Intermediate level



Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

17-st pattern stitch motif and 16 rows to 6 cm, using 3 mm needles
24 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm, measured over piqué stitch using 3 mm needles

YARN	COLOR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52
P.COTON3	CÉRÉALE or CAPPUCCINO or CRAIE	5	6	6	7	7

Composition: 100% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:
1 pair each of 2.5 mm and 3 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension squares)
4 x 9 mm pearlized shank buttons, ref: 055 150
Yarn needle

STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

Pattern stitch (see chart n° 1)

Piqué stitch (see chart n° 2)

Decrease at 1 st from the edge:

On the right: K1, then K2tog

On the left: work to the last 3 sts, SKP (slip 1 knitwise, K1, then pass the slipped st over the K1), then K1

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles, cast on 138 - 155 - 155 - 172 - 189 sts and work in pattern st (see chart n° 1); begin with K1 and the 1st st in the chart.

Total: 8 - 9 - 9 - 10 - 11 motifs.

Step 2: When your work measures 6 cm from the beginning (the 18 rows in the chart are finished), change to piqué st. Begin with K1 and the 2nd - 3rd - 3rd - 3rd - 4th st in the frame (see chart n° 2) and evenly decrease 21 - 24 - 24 - 25 - 28 sts in the 1st row.

Total sts: 117 - 131 - 131 - 147 - 161 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 12 cm from the beginning, decrease at 1 st from each edge (see STITCHES):

dec 1 st once, then every 12 rows, dec 1 st 4 times and 10 rows higher, dec 1 st once

dec 1 st once, then every 8 rows, dec 1 st 7 times and 6 rows higher, dec 1 st once

dec 1 st once, then every 18 rows, dec 1 st twice and 16 rows higher, dec 1 st once

dec 1 st once, then every 10 rows, dec 1 st twice and 8 rows higher, dec 1 st 5 times

dec 1 st once, then every 10 rows, dec 1 st 6 times

Total sts: 105 - 113 - 123 - 131 - 147 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 31 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off:

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice

4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice

5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

5 sts once, 4 sts twice, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times

6 sts once, 5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times

Total sts: 79 - 81 - 83 - 85 - 91 sts

Step 5: When your work measures 50 - 51 - 52 - 53 - 54 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 27 - 27 - 27 - 29 - 29 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 5 sts once and 4 st 3 times.

Step 6: When your work measures 53 - 54 - 55 - 56 - 57 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 9 - 10 - 11 - 11 - 14 sts for the shoulder.

Step 7: Finish the other side of the neck.

RIGHT FRONT

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles, cast on 70 - 79 - 79 - 87 - 96 sts and work in pattern st (see chart n° 1); begin with K1 and the 1st - 9th - 9th - 1st - 9th st in the chart.

Step 2: When your work measures 6 cm from the beginning (the 18 rows in the chart are finished), change to piqué st (see chart n° 2). Evenly decrease 12 - 14 - 14 - 14 - 16 sts in the 1st row and begin with K1 and the 1st st in the chart.

Total sts: 58 - 65 - 65 - 73 - 80 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 12 cm from the beginning, decrease at 1 st from each edge (see STITCHES):

dec 1 st once, then every 12 rows, dec 1 st 4 times and 10 rows higher, dec 1 st once

dec 1 st once, then every 8 rows, dec 1 st 7 times and 6 rows higher, dec 1 st once

dec 1 st once, then every 18 rows, dec 1 st twice and 16 rows higher, dec 1 st once

dec 1 st once, then every 10 rows, dec 1 st twice and 8 rows higher, 1 st 5 times

dec 1 st once, then every 10 rows, dec 1 st 6 times

Total sts: 52 - 56 - 61 - 65 - 73 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 31 cm from the beginning, shape the armhole. On the left edge, bind off:

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice

4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice

5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

5 sts once, 4 sts twice, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times

6 sts once, 5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times

At the same time, shape the neck. On the right edge, bind off:

1 st once, 2 sts once, 1 st twice, 2 sts once and 1 st 10 times, **4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, on the following rows, bind off 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 3 more times, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 4 times and 6 rows higher, bind off 1 st once**

1 st once, 2 sts once, 1 st twice, 2 sts once and 1 st 10 times, **4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, on the following rows, bind off 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 1 more time, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 4 times and 6 rows higher, bind off 1 st once**

1 st once, 2 sts once, 1 st twice, 2 sts once and 1 st 10 times, **4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, on the following rows, bind off 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 3 more times, then 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once and every 6 rows, bind off 1 st 4 times**

1 st once, 2 sts once, 1 st twice, 2 sts once and 1 st 10 times, **4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, on the following rows, bind off 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 3 more times, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice and every 6 rows, bind off 1 st 4 times**

1 st once, 2 sts once, 1 st twice, 2 sts once and 1 st 10 times, **4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, on the following rows, bind off 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 3 more times, then every 6 rows, bind off 1 st 6 times**

Step 5: When your work measures 53 - 54 - 55 - 56 - 57 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 9 - 10 - 11 - 11 - 14 sts for the shoulder.

