Intermediate level



Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

22 sts and 32 rows to 10 cm, measured over fishnet stitch using 3.5 mm needles

YARN	COLOR	2 yrs	4 yrs	6 yrs	8 yrs	10 yrs
P. COTON 4	PAPAYE	6	7	8	9	11

Composition: 100% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

1 pair of 3.5 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

1 yarn needle

4 - 4 - 5 - 5 - 5 x 14 mm buttons, ref: 054579

STITCHES:

Seed stitch

1st row: K1, P1, repeat the sequence in **bold**, then end with K1

2nd row: as for the 1st row

These 2 rows form the stitch (i.e. invert the sts in each row)

Fishnet stitch (see chart): work on a multiple of 3 sts

1st row: 1 selvage st, K1, **1 yo, sl1 knitwise (yarn behind the st), K2, pass the slipped st over the 2 knit sts**, repeat the sequence in **bold** and end with 1 selvage st

2nd and 4th rows: purl all the sts

3rd row: 1 selvage st, **sl1 knitwise (yarn behind the st), K2, pass the slipped st over the 2 knit sts, 1 yo**, repeat the sequence in **bold** and end with K1 and 1 selvage st

K1/P1 rib

Stockinette stitch

Single decrease:

On the right: SKP (sl1 knitwise, K1, then pass the slipped st over the K1)

On the left: K2tog

Double decrease:

On the right: SK2P (sl1 knitwise, K2tog, then pass the slipped st over the knit stitch)

On the left: K3tog

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 72 - 78 - 84 - 90 - 96 sts and work in fishnet st (see STITCHES and chart).

Step 2: When your work measures 22 - 24 - 26 - 28 - 31 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off 2 sts twice and 1 st twice.

Total sts: 60 - 66 - 72 - 78 - 84 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 35 - 39 - 43 - 46 - 50 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. On each edge, bind off:

4 sts twice and 5 sts twice

5 sts 4 times

5 sts twice and 6 sts twice

6 sts 4 times

6 sts once and 7 sts 3 times

At the same time as the 1st shoulder decrease, shape the neck. Bind off the center 6 - 8 - 10 - 12 - 12 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 5 sts once et 4 sts once.

RIGHT FRONT

Step 1: Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 42 - 45 - 48 - 51 - 54 sts and work in fishnet st (see STITCHES and chart).

Step 2: When your work measures 22 - 24 - 26 - 28 - 31 cm from the beginning, shape the armhole. On the left edge, bind off 2 sts twice and 1 st twice.

Total sts: 36 - 39 - 42 - 45 - 48 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 27 - 31 - 34 - 37 - 41 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. On the right edge:

1 dble dec once, then every 2 rows, 1 sgle dec 7 times, 1 dble dec once and 1 sgle dec 7 times

1 sgle dec once, then every 2 rows, 1 dble dec once and 1 sgle dec 4 times, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times

1 sgle dec once, then every 2 rows, 1 dble dec once and 1 sgle dec 4 times, repeat the sequence in **bold** 2 more times, then 2 rows higher, 1 sgle dec once

1 sgle dec once, then every 2 rows, 1 dble dec once and 1 sgle dec 3 times, repeat the sequence in **bold** 3 more times

1 sgle dec once, then every 2 rows, 1 dble dec once and 1 sgle dec 3 times, repeat the sequence in **bold** 3 more times

Step 4: Meanwhile, when your work measures 35 - 39 - 43 - 46 - 50 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the armhole edge, bind off:

4 sts twice and 5 sts twice

5 sts 4 times

5 sts twice and 6 sts twice

6 sts 4 times

6 sts once and 7 sts 3 times

Step 5: Work the Left Front, reversing all shaping.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 47 - 53 - 55 - 59 - 63 sts and work in seed st (see STITCHES) for 1 cm.

Step 2: Change to fishnet st and in the 1st row, evenly increase 4 - 4 - 5 - 4 - 6 sts (see STITCHES and chart).

Total sts: 51 - 57 - 60 - 63 - 69 sts

Increase on each edge:

6 rows higher, inc 1 st once, every 4 rows, inc 1 st twice

8 rows higher, inc 1 st once, every 6 rows, inc 1 st twice

every 6 rows, inc 1 st 3 times, every 4 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

every 4 rows, inc 1 st 9 times

every 6 rows, inc 1 st twice, every 4 rows, inc 1 st 7 times

Total sts: 57 - 63 - 72 - 81 - 87 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 7 - 9,5 - 12 - 13 - 15 cm from the beginning, shape the slope. On each edge, bind off:

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice, 3 sts twice and 4 sts once

4 sts twice, 3 sts once, 2 sts once, 3 sts once and 4 sts twice

5 sts once, 4 sts twice, 3 sts once, 4 sts twice and 5 sts once

6 sts once, 5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 4 sts once, 5 sts once and 6 sts once

6 sts once, 5 sts once, 4 sts twice, 5 sts once and 6 sts twice

Step 4: Bind off the remaining 15 - 15 - 14 - 15 - 15 sts.

COLLAR

Work in 3 sections:

1st section

Step 1: Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 67 - 71 - 79 - 85 - 85 sts and work in K1/P1 rib, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2.

