Easy Level



Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

25 sts and 42 rows to 10 cm, measured over seed stitch using 3 mm needles

YARN	COLOR	2 yrs	4 yrs	6 yrs	8 yrs	10 yrs
P.SOFT COTTON	JAUNE D'OR ou DAUPHIN	3	4	5	5	6

Composition: 100% cotton

MATERIALS:

1 pair each of 2.5 mm and 3 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)
3 x 14 mm light wood buttons, ref: 054 600
Stitch markers

STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

Seed stitch: worked on an uneven number of sts

1st row (RS): K1, P1, repeat the sequence in **bold**, end with K1

2nd row: as for the 1st row

These 2 rows form the pattern (i.e. invert the sts in each row)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 80 - 88 - 94 - 100 - 108 sts.

Step 2: Work in K1/P1 rib (i.e. alternate K1 and P1 to the end of the row).

In the following rows, work the sts as they are presented on the needle (i.e. K1 above a knit st and P1 above a purl st).

Work in K1/P1 rib until your work measures 3 cm.

Step 3: Change to 3 mm needles and seed st (see STITCHES). **IMPORTANT:** decrease 1 st (K2tog) at the end of the 1st row.

Continue in seed st on the remaining 79 - 87 - 93 - 99 - 107 sts until your work measures 24 - 26 - 28 - 30 - 33 cm from the beginning.

Step 4: Shape the armholes as follows: bind off the first 7 sts, then work to the end of the row.

In the following row, bind off the first 7 sts, then work to the end of the row.
Total sts: 65 - 73 - 79 - 85 - 93 sts

Continue in seed st until your work measures 36 - 40 - 46 - 47 - 51 cm from the beginning.

Step 5: Bind off all the sts, then place a marker after the 16th - 19th - 21st - 23rd - 27th st from each edge (to indicate the end of the shoulder seam).

FRONT

Repeat steps 1, 2 and 3 as for the Back.

Continue until your work measures 24 - 26 - 28 - 30 - 33 cm from the beginning.

Step 4: Shape the armholes and form the opening as follows: bind off the first 7 sts, work the following 31 - 35 - 38 - 41 - 45 sts, bind off the next 3 sts, then work to the end of the row.

In the following row, bind off the first 7 sts, then work to the end of the row.

Step 5: Continue on the 31 - 35 - 38 - 41 - 45 sts on the left until your work measures 32 - 36 - 39 - 42 - 46 cm from the beginning.

Step 6: Shape the neck:

Bind off the first 4 sts, then work to the end of the row

Work 1 row

In the following row, bind off the first 4 sts, then work to the end of the row

Work 1 row

In the following row, bind off the first 3 sts, then work to the end of the row

Work 1 row

In the following row, bind off the first 2 sts, then work to the end of the row

Work 1 row

In the following row, bind off 1 st, then work to the end of the row

Work 3 rows

In the following row, bind off 1 st, then work to the end of the row

Bind off the first 5 sts, then work to the end of the row

Step 7: Bind off all the sts.

Step 8: Pick up the sts on the other side of the neck (right side) and work seed st until your work measures 32 - 36 - 39 - 42 - 46 cm from the beginning.

Step 9: Bind off all the sts.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 50 - 54 - 56 - 58 - 60 sts.

Step 2: Work in K1/P1 rib as explained above, until your work measures 3 cm from the beginning.

Step 3: Change to 3 mm needles and seed st as explained above, decreasing 1 st at the end of the 1st row (K2tog on the last 2 sts).

Total sts: 49 - 53 - 55 - 57 - 59 sts

Step 4: Increase 1 st at the beginning and end of the following rows:

17th, 33rd, 49th, 63rd and 77th rows

13th, 25th, 37th, 49th, 61st, 73rd, 85th and 97th rows

11th, 21st, 31st, 41st, 51st, 61st, 71st, 81st, 91st, 101st, 111th and 121st rows

11th, 21st, 31st, 41st, 51st, 61st, 71st, 81st, 91st, 101st, 111th, 121st, 129th and 137th rows

11th, 21st, 31st, 41st, 51st, 61st, 71st, 81st, 91st, 101st, 111th, 121st, 131st, 141st and 151st rows

Total sts: 59 - 69 - 79 - 85 - 89 sts

Continue in seed st until your work measures 24.5 - 29 - 33.5 - 37.5 - 41 cm. Place a stitch marker on each edge.

Step 5: Continue straight until your work measures 27.5 - 32 - 36.5 - 40.5 - 44 cm from the beginning.

Bind off all the sts.

Locate the center of the sleeve and place a stitch marker (point M).

Make the other sleeve in the same way.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 85 - 89 - 95 - 101 - 101 sts.

