Crochet

TENSION SQUARE

20 sts and 12 rows to 10 cm, measured over double crochet using a 3 mm crochet hook

For this garment, you will need (for the number of balls):

YARN	COLOR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52
PHIL CABOTINE 3	CIEL	8	8	9	9	10

Composition: 55% acrylic, 45% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:
3 mm crochet hook (or other, depending on your tension square)
Stitch markers
Yarn needle
5 x 14 mm mother-of-pearl buttons, ref: 054604

Abbreviation and STITCHES (US terms):

St(s) = stitch(es)

Chain stitch (ch)

Slip stitch (sl st): insert the hook in a st, yo and draw the yarn through the st and the loop on the hook

Double crochet (dc): yo, insert the hook in a st, yo and draw the yarn through the st, yo and draw the yarn through the first 2 loops, yo and draw the yarn through the last 2 loops on the hook

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, ch 92 - 98 - 106 - 114 - 126. Turn.

Step 2: Ch 3, then work 1 dc (see STITCHES) in the 5th ch from the hook. Work in dc to the end of the row. Turn.

Step 3: Continue in dc, beginning each row with ch 3 in place of the 1st dc, until your work measures 32 cm from the beginning.

Step 4: Place a stitch marker on the 1st dc and another marker on the last dc in the row (to indicate the armholes).

Continue in dc until your work measures 49 - 50 - 51 - 52 - 53 cm from the beginning.

Step 5: Shape the 1st side of the neck as follows:

Continue in dc on the first 28 - 31 - 35 - 38 - 44 sts (do not work on the other sts) until your work measures 51 - 52 - 53 - 54 - 55 cm from the beginning.

Step 6: Fasten off (i.e. cut the yarn, pass it through the loop on the hook and pull tight).

Step 7: Shape the other side of the neck as follows:
Skip 36 - 36 - 36 - 38 - 38 dc, then join the yarn with a sl st (see STITCHES) on the next dc.

Repeat steps 5 and 6, working in dc on the last 28 - 31 - 35 - 38 - 44 sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Step 1: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, ch 50 - 53 - 57 - 61 - 67.

Step 2: Work in dc, beginning each row with ch 3 in place of the 1st dc, until your work measures 32 cm from the beginning.

Step 3: Place a stitch marker on the last dc in the row (to indicate the armhole).

Continue in dc until your work measures 43 - 44 - 45 - 46 - 47 cm from the beginning.

Step 4: Shape the right side of the neck as follows:

Fasten off.

Skip the first 22 - 22 - 22 - 23 - 23 dc, then join the yarn with a sl st (see STITCHES) on the next dc.

Work in dc on the last 28 - 31 - 35 - 38 - 44 sts until your work measures 51 - 52 - 53 - 54 - 55 cm from the beginning.

Step 5: Fasten off.

LEFT FRONT

Step 1: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, ch 50 - 53 - 57 - 61 - 67.

Step 2: Work in dc, beginning each row with ch 3 in place of the 1st dc, until your work measures 32 cm from the beginning.

Step 3: Place a stitch marker on the 1st dc in the row (to indicate the armhole).

Continue in dc until your work measures 43 - 44 - 45 - 46 - 47 cm from the beginning.

Step 4: Shape the left side of the neck as follows:

Continue in dc on the first 28 - 31 - 35 - 38 - 44 sts (do not work on the last 22 - 22 - 22 - 23 - 23 sts) until your work measures 51 - 52 - 53 - 54 - 55 cm from the beginning.

Step 5: Fasten off.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, ch 62 - 66 - 70 - 74 - 78.

Step 2: Work in dc, beginning each row with ch 3 in place of the 1st dc.

Step 3: Increase 1 st on each edge (i.e. work 2 dc in the 1st dc and 2 dc in the last dc) in the following rows:

8th - 16th - 24th - 32nd - 40th - 47th - 54th rows

8th - 16th - 24th - 32nd - 39th - 46th - 53rd rows

8th - 16th - 24th - 31st - 38th - 45th - 52nd rows

8th - 16th - 23rd - 30th - 37th - 44th - 51st rows

7th - 14th - 21st - 28th - 35th - 42nd - 49th rows

Total sts: 76 - 80 - 84 - 88 - 92 sts

Continue in dc until your work measures 50.5 - 50 - 49 - 48 - 46 cm from the beginning.

Step 4: Fasten off.

Locate the center of the sleeve and place a marker on this st (= point M).

Crochet the other sleeve in the same way.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Place the Back and front sections together with right sides facing. Sew the shoulder seams in overlock st, following the green lines in the diagram.

Step 2: Position 1 sleeve between the stitch markers on the Back and 1 front section.

Place the right side of the sleeve to the right side of the body.

Position point M on the sleeve to point M on the shoulders.

Join the sleeve to the body in overlock st, following the blue lines in the diagram.

Join the other sleeve in the same way.

Step 3: Sew the seams for the sides in overlock st, following the red lines in the diagram.

Step 4: Sew the sleeve seams in the same way, following the yellow lines in the diagram.

Step 5: Sew the buttons on the Left Front, on the 4th dc from the edge. Sew the 1st button 1 cm from the neck and the other buttons at intervals of 9.5 - 9.5 - 10 - 10 - 10.5 cm.

Use the space between the 3rd and 4th dc on the Right Front as buttonholes.
