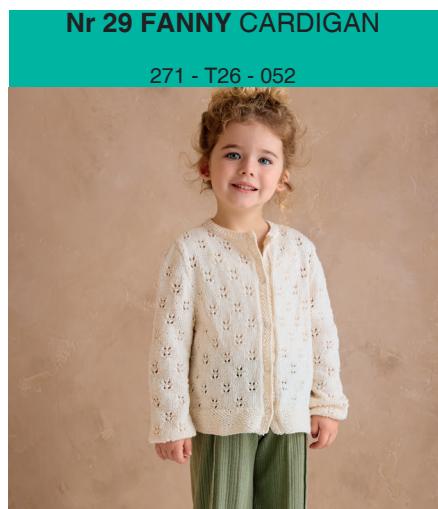

K1/P1 rib
Seed stitch

Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

27 sts and 37 rows to 10 cm, measured over pattern stitch using 2.5 mm needles

YARN	COLOR	2 yrs	4 yrs	6 yrs	8 yrs	10 yrs
P. SOFT COTTON	ECRU	3	4	4	5	6

Composition: 100% cotton

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

1 pair of 2.5 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

5 - 5 - 6 - 6 - 7 x 9 mm pearlized shank buttons, ref: 055150

Stitch markers

1 yarn needle

STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

Seed stitch: worked on an uneven number of sts

1st row: K1, P1, repeat the sequence in **bold**, then end with K1

2nd row: as for the 1st row

These 2 rows form the stitch (i.e. invert the sts in each row)

Pattern stitch (see chart)

Important: only work a yarn over if it is compensated for by a decrease, and vice versa

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 87 - 93 - 99 - 105 - 117 sts and work in seed st for 4 cm.

Step 2: Change to pattern st (see chart), beginning with 1 selvage st and the 9th - 6th - 3rd - 12th - 6th st in the chart (the 3rd st will be at the center of your work).

Step 3: When your work measures 19 - 21 - 23 - 25 - 28 cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off:

5 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once

5 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once

5 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once

5 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once

5 sts once, 4 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once

Total sts: 65 - 71 - 77 - 83 - 91 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 31 - 35 - 39 - 42 - 46 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulders. On each edge, bind off:

3 sts 4 times and 4 sts once

3 sts twice and 4 sts 3 times

4 sts 5 times

4 sts 4 times and 5 sts once

5 sts 5 times

At the same time as the 1st shoulder decrease, shape the neck. Bind off the center 17 - 19 - 21 - 21 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off:

3 sts twice and 2 sts once

3 sts 3 times

3 sts 3 times

4 sts once and 3 sts twice

4 sts once and 3 sts twice

RIGHT FRONT

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 42 - 46 - 48 - 52 - 58 sts and work in seed st for 4 cm.

Step 2: Change to pattern st (see chart); increase 1 - 1 st at the start of the 1st row and begin with 1 selvage st, K1 and the 6th st in the chart.

Total sts: 43 - 46 - 49 - 52 - 58 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 19 - 21 - 23 - 25 - 28 cm from the beginning, shape the armhole. On the left edge, bind off:

5 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once

5 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once

5 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once

5 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once

5 sts once, 4 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once

st once

Total sts: 32 - 35 - 38 - 41 - 45 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 29 - 33 - 36 - 39 - 43 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. On the right edge, bind off:

5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice

6 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st twice

6 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times

6 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st twice

6 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st twice

Step 5: When your work measures 31 - 35 - 39 - 42 - 46 cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the armhole edge, bind off:

3 sts 4 times and 4 sts once

3 sts twice and 4 sts 3 times

4 sts 5 times

4 sts 4 times and 5 sts once

5 sts 5 times

Work the Left Front, reversing all shaping and beginning the pattern st (see chart) with 1 selvage st and the 9th - 6th - 3rd - 12th - 6th st in the chart.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 46 - 50 - 52 - 54 - 58 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 1.5 cm, then purl 1 row (WS) and evenly increase 7 sts in this row.

Total sts: 53 - 57 - 59 - 61 - 65 sts

Step 2: Change to pattern st (see chart), beginning with K3 and the 4th st - K2 and the 1st st - K3 and the 1st st - K1 and the 10th st - K3 and the 10th st in the chart (the 3rd st will be at the center of your work).

Step 3: Increase on each edge (keeping the pattern st correct as far as possible):

every 22nd row, inc 1 st twice

18 rows higher, inc 1 st once, then every 16 rows, inc 1 st 3 times

every 16 rows, inc 1 st 5 times

every 14 rows, inc 1 st 7 times

every 14 rows, inc 1 st 7 times, then 12 rows higher, inc 1 st once

Total sts: 57 - 65 - 69 - 75 - 81 sts

Step 4: When your work measures 19.5 - 23.5 - 27.5 - 31 - 34.5 cm from the beginning, shape the slope. On each edge, bind off:

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 5 times, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times, on the next rows, bind off 1 st 5 times and 3 sts once

3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 4 times, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times, on the next rows, bind off 1 st 4 times, 2 sts twice and 3 sts once 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 5 times, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times, on the next rows, bind off 1 st 5 times, 2 sts twice and 3 sts once 3 sts once, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 5 times, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times, on the next rows, bind off 1 st 6 times, 2 sts twice and 3 sts once 3 sts once, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st 6 times, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times, on the next rows, bind off 1 st 6 times, 2 sts 3 times and 3 sts once

Step 5: Bind off the remaining 15 sts.

Work the other sleeve in the same way.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 95 - 101 - 111 - 117 - 117 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 1 cm, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2. Then work several rows of stockinette st in a different color.

