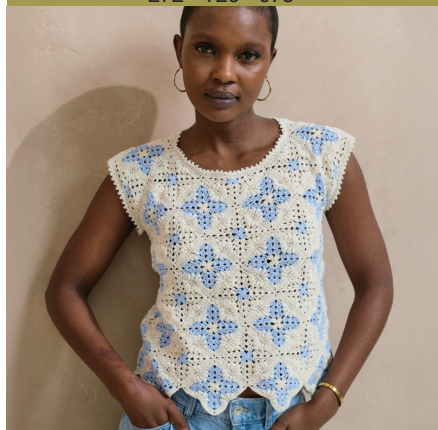

TENSION SQUARE

11 cm square measured diagonally for 5 rounds of granny square n° 1, using a 3 mm crochet hook

12 cm square measured diagonally for 6 rounds of granny square n° 2, using a 3 mm crochet hook

13 cm square measured diagonally for 6 rounds of granny square n° 3, using a 3 mm crochet hook

11 cm square measured diagonally for 5 rounds of granny square n° 1, using a 3 mm crochet hook

12 cm square measured diagonally for 6 rounds of granny square n° 2, using a 3 mm crochet hook

Composition: 100% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

3 mm crochet hook (or other, depending on your tension square)

Stitch markers

Yarn needle

STITCHES (US terms - refer to the glossary for instructions on the basic stitches):

Magic circle

Chain stitch (ch)

Slip stitch (sl st)

Single crochet (sc)

Half double crochet (hdc)

Double crochet (dc)

Treble crochet (tr)

6-loop puff stitch: yo, insert the hook under the ch in the previous row and draw up a long loop, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times, yo and draw the yarn through 6 loops, yo and draw the yarn through the last 2 loops on the hook

8-loop puff stitch: yo, insert the hook under the ch 2 rows below and draw up a long loop, repeat the sequence in **bold** 3 more times, yo and draw the yarn through 8 loops, yo and draw the yarn through the last 2 loops on the hook

Granny squares n° 1 - n° 2 - n° 3 (see charts)

Half granny squares n° 1 - n° 2 - n° 3 (see charts)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

GRANNY SQUARE N° 1

Step 1: Make a magic ring, then using a 3 mm crochet hook, work in the round as follows:

R1: ch 3 (counts as the 1st dc), 2 dc inserting the hook in the ring, **ch 3, 3 dc inserting the hook in the ring**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times, end with ch 1 and 1 hdc in the 3rd ch at the start of the round.

R2: ch 3 (counts as the 1st dc), 1 dc around the post of the hdc from the previous round, **1 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 dc, in the 3-st space: 2 dc + ch 3 + 2 dc**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times, 1 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 dc, 2 dc in the last space, end with ch 1 and 1 hdc in the 3rd ch at the start of the round.

R3: ch 3 (counts as the 1st dc), 1 dc around the post of the hdc from the previous round, **3 x (1 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st), 1 dc, in the 3-st space: 2 dc + ch 3 + 2 dc**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times, 3 x (1 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st), 1 dc, 2 dc in the last space, end with ch 1 and 1 hdc in the 3rd ch at the start of the round.

Step 2: Then follow the chart.

Step 3: When the 5 rounds in the chart are finished, fasten off.

GRANNY SQUARE N° 2

Step 1: Make a magic ring, then using a 3 mm crochet hook, work in the round as follows:

R1: ch 2 (counts as the 1st hdc), 2 hdc inserting the hook in the ring, **ch 3, 3 hdc inserting the hook in the ring**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times, end with ch 1 and 1 hdc in the 2nd ch at the start of the round

R2: ch 2 (counts as the 1st hdc), 1 hdc around the post of the hdc from the previous round, **3 hdc, in the 3-st space: 2 hdc + ch 3 + 2 hdc**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times, 3 hdc, 2 hdc in the last space, end with ch 1 and 1 hdc in the 2nd ch at the start of the round.

R3: ch 3 (counts as the 1st dc), 1 dc around the post of the hdc from the previous round, **3 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st, 3 dc, in the 3-st space: 2 dc + ch 3 + 2 dc**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times, 3 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st, 3 dc, 2 dc in the last space, end with ch 1 and 1 hdc in the 3rd ch at the start of the round.

