STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib - Stockinette stitch (st st)

Jacquard - Garter stitch

Single decrease at 1 st from the edge

Double decrease at 1 st from the edge

Stem stitch embroidery

Intermediate level



Back-and-forth knitting

TENSION SQUARE

23 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm measured over stockinette stitch using 3.5 mm needles

Composition: 50% wool, 50% acrylic

MATERIALS:

In the PPY range:

1 pair each of 3 mm and 3.5 mm knitting needles (or other, depending on your tension square)

Yarn needle

STITCHES:

K1/P1 rib

Stockinette stitch (st st)

Jacquard (see chart)

Garter stitch

Single decrease at 1 st from the edge:

On the right: K1, then K2tog

On the left: work to the last 3 sts, then SKP (sl1 knitwise, K1, pss0) and K1

Double decrease at 1 st from the edge:

On the right: K1, then K3tog

On the left: work to the last 4 sts, then SK2P (sl1 knitwise, K2tog, pss0) and K1

Stem stitch embroidery

INSTRUCTIONS

Follow the instructions in the color that corresponds to the size you are knitting.

BACK

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and BURGUNDY, cast on 76 - 82 - 90 - 94 - 100 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 3 cm.

Step 2: Change to 3.5 mm needles and st st.

Step 3: When your work measures 21 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 30 cm from the beginning, start to shape the raglan. On each edge, bind off 2 sts once, then every 2 rows, decrease at 1 st from each edge (see STITCHES) as follows:
sgle dec twice and dble dec once, sgle dec 3 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 2 more times, then sgle dec twice
sgle dec 5 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 2 more times, then sgle dec twice
sgle dec 6 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 2 more times, then sgle dec twice
sgle dec 10 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 1 more time, then sgle dec 3 times
sgle dec 5 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 3 more times, then sgle dec twice

Step 4: When your work measures 33 - 37 - 41 - 44 - 48 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 30 - 32 - 34 - 36 - 36 sts.

FRONT

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and BURGUNDY, cast on 76 - 82 - 90 - 94 - 100 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 3 cm.

Step 2: Change to 3.5 mm needles, work in st st and jacquard (see chart).

Step 3: When your work measures 15.5 - 17.5 - 19.5 - 21.5 - 25 cm from the beginning, continue in jacquard (see chart) as follows: 11 - 14 - 18 - 20 - 23 sts in BURGUNDY, the 54 sts in the chart and 11 - 14 - 18 - 20 - 23 sts in BURGUNDY.

Step 4: When your work measures 21 - 23 - 25 - 27 - 30 cm from the beginning, start to shape the raglan. On each edge, bind off 2 sts once, then every 2 rows, decrease at 1 st from each edge (see STITCHES) as follows:
sgle dec twice and dble dec once, sgle dec 3 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 2 more times
sgle dec 5 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 2 more times
sgle dec 6 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 2 more times
sgle dec 10 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 1 more time, then sgle dec once
sgle dec 5 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 3 more times

Step 5: When your work measures 29.5 - 33.5 - 36.5 - 39.5 - 43.5 cm from the beginning, shape the neck. Bind off the center 10 - 12 - 14 - 16 - 16 sts, then finish 1 side at a time. On the neck edge, bind off:

5 sts once and 4 sts once

5 sts once and 4 sts once

3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st once

3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st once

3 sts twice, 2 sts once and 1 st once

Step 6: When your work measures 32 - 36 - 40 - 43 - 47 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 3 sts.

Finish the other side of the neck.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and BURGUNDY, cast on 46 - 48 - 50 - 52 - 54 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 3 cm.

Step 2: Change to 3.5 mm needles and st st; increase on each edge:

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 5 times, then every 6 rows, inc 1 st twice

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 4 times, then every 6 rows, inc 1 st 5 times

every 6 rows, inc 1 st 12 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st twice, then every 6 rows, inc 1 st 11 times

every 8 rows, inc 1 st 2 twice, then every 6 rows, inc 1 st 13 times

Total: 60 - 66 - 74 - 78 - 84 sts

Step 3: When your work measures 9 - 10 - 11 - 12 - 14 cm from the beginning, knit 2 rows in garter st using BLANC, 6 rows in st st using BURGUNDY, 2 rows in garter st using BLANC, then continue in st st using BURGUNDY.

Step 4: When your work measures 22 - 25.5 - 29 - 32.5 - 36.5 cm from the beginning, start to shape the raglan. On each edge, bind off 2 sts once, then every 2 rows, decrease at 1 st from each edge (see STITCHES) as follows:
sgle dec twice, dble dec once, sgle dec 3 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 2 more times
sgle dec 5 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 2 more times
sgle dec 6 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 2 more times
sgle dec 10 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 1 more time, then sgle dec once
sgle dec 5 times and dble dec once, repeat the sequence in bold 3 more times

Step 5: On the right edge, bind off:

7 sts once and 6 sts once

8 sts once and 7 sts once

9 sts once and 8 sts once

10 sts once and 9 sts once

10 sts once and 9 sts once

At the same time, decrease at 1 st from the left edge: sgle dec once, then 2 rows higher, sgle dec once.

Step 6: When your work measures 34 - 39.5 - 45 - 49.5 - 54.5 cm from the beginning, bind off the remaining 3 sts.

Make the other sleeve, reversing the shaping.

NECKBAND

Step 1: Using 3 mm needles and BURGUNDY, cast on 104 - 108 - 114 - 118 - 118 sts and work in K1/P1 rib for 3.5 cm, then knit 1 row on the right side and work several rows of st st in yarn of a different color.

MAKE UP

Step 1: Using ANTHRACITE, outline the letters in stem stitch embroidery (see photo).

Step 2: Join the sleeves to the body via the raglan (the shortest side matches to the front).

Step 3: Sew the side seams.

Step 4: Sew the sleeve seams.

Step 5: Join the neckband, matching the sts and using backstitch on the right side of your work.
