Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

30 sts and 39 rows to 10 cm measured over pattern stitch using 3 mm needles

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P.SOFT COTTON	ECRU	8	9	10	10	11
P.COTON3	OUTREMER	1	1	1	1	1

Composition: 100% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:
1 pair each of 2.5 mm and 3 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)
3 x 9 mm pearlized buttons, ref: 055150
Yarn needle

STITCHES:

Pattern stitch: see chart
K1/P1 rib

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

LEG

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and OUTREMER, cast on 182 - 191 - 209 - 218 - 236 sts, then change to ECRU and work in pattern st (see chart), beginning with 1 selvage st and the 1st st in the chart.

Total: 20 - 21 - 23 - 24 - 26 motifs of 9 sts

Step 2: When your work measures 76 cm from the beginning, shape the inside leg. On each edge, bind off 6 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 6 times and 1 st 5 times, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times.

Total sts: 110 - 119 - 137 - 146 - 164 sts (12 - 13 - 15 - 16 - 18 motifs of 9 sts)

Step 3: When your work measures 99 - 100 - 101 - 102 - 103 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

Work the other leg in the same way.

WAISTBAND

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and ECRU, cast on 187 - 199 - 209 - 223 - 237 sts and work in K1/P1 rib, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2.

Step 2: When 2 rows have been worked, make a buttonhole as follows: work to the last 5 sts, yo, then K2tog, then work the last 3 sts.

Make 2 more buttonholes in the same way, at intervals of 2.5 cm

Step 3: When your work measures 8 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the seam to join the front and back (red and green lines in the diagram).

Step 2: Sew the legs (blue and orange lines in the diagram).

Step 3: Join the waistband, with the edges on the left side of the trousers.

Step 4: Sew the buttons.

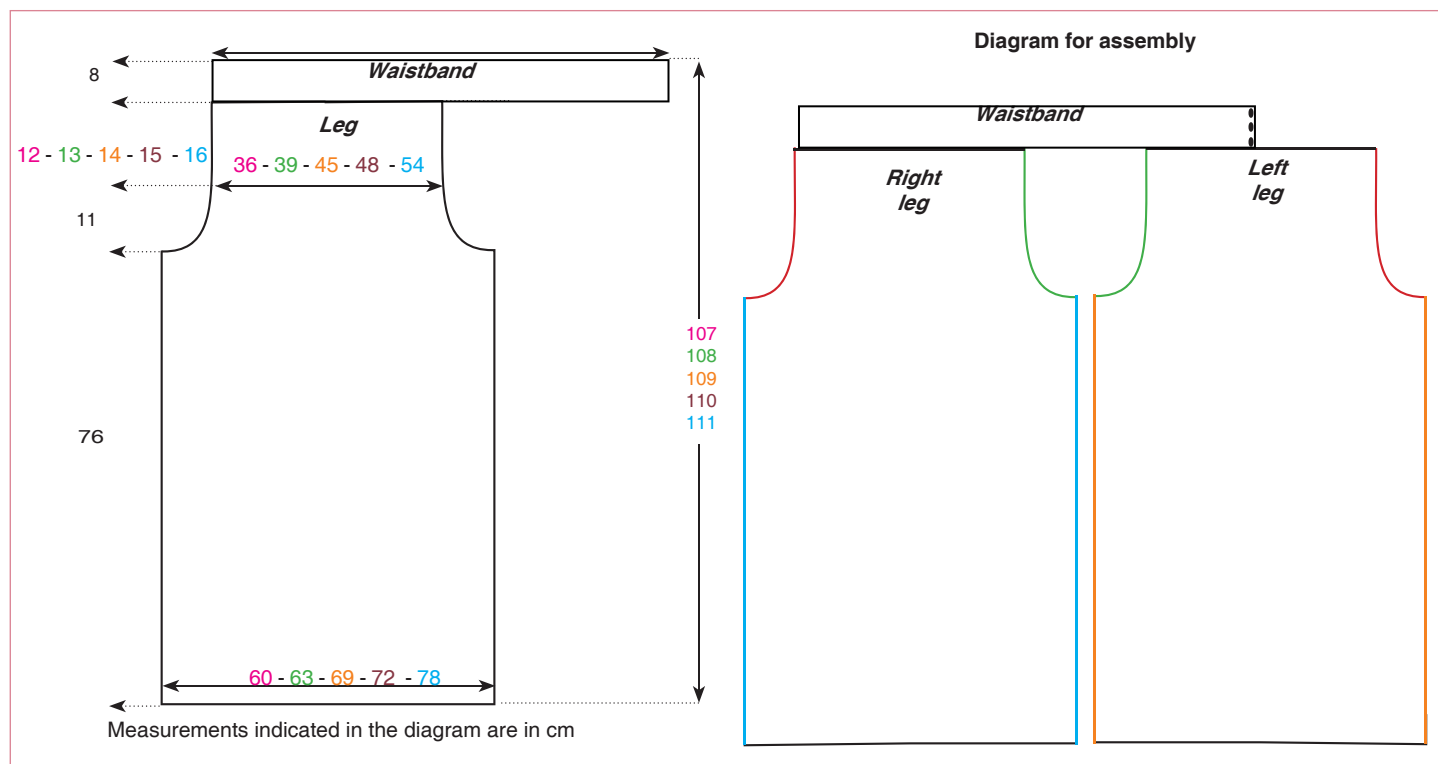
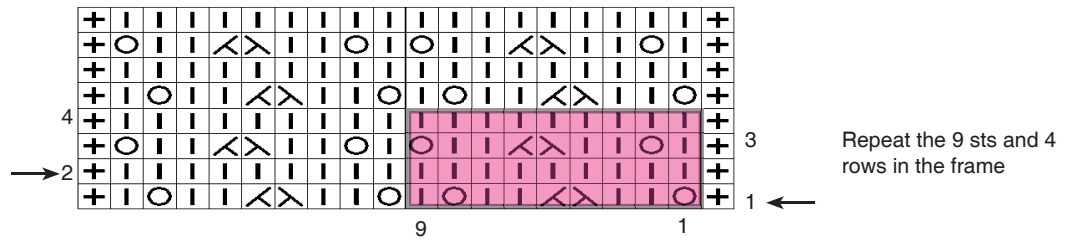


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Chart for pattern st



Direction ← = uneven rows → = even rows

⊕ = selvage st: work the 1st and last st as they would normally be worked for the st

⊥ = K1 (RS) or P1 (WS)

⊙ = yo

⊗ = SKP: sl 1 knitwise, K1, then pass the slipped st over the K1

⊞ = K2tog (RS)
