

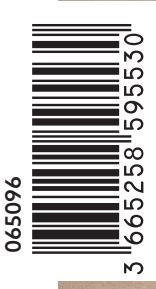

Chain stitch (ch)

Crochet

TENSION SQUARE

28 sts to 10 cm and 27 rows to 11 cm, measured over the stripes pattern using a 2.5 mm crochet hook

Composition: 100% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

2.5 mm crochet hook (or other, depending on your tension square)

Yarn needle

1 x 9 mm pearlized shank button, ref: 055150

STITCHES (US terms - refer to the glossary for instructions on the basic stitches):

Chain stitch (ch)

Slip stitch (sl st)

Single crochet (sc)

Single crochet 2 together (sc2tog)

Half double crochet (hdc)

Half-double crochet 2 together (hdc2tog): yo, insert the hook in a st, yo and draw the yarn through the st, yo and insert the hook in the next st, yo and draw the yarn through the st, yo and draw the yarn through the 5 loops on the hook

Decrease at the beginning and end of a row: sc2tog or hdc2tog depending on the stripes

Picot stitch: ch 3, 1 sl st in the 1st of the ch-3

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using a 2.5 mm crochet hook and LIE DE VIN, ch 120 - 128 - 138 - 150 - 166. Turn and work in stripes (see chart).

Begin each row of hdc with ch 2; these 2 sts count as the 1st hdc in the row

Step 2: When your work measures 26 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, dec 1 st (i.e. sc2tog or hdc2tog):

dec 1 st once, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 24 times

dec 1 st once, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 4 times, in the next row, dec 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 3 more times, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 7 times

dec 1 st once, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st twice, in the next row, dec 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 7 more times, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 7 times

dec 1 st once, then 2 rows higher, dec 1 st once, in the next row, dec 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 13 more times, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 7 times

dec 1 st once, then 2 rows higher, dec 1 st once, in each row, dec 1 st twice, repeat the sequence in bold 10 more times, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 7 times

Step 3: When your work measures 36 - 37 - 38 - 39 - 40 cm from the beginning, shape the slit. Divide the work in half and finish 1 side at a time, continuing the armhole decreases.

Step 4: When your work measures 46 - 47 - 48 - 49 - 50 cm from the beginning, fasten off.

Place a stitch marker after the 10th - 11th - 12th - 12th - 15th st on the armhole edge (to indicate the neck).

Step 5: Finish the other side of the slit.

FRONT

Step 1: Using a 2.5 mm crochet hook and LIE DE VIN, ch 120 - 128 - 138 - 150 - 166. Turn and work in stripes (see chart).

Begin each row of hdc with ch 2; these 2 sts count as the 1st hdc in the row.

Step 2: When your work measures 26 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, dec 1 st (i.e. sc2tog or hdc2tog):

dec 1 st once, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 24 times

dec 1 st once, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 4 times, in the next row, dec 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 3 more times, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 7 times

dec 1 st once, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st twice, in the next row, dec 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 7 more times, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 7 times

dec 1 st once, then 2 rows higher, dec 1 st once, in the next row, dec 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 13 more times, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 7 times

dec 1 st once, then 2 rows higher, dec 1 st once, in each row, dec 1 st twice, repeat the sequence in bold 10 more times, then every 2 rows, dec 1 st 7 times

Step 3: When your work measures 39 - 40 - 41 - 42 - 43 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Leave the 18 - 18 - 18 - 22 - 22 center sts unworked and finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, leave the following sts unworked on each row: 4 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts twice, then every 2 rows, 1 st 5 times.

Step 4: When your work measures 46 - 47 - 48 - 49 - 50 cm from the beginning (10 - 11 - 12 - 12 - 15 sts remain for the shoulder), fasten off.

Step 5: Finish the other side of the neck.

