

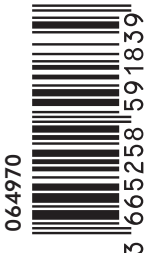

Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

20 sts and 29 rows to 10 cm, measured over stockinette stitch or intarsia jacquard using 1 strand of P. Coton 3 + 1 strand of P. Light Mohair and 4.5 mm needles

For this garment, you will need (for the number of balls):

Composition: 75% cotton, 10% acrylic, 7% polyamide, 4% mohair, 4% wool

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:
1 pair each of 4 mm and 4.5 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)
Stitch markers - 1 yarn needle
Jacquard bobbins

STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

Stockinette stitch

Jacquard (see charts)

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles and 1 strand of P. COTON 3 CRAIE + 1 strand of P. LIGHT MOHAIR CRAIE, cast on 66 - 72 - 78 - 82 - 88 sts work in K1/P1 rib for 4.5 cm.

Step 2: Change to 4.5 mm needles and jacquard (see charts).

Step 3: When your work measures 14 - 16 - 18 - 20 - 23 cm from the beginning, place a stitch marker on each edge (to indicate the armholes).

Step 4: When your work measures 25 - 29 - 33 - 36 - 40 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 8 - 10 - 12 - 14 - 14 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 5 sts twice.

Step 5: When your work measures 27 - 31 - 35 - 38 - 42 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 19 - 21 - 23 - 24 - 27 sts (for the shoulder).

Finish the other side of the neck.

FRONT

Step 1: Using 4 mm needles and 1 strand of P. COTON 3 CRAIE + 1 strand of P. LIGHT MOHAIR CRAIE, cast on 66 - 72 - 78 - 82 - 88 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 4.5 cm.

Step 2: Change to 4.5 mm needles and jacquard (see charts).

Step 3: When your work measures 14 - 16 - 18 - 20 - 23 cm from the beginning, place a stitch marker on each edge (to indicate the armholes).

Step 4: When your work measures 22 - 26 - 29 - 32 - 36 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 8 - 10 - 12 - 14 - 14 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once.

Step 5: When your work measures 27 - 31 - 35 - 38 - 42 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 19 - 21 - 23 - 24 - 27 sts (for the shoulder).

Finish the other side of the neck.

MAKE UP

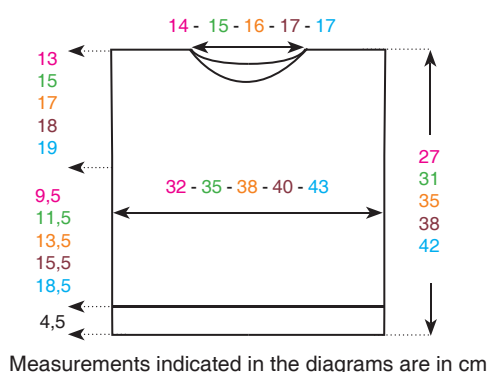
Step 1: Sew one shoulder seam.

Step 2: Neckline

Using 4 mm needles and 1 strand of P. COTON 3 CRAIE + 1 strand of P. LIGHT MOHAIR CRAIE, pick up 80 - 84 - 90 - 94 - 94 sts around the neck; work in K1/P1 rib for 2.5 cm, then bind off all the sts.

Step 3: Sew the 2nd shoulder seam, as well as the seams for the neck and sides.

