19 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm, measured over pattern stitch using 4 mm needles

| P. COTON 4 | JAUNE D'OR | 5     | 6     | 7     | 8     | 9      |

Composition: 100% cotton

#### MATERIALS:

1 pair each of 3.5 mm and 4 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

Stitch markers

1 yarn needle

4 - 4 - 4 - 5 - 5 x 9 mm buttons color OR, ref: 070225

#### STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

Stockinette stitch

Pattern stitch (see chart)

## INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

### BACK

**Step 1:** Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 73 - 79 - 85 - 91 - 97 sts and work 2 rows in K1/P1 rib.

**Step 2:** Change to 4 mm needles and work 2 rows in stockinette st; evenly decrease 11 - 11 - 11 - 13 - 13 sts in the 1<sup>st</sup> row.

Total sts: 62 - 68 - 74 - 78 - 84 sts

**Step 3:** Change to pattern st (see chart), beginning with the 4<sup>th</sup> - 1<sup>st</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> - 1<sup>st</sup> st in the chart. Important: only work a yo if it is compensated for by a decrease, and vice versa.

**Step 4:** When your work measures 17 - 19 - 21 - 23 - 26 cm from the beginning, place a marker on each selvage st (to indicate the armholes).

**Step 5:** When your work measures 29 - 33 - 37 - 40 - 44 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. On each edge, bind off:

4 sts twice and 5 sts twice

5 sts 4 times

5 sts twice and 6 sts twice

5 sts once and 6 sts 3 times

6 sts twice and 7 sts twice

**At the same time as the 1<sup>st</sup> shoulder decrease,** shape the neck. Bind off the center 10 - 12 - 14 - 16 - 16 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 4 sts twice.

Finish the other side of the neck.

### RIGHT FRONT

**Step 1:** Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 35 - 37 - 41 - 43 - 47 sts and work 2 rows in K1/P1 rib, beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> row with K2.

**Step 2:** Change to 4 mm needles and work 2 rows in stockinette st; evenly decrease 5 - 4 - 5 - 5 - 6 sts in the 1<sup>st</sup> row.

Total sts: 30 - 33 - 36 - 38 - 41 sts

**Step 3:** Change to pattern st (see chart), beginning with the 1<sup>st</sup> st in the chart.

**Step 4:** When your work measures 17 - 19 - 21 - 23 - 26 cm from the beginning, place a marker on the selvage st on the left (to indicate the armhole).

**Step 5:** When your work measures 19 - 23 - 26 - 29 - 33 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. On the right edge, bind off:

1 st once then, 2 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 4 more times, then 2 rows higher, bind off 1 st once

1 st once then, every 2 rows, bind off 1 st twice, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 3 more times

1 st once then, every 2 rows, bind off 1 st twice, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 3 more times, then 2 rows higher, bind off 1 st once

1 st once then, every 2 rows, bind off 1 st 6 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 1 more time

1 st once then, every 2 rows, bind off 1 st 6 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, repeat the sequence in bold 1 more time

**Step 6:** When your work measures 29 - 33 - 37 - 40 - 44 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the armhole edge, bind off:

4 sts twice and 5 sts twice

5 sts 4 times

5 sts twice and 6 sts twice

5 sts once and 6 sts 3 times

6 sts twice and 7 sts twice

Work the Left Front, reversing all shaping and beginning the pattern st as for the Back.

### SLEEVES

**Step 1:** Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 52 - 54 - 56 - 58 - 60 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm; then place a marker on each selvage st (to indicate the turnback) and continue in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm.

**Step 2:** Change to 4 mm needles and work 2 rows in stockinette st; evenly decrease 6 - 6 - 6 - 6 - 6 sts in the 1<sup>st</sup> row.

Total sts: 46 - 48 - 50 - 52 - 54 sts

**Step 3:** Change to pattern st (see chart), beginning with the 8<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup> - 6<sup>th</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> in the chart.

Continue straight

Increase on each edge, keeping the pattern st correct:

every 6 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

every 6 rows, inc 1 st twice and every 4 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

every 6 rows, inc 1 st 3 times and every 4 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

every 6 rows, inc 1 st 3 times and every 4 rows, inc 1 st 4 times

Total sts: 46 - 54 - 60 - 64 - 68 sts

**Step 4:** When your work measures 10.5 - 13 - 15 - 17 - 18.5 cm from the beginning (including the turnback), bind off all the sts.

Work the other sleeve in the same way.

### BUTTON BANDS AND NECKBAND

**Step 1:** Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 95 - 109 - 119 - 129 - 141 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm, beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> row with K2 and ending with P1; then knit 1 row (RS) and work several rows in stockinette st using yarn of a different color.

**Step 2:** Work another band; reverse the shaping, begin with P1 and end with K2.

**Step 3:** In the 2<sup>nd</sup> row, make 4 - 4 - 4 - 5 - 5 buttonholes (1 yo, then work 2 sts tog). Make the 1<sup>st</sup> buttonhole 5 - 3 - 3 - 3 - 3 sts from the edge and the following buttonholes at intervals of 10 - 14 - 16 - 14 - 16 sts.

When your work measures 2.5 cm from the beginning, knit 1 row (RS), then work several rows of stockinette st in yarn of a different color.

