Crochet

TENSION SQUARE

27 sts and 12 rows to 10 cm, measured over double crochet mesh stitch using a 3 mm crochet hook

YARN	COLOR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52

Composition: 55% acrylic, 45% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

3 mm crochet hook (or other, depending on your tension square)

Stitch markers

Yarn needle

STITCHES (US terms - refer to the glossary for instructions on the basic stitches):

Chain stitch (ch)

Slip stitch (sl st)

Single crochet (sc)

Half double crochet (hdc)

Double crochet (dc)

Picot stitch: ch 3, 1 sl st in the 1st of the ch-3

Double crochet mesh stitch:

Row 1: ch 3 (counts as the 1st dc), **ch 1, skip 1 st, 1 dc in the next st**, repeat the sequence in **bold** to the end of the row

Row 2: ch 3 (counts as the 1st dc), **ch 1, 1 dc in the next dc**, repeat the sequence in **bold** to the end of the row

Continue to repeat the 2nd row.

Pattern stitch (see chart)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, ch 135 - 143 - 151 - 163 - 179. Turn, then work in sc for 1 cm (= 2 rows).

Step 2: Change to dc mesh st (see STITCHES).

Step 3: When your work measures 34 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. Leave 12 sts unworked on each edge.

Total sts: 111 - 119 - 127 - 139 - 155 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 52 - 53 - 54 - 55 - 56 cm from the beginning, fasten off.

Place a marker on either side of the 57 - 57 - 57 - 59 - 59 center sts (to indicate the neck).

FRONT

Step 1: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, ch 135 - 143 - 151 - 163 - 179. Turn, then work in sc for 1 cm (= 2 rows).

Step 2: Change to dc mesh st (see STITCHES).

Step 3: When your work measures 6 - 7 - 8 - 9 - 10 cm from the beginning, work in dc mesh st and pattern st (see chart) as follows:

16 sts in dc mesh st, the 103 sts in the chart, 16 sts in dc mesh st
20 sts in dc mesh st, the 103 sts in the chart, 20 sts in dc mesh st
24 sts in dc mesh st, the 103 sts in the chart, 24 sts in dc mesh st
30 sts in dc mesh st, the 103 sts in the chart, 30 sts in dc mesh st
38 sts in dc mesh st, the 103 sts in the chart, 38 sts in dc mesh st

When the 42 rows in the chart are finished, continue in dc mesh st on all the sts.

Step 4: When your work measures 34 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. Leave 12 sts unworked on each edge.

Total sts: 111 - 119 - 127 - 139 - 155 sts

Step 5: When your work measures 43 - 44 - 45 - 46 - 47 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Leave the 19 - 19 - 19 - 21 - 21 center sts unworked, then finish 1 side at a time. In each row, leave the following sts unworked (crochet in sl sts, sc and hdc on these sts): 5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times.

Total sts: 27 - 31 - 35 - 40 - 48 sts

Step 6: When your work measures 52 - 53 - 54 - 55 - 56 cm from the beginning, fasten off.

Step 7: Finish the other side of the neck.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, ch 83 - 87 - 93 - 99 - 105. Turn, then work in sc for 1 cm (= 2 rows).

Step 2: Change to dc mesh st (see STITCHES) and increase by 1 st on each edge (= 2 dc in the selvage dc):

every 3 rows, inc 1 st 7 times

every 3 rows, inc 1 st 7 times

every 3 rows, inc 1 st 6 times and 2 rows higher, inc 1 st once

every 3 rows, inc 1 st 6 times and 2 rows higher, inc 1 st once

every 3 rows, inc 1 st 4 times and every 2 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

Total sts: 97 - 101 - 107 - 113 - 119 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 21 - 21 - 19.5 - 19.5 - 18 cm from the beginning, place a marker on both selvage sts and continue straight.

Step 4: When your work measures 26 - 26 - 24.5 - 24.5 - 23 cm from the beginning, fasten off.

Crochet the other sleeve in the same way.

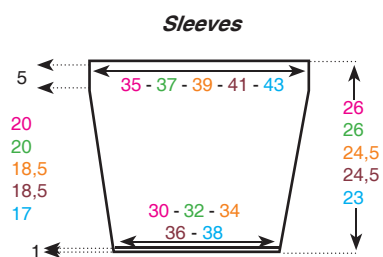
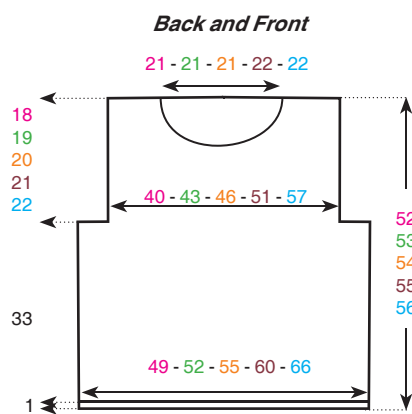
MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the seams for the shoulders and sides.

