Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

21 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm, measured over stockinette stitch stripes using 4.5 mm needles

Composition: 85% baby alpaca, 11% cotton, 4% polyamide

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

1 pair each of 4 mm and 4.5 mm knitting needle (or other, depending on your tension square)

Stitch markers

1 yarn needle

STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

Stockinette stitch stripes

Back and Front stripes:

6 - 8 - 8 - 8 - 8 rows in VERMILLON - 6 - 8 - 8 - 8 - 8 rows in GUIMAUVE, repeat these 12 - 16 - 16 - 16 - 16 rows 6 - 5 - 6 - 6 - 7 more times, then end in GUIMAUVE

Sleeve stripes:

6 - 8 - 8 - 8 - 8 rows in GUIMAUVE - 6 - 8 - 8 - 8 - 8 rows in VERMILLON, repeat these 12 - 16 - 16 - 16 - 16 rows.

Stem stitch and straight stitch embroidery: see diagram

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles and VERMILLON, cast on 66 - 72 - 78 - 82 - 88 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 1.5 cm.

Step 2: Change to stockinette st stripes (see STITCHES) and increase 1 st at the beginning of the row.

Total sts: 67 - 73 - 79 - 83 - 89 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 23 - 25 - 27 - 29 - 32 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off 6 sts once.

Total sts: 55 - 61 - 67 - 71 - 77 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 33 - 37 - 41 - 44 - 48 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 9 - 11 - 13 - 15 - 15 sts, then continue on 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 5 sts twice.

Step 5: When your work measures 35 - 39 - 43 - 46 - 50 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. Bind off the remaining 13 - 15 - 17 - 18 - 21 sts.

Step 6: Finish the other side of the neck.

FRONT

Work in the same way as for the Back, repeating steps 1 to 3. Total sts: 53 - 59 - 65 - 69 - 77 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 30 - 34 - 37 - 40 - 44 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 9 - 11 - 13 - 15 - 15 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 4 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once, then 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once.

Step 5: When your work measures 35 - 39 - 43 - 46 - 50 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders by binding off the remaining 13 - 15 - 17 - 18 - 21 sts.

Step 6: Finish the other side of the neck.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles and GUIMAUVE, cast on 44 - 46 - 48 - 50 - 52 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 1.5 cm, then work 6 rows in garter st.

Step 2: Change to 4.5 mm needles and stockinette st stripes (see STITCHES); increase 1 st at the beginning of the row.

Total sts: 45 - 47 - 49 - 51 - 53 sts

Step 3: Increase on each edge:

every 16 rows, inc 1 st twice and 14 rows higher, inc 1 st once
12 rows higher, inc 1 st once and every 10 rows, inc 1 st 5 times
every 10 rows, inc 1 st 3 times and every 8 rows, inc 1 st 6 times
every 10 rows, inc 1 st 4 times and every 8 rows, inc 1 st 6 times
every 10 rows, inc 1 st 5 times and every 8 rows, inc 1 st 6 times

Total sts: 51 - 59 - 67 - 71 - 75 sts

Step 4: Continue until your work measures 24.5 - 29 - 33.5 - 37.5 - 41 cm. Place a marker on each edge (to indicate where to join to the body), then continue straight.

Step 5: When your work measures 27.5 - 32 - 36.5 - 40.5 - 44 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

Locate the center of the sleeve and place a marker on the st (point M).

Work the other sleeve in the same way.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles and GUIMAUVE, cast on 86 - 90 - 96 - 100 - 100 sts.

Step 2: Work in K1/P1 rib for 1.5 cm, then work 6 rows of garter st.

Step 3: When your work measures 3 cm from the beginning, work several rows of stockinette st with yarn of a different color.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Using EUCALYPTUS, embroider the heart on the front, with the outline in stem st and the inside in straight st (see photo and diagram)

Step 2: Place the Back and Front together with right sides facing and sew the shoulder seams, using backstitch and following the green lines in the diagrams.

Step 3: Place a sleeve between the Back and Front, with the right sides showing. Position point M on the sleeve to point M on the shoulder seam.

Join the sleeve to the body, using backstitch and following the red lines in the diagram. Join the other sleeve in the same way.

Step 6: Sew the neckband, matching the sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work.
