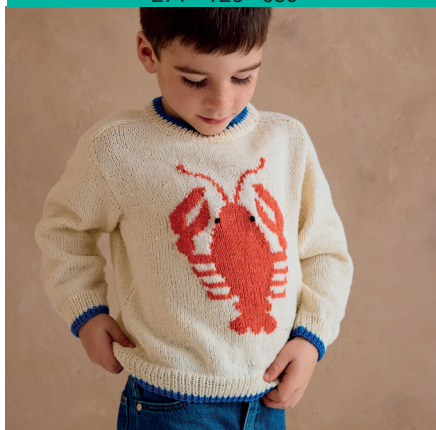

Intermediate level



Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

26 sts and 35 rows to 10 cm, measured over stockinette stitch or jacquard using 3 mm needles

YARN	COLOR	2 yrs	4 yrs	6 yrs	8 yrs	10 yrs

Composition: 57% cotton, 43% acrylic

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

1 pair each of 2.5 mm and 3 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

1 yarn needle

STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

Stockinette stitch

Jacquard: see charts

Satin stitch embroidery: see charts

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and OUTREMER, cast on 82 - 90 - 98 - 104 - 112 sts and work in K1/P1: work 2 rows in OUTREMER, then change to ECRU.

Step 2: When your work measures 4 cm from the beginning, change to 3 mm needles and stockinette st.

Step 3: When your work measures 21 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 30 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times.

Total sts: 66 - 74 - 82 - 88 - 96 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 29.5 - 33.5 - 37.5 - 40.5 - 44.5 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. On each edge, bind off:

4 sts 7 times

4 sts 5 times and 5 sts twice

4 sts twice and 5 sts 5 times

5 sts 7 times

5 sts 3 times and 6 sts 4 times

Step 5: When your work measures 33.5 - 37.5 - 41.5 - 44.5 - 48.5 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 10 - 14 - 16 - 18 - 18 sts.

FRONT

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and OUTREMER, cast on 82 - 90 - 98 - 104 - 112 sts and work in K1/P1: work 2 rows in OUTREMER, then change to ECRU.

Step 2: When your work measures 4 cm from the beginning, change to 3 mm needles and stockinette st.

Step 3: When your work measures 7 - 9 - 11 - 7 - 10 cm from the beginning, continue in stockinette st and jacquard (see charts) as follows. Work:

19 sts in stockinette st, the 44 sts in the chart and 19 sts in stockinette st

23 sts in stockinette st, the 44 sts in the chart and 23 sts in stockinette st

27 sts in stockinette st, the 44 sts in the chart and 27 sts in stockinette st

20 sts in stockinette st, the 64 sts in the chart and 20 sts in stockinette st

24 sts in stockinette st, the 64 sts in the chart and 24 sts in stockinette st.

Step 4: When your work measures 21 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 30 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times.

Total sts: 66 - 74 - 82 - 88 - 96 sts

Step 5: When your work measures 29.5 - 33.5 - 37.5 - 40.5 - 44.5 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. On each edge, bind off:

4 sts 4 times and 2 sts once

4 sts 5 times

4 sts twice and 5 sts 3 times

5 sts 5 times

5 sts twice, 6 sts twice and 7 sts once

At the same time as the 1st shoulder decrease, bind off the center 12 - 12 - 14 - 16 - 16 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off:

4 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once

5 sts once, 4 sts once and 2 sts once

5 sts once, 4 sts once and 2 sts once

5 sts once, 4 sts once and 2 sts once

5 sts once, 4 sts once and 2 sts once

Finish the other side of the neck.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and OUTREMER, cast on 52 - 54 - 56 - 58 - 62 sts and work in K1/P1: work 2 rows in OUTREMER, then change to ECRU.

Step 2: When your work measures 4 cm from the beginning, change to 3 mm needles and stockinette st.

