To knit this project, you'll need:

2 skeins of PHIL COTON MIMI in the colourway CERISE
1 skein of PHIL COTON MIMI in the colourway LAIT DE ROSE
1 skein of PHIL COTON MIMI in the colourway ACAJOU
1 skein of PHIL COTON MIMI in the colourway AMANDE
1 skein of PHIL COTON MIMI in the colourway NOIR
1 skein of PHIL ROMANCE in the colourway ECRU
1 skein of PHIL BRILLANT in the colourway OR

Yarn composition: 75 % Cotton - 12 % Polyamide - 11 % Viscose - 2 % Polyester

Tools & materials needed:

PPY 2,5 mm crochet hook, PPY 3 mm crochet hook
Stitch markers + 1 pack of stuffing

Crochet terminology and stitch patterns used:

Magic circle

rnd(s) = round(s)

rw(s) = row(s)

st. = stitch

ch = chain stitch or starting chain

sl. st. = slip stitch: insert your crochet hook into 1 st., pull through a loop and directly pass it through the loop already on your hook.

UK: (dc) / US: (sc) = UK: Double crochet / US: Single crochet: insert your crochet hook into 1 st., pull through a loop, YO (yarn over), pull the yarn through the 2 loops on your hook.

inc. = increase: make 2 **UK: Double crochet (dc) / US: Single crochet (sc)** into the same stitch.

dec. = decrease: **UK: Double crochet 2 together (dc2tog) / US: Single crochet 2 together (sc2tog):** insert your crochet hook into 1 st., pull through 1 loop, insert your crochet hook into the following st., pull through 1 loop, make 1 YO (yarn over), pull the yarn through the 3 loops on your crochet hook.

Straight stitch embroidery

CONSTRUCTION

Since UK and US crochet terminology differs, these have been colour-coded. Choose what you're most familiar with; **UK / US**.

CROCHETING THE BODY

The legs

With your 2,5 mm crochet hook, make a magic circle in col. LAIT DE ROSE

Rnd 1: 6 **UK: (dc) / US: (sc)** sts.

Rnd 2: 6 inc. (=12 sts.)

Rnd 3 to 31: 12 **(dc)/(sc)** sts.

Fill the leg with stuffing. Make a 2nd leg in the same way.

The body

With your 2,5 mm crochet hook and the col. LAIT DE ROSE, unite the 2 legs in the following way:

Rnd 32: 6 ch., 12 **(dc)/(sc)** (on the 1st leg), 6 ch., 12 **(dc)/(sc)** (on the 2nd leg) (=36 sts.)

Rnd 33 to 56: 36 **(dc)/(sc)** sts. Fill with stuffing.

Rnd 57: 4 **(dc)/(sc)**., 1 dec., 7 **(dc)/(sc)**., 1 dec., 7 **(dc)/(sc)**., 1 dec., 7 **(dc)/(sc)**., 1 dec., 3 **(dc)/(sc)**. (=32 sts.)

Rnd 58: 32 **(dc)/(sc)** sts.

Rnd 59: 4 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 6 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 6 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 6 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 2 **(dc)/(sc)** (=28 sts.)

Rnd 60: 28 **(dc)/(sc)**.

Rnd 61: 4 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 5 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 5 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 5 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 1 **(dc)/(sc)** (=24 sts.)

Rnd 62: 24 **(dc)/(sc)**

Rnd 63: 4 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 4 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 4 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 4 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec. (=20 sts.)

Rnd 64: 20 **(dc)/(sc)**

Stop filling the body with stuffing.

CROCHETING THE HEAD

With your 2,5 mm crochet hook, make a magic circle in col. LAIT DE ROSE

Rnd 1: 6 **(dc)/(sc)**

Rnd 2: 6 inc. (=12 sts.)

Rnd 3: (1 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 6 (=18 sts.)

Rnd 4: (2 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 6 (=24 sts.)

Rnd 5: (3 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 6 (=30 sts.)

Rnd 6: 2 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc., (4 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 5, 2 **(dc)/(sc)** (=36 sts.)

Rnd 7: (5 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 6 (=42 sts.)

Rnd 8: 3 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc., (6 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 5, 3 **(dc)/(sc)** (=48 sts.)

Rnd 9: (7 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 6 (=54 sts.)

Rnd 10: 4 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc., (8 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 5, 4 **(dc)/(sc)** (=60 sts.)

Rnd 11 to 22: 60 **(dc)/(sc)**

Fill the head with stuffing.

Rnd 23: 4 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., (8 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec.) x 5, 4 **(dc)/(sc)** (=54 sts.)

Rnd 24: (7 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec.) x 6 (=48 sts.)

