Easy Level



Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

20 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm measured over stockinette stitch, using 1 strand of P. STARLIGHT + 1 strand of P. CABOTINE 3 with 4.5 mm needles

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P. CABOTINE 3	ACAJOU	5	6	6	7	7
P. STARLIGHT	ACAJOU	4	4	4	5	5

Composition: 61% cotton, 30% acrylic, 9% polyester

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:
1 pair each of 4 mm and 4.5 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)
Stitch markers - Yarn needle

4 - 5 - 5 - 5 - 5 x 10 mm buttons, color OR, ref: 070225

Abbreviations and STITCHES:

St(s) = stitch(es)

RS = right side of your work

K1 = knit 1 st

P1 = purl 1 st

K2tog = knit 2 sts together

sgle dec = single decrease

yo = yarn over

Garter stitch: knit every row

Stockinette stitch (st st): knit 1 row, purl 1 row

K2/P1 rib: worked on a multiple of 3 + 2 sts

Row 1 (RS): K2, P1, repeat the sequence in **bold**, then end with K2

Row 2: P2, K1, repeat the sequence in **bold**, then end with P2

Repeat these 2 rows

Single decrease:

On the right: K2tog

On the left: SKP (slip 1 st knitwise, K1, then pass the slipped st over the K1)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

Important, this garment is worked using 2 strands together (1 strand of P. Cabotine 3 + 1 strand of P. Starlight)

BACK

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles, cast on 98 - 104 - 112 - 120 - 132 sts and work 6 rows of garter st (see STITCHES).

Step 2: Change to 4.5 mm needles and st st (see STITCHES).

Step 3: When your work measures 28 cm from the beginning, place a marker on the first and last st (to indicate the armholes).

Step 4: When your work measures 47 - 48 - 49 - 50 - 51 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. On each edge, bind off:
5 sts 3 times and 6 sts twice

6 sts 5 times

6 sts twice and 7 sts 3 times

7 sts 5 times

8 sts 5 times

Step 5: When your work measures 50 - 51 - 52 - 53 - 54 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 44 - 44 - 46 - 50 - 52 sts. Place a marker after the 6th - 6th - 7th - 8th - 9th st from each edge (to indicate the end of the shoulder seam).

RIGHT FRONT

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles, cast on 48 - 51 - 55 - 59 - 65 sts and work 6 rows of garter st.

Step 2: Change to 4.5 mm needles and st st.

Step 3: When your work measures 25 - 26 - 27 - 28 - 29 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Decrease on the right edge (see STITCHES):

1 sgle dec once, every 6 rows, 1 sgle dec 8 times, then every 4 rows, 1 sgle dec 6 times

1 sgle dec once, every 6 rows, 1 sgle dec 8 times, then every 4 rows, 1 sgle dec 6 times

1 sgle dec once, every 6 rows, 1 sgle dec 8 times, then every 4 rows, 1 sgle dec 6 times

Step 4: When your work measures 47 - 48 - 49 - 50 - 51 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the armhole edge, bind off:

5 sts 3 times and 6 sts 3 times

6 sts 6 times

6 sts twice and 7 sts 4 times

7 sts 5 times and 8 sts once

8 sts 5 times and 9 sts once

Step 5: Place a marker on the selvege st on the left edge, 28 cm from the bottom (to indicate the armhole).

LEFT FRONT

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles, cast on 48 - 51 - 55 - 59 - 65 sts and work 6 rows of garter st.

Step 2: Change to 4.5 mm needles and st st.

Step 3: When your work measures 25 - 26 - 27 - 28 - 29 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Decrease on the left edge (see STITCHES):

1 sgle dec once, every 6 rows, 1 sgle dec 8 times, then every 4 rows, 1 sgle dec 6 times

1 sgle dec once, every 6 rows, 1 sgle dec 8 times, then every 4 rows, 1 sgle dec 6 times

1 sgle dec once, every 6 rows, 1 sgle dec 8 times, then every 4 rows, 1 sgle dec 6 times

1 sgle dec once, every 6 rows, 1 sgle dec 6 times, then every 4 rows, 1 sgle dec 9 times

Step 4: When your work measures 47 - 48 - 49 - 50 - 51 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the armhole edge, bind off:

5 sts 3 times and 6 sts 3 times

6 sts 6 times

6 sts twice and 7 sts 4 times

7 sts 5 times and 8 sts once

8 sts 5 times and 9 sts once

Step 5: Place a marker on the selvege st on the right edge, 28 cm from the bottom (to indicate the armhole).

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles, cast on 65 - 68 - 71 - 77 - 80 sts and work 6 rows of garter st.

Step 2: Change to 4.5 mm needles and K2/P1 rib (see STITCHES).

Step 3: When your work measures 6.5 cm from the beginning, change to st st and increase 1 - 2 - 3 - 1 - 2 st(s) in the 1st row.

