### Easy Level



### Back-and-forth knitting

#### ENSION SQUARE

26 sts and 33 rows to 10 cm measured over stockinette stitch using 3 mm needles

| YARN           | COLOR   | 34/36 | 38/40 | 42/44 | 46/48 | 50/52 |

**Composition:** 64% cotton, 34% polyester, 2% polyamide

#### MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

1 pair each of 2.5 mm and 3 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

2.5 mm crochet hook (for the armhole edging)

4 x 10 mm buttons, color OR, ref: 070 225

Yarn needle

#### Abbreviations and STITCHES:

st(s) = stitch(es)

K1 = knit 1 st

P1 = purl 1 st

yo = yarn over

**K1/P1:** K1, P1 to the end of the row. In the next row, work the sts as they are presented on the needle (i.e. K1 above a K1 or P1 above a P1 in the previous row)

**Stockinette stitch (st st):** knit 1 row, purl 1 row

**Single crochet (sc):** insert the hook in a st, yo and draw the yarn through the st, yo and draw the yarn through the 2 loops on the hook

## INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

### BACK

**Step 1:** Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 113 - 121 - 131 - 141 - 157 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 5 cm.

**Step 2:** Change to 3 mm needles and st st; increase 1 st at the start of the 1<sup>st</sup> row.

Total sts: 114 - 122 - 132 - 142 - 158 sts

**Step 3:** When your work measures 29 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off:

4 sts once and 1 st 17 times

5 sts once and 1 st 19 times

6 sts once and 1 st 21 times

6 sts once and 1 st 25 times

6 sts once and 1 st 30 times

Total sts: 72 - 74 - 78 - 80 - 86 sts

**Step 4:** When your work measures 44.5 - 45.5 - 46.5 - 47.5 - 48.5 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 30 - 30 - 30 - 32 - 32 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 5 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

Total sts: 10 - 11 - 13 - 13 - 16 sts

**Step 5:** When your work measures 50 - 51 - 52 - 53 - 54 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

Finish the other side of the neck.

### RIGHT FRONT

**Step 1:** Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 55 - 59 - 65 - 69 - 77 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 5 cm, beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> row with K2 (end with P1).

**Step 2:** Change to 3 mm needles and st st; increase 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 st at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> row.

Total sts: 56 - 60 - 65 - 70 - 78 sts

**Step 3:** When your work measures 24.5 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. On the right edge, bind off:

1 st once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, then on the following right edges, bind off 1 st 23 times

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1 st once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, then on the following right edges, bind off 1 st 23 times

1 st once, every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice, then on the following right edges, bind off 1 st 23 times

1 st once, every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice, then on the following right edges, bind off 1 st 23 times

**Important: Meanwhile,** when your work measures 29 cm from the beginning, shape the armhole. On the left edge, bind off:

4 sts once and 1 st 17 times

5 sts once and 1 st 19 times

6 sts once and 1 st 21 times

6 sts once and 1 st 25 times

6 sts once and 1 st 30 times

Total sts: 10 - 11 - 13 - 13 - 16 sts

**Step 4:** When your work measures 50 - 51 - 52 - 53 - 54 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

### LEFT FRONT

**Step 1:** Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 55 - 59 - 65 - 69 - 77 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 5 cm, beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> row with P1 (end with K2).

**Step 2:** Change to 3 mm needles and st st; increase 1 - 1 - 1 - 1 st at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> row.

Total sts: 56 - 60 - 65 - 70 - 78 sts

**Step 3:** When your work measures 24.5 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. On the left edge, bind off:

1 st once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, then on the following left edges, bind off 1 st 23 times

1 st once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, then on the following left edges, bind off 1 st 23 times

1 st once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, then on the following left edges, bind off 1 st 23 times

1 st once, every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice, then on the following left edges, bind off 1 st 23 times

**Important: Meanwhile,** when your work measures 29 cm from the beginning, shape the armhole. On the right edge, bind off:

4 sts once and 1 st 17 times

5 sts once and 1 st 19 times

6 sts once and 1 st 21 times

6 sts once and 1 st 25 times

6 sts once and 1 st 30 times

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Total sts: 10 - 11 - 13 - 13 - 16 sts

**Step 4:** When your work measures 50 - 51 - 52 - 53 - 54 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

## BUTTON BANDS AND NECKBAND

**Step 1:** Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 7 sts and work in K1/P1, beginning and ending with K2.

**Step 2:** When your work measures 65.5 - 66.5 - 67.5 - 69.5 - 70.5 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

**Step 3:** Work another band in the same way.

## MAKE UP

**Step 1:** Place the Back and front sections together with the right sides facing. Sew the shoulder seams using backstitch and following the green lines in the diagram.

**Step 2:** Sew the side seams, using concealed stitching and following the blue lines in the diagram.

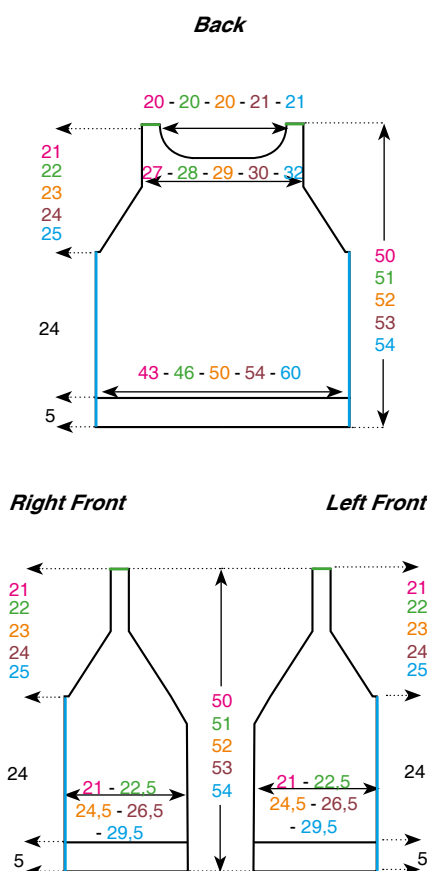
**Step 3:** Sew the bind-off rows of the button bands and neckband together using backstitch, then position this seam at the center of the back neck.

Sew the 2 bands along the front sections up to the center of the back neck, using concealed stitching.

**Step 4:** Make 4 buttonholes along the band on the Right Front by widening the 4<sup>th</sup> st (= the knit st). Make the 1<sup>st</sup> buttonhole 2.5 cm from the bottom and the other buttonholes at 6 cm intervals.

**Step 5:** Sew the buttons.

**Step 6:** Using a 2.5 mm crochet hook, work 1 row of sc (see STITCHES) around the armholes.



Measurements indicated in the diagrams are in cm