Rnd 25: 3 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., (6 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec.) x 5, 3 **(dc)/(sc)** (=42 sts.)

Rnd 26: (5 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec.) x 6 (=36 sts.)

Rnd 27: 2 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., (4 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec.) x 5, 2 **(dc)/(sc)** (=30 sts.)

Rnd 28: (3 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec.) x 6 (=24 sts.)

Rnd 29: (2 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec.) x 6 (=18 sts.)

Rnd 30: 18 **(dc)/(sc)**

Stop filling the head with stuffing.

CROCHETING THE ARMS

With your 2,5 mm crochet hook, make a magic circle in col. LAIT DE ROSE.

Rnd 1: 6 **(dc)/(sc)**

Rnd 2: (1 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 3 (=9 sts.)

Rnd 3 to 27: 9 **(dc)/(sc)**

Add some stuffing to the arm.

Make 4 **(dc)/(sc)** into both fabrics (the 2 sides touching when flattening your work) to close the arm.

CROCHETING THE HAIR

With your 2,5 mm crochet hook, make a magic circle in col. ACAJOU.

Rnd 1: 6 **(dc)/(sc)**

Rnd 2: 6 inc. (=12 sts.)

Rnd 3: (1 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 6 (=18 sts.)

Rnd 4: (2 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 6 (=24 sts.)

Rnd 5: (3 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 6 (=30 sts.)

Rnd 6: 2 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc. (4 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 5, 2 **(dc)/(sc)** (=36 sts.)

Rnd 7: (5 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 6 (=42 sts.)

Rnd 8: 3 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc., (6 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 5, 3 **(dc)/(sc)** (=48 sts.)

Rnd 9: (7 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 6 (=54 sts.)

Rnd 10: 4 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc. (8 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 inc.) x 5 **(dc)/(sc)** (=60 sts.)

Rnd 11 to 22: 60 **(dc)/(sc)**

Stop your work, place the hair onto the head and attach with an invisible seam. Make a 22 cm long braid of 24 strands in col. ACAJOU, then attach it to the side of the hair. Tie the end of the braid by wrapping 1 strand in col. OR (gold) around the end of the braid multiple times.

CROCHETING THE DUNGAREES

We start with 1 leg

With your 2,5 mm hook make a starting chain of 28 ch., in col. AMANDE.

Rnd 1 to 12: 28 **(dc)/(sc)**

Make the 2nd leg in the same way.

Rnd 13: unite the 2 legs (=56 sts.)

Rnd 14: 56 **(dc)/(sc)**

Rnd 15: 1 dec., 12 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 12 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 12 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 12 **(dc)/(sc)** (=52 sts.)

Rnd 16 to 17: 52 **(dc)/(sc)**

Rnd 18: 1 dec., 11 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 11 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 11 **(dc)/(sc)**, 1 dec., 11 **(dc)/(sc)** (=48 sts.)

Rnd 19 to 30: 48 **(dc)/(sc)**

Rnd 31: 32 **(dc)/(sc)**, turn your work and crochet only on the following 12 **(dc)/(sc)** sts. (back and forth) for 7 rws.

Make 2 shoulder straps by working back and forth over the first 2 and last 2 sts. of the 12 sts. of the bib, for 15 rws.

CROCHETING THE JACKET

With your 3 mm hook make a starting chain of 58 ch., in col. ECRU, work back and forth in the following way:

Rw 1 to 8: 58 (dc)/(sc)

Rw 9: 13 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 28 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 13 (dc)/(sc) (=56 sts.)

Rw 10 to 14: 56 (dc)/(sc)

Rw 15: 13 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 26 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 13 (dc)/(sc) (=54 sts.)

Rw 16 and 17: 54 (dc)/(sc)

Rw 18: 10 (dc)/(sc), 8 ch., skip 8 sts. (to shape the opening of sleeve 1), 18 (dc)/(sc), 8 ch., skip 8 sts. (to shape the opening of sleeve 2), 10 (dc)/(sc) (=54 sts.)

Rw 19: 54 (dc)/(sc)

Rw 20: (2 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec.) x 13, 2 (dc)/(sc) (=41 sts.)

Rw 21: (1 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec.) x 13, 2 (dc)/(sc) (=28 sts.)

The sleeves

Pick up the 16 sts. left on hold for the armhole.

Rnd 1 to 16: 16 (dc)/(sc)

Repeat the same steps on the 2nd sleeve.

CROCHETING THE BERET

With your 3 mm crochet hook, make a magic circle in col. ECRU.

Rnd 1: 6 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 2: 6 inc. (=12 sts.)

Rnd 3: (1 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc.) x 6 (=18 sts.)

