TENSION SQUARE

20 sts to 10 cm and 25 rows to 20 cm, measured over pattern stitch using a 3 mm crochet hook

Composition: 90% cotton, 10% cashmere

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

3 mm crochet hook (or other, depending on your tension square)

Stitch markers

Yarn needle

4 x 9 mm pearlized shank buttons, ref: 055150

STITCHES (US terms - refer to the glossary for instructions on the basic stitches):

Chain stitch (ch)

Single crochet (sc)

Half double crochet (hdc)

Double crochet (dc)

Double crochet 2 together (dc2tog)

Decrease 1 st = dc2tog

Pattern stitch (see chart): multiple of 2 + 1 + 1 selvage st on each edge

Row 1: ch 3 (counts as the 1st dc), **2 dc in the next st, skip 1 ch**, repeat the sequence in **bold**, end with 2 dc in the next st and 1 dc in the last st

Row 2: ch 3 (counts as the 1st dc), 1 dc in the dc from the previous row, **2 dc between each 2-dc group from the previous row**, repeat the sequence in **bold**, end with 2 dc in the 3rd ch from the previous row

Row 3: ch 3 (counts as the 1st dc), **2 dc between each 2-dc group from the previous row**, repeat the sequence in **bold**, end with 1 dc in the 3rd ch

Rows 2 and 3 form the pattern.

Finishing (see chart)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, ch **103 - 109 - 117 - 125 - 137**. Turn, then work in pattern st (see STITCHES and chart).

Total sts: **104 - 110 - 118 - 126 - 138** dc

Step 2: When your work measures 25 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. Leave 8 dc unworked on each edge.

Total sts: **88 - 94 - 102 - 110 - 122** dc

Step 3: When your work measures **43 - 44 - 45 - 46 - 47** cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. Leave the following sts unworked on each edge:

13 dc and in the next row, 14 dc

15 dc and in the next row, 15 dc

17 dc and in the next row, 17 dc

18 dc and in the next row, 19 dc

21 dc and in the next row, 22 dc

At the same time, shape the neck. Leave the **34 - 34 - 34 - 36 - 36** center dc unworked.

Step 4: Finish the other side of the neck in the same way.

RIGHT FRONT

Step 1: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, ch **51 - 54 - 58 - 62 - 68**. Turn, then work in pattern st (see chart), beginning with the **1st - 2nd - 2nd - 2nd - 2nd** row.

Total sts: **52 - 55 - 59 - 63 - 69** dc

Step 2: When your work measures **21 - 22 - 23 - 24 - 25** cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Decrease on the right edge (see STITCHES):

dec 1 st, then in the following rows, dec 1 st 4 times, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 12 times

dec 1 st, then in the following rows, dec 1 st 4 times, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 12 times

dec 1 st, then in the following rows, dec 1 st 4 times, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 12 times

dec 1 st, then in the following rows, dec 1 st 6 times, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 11 times

dec 1 st, then in the following rows, dec 1 st 6 times, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 11 times

Step 3: Meanwhile, when your work measures 25 cm from the beginning, shape the armhole. Leave 8 dc unworked on the left edge.

Step 4: When your work measures **43 - 44 - 45 - 46 - 47** cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. Leave the following sts unworked on the armhole edge:

13 dc and in the next row, 14 dc

15 dc and in the next row, 15 dc

17 dc and in the next row, 17 dc

18 dc and in the next row, 19 dc

21 dc and in the next row, 22 dc

Crochet the Left Front, reversing all shaping and beginning the pattern st with the **1st** row.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, ch **63 - 67 - 71 - 75 - 79**. Turn, then work in pattern st (see chart).

Total sts: **64 - 67 - 72 - 76 - 80** dc

Step 2: Increase by 1 dc on each edge:

every 6 rows, inc 1 dc twice and every 5 rows, inc 1 dc 3 times

6 rows higher, inc 1 dc once and every 5 rows, inc 1 dc 4 times

every 5 rows, inc 1 dc 5 times

every 5 rows, inc 1 dc 5 times

every 5 rows, inc 1 dc twice and every 4 rows, inc 1 dc 3 times

Total sts: **74 - 78 - 82 - 86 - 90** sts

Step 3: When your work measures **25.5 - 25 - 24 - 26 - 21** cm from the beginning, place a marker on both selvage sts, then work straight.