Step 3: Increase on each edge:

every 12 rows, inc 1 st twice and every 10 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 9 times

every 6 rows, inc 1 st 8 times and every 8 rows, inc 1 st 5 times

every 6 rows, inc 1 st 9 times and every 8 rows, inc 1 st 6 times

every 6 rows, inc 1 st 7 times and every 8 rows, inc 1 st 9 times

Total sts: 62 - 72 - 82 - 88 - 94 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 22.5 - 27 - 31.5 - 35.5 - 39 cm from the beginning, shape the slope. On each edge, bind off:

3 sts twice, 2 sts once, 1 st 3 times, 2 sts once, 3 sts once and 4 sts once

4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts 4 times, 3 sts twice and 4 sts once

4 sts twice, 3 sts twice, 2 sts twice, 3 sts once, 4 sts once and 5 sts once

5 sts once, 4 sts twice, 3 sts once, 2 sts once, 3 sts twice, 4 sts once and 5 sts once

5 sts once, 4 sts twice, 3 sts 3 times, 4 sts once and 5 sts twice

Total sts: 22 sts

Step 5: Work on these 22 sts for 7.5 - 8.5 - 9.5 - 10 - 11.5 cm to shape the shoulder saddle, then on the right edge, bind off 6 sts once, 5 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st once.

Bind off the 3 remaining sts.

Work the Left Sleeve, reversing all shaping.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles and OUTREMER, cast on 110 - 114 - 120 - 124 - 124 sts and work in K1/P1: work 2 rows in OUTREMER, then change to ECRU.

Step 2: When your work measures 2.5 cm from the beginning, knit 1 row (RS) and work several rows of stockinette st in a different color.

Step 3: Sew the sleeve seams.

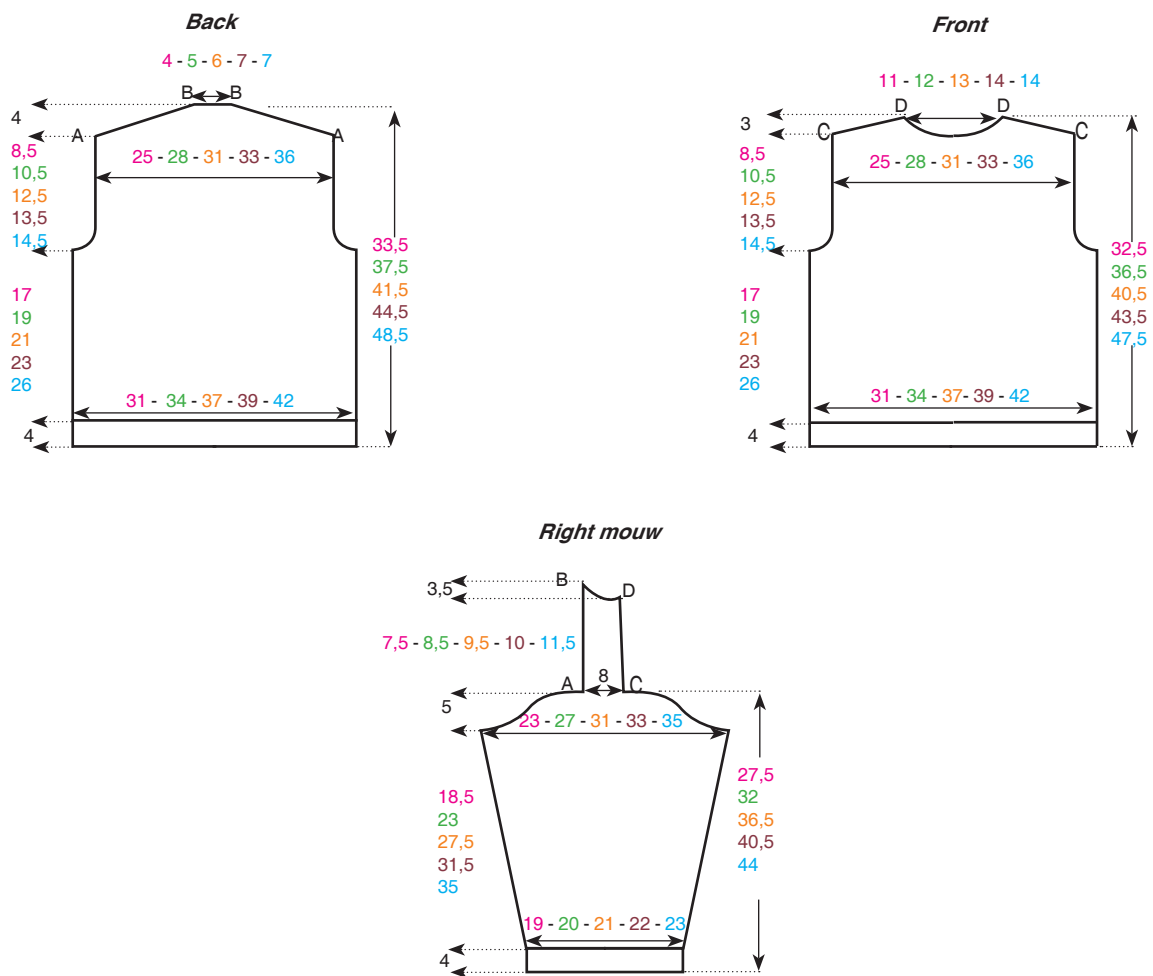
Step 4: Sew the side seams.

