

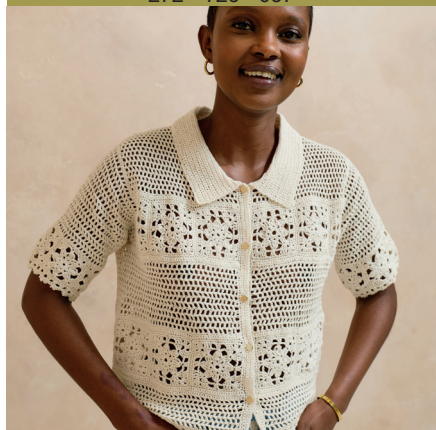

Crochet

TENSION SQUARES

27 sts and 14 rows to 10 cm, measured over staggered double crochet mesh stitch using a 3 mm crochet hook

5-round granny square to an 8 cm square, using a 3 mm crochet hook

4-round granny square to a 6.5 cm square, using a 3 mm crochet hook

YARN	COLOR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52

Composition: 100% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

3 mm crochet hook (or other, depending on your tension squares)

Stitch markers

Yarn needle

5 x 10 mm shank buttons, color OR, ref: 070225 0009

STITCHES (US terms - refer to the glossary for instructions on the basic stitches):

Magic circle

Chain stitch (ch)

Slip stitch (sl st)

Single crochet (sc)

Half double crochet (hdc)

Double crochet (dc)

Double crochet 2 together (dc2tog)

Treble crochet (tr)

Treble crochet 2 together (tr2tog)

Granny square (see chart)

Small granny square (see chart)

Half granny square (see chart)

Staggered double crochet mesh st (see chart)

Edging (see chart)

To leave 1 st unworked:

At the start of a row: ch 3 and 1 dc (counts as dc2tog)

At the end of a row: work dc2tog

To leave 2 sts unworked:

At the start of a row: 1 sc and 1 hdc, then work in staggered dc mesh st (if necessary, replace the chain with 1 dc)

At the end of a row: work up to the relevant sts (if necessary, replace the chain with 1 dc), then 1 hdc and 1 sc; turn and work back along these 2 sts to begin the next row

To leave 3 - 4 - 5 - 6 sts or more unworked:

At the start of a row: work 1 - 2 - 3 - 4 (or more) sl sts, 1 sc and 1 hdc, then work in staggered dc mesh st (if necessary, replace the chain with 1 dc)

At the end of a row: work up to the relevant sts (if necessary, replace the chain with 1 dc), then 1 hdc and 1 sc; turn and work back along these 2 sts to begin the next row

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

GRANNY SQUARE

STEP 1: Begin with a magic ring, then work in the round using a 3 mm crochet hook as follows:

R1: ch 3 and 1 dc (counts as dc2tog), ch 2, **dc2tog inserting the hook in the ring, ch 2**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 6 more times and end with 1 sl st in the dc2tog at the start of the round.

R2: ch 1 (counts as 1 sc), ch 3, tr2tog in the ch-space, **ch 3, 1 sc in the dc2tog from the previous round, ch 3, tr2tog in the next ch-space**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 6 more times, ch 3 and end with 1 sl st in the ch 1 at the start of the round. Fasten off.

R3: Join the yarn with 1 sl st in the tr2tog, ch 1 (counts as 1 sc), **ch 3, 3 dc + ch 2 + 3 dc in the next tr2tog, ch 3, 1 sc in the next tr2tog**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times, ch 3, 3 dc + ch 2 + 3 dc in the following tr2tog, ch 3 and end with 1 sl st in the ch st at the start of the round.

Step 2: Continue according to the chart.

Step 3: When the 5 rounds in the chart are finished, fasten off.

SMALL GRANNY SQUARE

STEP 1: Begin with a magic ring, then work in the round using a 3 mm crochet hook and following the chart (the first 3 rows are identical to the granny square explained above).

Step 2: When the 4 rounds in the chart are finished, fasten off.