Step 4: When your work measures **29.5 - 29 - 28 - 30 - 25** cm from the beginning, fasten off.

Crochet the other sleeve in the same way.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the shoulder seams.

Step 2: Sew the seams for the sides and sleeves.

Step 3: Join the sleeves to the body, placing the section after the markers to the unworked sts on the body.

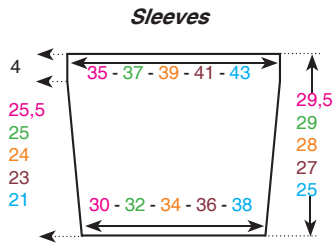
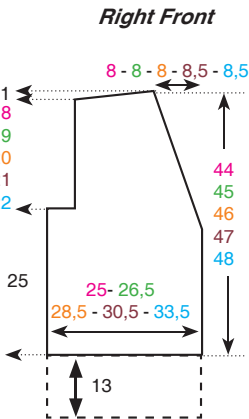
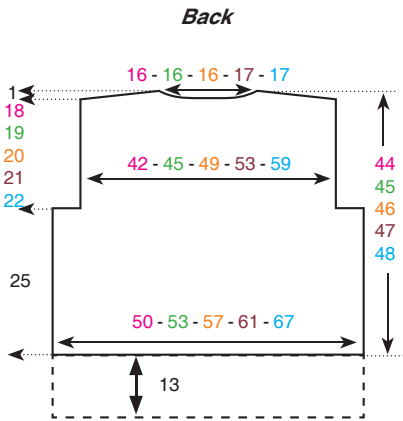
Step 4: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, work the finishing detail (see chart) around the bottom. Work a total of 229 - 241 - 265 - 277 - 301 dc in the 1st row as follows: 57 - 60 - 66 - 69 - 75 dc for the 1st front section, 115 - 121 - 133 - 139 - 151 dc for the Back and 57 - 60 - 66 - 69 - 75 dc for the 2nd front section.
Total motifs: 19 - 20 - 22 - 23 - 25
Crochet the 13 rows in the chart, then fasten off.

Step 5: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, work 2 rows of sc along the front sections and neck.

Step 6: Make 4 button loops on the Right Front. Make the 1st button loop at the neck and the other loops at intervals of 6 - 6 - 7 - 7 - 7 cm.

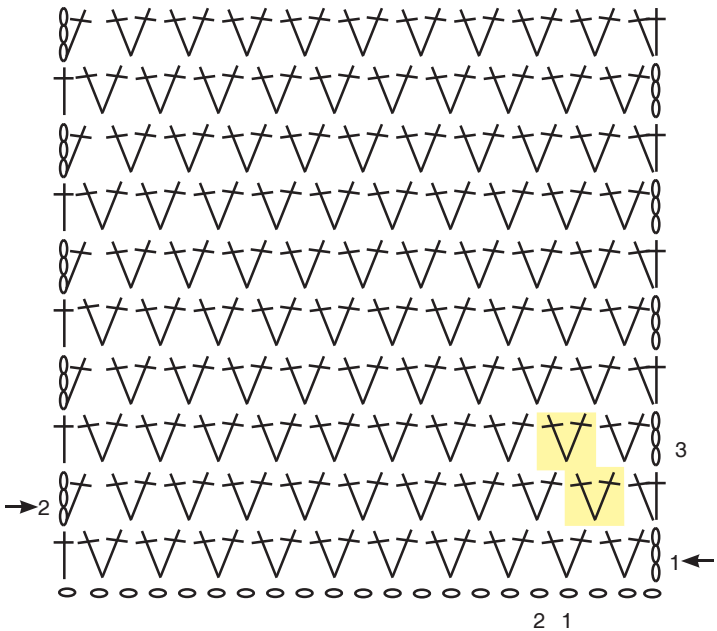
Step 7: Using 2 strands, make a cord of length 120 - 126 - 134 - 142 - 154 cm and thread it through the 1st row of pattern st.