Step 5: Sew the neckband, matching sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work.

MAKE UP

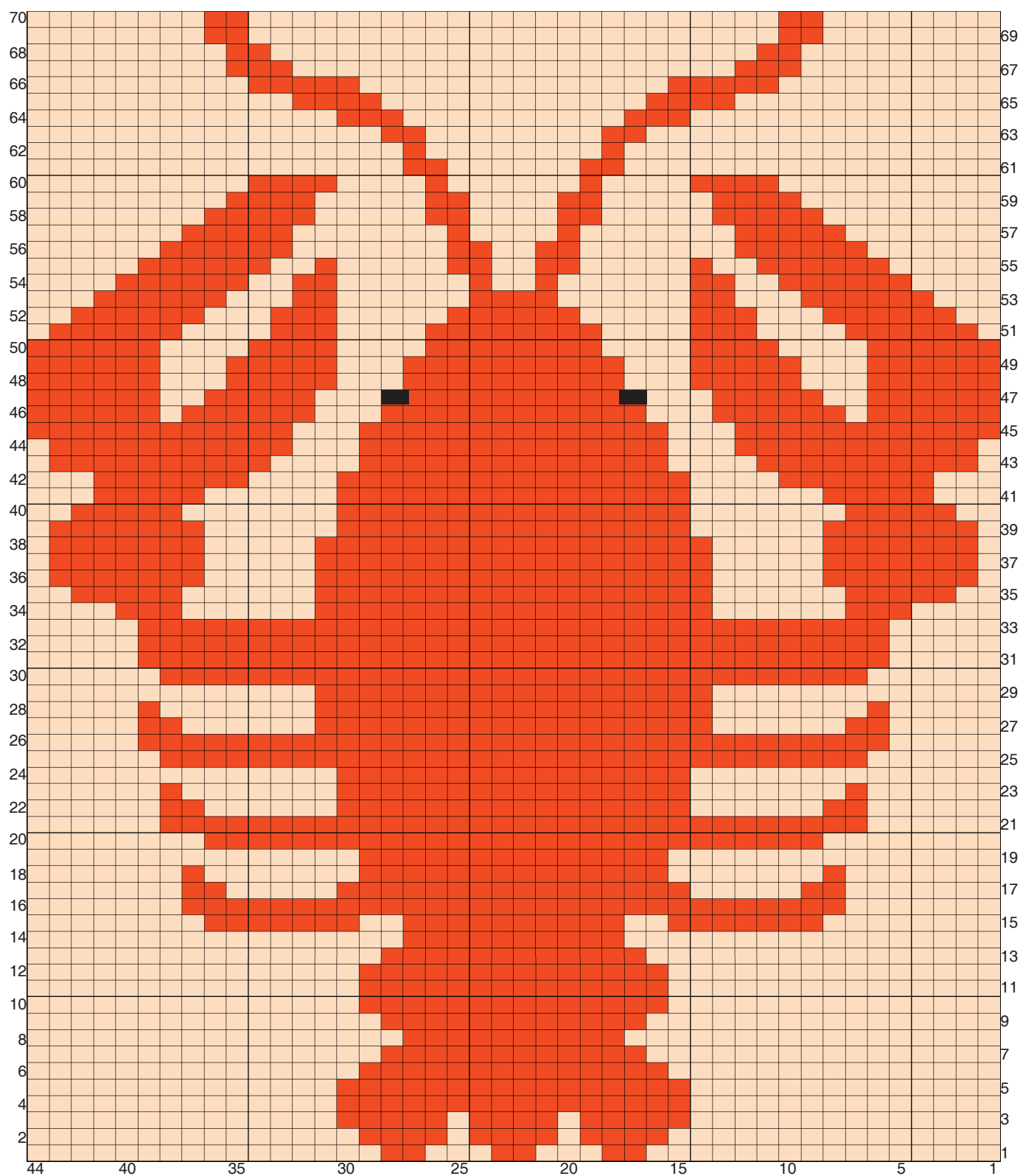
Step 1: Using NOIR, embroider the eyes in satin stitch (see the chart for how to place the embroidery).

