. left on hold for the top of the foot, continue by knitting in the lace and cables stitch pattern for the top of the foot and in reverse stockinette for the sole (using your 2,5 mm circ. needles). Knit in this way for 16 - 18 - 20 cm.

KNITTING THE TOE

Step 5: Continue by knitting in reverse stockinette on all sts. in the following way:

P1, skpo, P 27 - 27 - 29 sts., K2tog (knit 2 sts. together), P2, skpo, P 27 - 27 - 29 sts., K2tog, K1.

We have: 62 - 62 - 66 sts. left.

2 rws above:

P1, skpo, P 25 - 25 - 27 sts., K2tog., P2, skpo, P 25 - 25 - 27 sts., K2tog, K1.

We have: 58 - 58 - 62 sts. left.

2 rws above:

P1, skpo, P 23 - 23 - 25 sts., K2tog., P2, skpo, P 23 - 23 - 25 sts., K2tog, K1.

We have: 54 - 54 - 58 sts. left.

2 rws above:

P1, skpo, P 21 - 21 - 23 sts., K2tog., P2, skpo, P 21 - 21 - 23 sts., K2tog, K1.

We have: 50 - 50 - 54 sts. left.

2 rws above:

P1, sk2po, P 17 - 17 - 19 sts., K3tog., P2, sk2po, P 17 - 17 - 19 sts., K3tog., K1.

We have: 42 - 42 - 46 sts. left.

2 rws above:

P1, sk2po, P 13 - 13 - 15 sts., K3tog., P2, sk2po, P 13 - 13 - 15 sts., K3tog., K1.

We have: 34 - 34 - 38 sts. left.

2 rws above:

P1, sk2po, P 9 - 9 - 11 sts., K3tog., P2, sk2po, P 9 - 9 - 11 sts., K3tog., K1.

We have: 26 - 26 - 30 sts. left.

Close the toe using the kitchener stitch.

 = RS: K1 / WS: P1

 = RS: P1 / WS: K1

 = WS: P3tog. (purl 3 sts. together)

 = make 3 sts. in 1 st. by making: K1, P1, K1 into the same stitch.

 = 3-st LPC (K2, P1): slip 2 sts. to cn (cable needle) and hold in front (of your work), P1, K2 from cn.