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Total sts: 66 - 70 - 74 - 78 - 82 sts

Cast on 1 st at the beginning and end of the 7th, 13th, 15th, 21st and 27th rows.
Total sts: 76 - 80 - 84 - 88 - 92 sts

Step 4: Continue in st st until your work measures 18 cm from the beginning, then bind off all the sts.
Locate the center of the sleeve and place a stitch marker (point M).
Make the other sleeve in the same way.

BUTTON BANDS AND NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles, cast on 137 - 140 - 143 - 146 - 149 sts.

Step 2: Work in K2/P1 rib for 2.5 cm, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2.

Step 3: Bind off all the sts.

Step 4: Work another band in the same way, making 4 - 5 - 5 - 5 - 5 buttonholes as follows: work 3 sts, **yo, K2tog, then work 16 - 13 - 13 - 16 - 16 sts**. Repeat the sequence in **bold 3 - 4 - 4 - 4 - 4** more times, then work to the end of the row.

Step 5: Continue in K2/P1 rib until your work measures 2.5 cm from the beginning.

Step 6: Bind off all the sts.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Place the Back and front sections together with the right sides facing. Sew the shoulder seams up to the stitch markers, using backstitch and following the green lines in the diagram.

Step 2: Position 1 sleeve between the 2 markers on the Back and front sections.

Place the sleeve and the body side by side with the right sides facing. Position point M on the sleeve to point M on the shoulder seam. Join the sleeve to the body, using backstitch and following the red lines in the diagram.

Join the other sleeve in the same way.

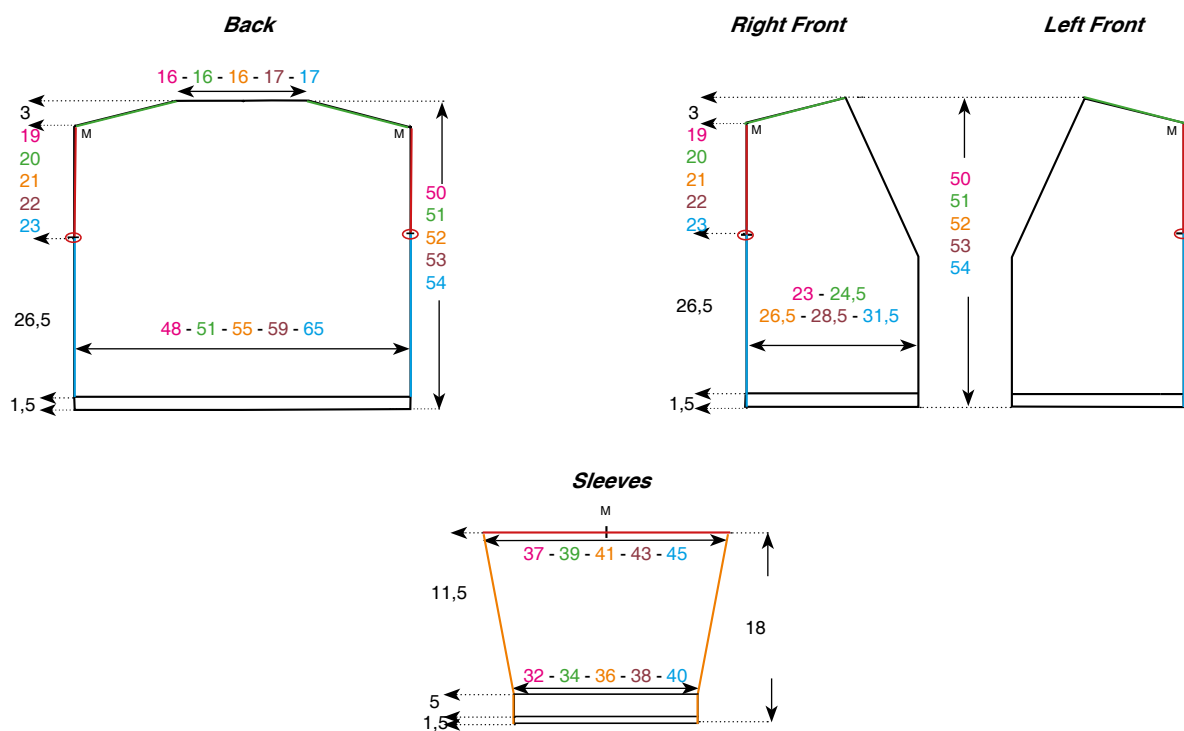
Step 3: Sew the side seams using concealed stitching and following the blue lines in the diagram.

Step 4: Sew the sleeve seams in the same way, following the yellow lines in the diagram.

Step 5: Using backstitching, sew the button band with the buttonholes along the Right Front and up to the center of the back neck.

Step 6: Sew the other band along the Left Front in the same way; then join the 2 bands at the center of the back neck.

Step 7: Sew the buttons.