Rnd 4: (2 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc.) x 6 (=24 sts.)

Rnd 5: (3 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc.) x 6 (=30 sts.)

Rnd 6: 2 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc., (4 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc.) x 5, 2 (dc)/(sc) (=36 sts.)

Rnd 7: (5 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc.) x 6 (=42 sts.)

Rnd 8: 3 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc., (6 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc.) x 5, 3 (dc)/(sc) (=48 sts.)

Rnd 9: (7 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc.) x 6 (=54 sts.)

Rnd 10: 4 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc., (8 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc.) x 5, 4 (dc)/(sc) (= 60 sts.)

Rnd 11: (9 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc.) x 6 (=66 sts.)

Rnd 12: 5 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc., (10 (dc)/(sc), 1 inc.) x 5, 5 (dc)/(sc) (=72 sts.)

Rnd 13: 72 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 14: 5 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec. (10 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec.) x 5, 5 (dc)/(sc) (=66 sts.)

Rnd 15: (9 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec.) x 6 (=60 sts.)

Rnd 16: 4 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., (8 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec.) x 5, 4 (dc)/(sc) (= 54 sts.)

Rnd 17 to 22: 54 (dc)/(sc)

CROCHETING THE BOOTS

With your 2,5 mm crochet hook, make a magic circle in col. AMANDE.

Rnd 1: 6 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 2: 6 inc. (=12 sts.)

Rnd 3 to 7: 12 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 8 to 10: 12 (dc)/(sc) in col. ECRU

CROCHETING THE DRESS

With your 2,5 mm hook, make a starting chain of 70 ch. in col. CERISE.

Rnd 1 to 4: 70 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 5: 33 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 33 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec. (=68 sts.)

Rnd 6 to 8: 68 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 9: 32 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 32 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec. (=66 sts.)

Rnd 10 to 12: 66 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 13: 31 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 31 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec. (=64 sts.)

Rnd 14 to 16: 64 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 17: 30 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 30 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec. (=62 sts.)

Rnd 18 and 19: 62 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 20: 29 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 29 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec. (=60 sts.)

Rnd 21 and 22: 60 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 23: 28 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 28 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec. (=58 sts.)

Rnd 24 and 25: 58 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 26: 27 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 27 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec. (=56 sts.)

Rnd 27: 56 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 28: 26 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 26 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec. (=54 sts.)

Rnd 29: 54 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 30: 25 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 25 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec. (=52 sts.)

Rnd 31: 52 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 32: 24 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec., 24 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec. (=50 sts.)

Rnd 33: 50 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 34: 8 (dc)/(sc), 8 ch., skip 8 sts. (to shape armhole 1), 18 (dc)/(sc), 8 ch., skip 8 sts. (to shape armhole 2), 8 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 35: 50 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 36: (2 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec.) x 12, 2 (dc)/(sc) (=38 sts.)

Rnd 37: (1 (dc)/(sc), 1 dec.) x 12, 2 (dc)/(sc) (=26 sts.)

Rnd 38: 26 (dc)/(sc)

The sleeves

Rw 1: With your 2,5 mm hook and col. CERISE, pick up 12 (dc)/(sc) of the 16 sts. left on hold for the armhole, starting on the armhole side.

Rw 2: Skip 1 st., 3 UK: Treble crochet (tr) / US: Double crochet (dc) into the same (following) st., skip 1 st., 1 (dc)/(sc), rep. the sequence in bold 2 more times.

Repeat the same steps on the 2nd armhole.

Make the same border onto the bottom of the dress (replicating a hem).

The boots

With your 2,5 mm crochet hook, make a magic circle in col. CERISE.

Rnd 1: 6 (dc)/(sc)

Rnd 2: 6 inc. (=12 sts.)

Rnd 3 to 11: 12 (dc)/(sc)

SEAMING & FINISHING TOUCHES

Attach the head to the body.

Attach the arms to the 63rd round of the body.

Embroider the eyes using some black thread (see chart).

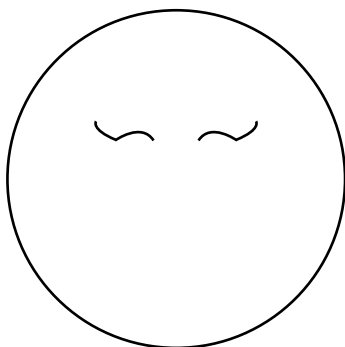
Attach the ends of the straps of the dungarees to the middle of the back.

Make 2 small cords to close the jacket.

Embroider 5 stars onto the dress using 1 thread in col. OR (gold), (see chart).