HALF-GRANNY SQUARE

STEP 1: Begin with a magic ring, then work in rows using a 3 mm crochet hook as follows:

Row 1: ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), ch 2, **dc2tog inserting the hook in the ring, ch 2**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 3 more times and end with 1 dc inserting the hook in the ring.

Row 2: ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), tr2tog in the 1st ch-space, ch 3, **1 sc sur les dc2tog from the previous row, ch 3, tr2tog in the ch-space, ch 3**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times, 1 sc in the dc2tog from the previous row, ch 3, tr2tog in the last ch-space, end with 1 dc in the 3rd ch at the start of the previous row.

Row 3: ch 1 (counts as 1 sc), **1 sc in the tr2tog, ch 3, 3 dc + ch 2 + 3 dc in the tr2tog, ch 3**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 1 more time, then 1 sc in the tr2tog and end with 1 sc in the 4th ch at the start of the previous row.

Step 2: Continue according to the chart.

Step 3: When the 5 rounds in the chart are finished, fasten off.

BACK AND FRONT SECTIONS

This garment is worked in a single piece up to the armholes.

To visualize the different steps, refer to the diagram for assembly that corresponds to the size you are working.

Step 1: Section 1

Using a 3 mm crochet hook, ch 259 - 283 - 303 - 327 - 347, then work as follows:

Work in staggered dc mesh st (see chart) for 5 cm, then work 3 rows of sc. Fasten off.

Step 2: Band of granny squares

Make 12 - 13 - 14 - 15 - 16 granny squares (see chart and instructions above), then join them to form a band.

Form the band by sewing along the last row of sc in overlock stitch.

Step 3: Section 2

Using a 3 mm crochet hook, work along this band of 12 - 13 - 14 - 15 - 16 granny squares as follows:

work 3 rows of sc (Total sts: 259 - 283 - 303 - 327 - 347 sts), work in staggered dc mesh st (see chart) for 10 cm, then work 3 rows of sc.

Fasten off.

Place a stitch marker on the 56th - 62nd - 67th - 73rd - 78th st and the 75th - 81st - 86th - 92nd - 97th st from each edge (to indicate the first and last st of each armhole).

Total sts: 55 - 61 - 66 - 72 - 77 sts for the Right Front, 20 sts for the armhole, 109 - 121 - 131 - 143 - 153 sts for the Back, 20 sts for the armhole, 55 - 61 - 66 - 72 - 77 sts for the Left front.

Step 4: Right Front

Make 2 granny squares and 1 half granny square - 2 granny squares and 1 half granny square - 3 granny squares - 3 granny squares - 3 granny squares and 1 half granny square (see charts and instructions above), then join them to form a band, placing the half granny square on the left.

Only for sizes 38/40 and 46/48:

work 6 rows of sc along the side of the half granny square on the left
work 6 rows of sc along the side of the granny square on the left

Form the band by sewing in overlock stitch along the last row of sc in step 3, up to the 1st stitch marker (i.e. on 55 - 61 - 66 - 72 - 77 sts).

Step 5: Section 3

Using a 3 mm crochet hook, work 3 rows of sc along this band of granny squares.

Total sts: 55 - 61 - 66 - 72 - 77 sts

Work in staggered dc mesh st (see chart).

4 - 6 - 7 - 9 - 10 rows higher, shape the neck; On the outside edge, leave the following sts unworked (crochet in sl sts, sc and hdc on these sts, see STITCHES):

6 sts once, then on each row, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 3 times
6 sts once, then on each row, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 3 times
6 sts once, then on each row, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 3 times
7 sts once, then on each row, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 3 times
7 sts once, then on each row, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 3 times

Important, after the 13th - 15th - 16th - 18th - 19th row, shape the shoulder. On the armhole edge, leave the following sts unworked (crochet in sl sts, sc and hdc on these sts, see STITCHES):

7 sts once, then on each row, 7 sts twice and 9 sts once
7 sts once, then on each row, 9 sts twice and 11 sts once
9 sts once, then on each row, 9 sts once, 11 sts once and 12 sts once
11 sts once, then on each row, 11 sts twice and 13 sts once
11 sts once, then on each row, 13 sts twice and 14 sts once

Step 6: Back

Make 4 granny squares and 2 half granny squares - 5 granny squares - 6 granny squares - 5 granny squares and 2 half granny squares - 6 granny squares and 2 half granny squares (see charts and instructions above), then join them to form a band, placing the half granny squares on either side of the granny squares.