Back and Front

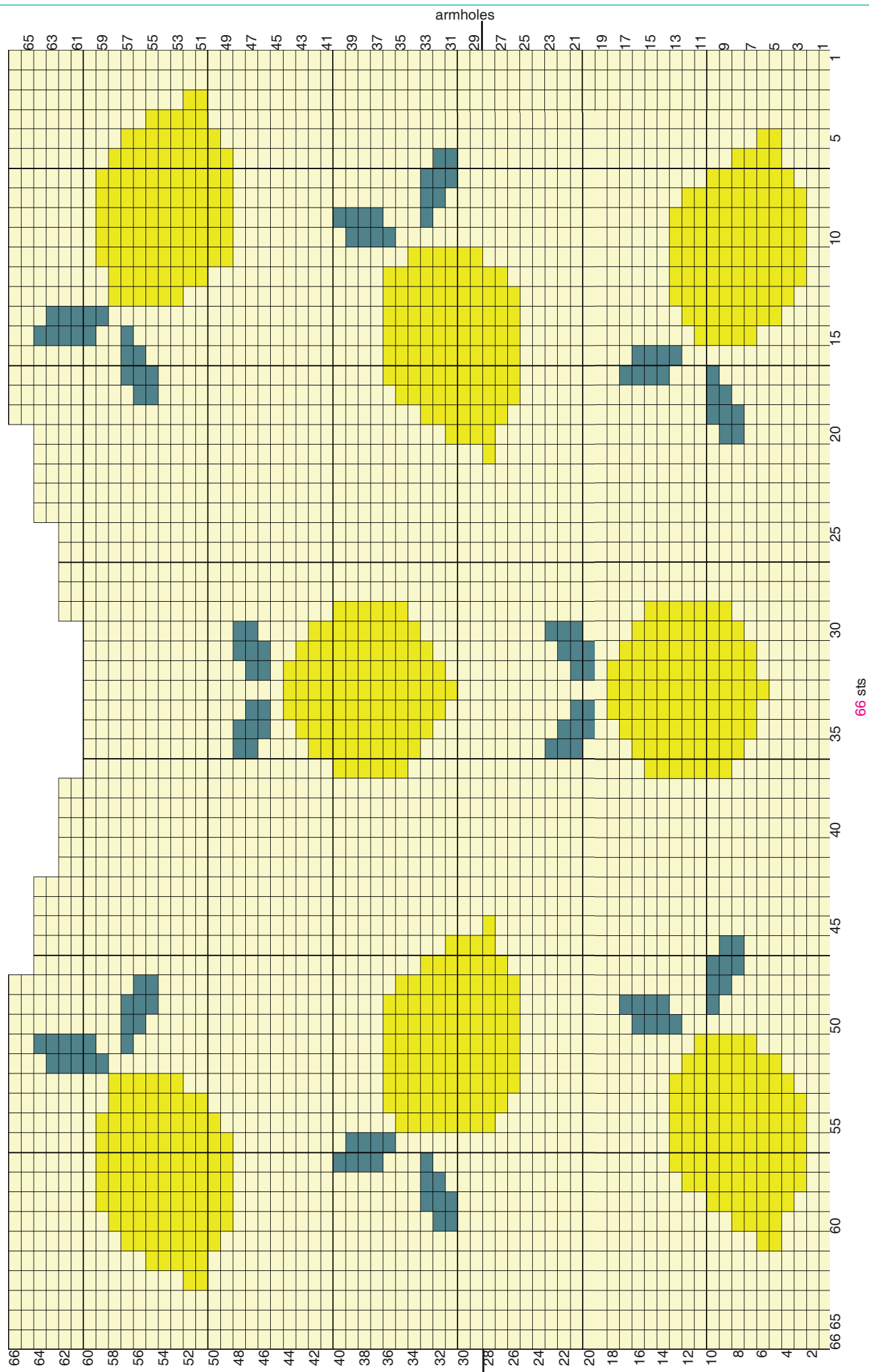


Chart for Back 4 - 6 years

