TENSION SQUARES

28 sts and 36 rows to 10 cm, measured over mesh stitch using P. Cabotine 3 and 3 mm needles

17 sts and 18 rows to 6 cm, measured over pattern stitch using 3 mm needles

Composition: 50% cotton, 43% acrylic, 7% polyamide

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

1 pair of 3 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension squares)

3 mm and 5 mm crochet hooks

Yarn needle

STITCHES:

Mesh stitch: work on a multiple of 3 + 1 + 1 st on each edge

Row 1: 1 selvage st, K1, **yo, slip 1 st knitwise (yarn behind the st), K2, pass the slipped st over the 2 knit sts**, repeat the sequence in **bold** and end with 1 selvage st

Rows 2 and 4: purl all the sts

Row 3: 1 selvage st, **slip 1 st knitwise (yarn behind the st), K2, pass the slipped st over the 2 knit sts, yo**, repeat the sequence in **bold** and end with K1 and 1 selvage st

Pattern stitch: see chart

Single crochet (sc): insert the hook in a st, yo and draw the yarn through the st, yo and draw the yarn through the 2 loops on the hook

Straight st embroidery: see diagram

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Worked in 2 sections:

1st section:

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and MASTIC, cast on 138 - 153 - 171 - 171 - 186 sts and work in mesh st (see STITCHES or the chart), beginning with 1 selvage st and the 1st st in the chart.

Step 2: When your work measures 25 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off:

5 sts once: 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice

5 sts once: 4 sts twice, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st twice

5 sts once: 4 sts 3 times, 3 sts 3 times, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 4 times

5 sts once: 4 sts 3 times, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 4 times

5 sts once: 4 sts 3 times, 3 sts 3 times, 2 sts 4 times and 1 st 5 times

Total sts: 96 - 99 - 99 - 105 - 108 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 43 - 44 - 45 - 46 - 47 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. On each edge, bind off:

5 sts 4 times

5 sts 3 times and 6 sts once

5 sts 3 times and 6 sts once

5 sts once and 6 sts 3 times

6 sts 4 times

At the same time as the 1st shoulder decrease, shape the neck. Bind off the center 20 - 21 - 21 - 23 - 24 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 9 sts twice.

2nd section: Edging

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles, cast on 138 - 155 - 172 - 172 - 189 sts and work in pattern st (see chart).

Step 2: When the 18 rows are finished, bind off all the sts.

FRONT

Worked in 2 sections:

1st section:

Repeat **steps 1 and 2** as for the Back.

Total sts: 96 - 99 - 99 - 105 - 108 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 37 - 38 - 39 - 40 - 41 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 18 - 19 - 19 - 21 - 22 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times.

Step 4: When your work measures 43 - 44 - 45 - 46 - 47 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the armhole edge, bind off:

4 sts once and 5 sts 3 times

5 sts 3 times and 6 sts once

5 sts 3 times and 6 sts once

5 sts once and 6 sts 3 times

6 sts 4 times

Step 5: Finish the other side of the neck.

2nd section: Edging

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles, cast on 138 - 155 - 172 - 172 - 189 sts and work in pattern st (see chart).

Step 2: When the 18 rows are finished, bind off all the sts.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles, cast on 99 - 105 - 111 - 114 - 123 sts and work in mesh st (see STITCHES or the chart), beginning with 1 selvage st and the 1st st in the chart.

Step 2: Decrease on each edge:

every 24 rows, dec 1 st 4 times, then every 22 rows, dec 1 st twice

every 24 rows, dec 1 st 4 times, then every 22 rows, dec 1 st twice

every 24 rows, dec 1 st 4 times, then every 22 rows, dec 1 st 2 twice

every 40 rows, dec 1 st 3 times

every 40 rows, dec 1 st 3 times

Total sts: 87 - 93 - 99 - 108 - 117 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 45 cm from the beginning, shape the slope. On each edge, bind off:

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st once, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 8 times, on the following rows, bind off 1 st once, 2 sts twice and 3 sts twice

4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts twice and 1 st once, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 8 times, on the following rows, bind off 1 st once, 2 sts once, 3 sts twice and 4 sts once

4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 6 times, on the following rows, bind off 1 st twice, 2 sts twice, 3 sts twice and 4 sts once

5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 7 times, on the following rows, bind off 1 st once, 2 sts once, 3 sts twice, 4 sts once and 5 sts once

5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts twice and 1 st once, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 6 times, on the following rows, bind off 1 st once, 2 sts 3 times, 3 sts twice, 4 sts once and 5 sts once

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Step 4: Bind off the remaining 21 - 21 - 21 - 22 - 21 sts.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the seam for the edging around the bottom of the Back and Front.