Only for sizes 38/40 and 46/48:

work 6 rows of sc along the side of each granny square on the edges.
work 6 rows of sc along the side of each half granny square on the edges.

Form the band by sewing in overlock stitch along the last row of sc in step 3, between the 2nd and 3rd stitch marker (i.e. on 109 - 121 - 131 - 143 - 153 sts), you will skip the 20 sts for the armhole.

Step 7: Section 4

Using a 3 mm crochet hook, work 3 rows of sc along this band of granny squares.

Total sts: 109 - 121 - 131 - 143 - 153 sts

Work in staggered dc mesh st (see chart), beginning with the 1st - 1st - 2nd - 2nd - 1st row in the chart.

12 - 14 - 15 - 17 - 18 rows higher, shape the shoulders. On each edge, leave the following sts unworked (crochet in sl sts, sc and hdc on these sts, see STITCHES):

7 sts once, then on each row, 7 sts twice and 9 sts once
7 sts once, then on each row, 9 sts twice and 11 sts once
9 sts once, then on each row, 9 sts once, 11 sts once and 12 sts once
11 sts once, then on each row, 11 sts twice and 13 sts once

11 sts once, then on each row, 13 sts twice and 14 sts once

At the same time, shape the neck. Leave the 21 - 21 - 21 - 23 - 23 center sts unworked, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, leave the following sts unworked in each row (crochet in sl sts, sc and hdc on these sts, see STITCHES): 7 sts twice

Finish the other side of the neck in the same way.

Step 8: Left Front

Make 2 granny squares and 1 half granny square - 2 granny squares and 1 half granny square - 3 granny squares - 3 granny squares - 3 granny squares and 1 half granny square (see charts and instructions above), then join them to form a band, placing the half granny square on the right.

Only for sizes 38/40 and 46/48:

work 6 rows of sc along the side of the half granny square on the right
work 6 rows of sc along the side of the granny square on the right

Form the band by sewing in overlock stitch along the last row of sc in step 3, from the 4th stitch marker (i.e. on 55 - 61 - 66 - 72 - 77 sts).

Step 9: Section 5

Using a 3 mm crochet hook, work 3 rows of sc along this band of granny squares.

Total sts: 55 - 61 - 66 - 72 - 77 sts

Work in staggered dc mesh st (see chart), beginning with the 1st - 1st - 2nd - 2nd - 1st row in the chart.

4 - 6 - 7 - 9 - 10 rows higher, shape the neck. On the outside edge, leave the following sts unworked (crochet in sl sts, sc and hdc on these sts, see STITCHES):

6 sts once, then on each row, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 3 times
6 sts once, then on each row, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 3 times
6 sts once, then on each row, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 3 times
7 sts once, then on each row, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 3 times
7 sts once, then on each row, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 3 times

Important, after the 12th - 14th - 15th - 17th - 18th row, shape the shoulder. On the armhole edge, leave the following sts unworked (crochet in sl sts, sc and hdc on these sts, see STITCHES):

7 sts once, then on each row, 7 sts twice and 9 sts once
7 sts once, then on each row, 9 sts twice and 11 sts once
9 sts once, then on each row, 9 sts once, 11 sts once and 12 sts once
11 sts once, then on each row, 11 sts twice and 13 sts once
11 sts once, then on each row, 13 sts twice and 14 sts once

Step 10: Edging for the body

Using a 3 mm crochet hook, work 3 rows of edging (see chart) around the bottom of the Back and front sections.

Total sts: 257 - 281 - 305 - 329 - 347 sc in the 1st row (i.e. 43 - 47 - 51 - 55 - 58 motifs).

SLEEVES

Step 1: Granny squares

Make 5 - 5 - 5 - 6 - 6 small granny squares (see chart and instructions above), then join them to form a band.

