STITCHES:
 Chain stitch (ch)
 Slip stitch (sl st)
 Single crochet (sc)

272 - T26 - 074



14 sts and 17 rows to 10 cm, measured over single crochet using a 5 mm
crochet hook

For this garment, you will need (for the number of balls):

YARN	COLOR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52
P. CHROMIA	MULTICO VERT	4	4	5	5	6

Composition: 80% cotton, 20% polyester

MATERIALS:
In the PPY range:
5 mm crochet hook (or other, depending on your tension square)
Stitch markers
Yarn needle

$$\text{St}(s) = \text{stitch}(es)$$

Chain stitch (ch)

Slip stitch (sl st): insert the hook in a st, yarn over and draw the yarn through the st and the loop on the hook

Single crochet (sc): insert the hook in a st, yarn over and draw the yarn through the st, yarn over and draw the yarn through the 2 loops on the hook

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

Step 1: Using a 5 mm crochet hook, ch 72 - 76 - 82 - 87 - 95. Turn.

Step 2: ch 1, then 1 sc (see STITCHES) in the 2nd ch from the hook. Work in sc to the end of the foundation chain (= 1 row of sc). Turn.

Step 3: Continue to work in sc (beginning every row with ch 1 in place of the 1st sc in the row) until your work measures 31 cm from the beginning.

Step 4: Place a stitch marker on the 1st sc and another marker on the last sc in the row (to indicate the armholes).

Continue in sc until your work measures 50 - 51 - 52 - 53 - 54 cm from the beginning.

Step 5: Fasten off (i.e. cut the yarn, pass the strand through the loop from the hook and pull tight).

Place a stitch marker after the 19th - 21st - 24th - 26th - 30th sts from each edge (to indicate the end of the shoulder seams).

FRONT

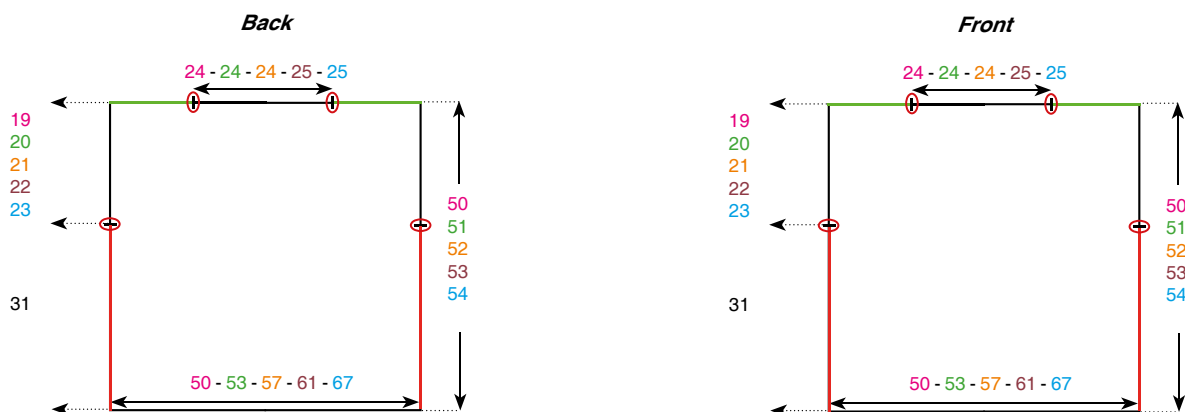
Crochet as for the Back, repeating steps 1 to 4.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Place the Back and Front together with the right sides facing. Sew the shoulder seams in overlock stitch, following the green lines in the diagram.

Step 2: Sew the side seams in overlock stitch, following the red lines in the diagram.

Step 3: Fold the top of the armhole inwards over 3 cm and hold in place with several sts at the shoulder seam.



Measurements indicated in the diagrams are in cm