Step 2: Sew the seams for the shoulders, sides and sleeves.

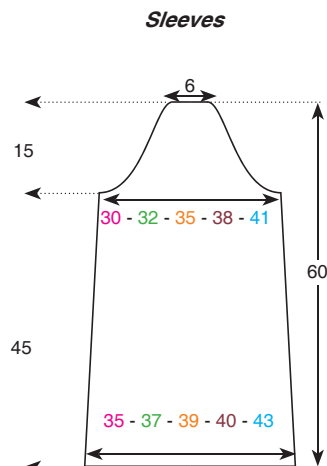
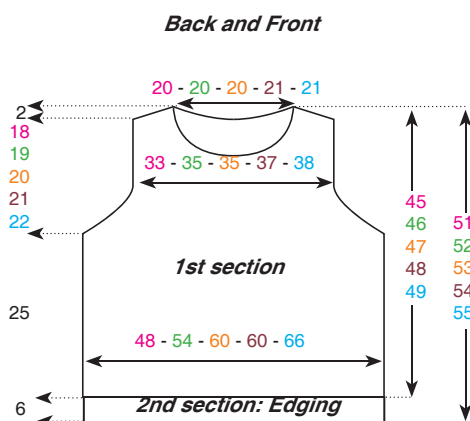
Step 3: Join the sleeves to the body.

Step 4: Using a 3 mm crochet hook and MASTIC, work 1 row of sc (see STITCHES) around the neck.

Step 5: Using BLEU KLEIN, embroider in straight st around the bottom of the body and sleeves, wrapping the yarn around the first 2 rows every 2 sts (see photo).

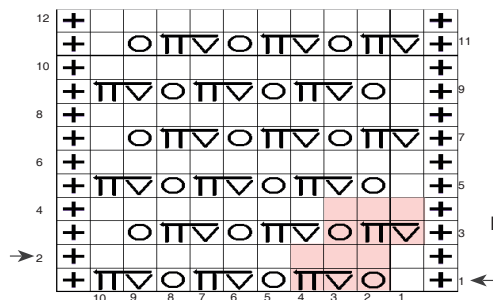
Step 6: Using a 5 mm crochet hook and BLEU KLEIN, make 19 chains (see diagram) as follows: 4 lengths of chain 47 sts, 2 lengths of chain 35 sts, 2 lengths of chain 53 sts, 2 lengths of chain 87 sts; 2 lengths of chain 70 sts, 2 lengths of chain 61 sts, 2 lengths of chain 45 sts, 2 lengths of chain 48 sts and 1 length of chain 51 sts.

Step 7: Sew these lengths of chain sts according to the diagram, using concealed stitching.

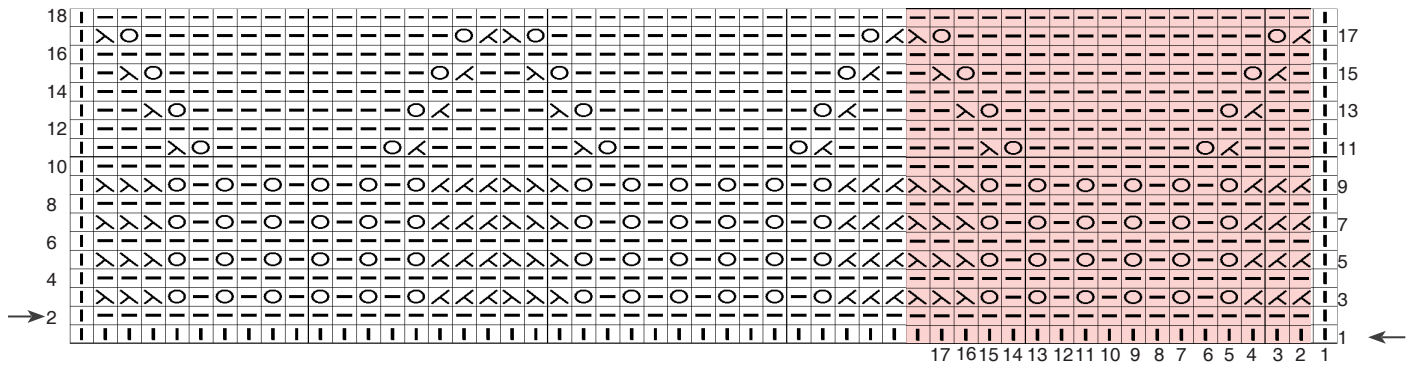