Step 2: Join the sleeves to the body and the shoulder saddles between the Back and Front (see points A-B-C-D in the diagrams).



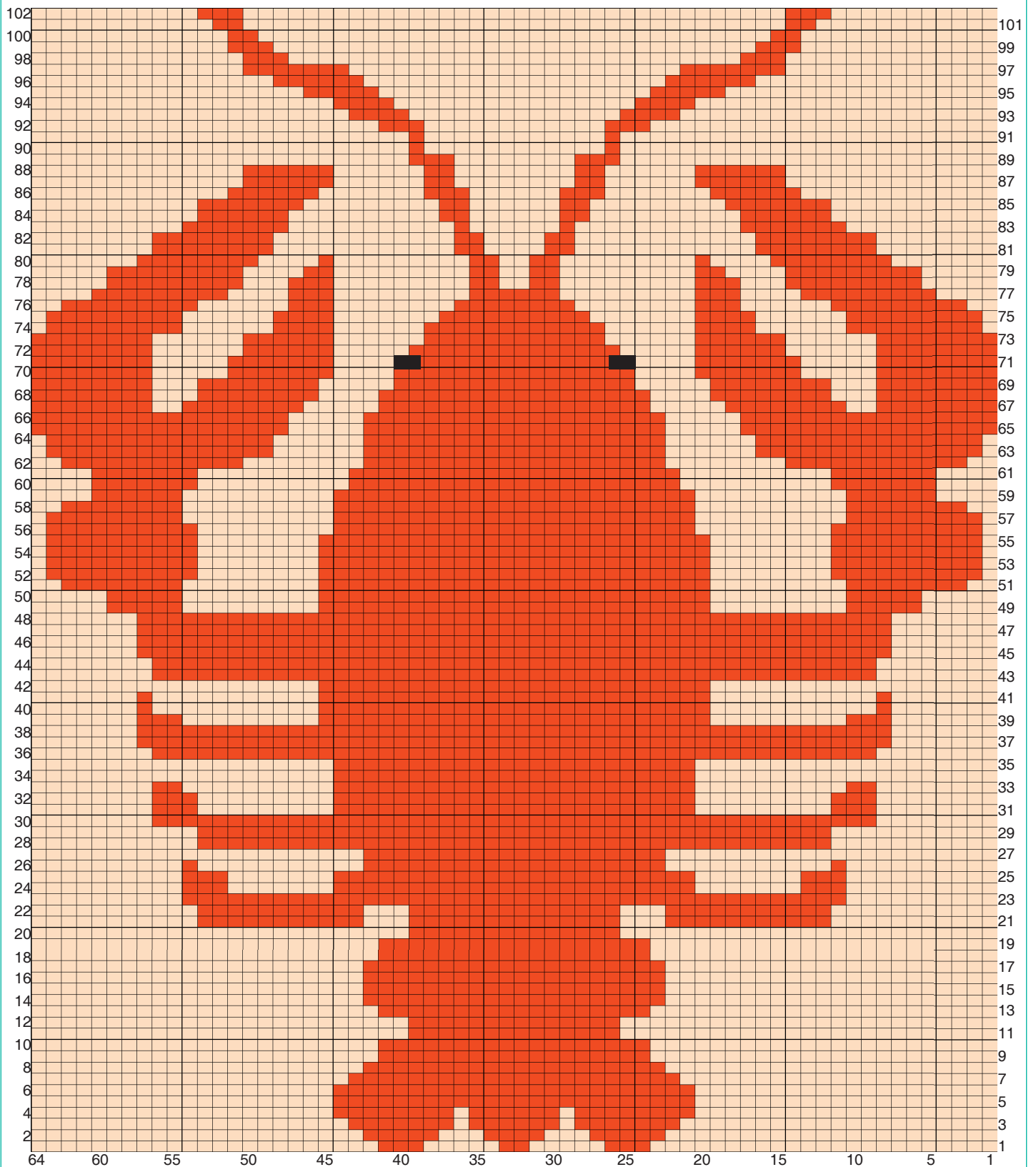
Measurements indicated in the diagrams are in cm
