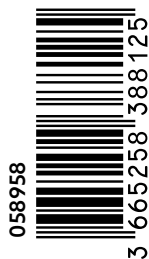

#### To knit this project, you'll need:

- Size 34/36:** 3 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway NACRE  
2 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway FLANELLE  
2 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway NOIR  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway CHANTILLY  
1 skein of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway GIVRE  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway NOIR
- Size 38/40:** 3 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway NACRE  
3 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway FLANELLE  
3 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway NOIR  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway CHANTILLY  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway GIVRE  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway NOIR
- Size 42/44:** 3 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway NACRE  
3 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway FLANELLE  
3 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway NOIR  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway CHANTILLY  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway GIVRE  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway NOIR
- Size 46/48:** 3 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway NACRE  
3 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway FLANELLE  
3 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway NOIR  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway CHANTILLY  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway GIVRE  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway NOIR
- Size 50/52:** 3 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway NACRE  
3 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway FLANELLE  
3 skeins of PHIL IRISE in the colourway NOIR  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway CHANTILLY  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway GIVRE  
2 skeins of PHIL LIGHT in the colourway NOIR

**Yarn composition:** 41 % Viscose - 21 % Acrylic - 18 % Polyamide - 11 % Merino Wool - 7 % Wool - 2 % Mohair

#### Tools and materials needed:

PPY circular knitting needles n° 3,5 and n° 4,5 (3,5 mm, 4,5 mm) or other sizes following your gauge swatch  
Stitch markers  
1 tapestry needle

#### Gauge swatch & obtaining the right dimensions for your project:

When knitting your gauge swatch, it's always best to do so "in pattern". For this model we'll be using stranded colourwork in stockinette and your 4,5 mm circ. needles. Knit using 1 strand of PHIL IRISE and 1 strand of PHIL LIGHT held together. 19 sts. (stitches) and 24 rws (rows) = a square of 10 cm x 10 cm.

#### Stitch patterns used:

1/1 ribbing (in the round)

Garter stitch (in the round) - Stockinette (in the round)

Stranded colourwork (in the round): (see charts)

**Dec. (decrease) on both sides of the stitch marker (point B):**

to the right: K2tog (knit 2 sts. together)

to the left: skpo (meaning: slip 1 st., K1, pass the sl. (slipped) st. over the knitted st.)

**Double dec. on both sides of the stitch marker (point B):**

to the right: K3tog (knit 3 sts. together)

to the left: sk2po (slip 1 st., k2tog, pass the sl. st. over the st. you just made)

## CONSTRUCTION

When reading the pattern, follow the colour corresponding to the size you wish to knit, we've colour-coded our instructions to help you.

### KNITTING THE BACK AND FRONT PIECES

**Step 1:** With your 3,5 mm circ. needles, CO (cast on) 176 - 192 - 208 - 224 - 240 sts., using 1 strand of PHIL IRISE in col. NOIR + 1 strand of PHIL LIGHT in col. NOIR, join in the round. PM (place stitch marker) at the 1st st. to indicate the BOR (beginning of round).

**Step 2:** Knit in 1/1 ribbing (using your 3,5 mm circ. needles) for 4 cm.

**Step 3:** Knit in garter stitch (3,5 mm circ. needles) for 4 rnds while distributing in the 1st rnd: 6 inc. (increases)  
We have: 182 - 198 - 214 - 230 - 246 sts.

**Step 4:** Switch to your 4,5 mm circ. needles and start knitting in stranded colourwork (see chart n° 1), while distributing in the 1st rnd: 5 - 6 - 7 - 8 - 9 inc. and by starting at the 1st st. of the coloured box in the colourwork chart. We have: 187 - 204 - 221 - 238 - 255 sts.  
PM (= point A) at the centr. (central) st. or the middle of the front (see chart), knit the 28 rnds of the chart.

**Step 5:** Knit the 36 rnds of chart n° 2, starting at the 1st st. of the coloured box in the colourwork chart.  
On the 35th rnd, distribute 5 - 6 - 7 - 8 - 9 dec.  
We have: 182 - 198 - 214 - 230 - 246 sts. left

**Step 6:** At a tot. height of 30 cm, PM at the sides in the following way: place 4 stitch markers (= points B) on the 45th - 49th - 53rd - 57th - 61st st. from the central stitch of the front and back, on both sides.