Only for sizes 38/40 and 42/44:

work 4 rows of sc along the edge of the granny squares at the sides.

Step 2: Staggered dc mesh st

Using a 3 mm crochet hook, work in staggered dc mesh st (see chart) on this band of granny squares.

Total sts: 89 - 95 - 95 - 107 - 107 sts

Increase on each edge (work 2 dc in the dc on each edge):

every 3 rows, inc 1 st 4 times
every 4 rows, inc 1 st twice and 3 rows higher, inc 1 st once
every 2 rows, inc 1 st 6 times
every 4 rows, inc 1 st twice and 3 rows higher, inc 1 st once
every 2 rows, inc 1 st 6 times

Total sts: 97 - 101 - 107 - 113 - 119 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 16.5 cm from the beginning, place a marker on each selvage st (to indicate the part to be joined to the armholes).

Step 4: When your work measures 20.5 cm from the beginning, fasten off.

Step 5: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, work 3 rows of edging (see chart) for the sleeve.

Total sts: 89 - 95 - 95 - 107 - 107 sc in the 1st row (i.e. 15 - 16 - 16 - 18 - 18 motifs).

Crochet the other sleeve in the same way.

Step 3: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, work 5 rows of sc along the Left Front. Total sts: 104 - 107 - 110 - 113 - 116 sts

Work in the same way along the Right Front and make 5 buttonholes in the 3rd row as follows: 16 - 15 - 14 - 13 - 12 sc, **ch 1, skip 1, 20 - 21 - 22 - 23 - 24 sc**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 3 more times, ch 1, skip 1 and 3 sts.

Step 4: Sew the collar around the neck, placing the selvage sts at the center of the button bands.

Step 5: Sew the buttons.

COLLAR

Step 1: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, ch 136 - 136 - 136 - 140 - 140, then work in sc.

Step 2: When your work measures 7 cm from the beginning, on each edge, leave the following sts unworked: 10 sts once, then in each row, 7 sts 5 times.

Total sts: 46 - 46 - 46 - 50 - 50 sts

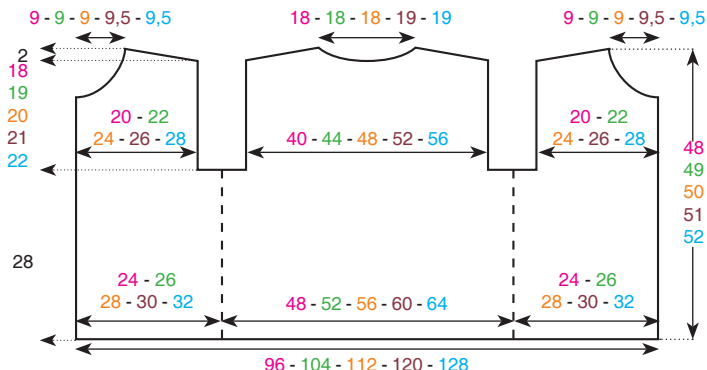
Step 3: Fasten off.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the sleeve seams up to the stitch markers.

Step 2: Join the sleeves to the body, placing the part above the markers to the unworked sts on the body.

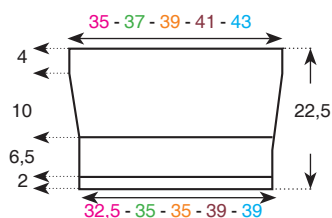


Chart for staggered dc mesh st

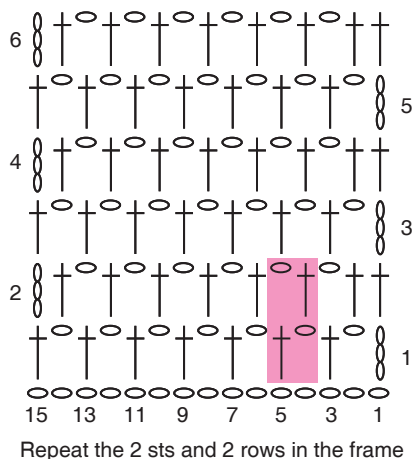
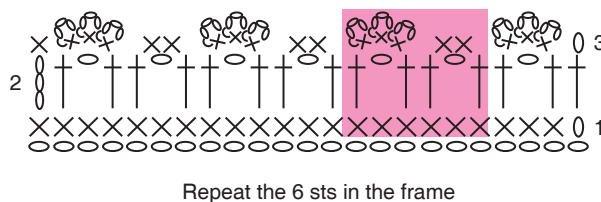