Step 2: Then follow the chart.

Step 3: When the 6 rounds in the chart are finished, fasten off.

GRANNY SQUARE N° 3

Step 1: Make a magic ring, then using a 3 mm crochet hook, work in the round as follows:

R1: ch 3 (counts as the 1st dc), 2 dc inserting the hook in the ring, **ch 3, 3 dc inserting the hook in the ring**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times, end with ch 1 and 1 hdc in the 3rd ch at the start of the round.

R2: ch 3 (counts as the 1st dc), 1 dc around the post of the hdc from the previous round, **3 dc, in the 3-st space: 2 dc + ch 3 + 2 dc**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times, 3 dc, 2 dc in the last space, end with ch 1 and 1 hdc in the 3rd ch at the start of the round.

R3: ch 3 (counts as the 1st dc), 1 dc around the post of the hdc from the previous round, **3 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st, 3 dc, in the 3-st space, work: 2 dc + ch 3 + 2 dc**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times, 3 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st, 3 dc, 2 dc in the last space, end with ch 1 and 1 hdc in the 3rd ch at the start of the round.

Step 2: Then follow the chart.

Step 3: When the 6 rounds in the chart are finished, fasten off.

HALF-GRANNY SQUARE N° 1

Step 1: Make a magic ring, then using a 3 mm crochet hook, work in rows as follows:

Row 1: ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), ch 1, 3 dc inserting the hook in the ring, ch 3, 3 dc inserting the hook in the ring, ch 1 and 1 tr inserting the hook in the ring.

Row 2: ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), ch 1, 2 dc in the ch from the previous row, 1 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 dc, in the 3-st space: 2 dc + ch 3 + 2 dc, 1 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 dc, 2 dc in the ch from the previous row, ch 1 and 1 tr in the 4th ch at the start of the previous row.

Row 3: ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), ch 1, 2 dc in the ch from the previous row, 3 x (1 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st), 1 dc, in the 3-st space: 2 dc + ch 3 + 2 dc, 3 x (1 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st), 1 dc, 2 dc in the ch from the previous row, ch 1 and 1 tr in the 4th ch at the start of the previous row.

Step 2: Then follow the chart.

Step 3: When the 5 rows in the chart are finished, fasten off.

HALF-GRANNY SQUARE N° 2

Step 1: Make a magic ring, then using a 3 mm crochet hook, work in rows as follows:

Row 1: ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), ch 1, 3 hdc inserting the hook in the ring, ch 3, 3 hdc inserting the hook in the ring, ch 1 and 1 dc inserting the hook in the ring.

Row 2: ch 3 (counts as 1 dc), ch 1, 2 hdc in the ch from the previous row, 3 hdc, in the 3-st space: 2 hdc + ch 3 + 2 hdc, 3 hdc, 2 hdc in the ch from the previous row, ch 1 and 1 dc in the 3rd ch at the start of the previous row.

Row 3: ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), ch 1, 2 dc in the ch from the previous row, 3 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st, 3 dc, in the 3-st space: 2 dc + ch 3 + 2 dc, 3 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st, 3 dc, 2 dc in the ch from the previous row, ch 1 and 1 tr in the 4th ch at the start of the previous row.

Step 2: Then follow the chart.

Step 3: When the 6 rows in the chart are finished, fasten off.

HALF-GRANNY SQUARE N° 3

Step 1: Make a magic ring, then using a 3 mm crochet hook, work in rows as follows:

Row 1: ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), ch 1, 3 dc inserting the hook in the ring, ch 3, 3 dc inserting the hook in the ring, ch 1 and 1 tr inserting the hook in the ring.

Row 2: ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), ch 1, 2 dc in the ch from the previous row, 3 dc, in the 3-st space: 2 dc + ch 3 + 2 dc, 3 dc, 2 dc in the ch from the previous row, ch 1 and 1 tr in the 4th ch at the start of the previous row.

