YARN	COLOR	One size

STITCHES:
Chain stitch (ch)
Single crochet (sc)
Half double crochet (hdc)



Easy level



Crochet

TENSION SQUARES

15 sts and 12 rows to 10 cm, measured over half double crochet stripes using a 4.5 mm crochet hook

16 sts and 14 rows to 10 cm measured over single crochet, using AUBERGINE or OLIVE and a 4.5 mm crochet hook

For this garment, you will need (for the number of balls):

Version B

YARN	COLOR	One size

P. STARLIGHT	DENIM	1

Composition: 43% cotton, 42% paper, 13% acrylic, 2% polyester

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

4.5 mm crochet hook (or other, depending on your tension squares)

Yarn needle

Abbreviations and STITCHES (US terms):

St(s) = stitch(es)

yo = yarn over

Chain stitch (ch)

Single crochet (sc): insert the hook in a st, yo and draw the yarn through the st, yo and draw the yarn through the 2 loops on the hook

Half double crochet (hdc): yo, insert the hook in a st, yo and draw the yarn through the st, yo and draw the yarn through the 3 loops on the hook

INSTRUCTIONS

Important: the bag is worked using a double strand for all the colors, except AUBERGINE and OLIVE that are worked with a single strand.

SIDES

Step 1: Using a 4.5 mm crochet hook and AUBERGINE or OLIVE, ch 50. Turn.

Step 2: ch 2, then 1 hdc (see STITCHES) in the 4th ch from the hook. Work in hdc to the end of the row.

Step 3: Continue in hdc stripes (see chart for sides), beginning each row with ch 2 in place of the 1st hdc, until your work measures 42 cm from the beginning.

The 51 rows in the chart have been worked.

Tip: to change color, work the last yo of the last hdc in the row in the new color for the next row.

Step 4: Fasten off (i.e. cut the yarn, pass it through the loop on the hook and pull tight).

Crochet the other side in the same way.

ENDS

Step 1: Using a 4.5 mm crochet hook and AUBERGINE or OLIVE, ch 50. Turn.

Step 2: Work in hdc stripes (see chart for ends), beginning each row with ch 2 in place of the 1st hdc, until your work measures 17 cm from the beginning.

The 21 rows in the chart have been worked.

Step 3: Fasten off.

Crochet the other end in the same way.

BOTTOM

Step 1: Using a 4.5 mm crochet hook and AUBERGINE or OLIVE, ch 68. Turn.

Step 2: Work in sc, beginning each row with ch 1 in place of the 1st sc, until your work measures 17 cm from the beginning.

Step 3: Fasten off.

HANDLES

Step 1: Using a 4.5 mm crochet hook and AUBERGINE or OLIVE, ch 7. Turn.

Step 2: Work in sc, beginning each row with ch 1 in place of the 1st sc, until your work measures 70 cm from the beginning.

Step 3: Fasten off.

Crochet the other handle in the same way.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew 1 end to 1 of the sides using overlock stitch, following the red lines in the diagrams. Then sew the end to the 2nd side in the same way, following the green lines in the diagrams. Sew the other end to the 2 sides in the same way.

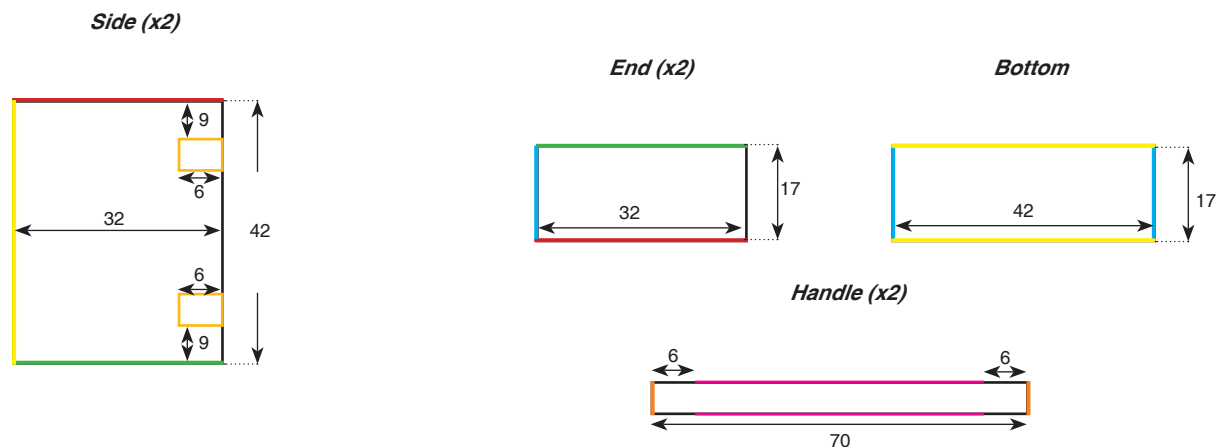
Step 2: Sew the bottom to the ends and sides using overlock stitch, following the yellow and blue lines in the diagrams.

Step 3: Using a 4.5 mm crochet hook and AUBERGINE or OLIVE, work 1 row of sc around the top of the bag.

Step 4: Fold 1 handle in half and sew it closed using overlock st, following the pink lines in the diagram, and leaving 6 cm free at each end. Work in the same way for the other handle.

Step 5: Sew the end of a handle to the top of 1 side, following the orange lines in the diagrams. Position the 6 cm left free flat on the side and 9 cm from the ends of the bag. Work in the same way for the other handle.

Diagram for side version A

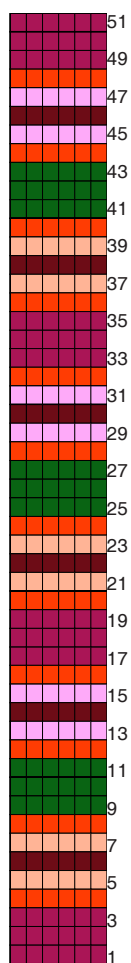
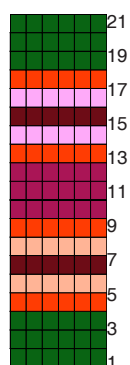


Diagram for end version A

Diagram for side version B

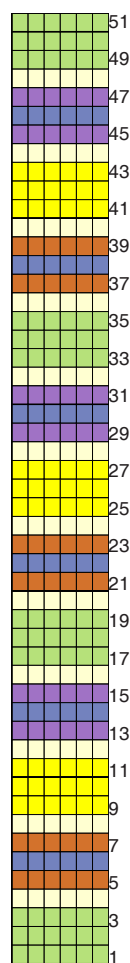
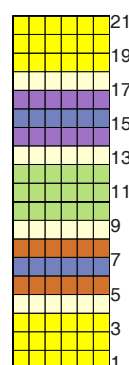


Diagram for end version B
