Intermediate level



Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

28 sts and 53 rows to 10 cm measured over seed stitch using 3 mm needles

YARN	COLOR	2 yrs	4 yrs	6 yrs	8 yrs	10 yrs

Composition: 70% acrylic, 30% lambswool

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

1 pair 3 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

Stitch markers - Yarn needle

1 x 9 mm pearlized shank button, ref: 055150

STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

Seed stitch

Work on an uneven number of sts

Row 1: K1, P1, repeat the sequence in **bold**, end with K1

Row 2: As for Row 1

These 2 rows form the stitch (i.e. alternate the sts in each row)

Frill: Work on an even number of sts

Row 1 (RS): knit all the sts

Row 2 (WS): purl all the sts

Row 3: K1, then K2tog to the last st and K1

Row 4: P1, then P2tog to the last st and P1

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and ROSE POUDRE, cast on **88 - 96 - 104 - 110 - 118** sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 1.5 cm.

Step 2: Change to seed st (see STITCHES) and increase 1 st at the beginning of the 1st row.

Total: **89 - 97 - 105 - 111 - 119** sts

Step 3: When your work measures **18 - 20 - 22 - 24 - 27** cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off:

4 sts once and 2 sts twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

4 sts once and 2 sts twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

4 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st once, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

4 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st once, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

4 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

Total: **69 - 77 - 83 - 89 - 95** sts

Step 4: When your work measures **27 - 31 - 35 - 38 - 42** cm from the beginning, form the slit. Bind off the center st, then continue on 1 side at a time on the first **34 - 38 - 41 - 44 - 47** sts.

Step 5: When your work measures **30 - 34 - 38 - 41 - 45** cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the armhole edge, bind off:

3 sts 5 times and 4 sts once

3 sts twice and 4 sts 4 times

3 sts once and 4 sts 5 times

4 sts 5 times and 5 sts once

4 sts twice and 5 sts 4 times

At the same time as the 1st shoulder decrease, shape the neck. On the slit edge, bind off:

6 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st once

7 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st once

7 sts once, 5 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

8 sts once, 5 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

8 sts once, 5 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once

Then finish the other side.

FRONT

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and ROSE POUDRE, cast on **88 - 96 - 104 - 110 - 118** sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 1.5 cm.

Step 2: Change to seed st (see STITCHES) and increase 1 st at the beginning of the 1st row.

Total: **89 - 97 - 105 - 111 - 119** sts

Step 3: When your work measures **18 - 20 - 22 - 24 - 27** cm from the beginning, shape the armholes. On each edge, bind off:

4 sts once and 2 sts twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

4 sts once and, 2 sts twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

4 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st once, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

4 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st once, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

4 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

Total: **69 - 77 - 83 - 89 - 95** sts

Step 4: When your work measures **28 - 32 - 35 - 38 - 42** cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center **11 - 13 - 13 - 15 - 15** sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off:

4 sts once and 2 sts twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

4 sts once and 2 sts twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice

3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times

3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times

3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st twice, then every 4 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times

Step 5: When your work measures **30 - 34 - 38 - 41 - 45** cm from the beginning, shape the shoulder. On the armhole edge, bind off:

3 sts 5 times and 4 sts once

3 sts twice and 4 sts 4 times

3 sts once and 4 sts 5 times

4 sts 5 times and 5 sts once

4 sts twice and 5 sts 4 times

Finish the other side.

SLEEVES

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and ROSE POUDRE, cast on **52 - 54 - 56 - 60 - 62** sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 1.5 cm.

Step 2: Change to seed st (see STITCHES) and increase 1 st at the beginning of the 1st row.

Total: **53 - 55 - 57 - 61 - 63** sts

Step 3: Increase on each edge (keeping the seed st correct as you increase):

24 rows higher, inc 1 st once, then every 22 rows, inc 1 st twice

every 16 rows, inc 1 st 6 times

every 16 rows, inc 1 st 3 times, then every 14 rows, inc 1 st 5 times

every 18 rows, inc 1 st 4 times, then every 16 rows, inc 1 st 4 times

every 16 rows, inc 1 st 8 times, then every 14 rows, inc 1 st twice

Total: **59 - 67 - 73 - 77 - 83** sts

Step 4: When your work measures **18.5 - 22.5 - 26.5 - 30 - 33.5** cm from the beginning, shape the slope. On each edge, bind off:

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once,

every 6 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times, every 4 rows, bind off 1 st twice and on

the following rows, bind off 1 st 3 times, 2 sts once and 3 sts once

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 5 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once,

every 6 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once and on

the following rows, bind off 1 st 6 times, 2 sts once and 3 sts once

3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 5 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, every 6 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st twice and on the following rows, bind off 1 st 8 times, 2 sts once and 3 sts once
 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 7 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, every 6 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once and on the following rows, bind off 1 st 9 times, 2 sts once and 3 sts once
 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st 9 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once, every 6 rows, bind off 1 st 3 times, 4 rows higher, bind off 1 st once and on the following rows, bind off 1 st 10 times, 2 sts once and 3 sts once

Step 5: Bind off the remaining 15 sts.

Make the other sleeve in the same way.

BOTTOM FRILL

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and CYGNE, cast on 354 - 386 - 418 - 442 - 474 sts and work the frill according to the instructions in STITCHES:
 Once the 4 rows have been worked, 90 - 98 - 106 - 112 - 120 sts remain.

Step 2: Work 8 rows in st st, then bind off all the sts.

Make another frill in the same way.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and ROSE POUDRE, cast on 95 - 101 - 111 - 117 - 117 sts and work 2 rows in K1/P1 rib, beginning and ending the 1st row with K2.

Step 2: Knit 1 row on the right side, then work several rows of st st in yarn of a different color.

NECK FRILL

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and CYGNE, cast on 338 - 362 - 402 - 426 - 426 sts and work the frill according to the instructions in STITCHES.
 Once the 4 rows have been worked, 86 - 92 - 102 - 108 - 108 sts remain.

Step 2: Work 4 rows in st st, then bind off all the sts.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Sew the seams for the shoulders and sides.

Step 2: Sew the sleeve seams.

Step 3: Join the sleeves to the body.

Step 4: Join the neckband, matching the sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work.

Step 5: Position the last 3 rows of st st on the bottom frill under the 3 rows of K1/P1 rib and sew using concealed stitching.

Step 6: Sew the frill under the neckband in the same way.

Step 7: Make a button loop at the top of the slit.

Step 8: Sew the button opposite the button loop.
