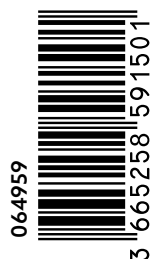

 Garter stitch
 K1/P1 rib
 Stockinette stitch
 Seed stitch

Intermediate level



Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

15 sts and 23 rows to 10 cm, measured over stockinette stitch using 6 mm needles

15 sts and 25 rows to 10 cm, measured over seed stitch using 5.5 mm needles

YARN	COLOR	2 yrs	4 yrs	6 yrs	8 yrs	10 yrs

Composition: 68% cotton, 32% polyamide

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

1 pair each of 6 mm and 5.5 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

Stitch markers

1 yarn needle

4 - 4 - 5 - 5 - 5 x 18 mm buttons, ref: 054579

STITCHES:

Garage stitch

K1/P1 rib

Stockinette stitch

Seed stitch: worked on an uneven number of sts

1st row: **K1, P1**, repeat the sequence in **bold**, end with K1

2nd row: as for the 1st row

These 2 rows form the stitch (i.e. invert the sts in each row)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 5.5 mm needles, cast on 51 - 57 - 61 - 63 - 69 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2 cm, beginning and ending the 1st row with P1.

Step 2: Change to 6 mm needles and work in stockinette st.

Step 3: When your work measures 22 - 24 - 26 - 28 - 31 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off 2 sts twice and 1 st once.

Total sts: 41 - 47 - 51 - 53 - 59 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 27 - 31 - 35 - 38 - 42 cm from the beginning, work 4 rows of garter st.

Step 5: Change to 5.5 mm needles and finish in seed st (see STITCHES).

Step 6: When your work measures 36 - 40 - 44 - 47 - 51 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. On each edge, bind off:

3 sts twice and 4 sts once

4 sts 3 times

4 sts twice and 5 sts once

4 sts twice and 5 sts once

5 sts twice and 6 sts once

At the same time as the 1st shoulder decrease, shape the neck. Bind off the center 11 - 13 - 15 - 17 - 17 sts, then finish on 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 5 sts once.

RIGHT FRONT

Step 1: Using 5.5 mm needles, cast on 24 - 26 - 28 - 30 - 32 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2 cm, beginning the 1st row with K2 and ending with K1.

Step 2: Change to 6 mm needles and work in stockinette st; increase 1 - 1 - 1 st at the end of the 1st row.

Total sts: 24 - 27 - 29 - 30 - 33 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 22 - 24 - 26 - 28 - 31 cm from the beginning, shape the armhole. On the left edge, bind off 2 sts twice and 1 st once.

Total sts: 19 - 22 - 24 - 25 - 28 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 27 - 31 - 35 - 38 - 42 cm from the beginning, work 4 rows of garter st.

Step 5: Change to 5.5 mm needles and finish in seed st (see STITCHES).

Step 6: When your work measures 34 - 38 - 41 - 44 - 48 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. On the right edge, bind off:

4 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st once

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st once

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st once

Step 7: When your work measures 36 - 40 - 44 - 47 - 51 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the left edge, bind off:

3 sts twice and 4 sts once

4 sts 3 times

4 sts twice and 5 sts once

4 sts twice and 5 sts once

5 sts twice and 6 sts once

Work the Left Front, reversing all shaping.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 5.5 mm needles, cast on 34 - 36 - 38 - 40 - 42 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 3.5 cm.

Step 2: Change to 6 mm needles and work in stockinette st.

Step 3: Increase on each edge:

every 10 rows, inc 1 st once and every 8 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 5 times and every 6 rows, inc 1 st once

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 4 times and every 6 rows, inc 1 st 4 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 6 times and every 6 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 9 times

Total sts: 42 - 48 - 54 - 58 - 60 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 21.5 - 26 - 30.5 - 34.5 - 38 cm from the beginning, shape the slope. On each edge, bind off:

3 sts once, 2 sts 3 times, 3 sts once and 4 sts once

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice, 3 sts once and 5 sts once

4 sts once, 3 sts 3 times, 4 sts once and 5 sts once

5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 4 sts once and 5 sts once

5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 4 sts twice and 5 sts once

Step 5: Bind off the remaining 10 sts.

Work the other sleeve in the same way.

BUTTON BANDS

Step 1: Using 5.5 mm needles, cast on 61 - 69 - 75 - 79 - 87 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 3 cm, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2

Step 2: Knit 1 row (RS), then several rows of stockinette st in yarn of a different color.

