Easy Level



Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

21 sts and 34 rows to 10 cm measured over pattern stitch stripes using 3.5 mm needles

YARN	COLOR	34/36	38/40	42/44	46/48	50/52
P. CABOTINE	CRAIE	5	5	6	6	7
	INDIGO	1	2	2	2	2

Composition: 55% acrylic, 45% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:
1 pair each of 3 mm and 3.5 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)
Stitch markers
Yarn needle

Abbreviations and STITCHES:

St(s) = stitch(es)

RS = right side of your work

WS = wrong side of your work

K1 = knit 1 st

P1 = purl 1 st

K1/P1: K1, P1 to the end of the row. In the next row, work the sts as they are presented on the needle (i.e. K1 above a K1 or P1 above a P1 in the previous row)

Stockinette stitch (st st): knit 1 row (RS), then purl 1 row (WS)

Reverse stockinette stitch (rev st st): purl 1 row (RS), then knit 1 row (WS)

Pattern stitch stripes:

6 rows of st st in CRAIE, 1 row of st st in INDIGO, 1 row of rev st st in INDIGO, 2 rows of rev st st in CRAIE, 2 rows of rev st st in INDIGO, 2 rows of rev st st in CRAIE, 8 rows of st st in CRAIE, repeat the sequence in **bold** 5 more times, then end with st st in CRAIE

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and CRAIE, cast on 112 - 118 - 126 - 134 - 146 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 3.5 cm.

Step 2: Change to 3.5 mm needles and pattern st stripes (see STITCHES).

Step 3: When your work measures 29 cm from the beginning, place a stitch marker on each edge to indicate the armholes.

Step 4: When your work measures 48 - 49 - 50 - 51 - 52 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 14 - 14 - 14 - 16 - 16 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 7 sts twice.

Step 5: Bind off the remaining 35 - 38 - 42 - 45 - 51 sts for the shoulder.

Step 6: Finish the other side of the neck.

FRONT

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and CRAIE, cast on 112 - 118 - 126 - 134 - 146 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 3.5 cm.

Step 2: Change to 3.5 mm needles and pattern st stripes (see STITCHES).

Step 3: When your work measures 29 cm from the beginning, place a stitch marker on each edge to indicate the armholes.

Step 4: When your work measures 42 - 43 - 44 - 45 - 46 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 12 - 12 - 12 - 14 - 14 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st once, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times.

Step 5: Bind off the remaining 35 - 38 - 42 - 45 - 51 sts for the shoulder.

Step 6: Finish the other side of the neck.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and CRAIE, cast on 120 - 120 - 120 - 124 - 124 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2 cm.

Step 2: Loosely bind off all the sts.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the shoulder seams, following the green lines in the diagram.

Step 2: Sew the side seams up to the armholes, following the blue lines in the diagram.

Step 3: At each shoulder, fold the 8 sts (on the armhole edge) inwards and hold in place by sewing a single st.

Step 4: Lay the neckband flat and sew it around the neck.

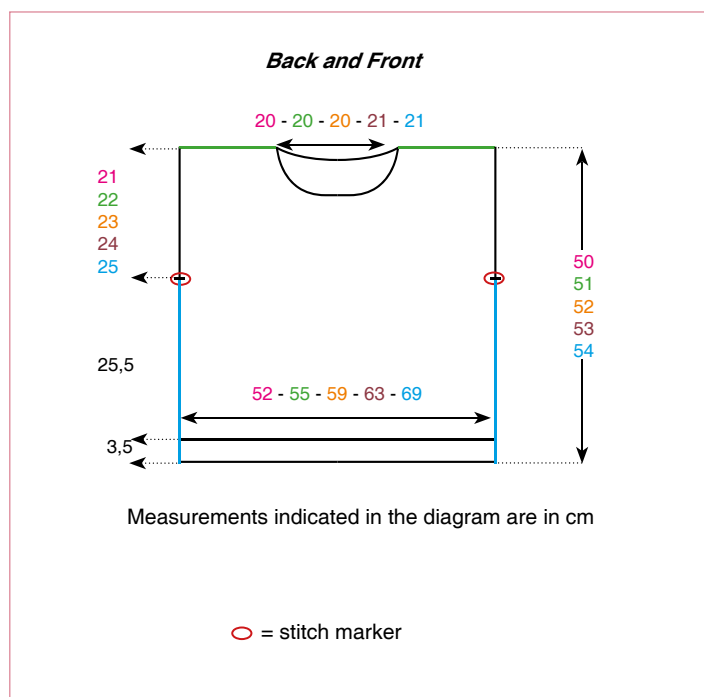


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