Row 3: ch 4 (counts as 1 tr), ch 1, 2 dc in the ch from the previous row, 3 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st, 3 dc, in the 3-st space: 2 dc + ch 3 + 2 dc, 3 dc, ch 1, skip 1 st, 3 dc, 2 dc in the ch from the previous row, ch 1 and 1 tr in the 4th ch at the start of the previous row.

Step 2: Then follow the chart.

Step 3: When the 6 rows in the chart are finished, fasten off.

BACK AND FRONT

Step 1: Granny squares A

Make **38** granny squares n° 1 - **34** granny squares n° 2 - **34** granny squares n° 3 - **42** granny squares n° 1 - **38** granny squares n° 2 using the colors as follows:

For granny square n° 1:

Magic ring and R1: ÉCRU

R2, R3 and R4: BABY BLUE

R5: ÉCRU

For granny squares n° 2 and n° 3:

Magic ring and R1: ÉCRU

R2, R3, R4 and R5: BABY BLUE

R6: ÉCRU

Step 2: Granny squares B

Make **25** granny squares n° 1 - **22** granny squares n° 2 - **22** granny squares n° 3 - **48** granny squares n° 1 - **43** granny squares n° 2 using the colors as follows:

For granny square n° 1:

Magic ring and R1: BABY BLUE

R2, R3, R4 and R5: ÉCRU

For granny squares n° 2 and n° 3:

Magic ring and R1: BABY BLUE

R2, R3, R4, R5 and R6: ÉCRU

Step 3: Half-granny square C

Make **12** half-granny squares n° 1 - **18** half-granny squares n° 2 - **18** half-granny squares n° 3 - **2** half-granny squares n° 1 - **2** half-granny squares n° 2 using the colors as follows:

For half-granny square n° 1:

Magic ring and R1: BABY BLUE

R2, R3, R4 and R5: ÉCRU

For half-granny squares n° 2 and n° 3:

Magic ring and R1: BABY BLUE

R2, R3, R4, R5 and R6: ÉCRU

Step 4: Half-granny square D

Make **8** half-granny squares n° 1 - **22** half-granny squares n° 1 - **20** half-granny squares n° 2 using the colors as follows:

For half-granny square n° 1:

Magic ring and R1: ÉCRU

R2, R3 and R4: BABY BLUE

R5: ÉCRU

For half-granny square n° 2:

Magic ring and R1: ÉCRU

R2, R3, R4 and R5: BABY BLUE

R6: ÉCRU

Step 5: Assemble the various granny squares, using overlock st and following the corresponding chart.

You can leave the 5 puff sts free and only sew the seams along the dc and chains, this will give an openwork effect and make the garment an airier feel.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the side seams over **29.5** - **27** - **30** - **32** - **30** cm to obtain an armhole height of **21** - **22** - **23** - **24** - **25** cm.

Step 2: Using a 3 mm crochet hook and ÉCRU, work around the armholes as follows:

R1 and R2: sc (= **100** - **106** - **112** - **118** - **124** sts)

R3: **2 sc, ch 3, 1 sl st in the previous sc**, repeat the sequence in **bold** and end with 2 sc

Fasten off.

Step 3: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, work around the neck in the same way: crochet **26** - **28** - **30** - **26** - **28** sc along a half-granny square and **19** - **21** - **23** - **19** - **21** sc along each granny square (= **128** - **140** - **152** - **128** - **140** sc in R1).

