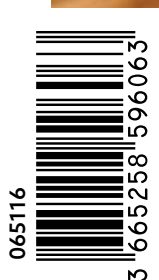

STITCHES:
Garter stitch
Stockinette stitch (st st)

Easy Level



Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

12 sts and 25 rows to 10 cm, measured over garter stitch using 6 mm needles

For this garment, you will need (for the number of balls):

YARN	COLOR	Dimensions 29 cm wide x 59 cm high
P. RAPHIA RUBAN	BABY BLUE	2

Composition: 100% paper

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:
1 pair of 6 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)
6 mm crochet hook
Stitch markers
Yarn needle

Abbreviations and STITCHES:

St(s) = stitch(es)

K1 = knit 1 st

P1 = purl 1 st

ch = crochet chain st

yo = yarn over

Garter stitch: knit every row

Stockinette stitch (st st): knit 1 row, purl 1 row

INSTRUCTIONS

Important, this bag is worked in several sections (see diagram)

CENTER SECTION

Step 1: Using 6 mm knitting needles, cast on 37 sts and work in garter st.

Step 2: When your work measures 18 cm from the beginning, place a marker on both selvedge sts (to indicate the seam); then shape the curves. On each edge, bind off 4 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice.

Step 3: When your work measures 26 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 17 sts.

Make another center section in the same way.

BASE

Step 1: Using 6 mm knitting needles, pick up 37 sts along the 1st row of 1 center section (follow the red line in the diagram)

Step 2: Work in st st.

Step 3: When your work measures 9 cm from the beginning, work 1 st, then work 2 sts together to the end of the row.

Work 1 row on the remaining 19 sts. End with: work 1 st, then work 2 sts together to the end of the row. Bind off the remaining 10 sts.

Step 4: Work in the same way for the other center section.

CROCHETED HANDLES

Step 1: Using a 6 mm crochet hook, ch 3, then place a marker on the 1st st and another marker on the 2nd st.

Insert the hook at the 1st marker, yo and draw the yarn through the loop, then insert the hook in the space under the 1st ch, yo and draw the yarn through the loop (there are now 3 loops on the hook), yo and draw the hook through all the loops.

Turn (the 2nd marker will be above the 1st marker). Remove the 2nd marker and insert the hook in this same place, yo and draw the yarn through the loop, remove the 1st marker and insert the hook in this same place, yo and draw the yarn through the loop (there are now 3 loops on the hook), yo and draw the hook through all the loops.

Turn, 3 loops will be visible at the top, insert the hook in the 1st loop, yo and draw the yarn through the loop, insert the hook in the other 2 loops, yo and draw the yarn through the loops, yo and draw the yarn through the 3 loops.

Repeat the sequence in **bold** until your work measures 80 cm.

Make a second handle in the same way.

CROCHETED EDGING

Step 1: Using a 6 mm crochet hook, ch 3, then work as above for 12 cm.

Make a second band in the same way.

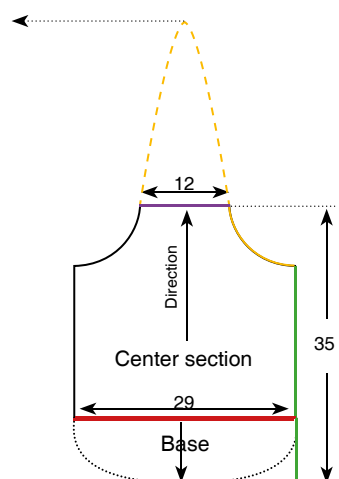
MAKE UP

Step 1: Place both center sections of the bag together with the right sides facing; sew together up to the stitch markers, using backstitch and following the green lines in the diagram.

Step 2: Pass a strand of yarn through the bind-off sts on the base and pull tight to close the base.

Step 3: Sew the edging bands around the top of the bag, following the mauve lines in the diagram.

Step 4: Sew the handles. Sew the ends along the curves of the bag, following the yellow lines in the diagram.