MAKE UP

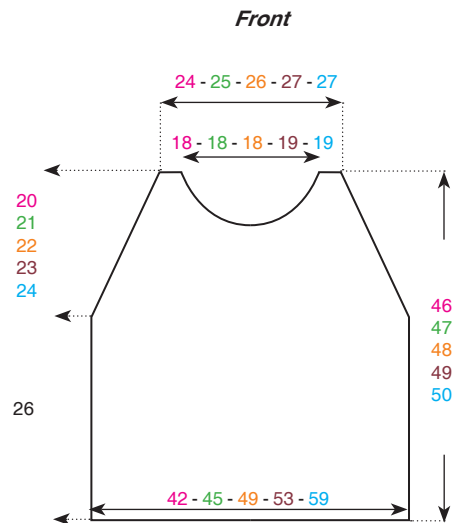
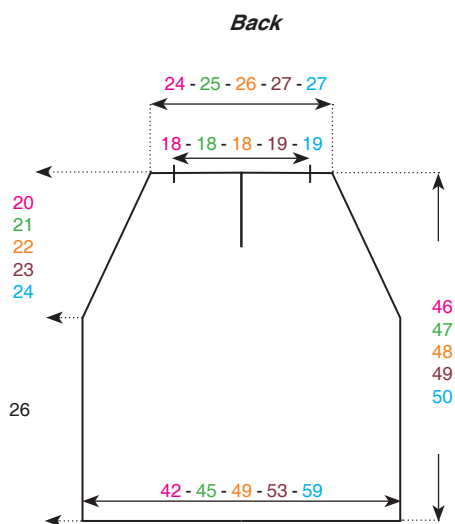
Step 1: Sew the seams for the shoulders and sides.

Step 2: Using a 2.5 mm crochet hook and IVOIRE, work 1 row of sc and 1 row of picot (see chart for edging) around the bottom of the garment.

Step 3: Using a 2.5 mm crochet hook and LIE DE VIN, work 2 rows of sc around the neck and back slit. In the 2nd row, make a ch-3 buttonhole at the top of the slit.

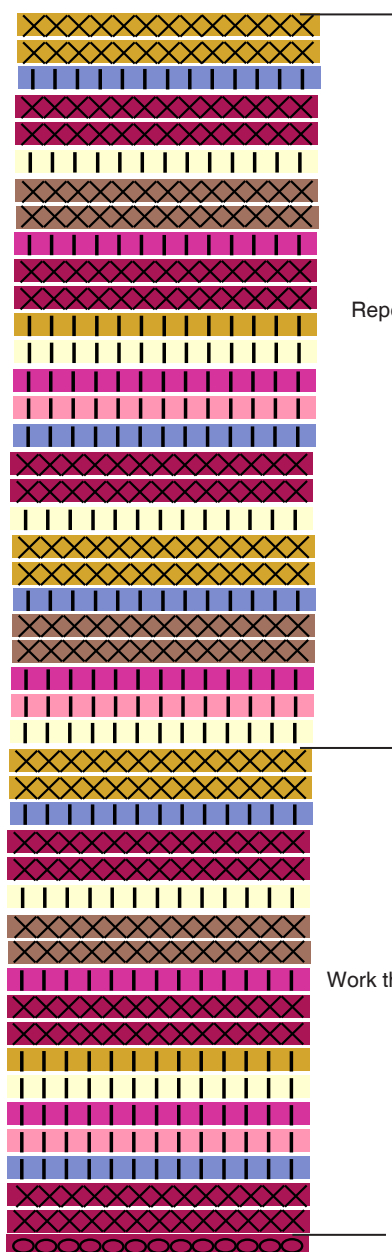
Step 4: Using a 2.5 mm crochet hook and LIE DE VIN, work 2 rows of sc around the armholes.

Step 5: Sew the button.

Work these 18 rows once

= JEANS

= LIE DE VIN

= IVOIRE

= HAVANE

= FUCHSIA

= VIEUX ROSE

= ch