join n° 1 granny squares or half-granny squares

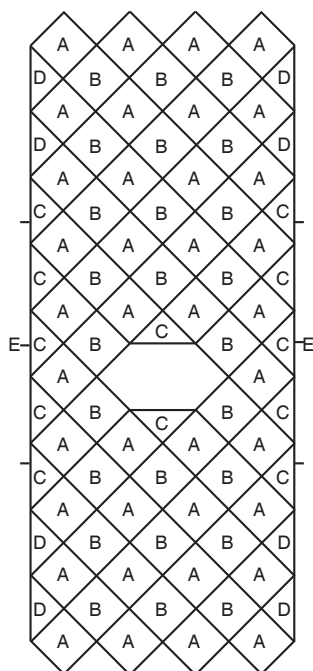


Diagram for assembly, size 38/40

join n° 2 granny squares or half-granny squares

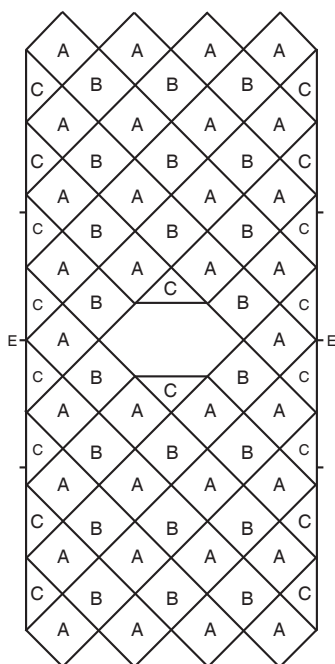
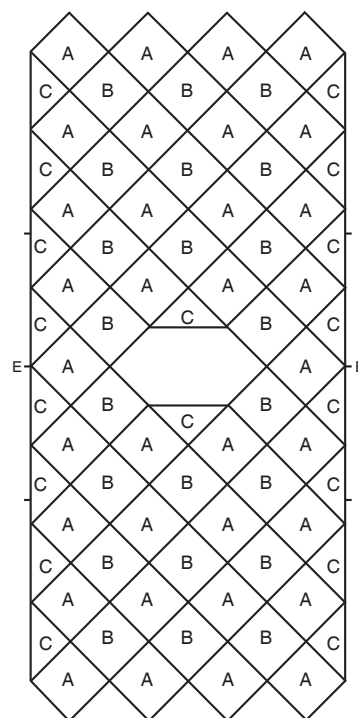


Diagram for assembly, size 42/44

join n° 1 granny squares or half-granny squares

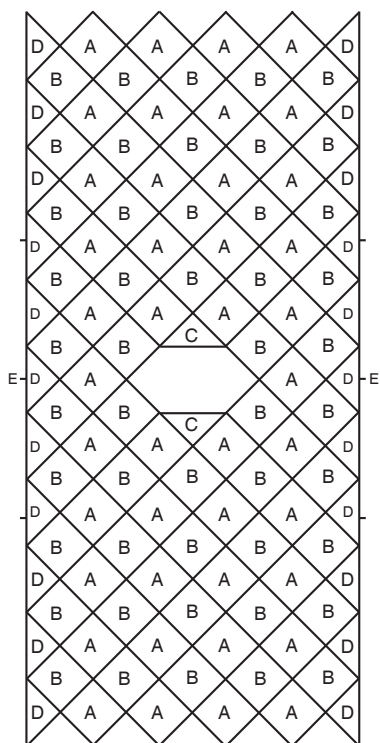
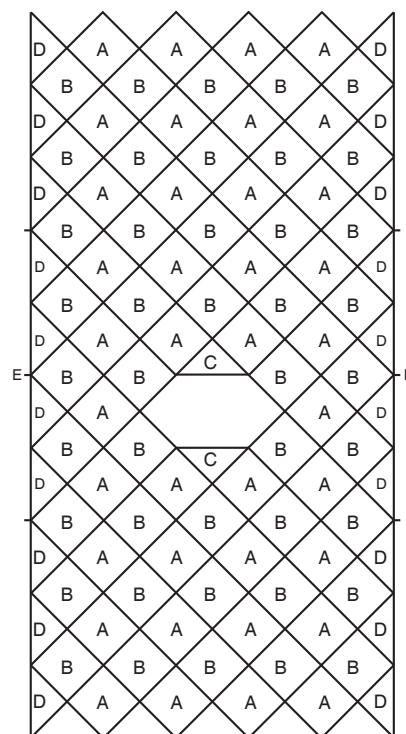
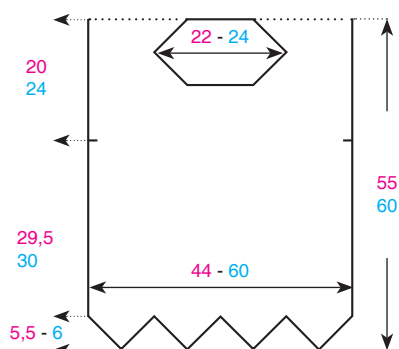