Step 2: When your work measures 5 cm from the beginning, shape the base of the collar. On each edge, bind off:

5 sts once and 6 sts twice

6 sts 3 times

6 sts twice and 7 sts once

7 sts once and 8 sts twice

7 sts once and 8 sts twice

Step 3: Bind off the remaining 33 - 35 - 37 - 39 - 39 sts.

2nd section

Step 1: Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 17 sts and work in K1/P1 rib, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2.

Step 2: 2 rows higher, on the right edge, bind off 4 sts 3 times.

Step 3: Bind off the remaining 5 sts.

Work the 3rd section, reversing all shaping.

POCKET

Step 1: Using 3.5 mm needles, cast on 17 - 19 - 19 - 21 - 21 sts and work 4 rows in seed st, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2.

Step 2: Change to stockinette st.

Step 3: When your work measures 9 - 10 - 10 - 11 - 11 cm from the beginning, bind off all the sts.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the seams for the shoulders, sides and sleeves.

Step 2: Join the sleeves to the body.

Step 3: Sew the 2 triangular parts of the collar along the neck on the front sections (see photo).

Step 4: Sew the collar around the neck up to the center of the triangle sides, using concealed stitching.

Step 5: Sew the pocket on the center of the Left Front and 5 cm below the armhole.

Step 6: Sew 4 - 4 - 5 - 5 - 5 buttons on the Right Front, 3 sts from the edge; sew the 1st button 1 cm below the neck and the following buttons at intervals of 6 - 7 - 6 - 6.5 - 8 cm.

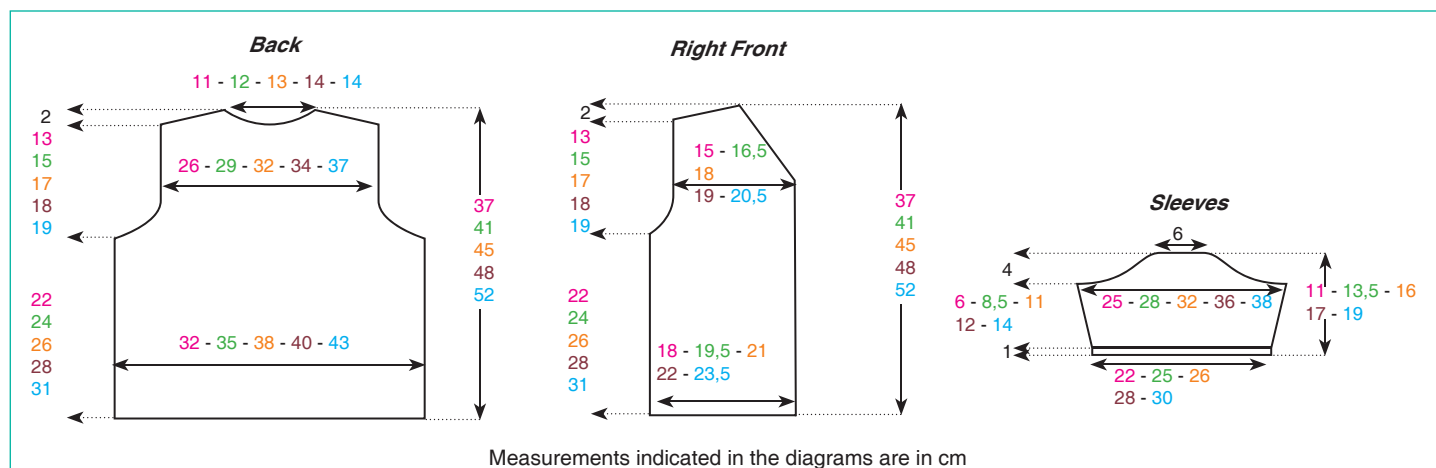
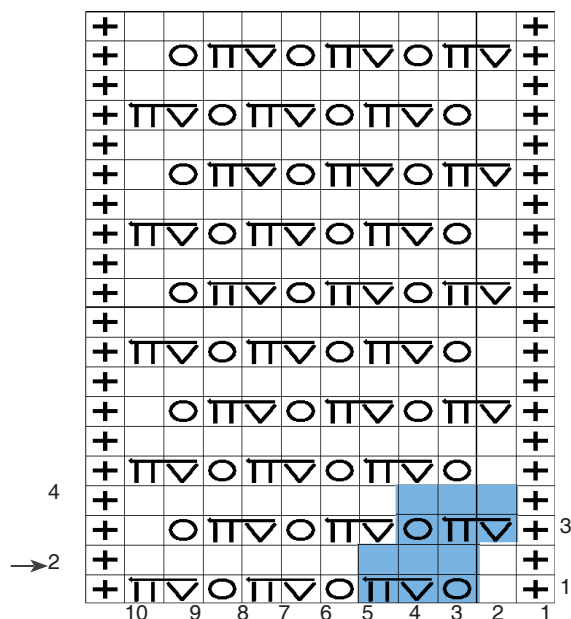


Chart for Fishnet st



Repeat the sts in the colored frame

Only work a yo if it is compensated for by a bind-off slip st

+ = selvsage st: work the 1st and last sts as they would be worked normally for the stitch.

□ = K1 (RS) or P1 (WS)

○ = yo

||| = sl1 knitwise (yarn behind the st), K2, pass the slipped st over the K2

Direction ← = uneven rows → = even rows