Step 2: Sew the sleeve seams up to the stitch markers.

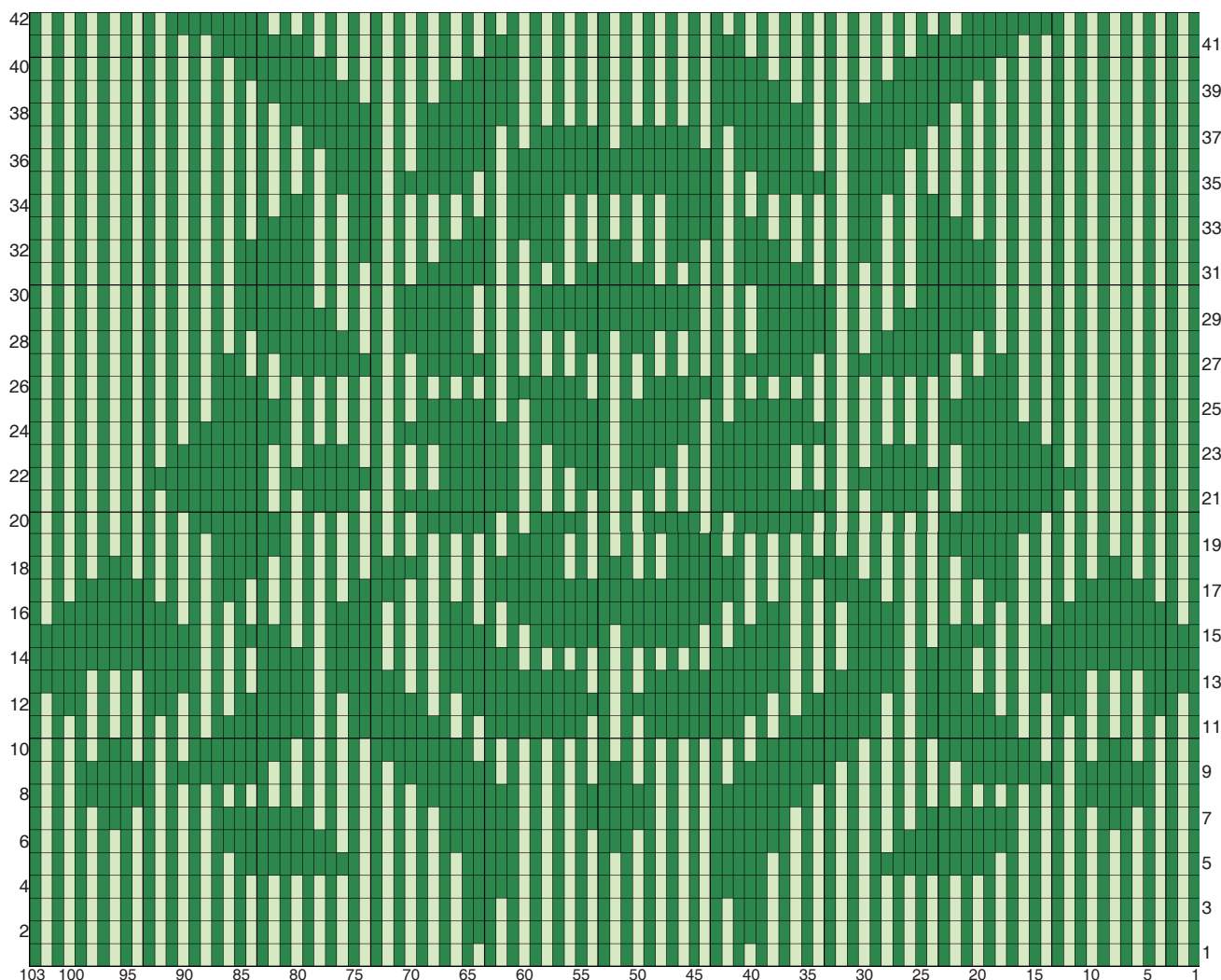
Step 3: Join the sleeves to the body, matching the section above the markers to the unworked sts at the armholes.

Step 4: Using a 3 mm crochet hook, work 2 rounds of sc at the neck (making sure you work a multiple of 3 sts), then work 1 round of picot as follows: 2 sc, 1 picot st (see STITCHES), 1 sc, repeat the sequence in **bold**.

When the 42 rows in the chart are finished, continue in dc mesh st

= 1 ch