Diagram for assembly, size 50/52

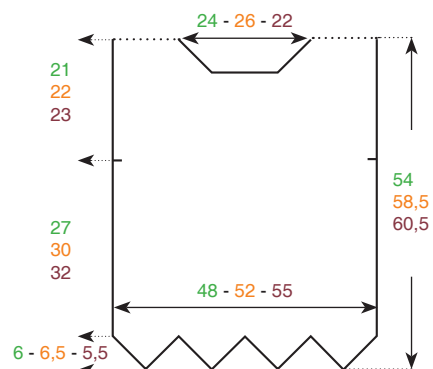

Chart for granny square n° 1

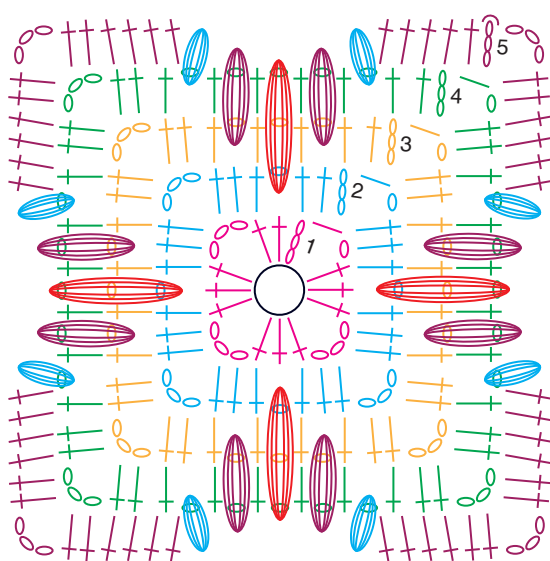


Chart for granny square n° 2

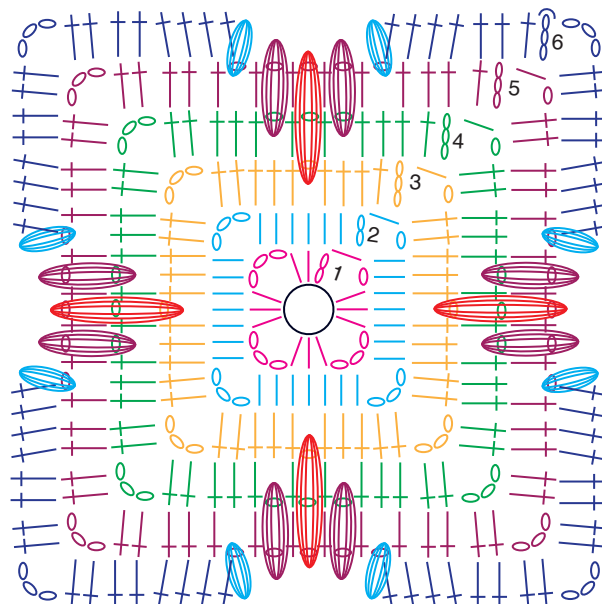
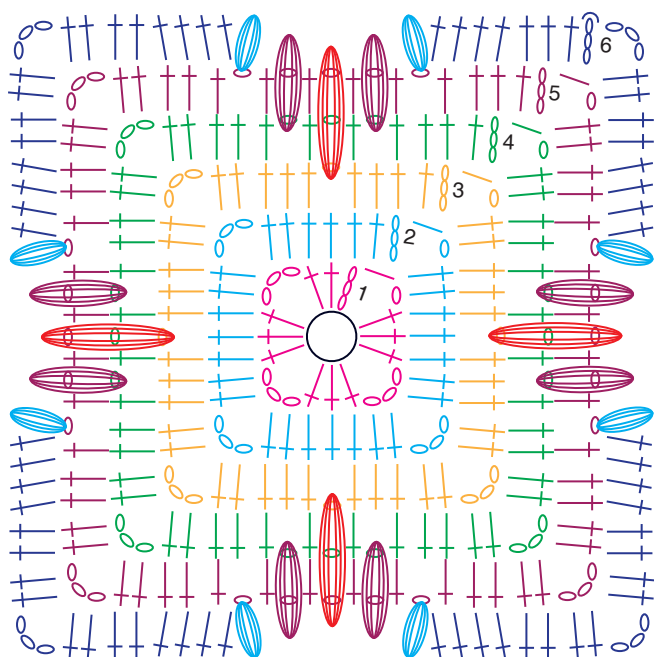