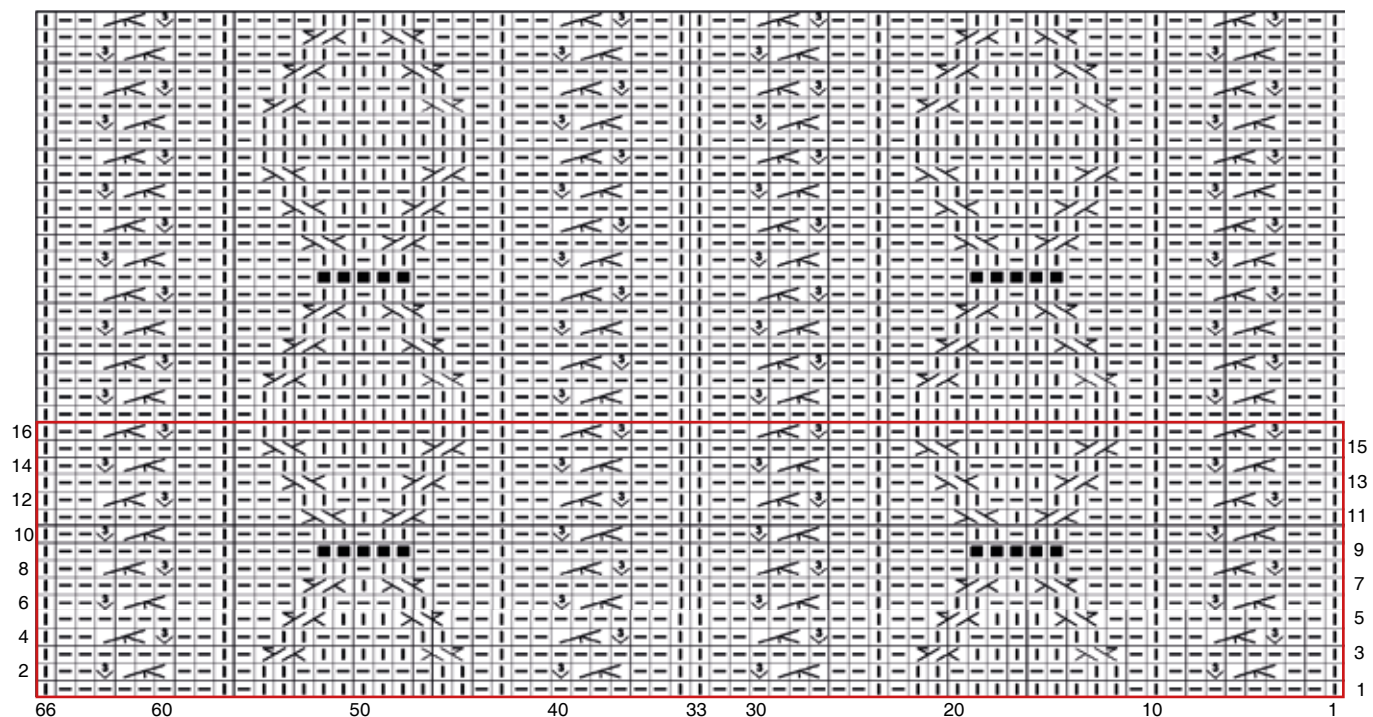
 = 3-st RPC (P1, K2): slip 1 st. to cn (cable needle) and hold back (behind your work), K2, P1 from cn.

 = 3-st RC (1 and 2): slip 1 st. to cn (cable needle) and hold back (behind your work), K2, K1 from cn.

 = 3-st LC (2 and 1): slip 2 sts. to cn (cable needle) and hold in front (of your work), K1, K2 from cn.

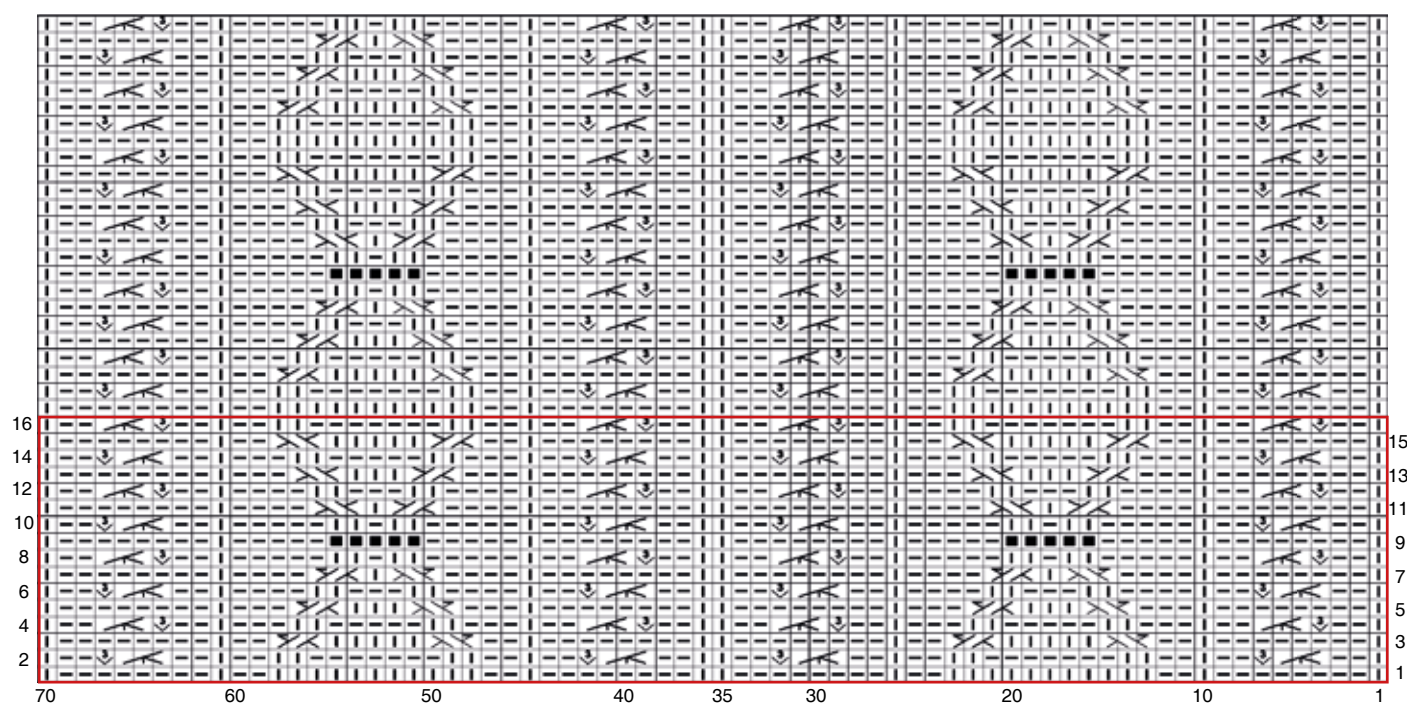
 = 5-st LPC (K2, P1, K2): slip 2 sts. to cn (cable needle) and hold in front (of your work), slip 1 st. to a 2nd cn and hold back (behind your work), K2, P1 from the 2nd cn, K2 from the 1st cn.