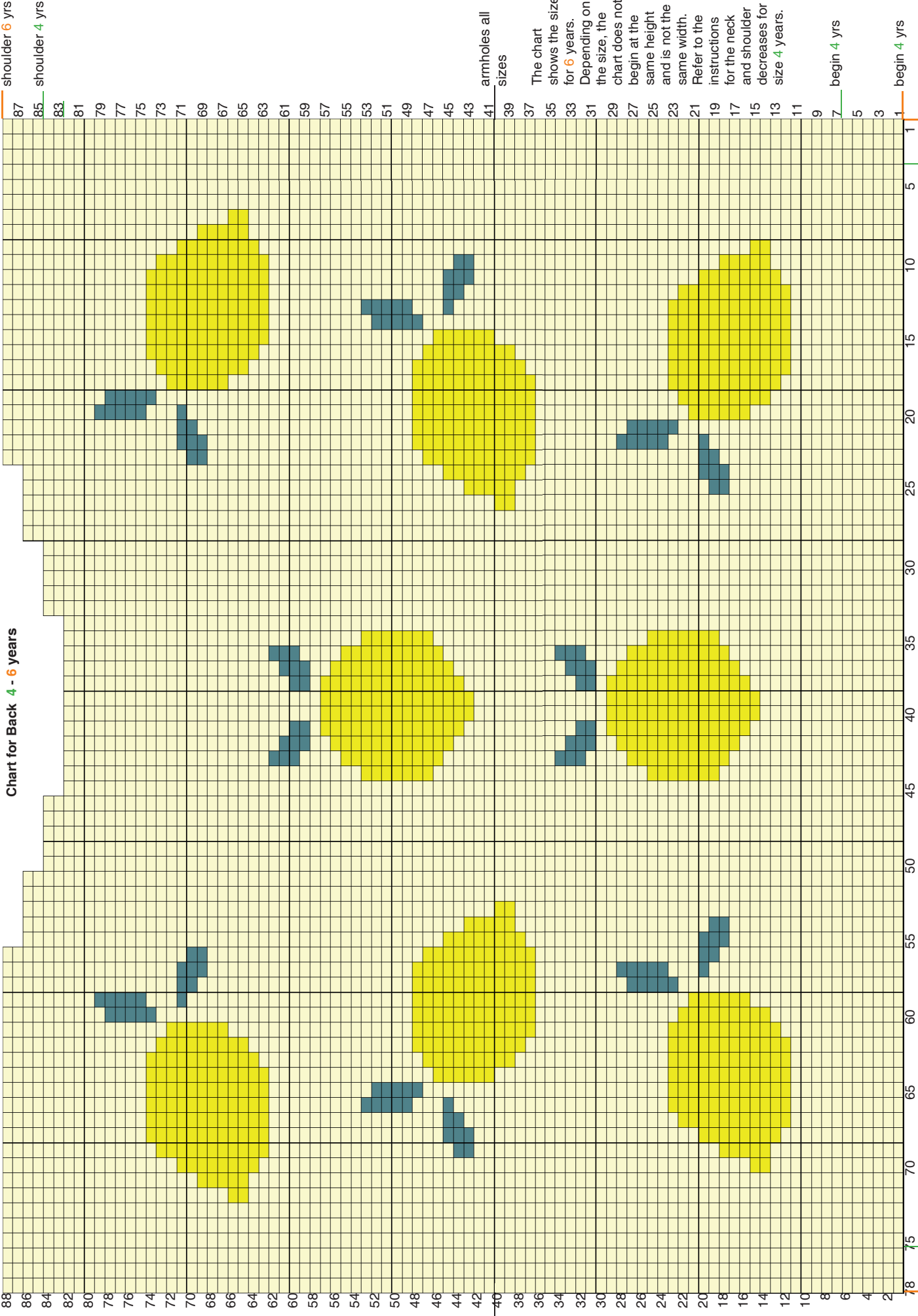
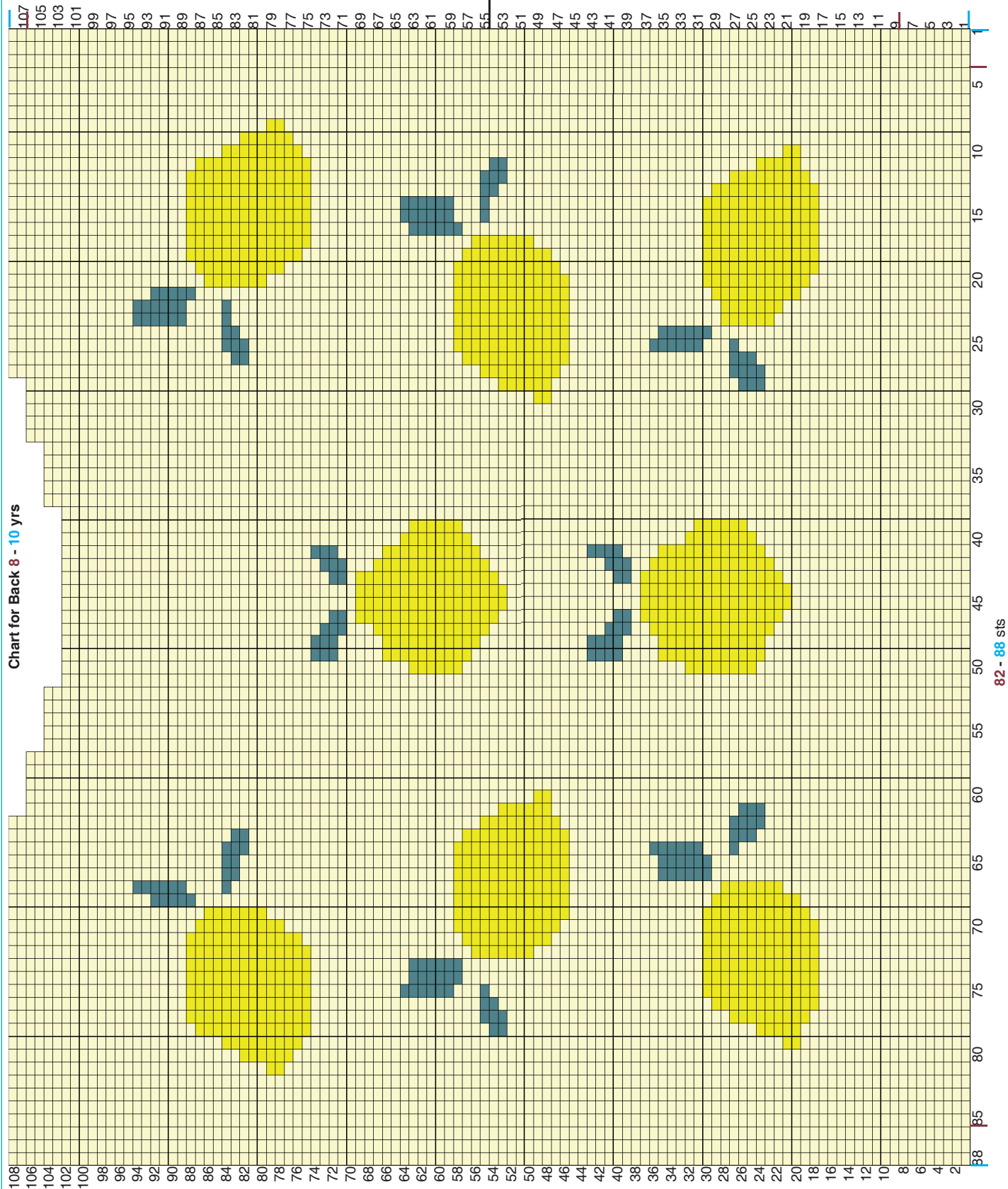


Chart for Back 8 - 10 yrs
