TENSION SQUARE

23 sts and 40 rows to 10 cm, measured over stockinette stitch and garter stitch using 2.5 mm needles

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P. SOFT COTTON	OUTREMER	1	1	1	1	1

Composition: 100% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

1 pair of 2.5 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

Stitch markers

1 French knitter, ref: 070117

1 yarn needle

Abbreviations and STITCHES:

St(s) = stitch(es)

RS = endroit

WS = envers

K1 = knit 1 st

P1 = purl 1 st

K1/P1 rib: K1 then P1 alternately to the end of the row. In the following rows, work the sts as they are presented on the needle (i.e. K1 above a knit st and P1 above a purl st).

Stockinette stitch: alternate with knit 1 row, purl 1 row

Garter stitch: knit every row

Stripes:

10 rows of stockinette stitch using EMERAUDE

8 rows of garter stitch using MENTHOL

Repeat the instructions in **bold** (i.e. total of 18 rows)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

NStep 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and EMERAUDE, cast on 78 - 86 - 92 - 96 - 104 sts and work in K1/P1 rib (see STITCHES) for 2 cm.

Step 2: Change to stockinette st and garter st, according to the instructions for the stripes (see STITCHES).

Step 3: When your work measures 35 - 39 - 43 - 46 - 50 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts. Then place a marker after the 23 - 26 - 28 - 28 - 32 st from each edge (to indicate the end of the shoulder seam).

Step 4: Place another stitch marker on each edge 23 - 25 - 27 - 29 - 32 cm from the beginning (to indicate the armholes).

FRONT

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and EMERAUDE, cast on 78 - 86 - 92 - 96 - 104 sts and work in K1/P1 rib (see STITCHES) for 2 cm.

Step 2: Change to stockinette st and garter st, according to the instructions for the stripes (see STITCHES).

Step 3: When your work measures 30 - 34 - 37 - 40 - 44 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 10 - 12 - 12 - 14 - 14 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off:

4 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice
4 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice
4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

Step 4: When your work measures 35 - 39 - 43 - 46 - 50 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 23 - 26 - 28 - 28 - 32 sts.

Step 5: Finish the other side of the neck.

Step 6: Place a stitch marke on each edge 23 - 25 - 27 - 29 - 32 cm from the beginning (to indicate the armholes).

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and EMERAUDE, cast on 48 - 50 - 52 - 54 - 58 sts and work in K1/P1 rib (see STITCHES) for 2 cm.

Step 2: Change to stockinette st and garter st, according to the instructions for the stripes (see STITCHES).

Step 3: Increase 1 st at the beginning and end of the following rows:

21st, 41st and 61st rows

15th, 29th, 41st, 53rd, 65th, 77th and 89th rows

11th, 21st, 31st, 41st, 51st, 61st, 71st, 81st, 91st, 101st and 111th rows

13th, 25th, 35th, 45th, 55th, 65th, 75th, 85th, 95th, 105th, 115th and 125th rows

13th, 25th, 37th, 49th, 61st, 73rd, 85th, 97th, 109th, 119th, 129th and 139th rows

Total sts: 54 - 64 - 74 - 78 - 82 sts

Step 4: Continue straight until your work measures 22.5 - 27 - 31.5 - 35.5 - 39 cm. Then bind off all the sts.

Locate the center of the sleeve and place a marker on this st (point M).

Work the other sleeve in the same way.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and a double strand of OUTREMER, cast on 94 - 100 - 108 - 114 - 114 sts.

Step 2: Work in K1/P1 rib for 1.5 cm.

Step 3: Bind off all the sts.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Place the Front and the Back together with the right sides facing; sew the shoulder seams up to the markers, using backstitch and following the green lines in the diagram.

Step 2: Place a sleeve between the 2 stitch markers on the Back and Front. Place the right side of the sleeve to the right side of the body. Place point M for the sleeve to point M for the shoulder seam. Join the sleeve using backstitch and following the red lines in the diagram. Join the other sleeve in the same way.

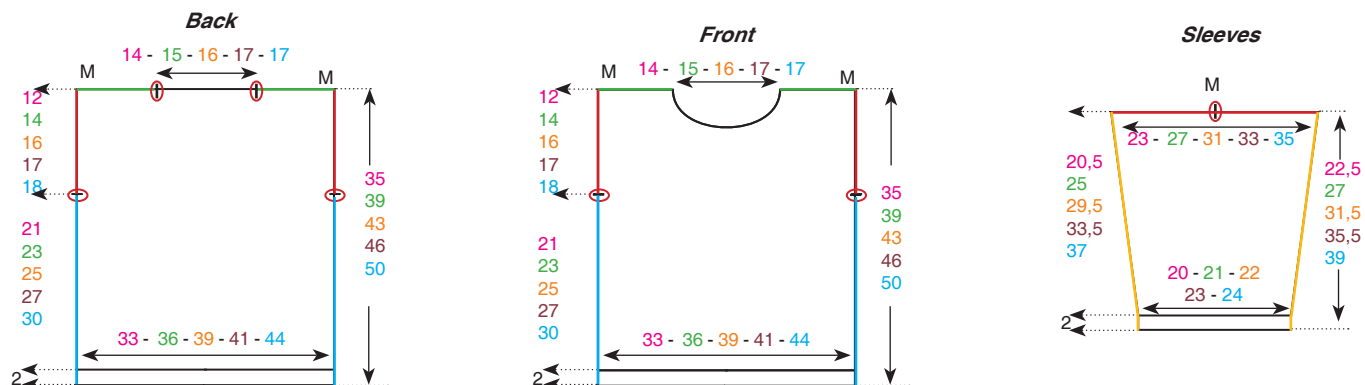
Step 3: Sew the side seams using concealed stitching and following the blue lines in the diagram.

Step 4: Sew the sleeve seams in the same way, following the yellow lines in the diagram.

Step 5: Sew the neckband using backstitch.

Step 6: Using OUTREMER, make 4 French knitter cords. Make the 1st cord 29 cm long (green lettering), the 2nd cord 16 cm long (pink lettering), the 3rd cord 5 cm long (blue lettering) and the 4th cord 1 cm long (red lettering).

Step 7: Sew the cords on the Front using concealed stitching; center the lettering and follow the “ciao” diagram (see photo).