Lace and cables stitch pattern chart A



Keep repeating the 16 rws in the coloured rectangle

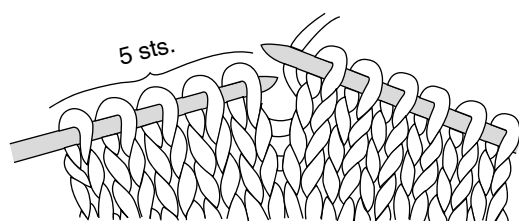
Lace and cables stitch pattern chart B



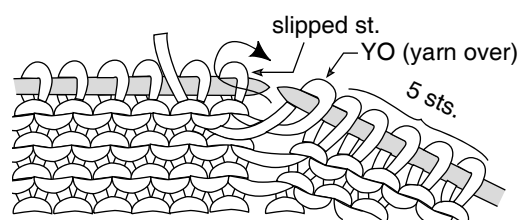
Keep repeating the 16 rws in the coloured rectangle

Knitting short rows

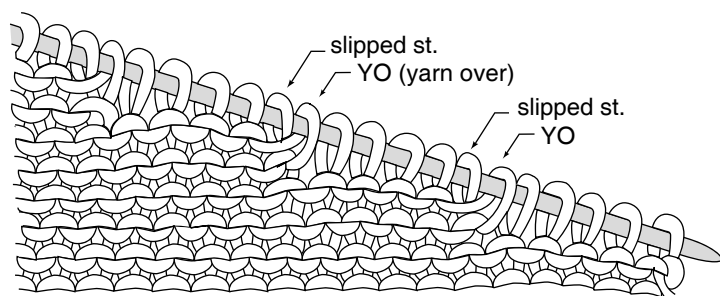
1/ On the RS (right side): knit the row, leaving the last 5 sts. on hold.



2/ Turn your work. Make 1 YO (yarn over), slip the next st. to your right needle, knit normally on the sts. following the slipped st.



3/ Repeat the same work at the end of every row until you've put as many sts. as needed on hold on this side.



4/ Then knit all sts.
At each row offset, knit the YO and the following st. together. The YO ends up behind the other st. and becomes invisible on the RS of your work.
