To knit this project, you'll need:

Size 34/36: 3 skeins of PHIL INUIT in the colourway VISON

Size 38/40: 3 skeins of PHIL INUIT in the colourway VISON

Size 42/44: 3 skeins of PHIL INUIT in the colourway VISON

Size 46/48: 3 skeins of PHIL INUIT in the colourway VISON

Size 50/52: 3 skeins of PHIL INUIT in the colourway VISON

Yarn composition: 100 % Polyester

Tools & Materials needed:

PPY knitting needles n°8 (8 mm) or other size following your gauge swatch.

Stitch markers

1 tapestry needle

Gauge swatch & obtaining the right dimensions for your project:

When knitting your gauge swatch, it's always best to do so "in pattern". For this model we'll be using stockinette and your 8 mm needles (n° 8). 9 sts. (stitches) and 11 rws (rows) = a square of 10 cm x 10 cm, after blocking.

CONSTRUCTION

The different size options have been colour-coded in order to help you follow the instructions for the size you wish to knit with more ease.

KNITTING THE BACK PIECE

Step 1: With your 8 mm needles, CO (cast on) 34 - 36 - 36 - 37 - 39 sts.

Step 2: Knit in stockinette, meaning: K (knit) all on the RS (right side) row, P (purl) all on the WS (wrong side) row. Keep repeating these 2 rws until you've reached a tot. (total) height of 48 - 49 - 50 - 51 - 52 cm.

Step 3: Shape the shoulders in the following way:

BO (bind off) 2 sts. and finish the rw. Rep. (repeat) in the following rw.

BO 3 sts. and finish the rw. Rep. in the following rw.

BO (bind off) 3 sts. and finish the rw. Rep. (repeat) in the following 3 rws.

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BO (bind off) 3 sts. and finish the rw. Rep. (repeat) in the following 3 rws.

BO (bind off) 3 sts. and finish the rw. Rep. (repeat) in the following rw.

BO 4 sts. and finish the rw. Rep. in the following rw.

We have: 24 - 24 - 24 - 25 - 25 sts. left.

Step 4: Keep knitting straight, in stockinette until you've reached a tot. height of 55 - 56 - 57 - 58 - 59 cm, then BO all sts.

KNITTING THE FRONT PIECE

Step 1: With your 8 mm needles, CO 34 - 36 - 36 - 37 - 39 sts.

Step 2: Knit in stockinette, meaning: K all on the RS (right side) row, P all on the WS (wrong side) row. Keep repeating these 2 rws until you've reached a tot. height of 40 - 41 - 42 - 43 - 44 cm.

Step 3: Shape the shoulders in the following way:

BO 2 sts. and finish the rw. Rep. in the following rw.

BO 3 sts. and finish the rw. Rep. in the following rw.

BO 3 sts. and finish the rw. Rep. in the following 3 rws.

We have: 24 - 24 - 24 - 25 - 25 sts. left.

Step 4: Keep knitting straight, in stockinette until you've reached a tot. height of 47 - 48 - 49 - 50 - 51 cm, then BO all sts.

KNITTING THE STRAPS

Step 1: With your 8 mm needles, CO 11 - 13 - 16 - 18 - 22 sts.

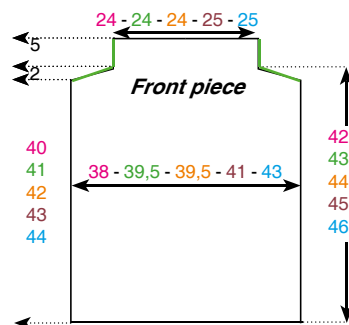
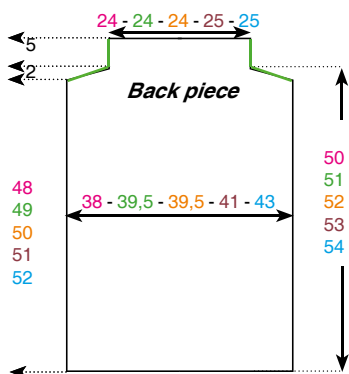
Step 2: Knit in stockinette, meaning: K all on the RS (right side) row, P all on the WS (wrong side) row. Keep repeating these 2 rws until you've reached a tot. height of 2 cm, then BO all sts.

Step 3: Knit 1 more strap in the same way.

SEAMING & FINISHING TOUCHES

Step 1: Place the back and front pieces right sides together. Sew the shoulders together using an invisible seam (backstitching), following the green lines on the pattern illustration.

Step 2: Sew the straps onto the sides at 30 - 31 - 32 - 33 - 34 cm from the shoulder seam.