Step 2: Work in K1/P1 rib as explained above, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2.

Continue until your work measures 1.5 cm.

Step 3: Bind off all the sts as they are presented on the needle (i.e. bind off knit sts knitwise and purl sts purlwise).

BUTTON BANDS

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 35 - 39 - 43 - 47 - 51 sts.

Step 2: Work in K1/P1 rib as explained above, until your work measures 1.5 cm from the beginning.

Step 3: Bind off all the sts as they are presented on the needle (i.e. bind off knit sts knitwise and purl sts purlwise).

Step 4: Work the other band in the same way, but make 3 buttonholes in the 3rd row as follows:

work 8 sts, yo, K2tog, **knit 8 - 10 - 12 - 14 - 16 sts, yo, K2tog**, repeat the sequence in **bold** 1 more time, then work the last 5 sts.

Step 5: Bind off all the sts as they are presented on the needle.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Place the Back and Front together with right sides facing and sew the shoulder seams using backstitch and following the green lines in the diagram.

Step 2: Place a sleeve between the Back and Front, with the right sides showing.

Position point M on the sleeve to point M on the shoulder seam.

Join the sleeve using backstitch and following the red lines in the diagram.

Then join the other sleeve in the same way.

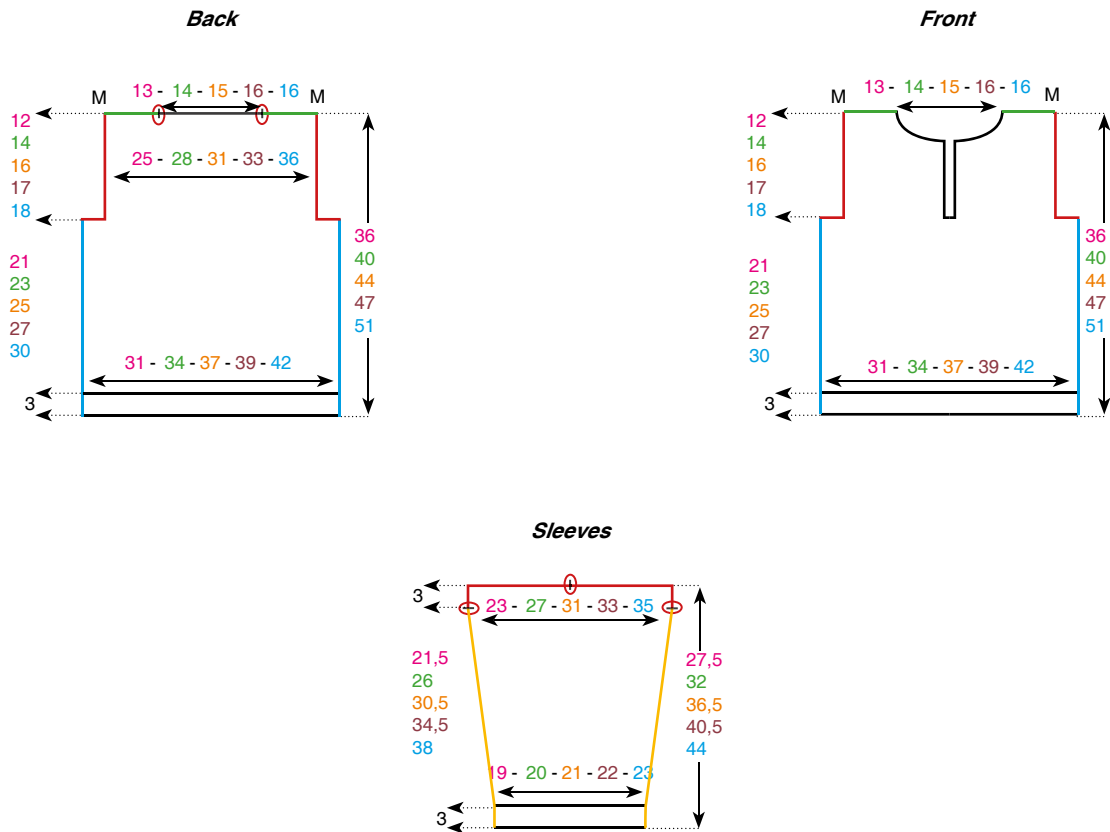
Step 3: Sew the side seams using backstitch and following the blue lines in the diagram.

Step 4: Sew the sleeve seams in the same way, following the yellow lines in the diagram.

Step 5: Lay your work flat and sew the neckband around the neck.

Overlap the bands at the bottom and hold in place with concealed stitching.

Step 6: With your work flat, sew the button bands along the opening and up the neckband.



Measurements indicated in the diagrams are in cm

○ = stitch marker

M = center sleeve and shoulder seam