### MAKE UP

**Step 1:** Sew the shoulder seams.

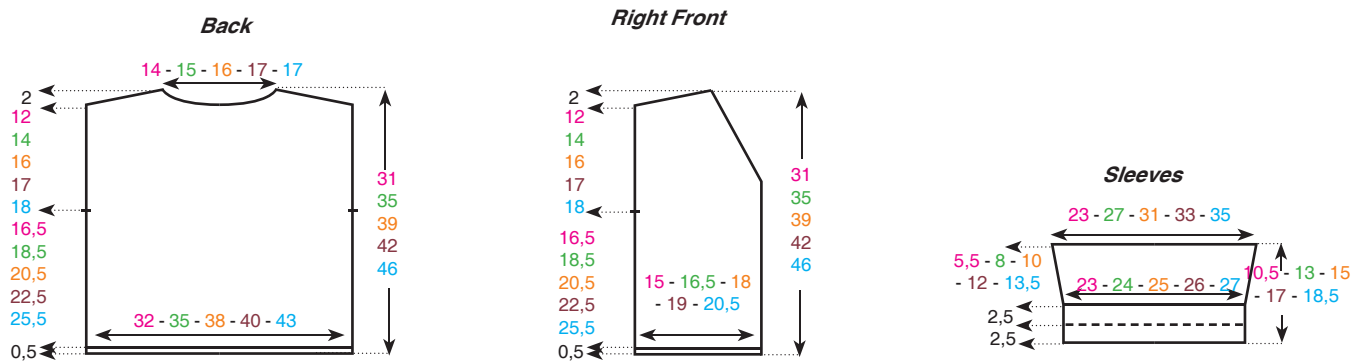
**Step 2:** Sew the sleeve seams between the 2 stitch markers on the Back and Front sections.

**Step 3:** Sew the side seams.

**Step 4:** Sew the lower sleeve seams, reversing the seam over 2.5 cm for the turnback.

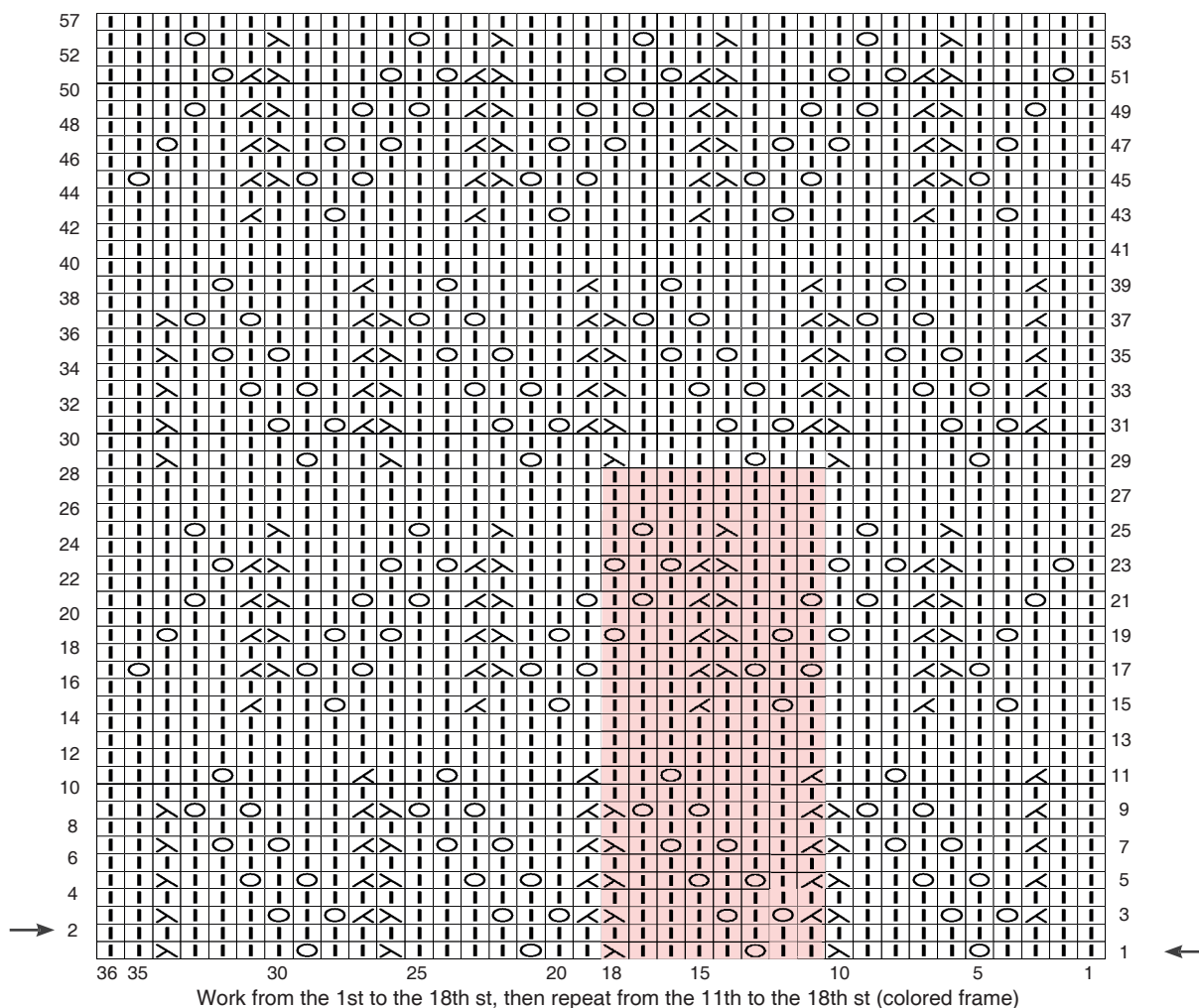
**Step 5:** Sew the button bands and neckband, matching sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work.

**Step 6:** Sew the buttons.
