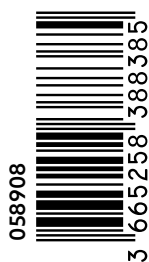

Estimated time between
10 to 20 hours to finish

To knit this sweater, you'll need:

One size: 3 skeins of PHIL INUIT in the colourway VISON

Dimensions:

30 cm wide, 20 cm tall (without handles), 13 cm deep.

Yarn composition: 100% Polyester

Tools & Materials needed:

PPY knitting needles n° 3,5 (3,5 mm)

1 tapestry needle

1 snap button of 13 mm, ref.: 070075 1472 01

Gauge swatch & obtaining the right dimensions for your project:

When knitting your gauge swatch, it's always best to do so "in pattern". For this model we'll be using stockinette and your 3,5 mm needles. 14 sts. (stitches) and 23 rws (rows) = a square of 10 cm x 10 cm.

KNITTING THE PATTERN

KNITTING THE BAG

Step 1: With your 3,5 mm needles, CO (cast on) 42 sts.

Step 2: Knit in stockinette, meaning : K all, on the RS (right side) row, P all on the WS (wrong side) row. Keep repeating these 2 rws. Continue knitting in stockinette until you've reached a tot. height of 21,5 cm then BO (bind off) all sts.

Step 3: Knit the second side in the same way.

Step 4: With your 3,5 mm needles, CO 20 sts. to knit the bottom of the bag.

Step 5: Knit in stockinette until you've reached a tot. height of 70 cm then BO all sts.

KNITTING THE HANDLES

Step 1: With your 3,5 mm needles, CO 7 sts. to knit the first handle of the bag.

Step 2: Knit in stockinette until you've reached a tot. height of 32 cm then BO all sts.

Step 3: Knit a second handle in the same way.

Step 4: Fold one handle in half and seam it along its length. Do the same on the second handle.

SEAMING & FINISHING TOUCHES

Step 1: Using a visible seam, sew the bottom and sides together on one side of the bag.

Step 2: Using a visible seam, sew the bottom and sides together on the other side of the bag.

Step 3: Sew one handle onto one side (see photo).

Step 4: Sew the other handle to the other side.

Step 4: Sew the snap button onto the bag.