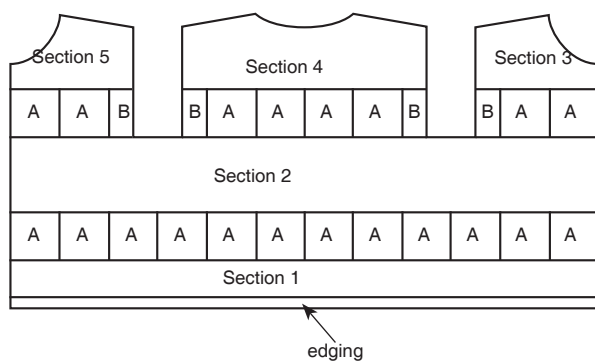
Chart for bottom edging on the body



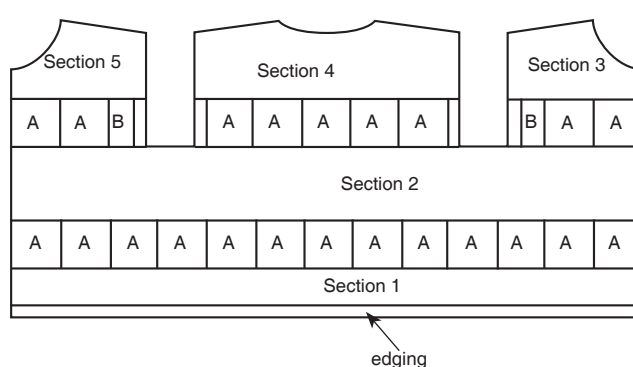

Back and front sections, size 34/36

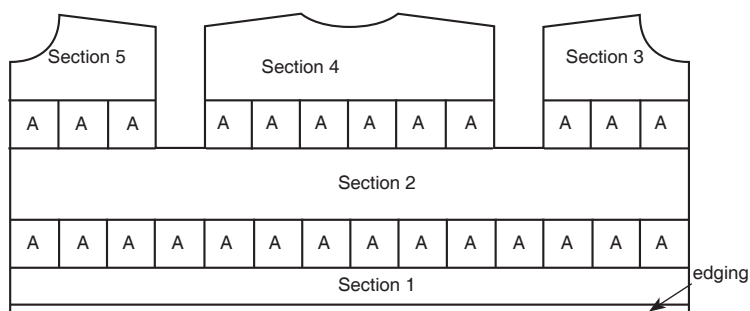


Back and front sections, size 38/40

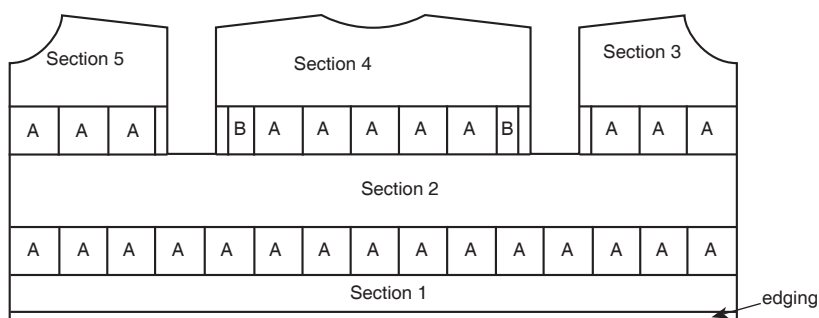


Back and front sections, size 42/44

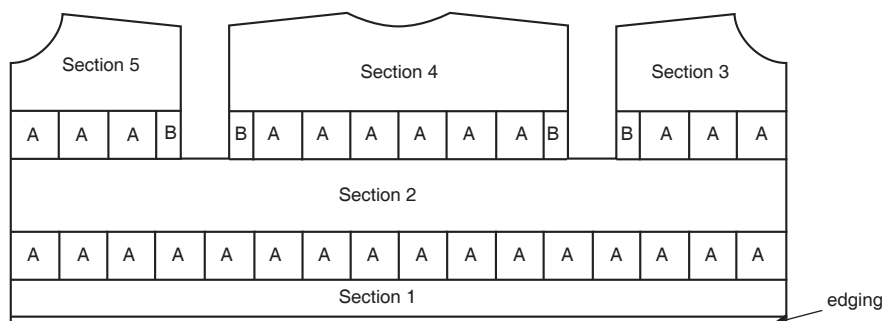
A = granny square

C = small granny square