BUTTON BANDS

Step 1: Using 2.5 mm needles, cast on 93 - 105 - 115 - 121 - 135 sts and work in seed st for 1.5 cm. Then work several rows of stockinette st in a different color.

Step 2: Work another band in the same way.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the seams for the shoulders and sides.

Step 2: Sew the sleeve seams.

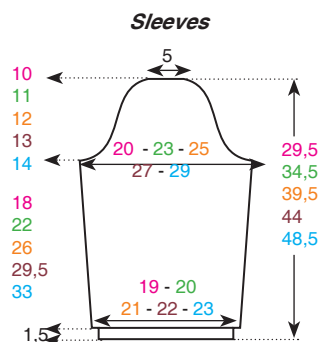
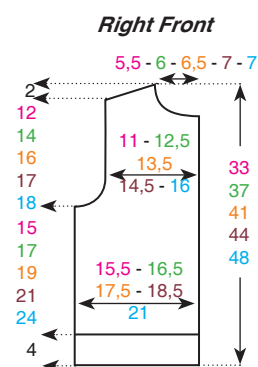
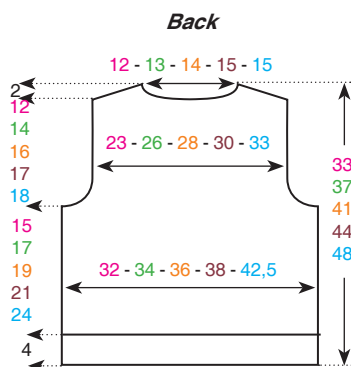
Step 3: Join the sleeves to the body.

Step 4: Sew the neckband, matching sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work.

Step 5: Sew the button bands along the front sections, matching sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work.

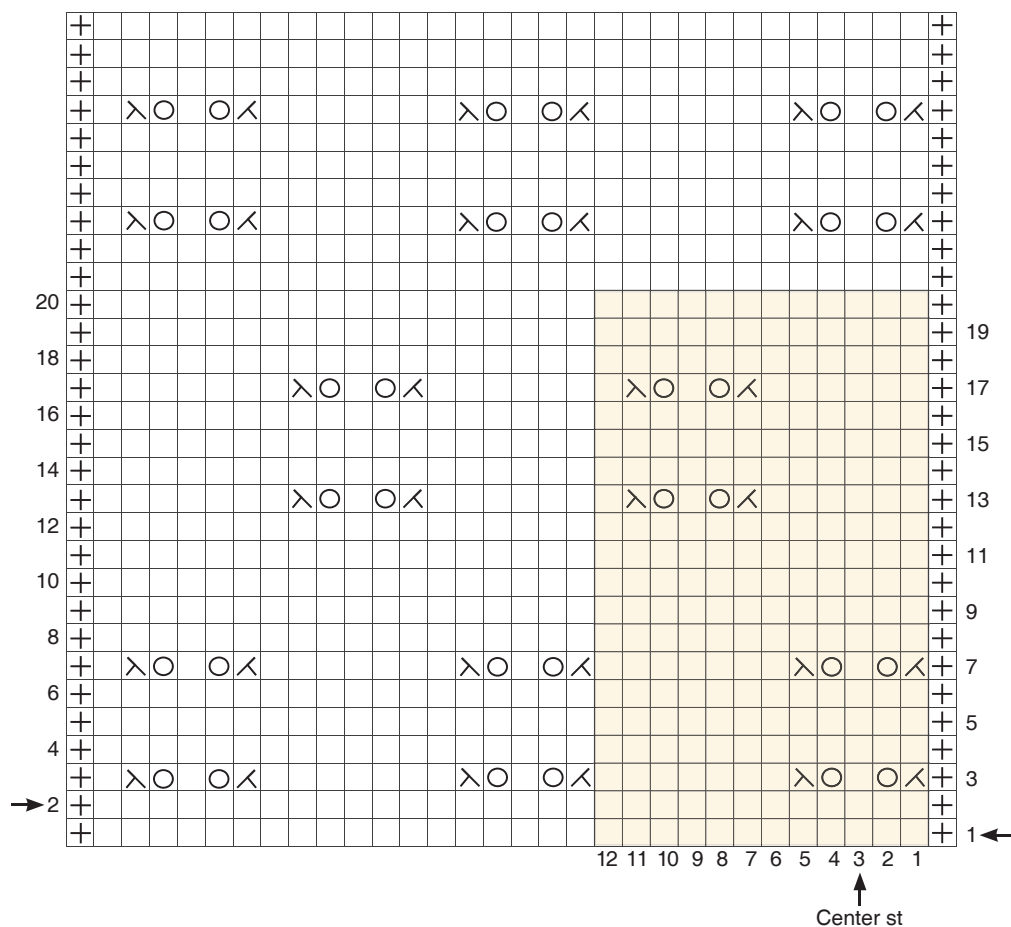
Step 6: Make 5 - 5 - 6 - 6 - 7 buttonholes along the Right Front. Make the 1st buttonhole 1 cm from the neck edge and the following buttonholes at intervals of 6 - 7 - 6.5 - 7 - 6.5 cm.

Step 7: Sew the buttons.

Repeat the 12 sts and 20 rows in the colored frame

important: only work a yarn over if it is compensated for by a decrease, and vice versa

→ = direction

⊕ = selvage st (work the first and last sts as they would normally be worked in the stitch)

□ = K1 (RS) or P1 (WS)

○ = yo

⋈ = K2tog

λ = SKP (sl1, K1, then pass the slipped st over)