Step 3: Make another band in the same way, but in the 3rd row, make 4 - 4 - 5 - 5 - 5 buttonholes (1 yo, K2tog). Make the 1st buttonhole 8 - 10 - 6 - 6 - 10 sts from the edge and the other buttonholes at intervals of 14 - 16 - 14 - 15 - 17 sts.

Step 4: Bind off all the sts.

Make a second pocket in the same way.

COLLAR

Step 1: Using 5.5 mm needles, cast on 59 - 63 - 69 - 73 - 73 sts and work in K1/P1 rib, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2.

Step 2: When your work measures 7 cm from the beginning, bind off on each edge. Bind off:

19 sts once and 5 sts once

20 sts once and 5 sts once

22 sts once and 5 sts once

22 sts once and 6 sts once

22 sts once and 6 sts once

Step 3: Bind off the remaining 11 - 13 - 15 - 17 - 17 sts.

POCKETS

Step 1: Using 5.5 mm needles, cast on 17 - 19 - 19 - 21 - 21 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2.

Step 2: Change to 6 mm needles and work 4 rows in garter st.

Step 3: Work in stockinette st until your work measures 11 - 12 - 12 - 13.5 - 13.5 cm from the beginning.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the shoulder seams.

Step 2: Sew the side seams.

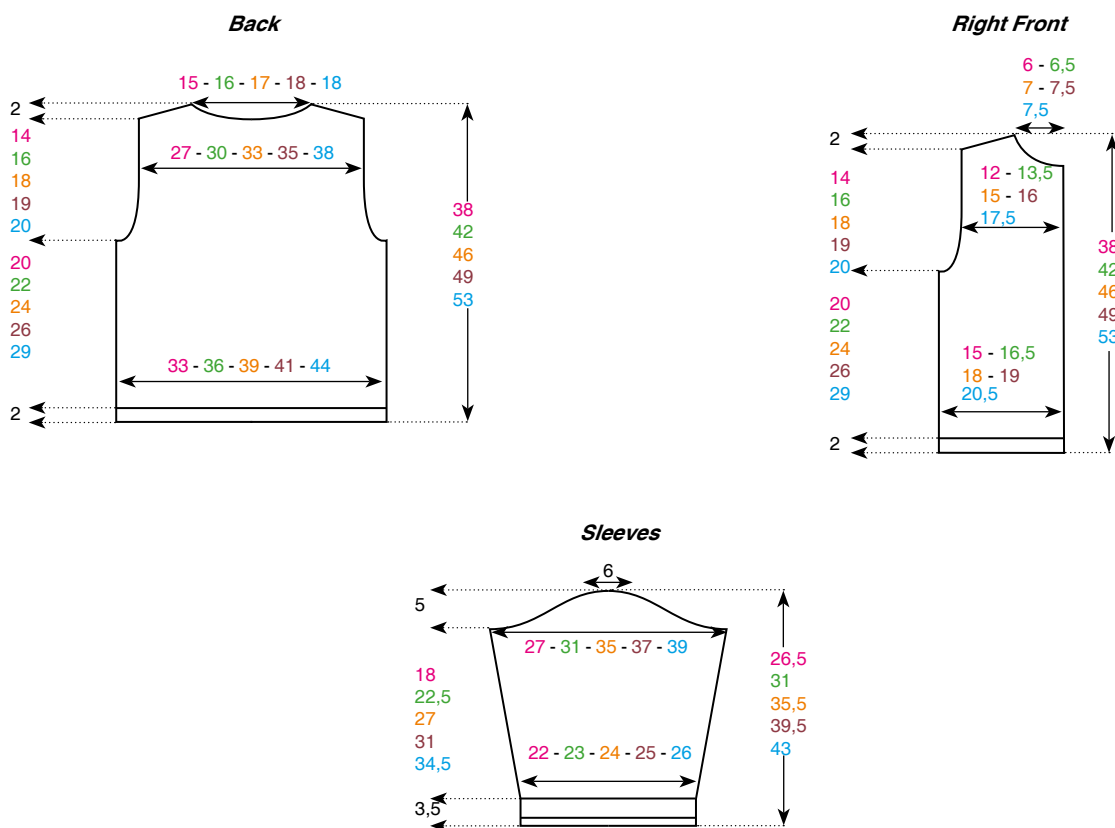
Step 3: Sew the seams for the sleeves and join them to the body.

Step 4: Sew the button bands along the front sections.

Step 5: Sew the buttons opposite the buttonholes.

Step 6: Sew the collar around the neck, positioning the edges midway across the button bands.

Step 7: Sew the pockets 3.5 cm from the bottom and 2.5 cm from the button band.



Measurements indicated in the diagrams are in cm