Chart for granny square n° 3

Chart for half-granny square n° 1

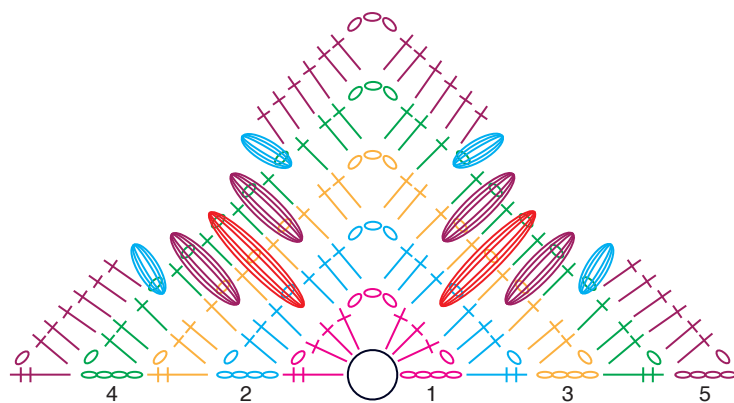


Chart for half-granny square n°2

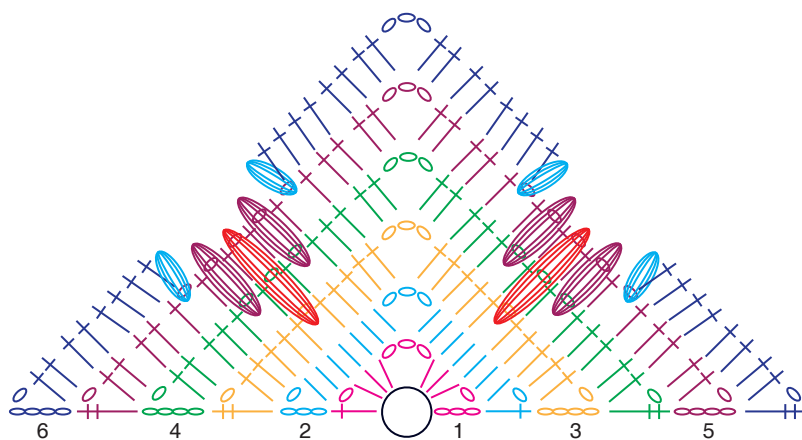
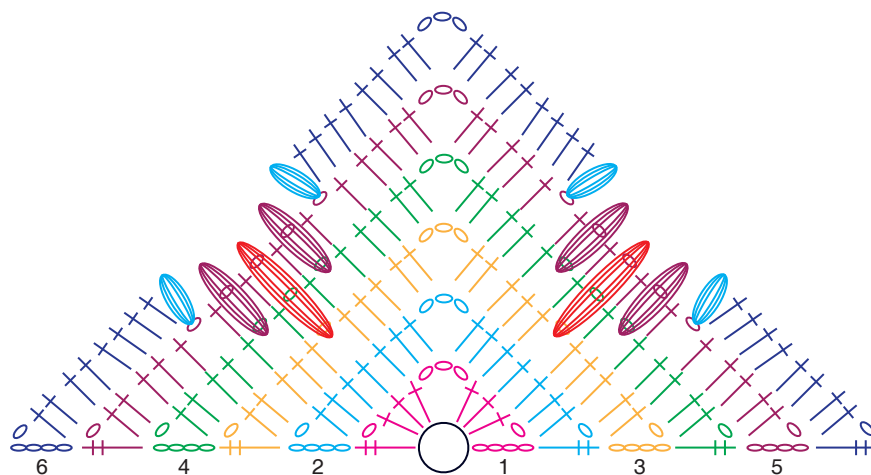


Chart for half-granny square n°3