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Work the Left Front, reversing all shaping. Begin the pattern st and piqué st as for the Back.

BUTTON BANDS

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 7 sts and work in K1/P1 rib, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2.

Step 2: When your work measures 31 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

Make another band, working 4 x 3-row buttonholes at 3 sts from the right edge. Make the 1st buttonhole 10 cm from the bottom and the following buttonholes at 5.5 cm intervals.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the shoulder seams.

Step 2: Using 3 mm needles, pick up and knit the sts along the armholes, then bind off all these sts knitwise in the next row.

Step 3: Sew the button bands along the front sections.

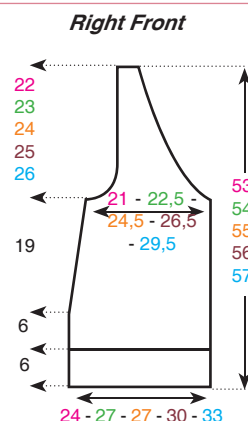
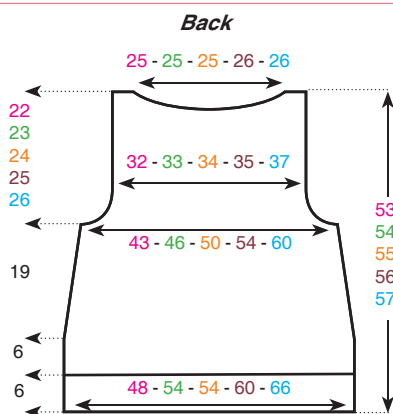
Step 4: Using 3 mm needles, pick up and knit the sts around the neck and the 7 sts of the button bands, then bind off all these sts knitwise in the next row.

Step 5: Sew the side seams.

Step 6: Sew the buttons.

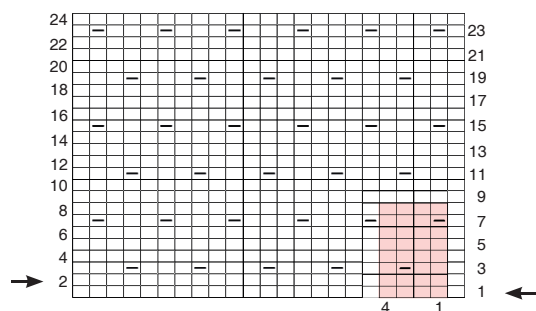
Step 7: Using 2 strands of yarn, make a tie of finished length 140 cm.

Thread this tie through the sts in the 35th row of piqué st. Begin at the center Back: leave the 3 center sts free and thread the tie through the st on either side of these 3 sts; thn continue in the same way, leaving 3 sts free each time.

Repeat the 4 sts and 8 rows in the frame

▬ = P1 (RS) or K1 (WS)

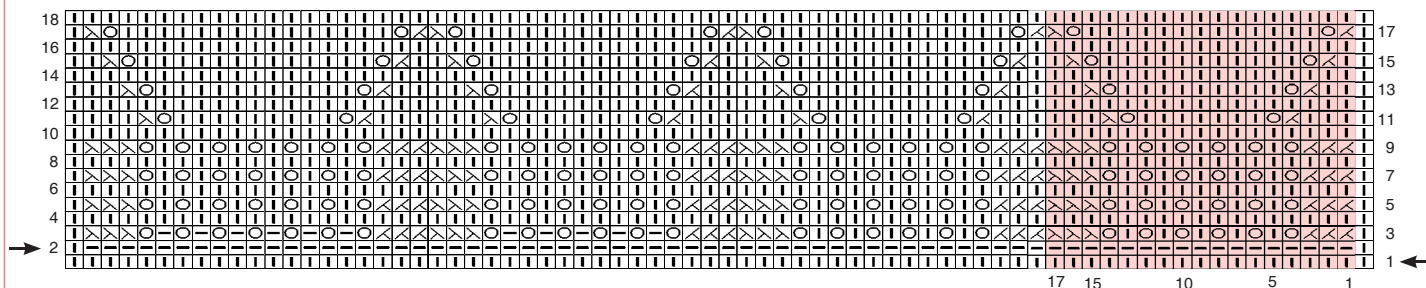
○ = yo

⊗ = SKP (RS): sl 1 knitwise, K1, then pass the slipped st over the K1

⌞ = vertical dble dec (RS): in a group of 3 sts, slip the first 2 sts as if to knit together, place the 1st of these 2 sts back on the left needle by passing behind the 2nd st. Knit the 1st and 3rd sts together, then pass the 2nd st over this new st

Direction ← = uneven rows → = even rows