### KNITTING THE SLEEVES

**Step 1:** With your 3,5 mm circ. needles, CO 38 - 42 - 46 - 50 - 52 sts., using 1 strand of PHIL IRISE in col. NOIR + 1 strand of PHIL LIGHT in col. NOIR, join in the round. PM (place stitch marker) at the 1st st. to indicate the BOR (= point D).

**Step 2:** Knit in 1/1 ribbing (using your 3,5 mm circ. needles) for 6 cm.

**Step 3:** Switch to your 4,5 mm circ. needles and start knitting in garter stitch, while distributing in the 1st rnd: 5 inc.  
We have: 43 - 47 - 51 - 55 - 57 sts.

**Step 4:** Using your 4,5 mm circ. needles start knitting in stranded colourwork (see chart n° 1), while distributing in the 1st rnd: 6 inc. Start by knitting the 2nd - 17th - 15th - 13th - 12th st. of the coloured box in the colourwork chart. (PM at the 9th st. in the centre = point C).  
We have: 49 - 53 - 57 - 61 - 63 sts.

**Simultaneously,** inc. on each side of the stitch marker for point D:

every 8 rnds: 7 times and every 6 rnds: 6 times.

8 rnds above: 1 time and every 6 rnds: 14 times.

every 6 rnds: 13 times and every 4 rnds: 4 times.

every 6 rnds: 9 times and every 4 rnds: 10 times.

every 6 rnds: 3 times and every 4 rnds: 19 times.

**Step 5:** After having knitted the 28 rnds of the chart, continue by knitting stockinette in the round using 1 strand of PHIL IRISE in col. NACRE + 1 strand of PHIL LIGHT in col. CHANTILLY.

**Step 6:** At a tot. height of 34,5 cm, continue by following chart n° 2 and placing the 9th st. of the coloured box at the centre of your work (point C).

**Caution,** on the 35th rnd distribute 5 dec. in this rnd.

We have: 70 - 78 - 86 - 94 - 102 sts. left that we leave on hold.

Knit the second sleeve in the same way.

### KNITTING THE YOKE

**Step 1:** With your 4,5 mm circ. needles, using 1 strand of PHIL IRISE in col. NOIR + 1 strand of PHIL LIGHT in col. NOIR, pick up sts. in the following way: 91 - 99 - 107 - 115 - 123 sts. of the front piece, the 70 - 78 - 86 - 94 - 102 sts. of one sleeve, the 91 - 99 - 107 - 115 - 123 sts. of the back piece, then the 70 - 78 - 86 - 94 - 102 sts. of the 2nd sleeve.  
We have: 322 - 354 - 386 - 418 - 450 sts.

**Step 2:** Knit stockinette in the round while making on each side of the stitch markers for points B (or 8 dec. in the round, see stitch patterns used):

We have: 298 - 314 - 338 - 362 - 386 sts.

We have: 306 - 323 - 340 - 374 - 391 sts.

We have: 108 - 114 - 120 - 132 - 138 sts.

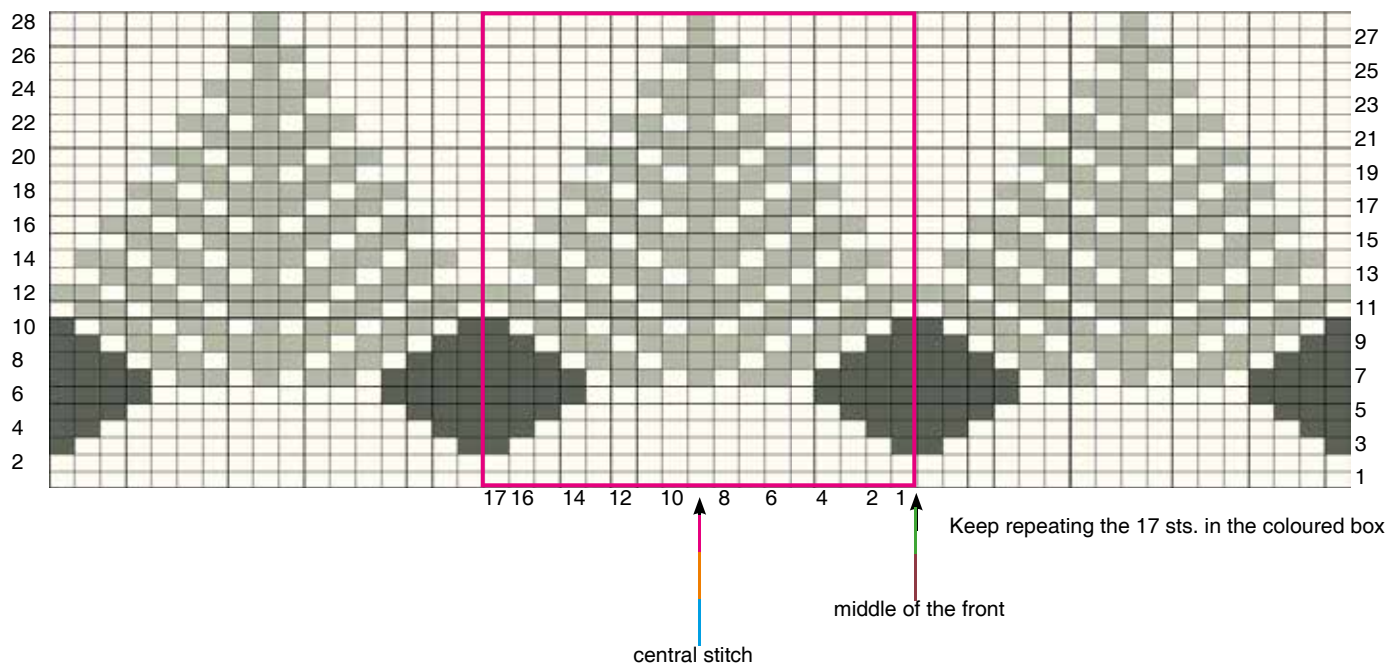
We have: 108 - 114 - 114 - 126 - 130 sts. left

Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 3 cm then BO (bind off) all sts.

**Step 1:** Weave in all ends.

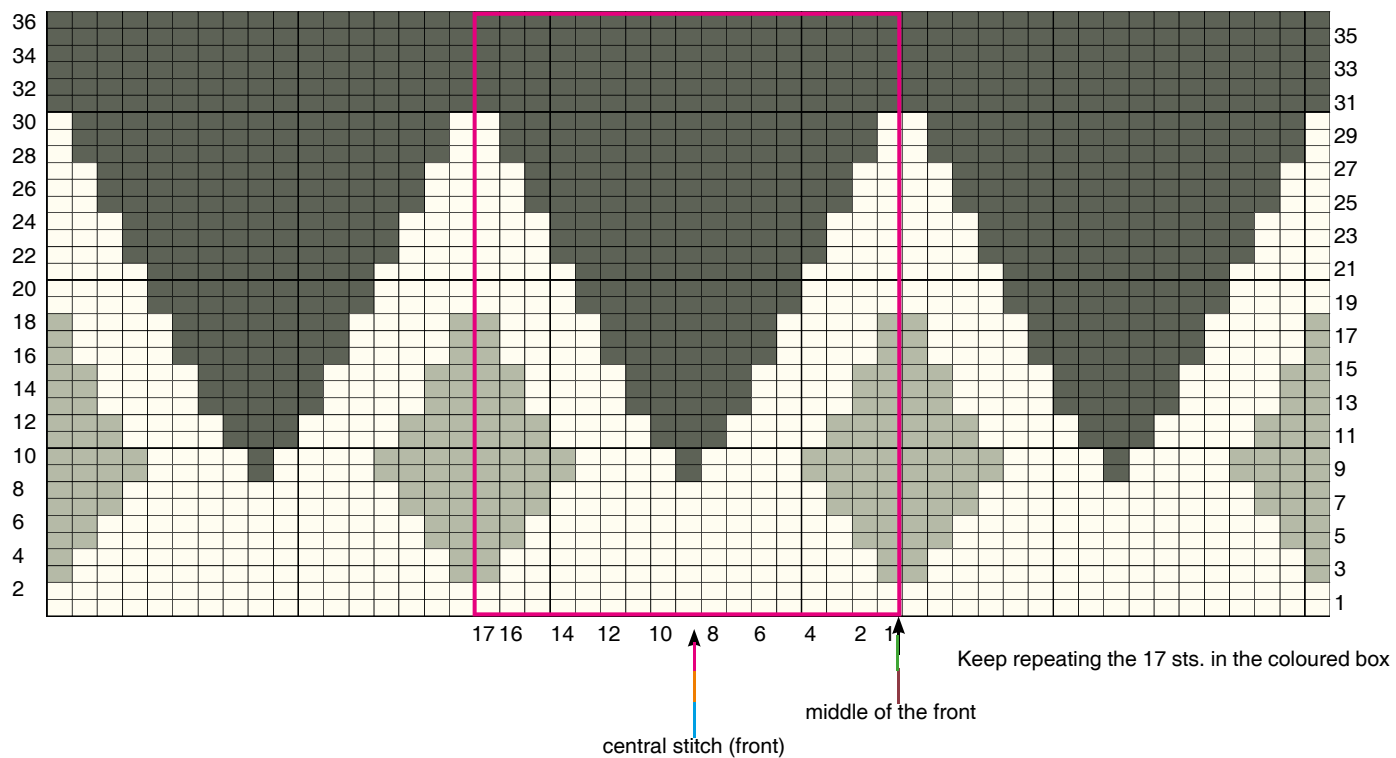
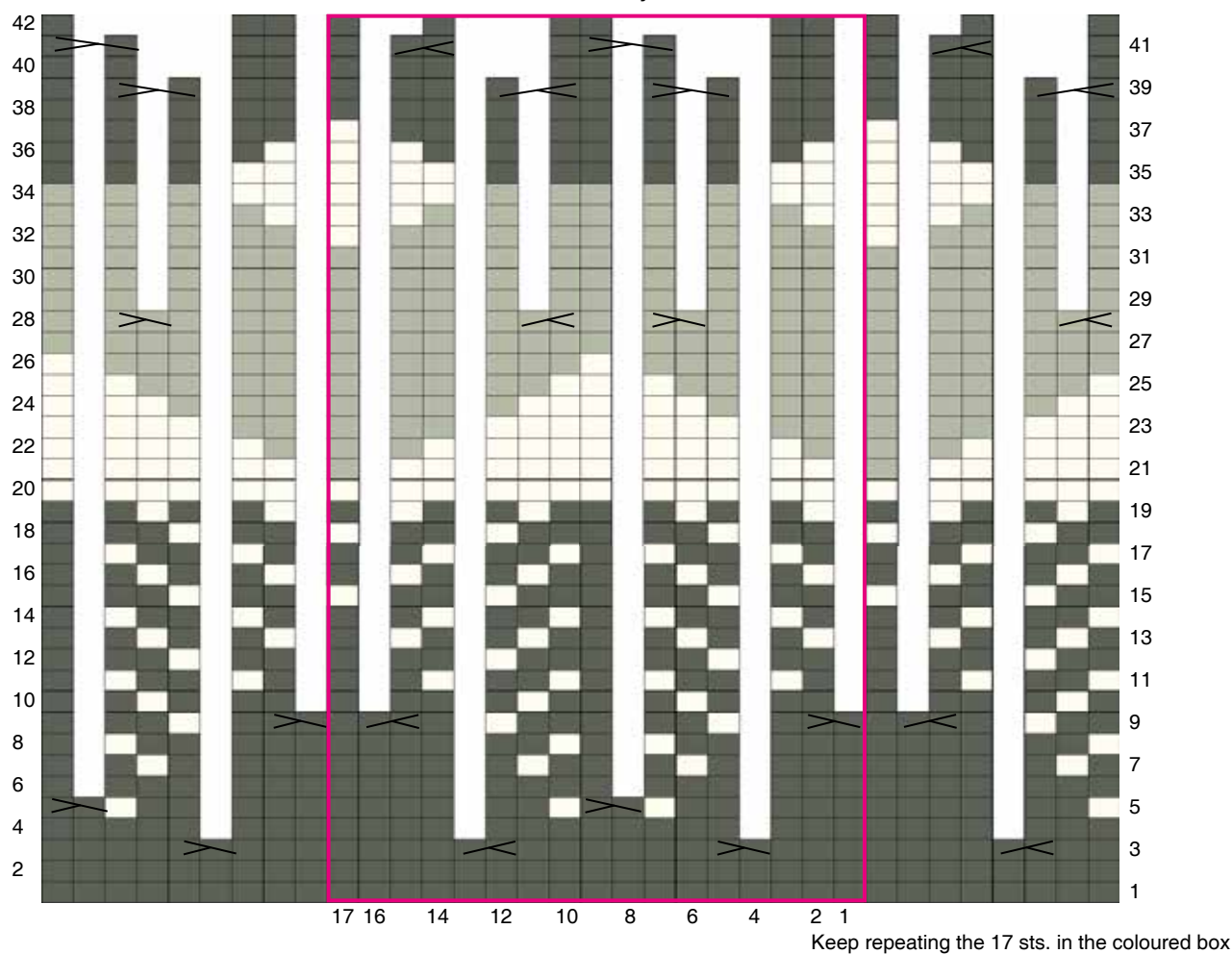


Chart for the yoke