Step 8: Sew the buttons.



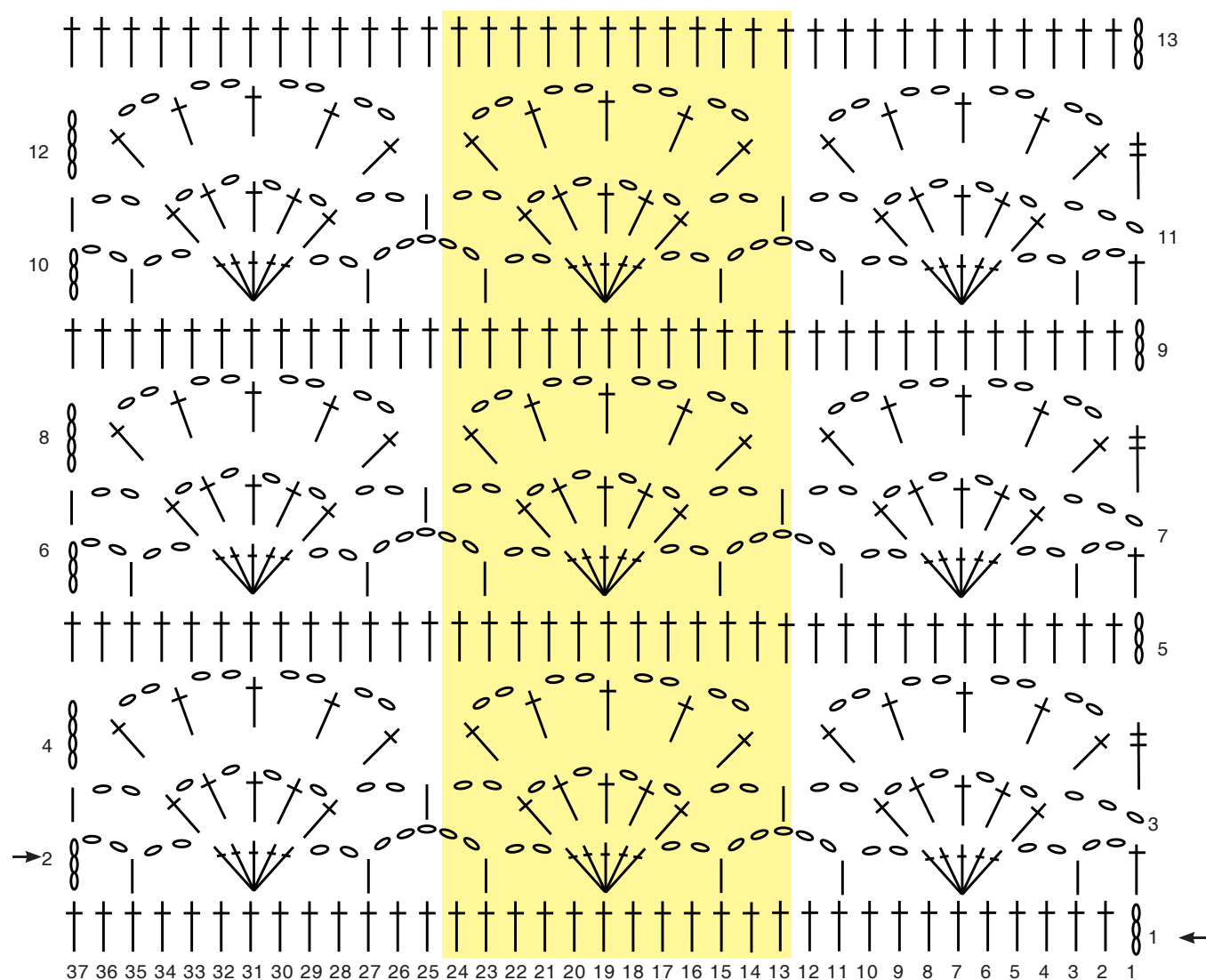
