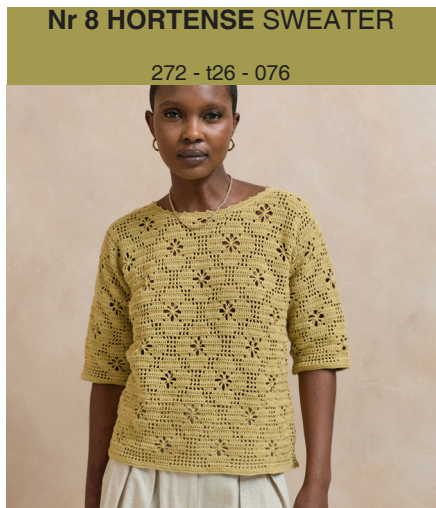
Chain stitch (ch)

Slip stitch (sl st) - Single crochet (sc)

Crochet

TENSION SQUARE

29 sts and 13 rows to 10 cm, measured over pattern stitch using a 2.5 mm crochet hook

YARN	COLOR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52

Composition: 100% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

2.5 mm crochet hook (or other, depending on your tension square)

Stitch markers

Yarn needle

STITCHES (US terms - refer to the glossary for instructions on the basic stitches):

Chain stitch (ch)

Slip stitch (sl st)

Single crochet (sc)

Half double crochet (hdc)

Double crochet (dc)

Double crochet mesh stitch: ch 3 (counts as 1st dc), **ch 1, skip 1, 1 dc**, repeat the sequence in **bold**

Pattern stitch (see chart)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using a 2.5 mm crochet hook, ch 135 - 143 - 155 - 167 - 183. Turn, then work in sc for 1 cm.

Step 2: Continue in pattern st (see chart) and dc mesh st as follows:

4 - 10 - 2 - 10 sts in dc mesh st, 135 - 135 - 135 - 163 - 163 sts in pattern st (i.e. from the 1st to 20th st, then from the 21st to 48th st 3 - 3 - 3 - 4 - 4 times and from the 49th to 79th st), then 4 - 10 - 2 - 10 sts in dc mesh st.

Step 3: When your work measures 37 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. Leave 16 sts unworked on each edge of the next row.

Total sts: 103 - 111 - 123 - 135 - 151 sts

When the ch sts and sc at the center of the "flower" can no longer be worked (i.e. for sizes 38/40 - 46/48), replace these sts with dc.

Step 4: When your work measures 53 - 54 - 55 - 56 - 57 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Leave the center 37 - 37 - 37 - 39 - 39 sts unworked, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge of the next rows, leave the following sts unworked (crochet in sl sts, sc and hdc on these sts): 8 sts once and 7 sts once.

Step 5: Fasten off.

Step 6: Finish the other side of the neck in the same way.

FRONT

Step 1: Using a 2.5 mm crochet hook, ch 135 - 143 - 155 - 167 - 183. Turn, then work in sc for 1 cm.

Step 2: Continue in pattern st (see chart) and dc mesh st as follows:

4 - 10 - 2 - 10 sts in dc mesh st, 135 - 135 - 135 - 163 - 163 sts in pattern st (i.e. from the 1st to 20th st, then from the 21st to 48th st 3 - 3 - 3 - 4 - 4 times, and from the 49th to 79th st), then 4 - 10 - 2 - 10 sts in dc mesh st.

Step 3: When your work measures 37 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. Leave 16 sts unworked on each edge of the next row.

Total sts: 103 - 111 - 123 - 135 - 151 sts

When the ch sts and sc at the center of the "flower" can no longer be worked (i.e. for sizes 38/40 - 46/48), replace these sts with dc.

Step 4: When your work measures 47 - 48 - 49 - 50 - 51 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Leave the center 27 - 27 - 27 - 29 - 29 sts unworked, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge of the next rows, leave the following sts unworked (crochet in sl sts, sc and hdc on these sts): 5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 4 times.

Step 5: When your work measures 55 - 56 - 57 - 58 - 59 cm from the beginning, fasten off.

Step 6: Finish the other side of the neck in the same way.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using a 2.5 mm crochet hook, ch 85 - 91 - 97 - 103 - 107. Turn, then work in sc for 1 cm.

Step 2: Continue in pattern st (see chart) as follows:

Work from the 12th - 9th - 6th - 3rd - 1st to 20th st in the chart, then work from the 21st to 48th st twice, then from the 49th to 68th - 71st - 74th - 77th - 79th st in the chart.

Step 3: Increase on each edge (keeping the pattern st correct whenever possible):

every 3 rows, inc 1 st 8 times and 2 rows higher, inc 1 st once
every 3 rows, inc 1 st 8 times and 2 rows higher, inc 1 st once
every 3 rows, inc 1 st 6 times and every 2 rows, inc 1 st 3 times
every 3 rows, inc 1 st 4 times and every 2 rows, inc 1 st 5 times
every 3 rows, inc 1 st twice and every 2 rows, inc 1 st 7 times

Total sts: 103 - 109 - 115 - 121 - 125 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 23 - 22.5 - 21.5 - 20.5 - 18.5 cm from the beginning, place a marker on each selvage st.

Step 5: When your work measures 29 - 28.5 - 27.5 - 26.5 - 24.5 cm from the beginning, fasten off.

