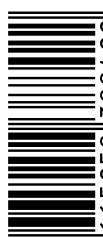

PLEASE REMEMBER TO GAUGE SWATCH

10 cm of the cables stitch pattern with yarn held double (2 strands tog.) using your 5 mm knitting needles = 25 sts. (stitches) and 26 rws (rows) (To better understand our abbreviations and knitting terms, refer to page 3)

To knit this project, you'll need:

YARN	COLOUR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52
P. MOHAIR SOIE LUREX	LILAS or ROSÉE or SAPHIR or ZESTE	8	9	10	11	12

Yarn composition: 70 % Mohair - 26 % Brushed Silk - 4 % Polyester

Tools & materials needed:

From the PPY range:
4,5 mm knitting needles, 5 mm knitting needles (or other sizes following your gauge swatch)
1 cable needle + 1 tapestry needle
4 buttons Ø 9 mm ref.: 055150 9999

Stitch patterns used:

1/1 ribbing

Cables stitch pattern (see chart)

CONSTRUCTION

When reading the pattern, follow the colour corresponding to the size you wish to knit, we've colour-coded our instructions to help you.

KNITTING THE BACK PIECE

Step 1: With your 4,5 mm needles (yarn held double), CO (cast on) 84 - 88 - 96 - 104 - 114 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 6 cm, then make 1 rw of purl sts. on the WS (wrong side) while distributing 29 - 33 - 33 - 35 - 41 inc. (increases).
We have: 113 - 121 - 129 - 139 - 155 sts.

Step 2: Switch to your 5 mm needles and knit in the cables stitch pattern (see chart) by starting with: the 1st st. of the chart - the 1st st. of the chart - the 1st st. of the chart - P1, then the 1st st. of the chart - P1, then the 1st st. of the chart.

Knit in the cables stitch pattern until you've reached a tot. height of 28 cm.

Step 3: Shape the armholes by BO (binding off) on both sides:

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 1 x 1 st.
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.
1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.
1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 st.
1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 5 sts., 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts., 3 x 1 st.

We have: 89 - 89 - 93 - 93 - 99 sts.

Continue knitting until you've reached a tot. height of 46 - 47 - 48 - 49 - 50 cm.

Step 4: Shape the shoulders by BO on both sides:

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 6 sts. and 1 x 7 sts.
1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 6 sts. and 1 x 7 sts.
1 x 7 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 7 sts.
1 x 7 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 7 sts.
1 x 8 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 8 sts.

Simultaneously as the 1st shoulder dec., shape the neckline by BO the 23 centr. sts. then finish one side at a time, binding off on the neckline side, 2 rws above: 1 x 14 sts.

KNITTING THE FRONT PIECE

Step 1: With your 4,5 mm needles (yarn held double), CO 84 - 88 - 96 - 104 - 114 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 6 cm, then make 1 rw of purl sts. on the WS while distributing 29 - 33 - 33 - 35 - 41 inc. We have: 113 - 121 - 129 - 139 - 155 sts.

Step 2: Switch to your 5 mm needles and knit in the cables stitch pattern (see chart) by starting with: the 1st st. of the chart - the 1st st. of the chart - the 1st st. of the chart - P1, then the 1st st. of the chart - P1, then the 1st st. of the chart.

Knit in the cables stitch pattern until you've reached a tot. height of 21 - 22 - 23 - 24 - 25 cm.

Step 3: Shape the opening by BO the 5 centr. sts. then finish one side at a time.

We have: 54 - 58 - 62 - 67 - 75 sts.

Continue knitting until you've reached a tot. height of 28 cm.

Step 4: Shape the armhole by BO on the exterior side:

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 1 x 1 st.
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.
1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 2 x 1 st.
1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts. and 3 x 1 st.
1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 5 sts., 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 2 sts., 3 x 1 st.

Cont. knitting until you've reached a tot. height of 30 - 31 - 32 - 33 - 34 cm.

Step 5: Shape the neckline by BO on the opening side: 1 x 1 st. then every 2 rws: 22 x 1 st.

Cont. knitting until you've reached a tot. height of 46 - 47 - 48 - 49 - 50 cm.

Step 6: Shape the shoulder by BO on the armhole side:

1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 6 sts. and 1 x 7 sts.
1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 6 sts. and 1 x 7 sts.
1 x 7 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 7 sts.
1 x 7 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 7 sts.
1 x 8 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 8 sts.

Step 7: Finish the other side of the opening.

KNITTING THE SLEEVES

Step 1: With your 4,5 mm needles (yarn held double), CO 54 - 58 - 62 - 64 - 68 sts. Knit in 1/1 ribbing for 6 cm, then make 1 rw of purl sts. on the WS (wrong side) while distributing 31 - 31 - 35 - 41 - 45 inc. We have: 85 - 89 - 97 - 105 - 113 sts.

Step 2: Switch to your 5 mm needles and knit in the cables stitch pattern (see chart) by starting with the 1st st. of the chart.

Knit in the cables stitch pattern until you've reached a tot. height of 11 cm.

Step 3: Round the shape by BO on both sides:

1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 2 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 8 x 1 st., 1 x 2 sts., 2 x 3 sts. and 1 x 4 sts.
1 x 4 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 8 x 1 st., 1 x 2 sts., 1 x 3 sts. and 2 x 4 sts.
1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 3 x 2 sts., 6 x 1 st., 2 x 2 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 4 sts. and 1 x 5 sts.
1 x 5 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 4 sts., 2 x 3 sts., 3 x 2 sts., 4 x 1 st., 2 x 2 sts., 2 x 3 sts., 1 x 4 sts. and 1 x 5 sts.
1 x 6 sts. then every 2 rws: 1 x 5 sts., 1 x 4 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 2 x 2 sts., 5 x 1 st., 2 x 2 sts., 1 x 3 sts., 1 x 4 sts. and 2 x 5 sts.

Step 4: BO the 17 sts. remaining.

Knit the second sleeve in the same way.

→ = even rws