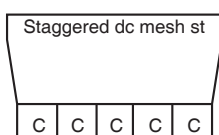

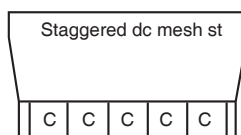
Back and front sections, size 50/52

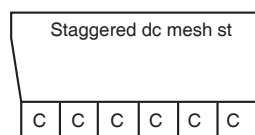


Chart for granny square A

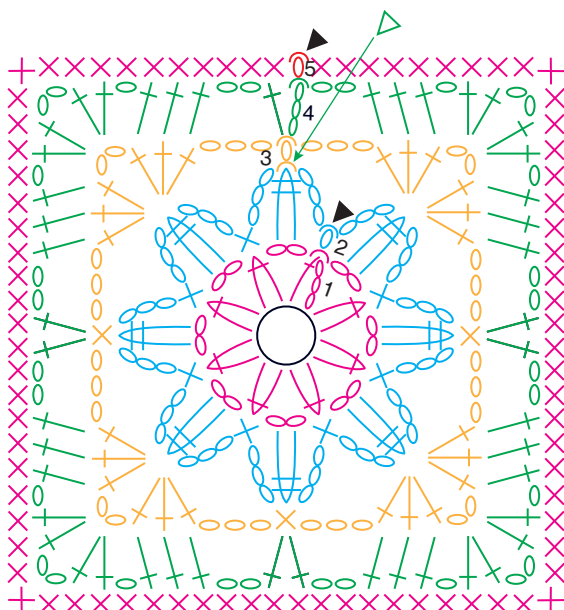


Chart for half granny square B

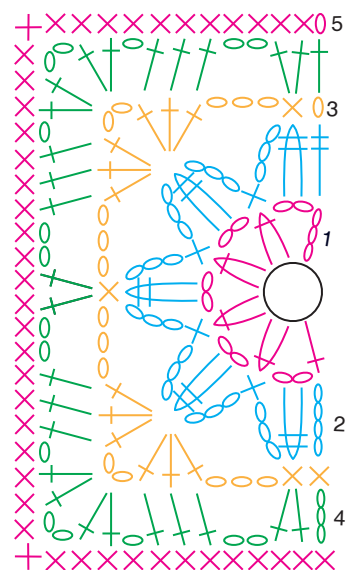
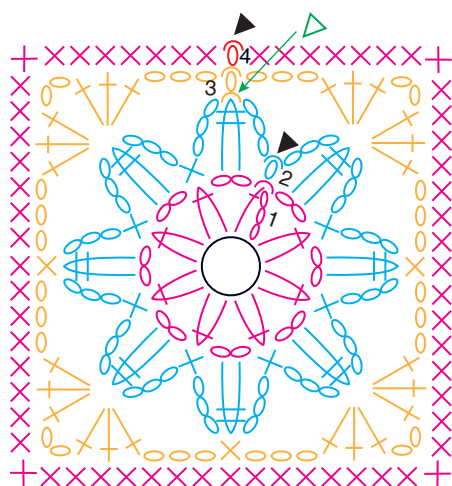


Chart for small granny square C