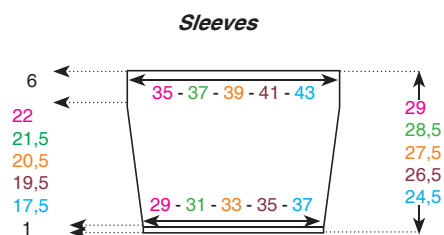
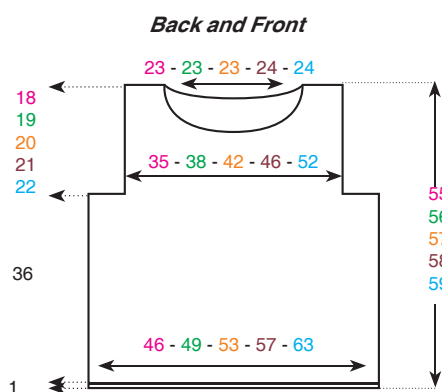
Crochet the other sleeve in the same way.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the seams for the shoulders, sides and sleeves.

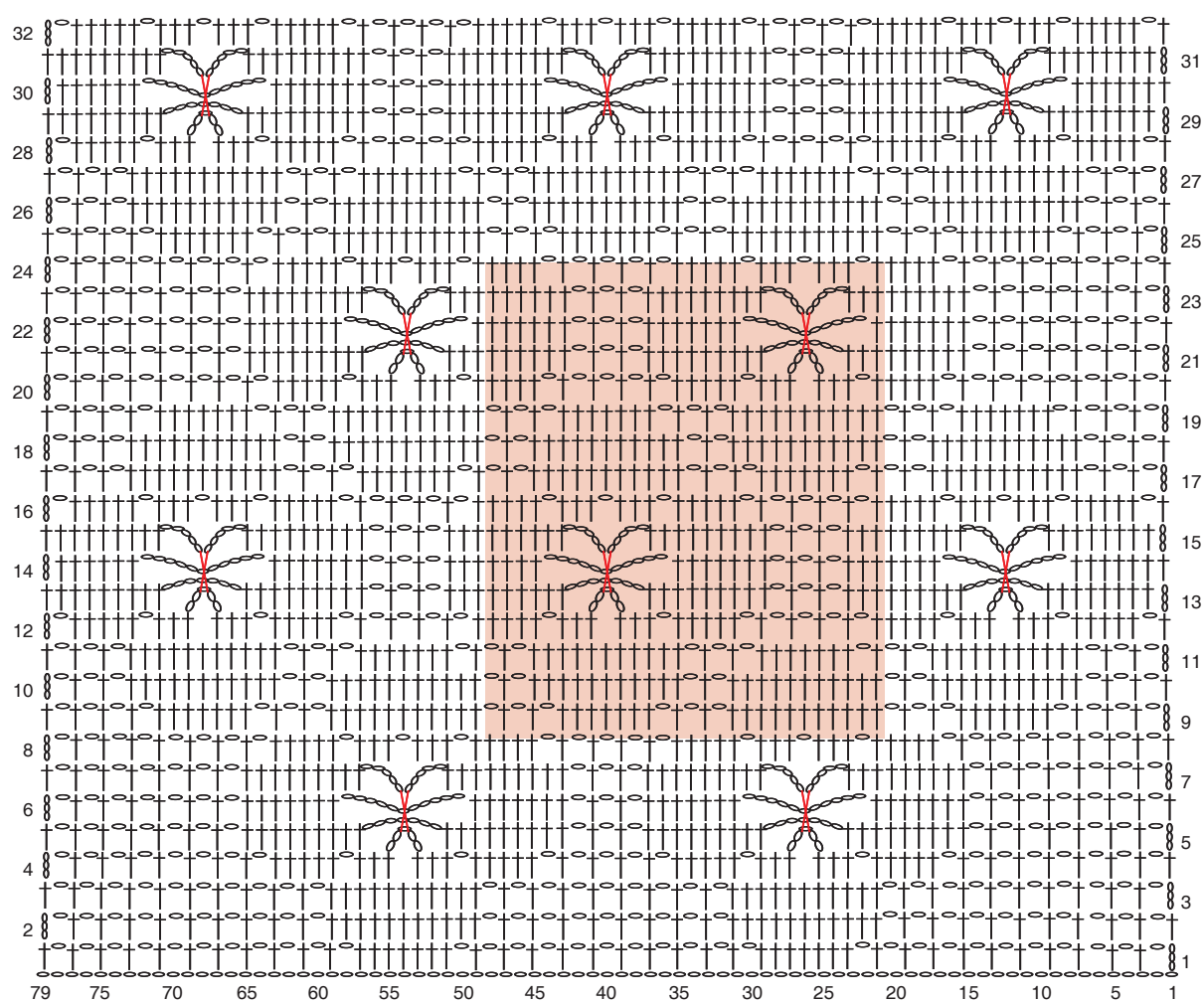
Step 2: Join the sleeves to the body, matching the part above the markers to the sts left unworked on the body.

Step 3: Work 3 rounds of sc around the neck (total sts: 108 - 108 - 108 - 112 - 112 sts), then 1 row of picot as follows: **4 sc, 1 picot** (= ch 3 and 1 sl st in the 1st of the ch 3), repeat the sequence in **bold**.



Measurements indicated in the diagrams are in cm

Chart for pattern st



○ = ch

✕ = sc inserting the hook under the 3 chain spaces from the previous rows

† = dc

Work the first 8 rows, then repeat the 16 rows in the frame

Back and Front: work as follows:

4 - 10 - 2 - 10 sts in dc mesh st, 135 - 135 - 135 - 163 - 163 sts in pattern st (i.e. from the 1st to 20th st, then from the 21st to 48th st: 3 - 3 - 3 - 4 - 4 times, and from the 49th to 79th st), then 4 - 10 - 2 - 10 sts in dc mesh st.

Sleeves: work as follows:

From the 12e - 9e - 6e - 3e - 1ère to 20th st, then from the 21st to 48th st twice, then from the 49th to 68e - 71e - 74e - 77e - 79e st.
